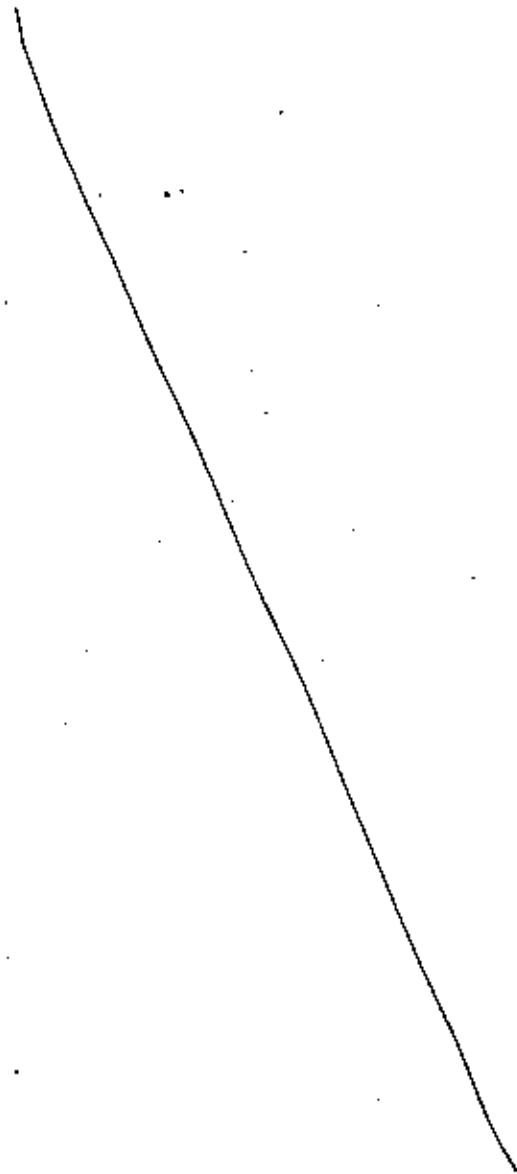

The point-wise comments are as follows.

PART – I

Point no. 11

(a) Books: The latest edition (12th Ed.2011) of reference book "Goodman and Gilman's the pharmacological basis of therapeutics is not available.

(b) Journals: Only one foreign Journal related with pharmacology is subscribed. The printed journal related with pharmacology from January 2011 onward are not available. E journals subscribed have only one pharmacology journal and it is same which is available in printed form.

Point no. 13:

(a) Insitutional Animal Ethics Committee (IAEC): The constitution of committee is not as per norms as there is not any member from CPCSEA while **four members should be nominated by CPCSEA** (Committee for Control and Supervision of Experiments on Animals).

(b) Institutional ethics committee (IEC): The constitution of committee is not as per norms as chairman is from the institute. The **chairman of IEC should be from outside the institute** as per clinical trial and national guidelines norms.

Point no. 14: The workshop on medical education technology was conducted and it was **in absence of MCI Observer** or Observer from the MCI recognized Regional Centre (Gandhi medical college, Secunderabad).

Point no. 17: Currently, the registration of central animal house is expired and it is not renewed.

PART – II

Teaching staff: Please note the following.

(a) Appointment order (Encl. 3 of Declaration form): Appoint order of most of the teachers does not show the nature of appointment (regular or contract). It does not reveal their salary or the pay scale at the time of appointment.

(b) Address proof (Encl. 4 of Declaration Form): Address proof attached for most of the teachers is the postpaid mobile connection certificate and not the


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bill, and date of issue is missing. Such proof is not satisfactory as it is not the phone bill and does not show the exact address.

(c) **Recognized PG teacher:** The certificate showing the name of recognized teacher for MD (pharmacology) is not available.

(d) **Others:**

- The age of most of the senior faculty is more than 60 years.
- Keeping in mind the long experience except Prof and HOD the other professors have no publication in their entire career. Associate professor has only two publications in his entire career.

Medium sized **kymographs** required for PG experiments are not available- There should be at least four (4) medium sized kymographs for *in vitro* exercises.


Physiographs are not available - There should be at least four (4) physiographs for long experiments (*in vivo* exercises).

(b) For teaching UG experiments neither computer simulated model nor the animal are used. Permission was not taken from CPCSEA to use animals for demonstration purpose though there is animal house.
