5. Policy development, coordination for furtherance of medical education by establishing task forces and consortiums.
6. Developing system of assessment/testing e.g. programme evaluation student evaluation and faculty evaluation.
7. Developing communication links e.g. newsletter, network etc.
8. Instructional design-developing curricula and providing guidelines for implementing these.

Medical Education Technology Unit has conducted a **Faculty Development Programme Workshop** on 12<sup>th</sup>, 13<sup>th</sup> & 14<sup>th</sup> of December 2011 and imparted training for 20 freshly recruited Faculty Members of this Medical College. Dr. David SA Kumar, Professor of Physiology has attended as a special invitee and Resource Person.
