Medical Education Unit is established as per the Medical Council of India circular keeping in view of the following objectives:



Special emphasis is laid on preparing self-learning modules and packages for providing clinical skills to the students.
3. To act as resource centre for educational materials and information and audio-visual media support.
4. To help in continuing Medical Education of private practitioners.

5. Policy development, coordination for furtherance of medical education by establishing task forces and consortiums.
6. Developing system of assessment/testing e.g. programme evaluation student evaluation and faculty evaluation.
7. Developing communication links e.g. newsletter, network etc.
8. Instructional design-developing curricula and providing guidelines for implementing these.
9. Horizontal Integrated Teaching for MBBS Students.
10. Vertical Interaction for Postgraduate Students.


