**Minutes of the 9<sup>th</sup> Meeting of the Board of Governors dated 25.6.2013.**

The 9<sup>th</sup> Meeting of the Board of Governors was held on 25.6.2013 at 11.00 a.m. in the Council's Chamber at Sector-8, Pocket 14, Dwarka, New Delhi-110077, under the Chairmanship of Dr. R.K. Srivastava, Chairman, Board of Governors. The following members of the Board of Governors attended the meeting :

2. Leave of absence was granted to Dr. K.S. Sharma, Member.

3. At the outset, the Chairman welcomed the Members of BOG. Thereafter, he desired that a List of all pending cases pertaining to the Medical Colleges, Division-wise, which require BOGs' decision be placed before the BOG so that the BOG could prepare a proper plan for ensuring disposal of those cases in time.

3. The following items, as per Agenda circulated, were considered by the Board of Governors and decision taken thereon as under :

**Item No. 1 : Status of consideration of Inspection Reports for establishment of new Medical Colleges (for MBBS seats)/Inspection Report for recognition of MBBS seats/Inspection Reports for renewal of permission :**

The Item was considered and decisions of the BOG are as mentioned at Annexure-A.

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**Item No.2 : Deferred cases of Medical Colleges due to Tehalka issue.**

The Colleges involved are (1) Santosh Medical College, Ghaziabad; (2) Subharati Medical College (Recognized); (3) School of Medical Sciences & Research, Greater NOIDA, (4) Saraswathi Institute of Medical Sciences, Hapur; (5) SGT Medical College, Gurgaon; and (6) Rama Medical College, Hapur. The matter was discussed in detail and the following decisions were taken :

- (1) Letter received from the Ministry of Health & Family Welfare be suitably replied to, mentioning the rule position.
- (2) CVO was requested to ascertain from CBI about any pending investigation enquiry against the above Colleges.
- (3) Secretary to put up a detailed note regarding earlier decision, chronological events and all supporting documents from relevant sections.

**Item No. 3 : Deferred cases of Medical Colleges due to CBI Report :**

(i) Melmaruvathur Adhiparashakti Institute of Medical Sciences & Research

It was noted that the issue of show cause notice emanated from the CBI enquiry was considered in the past by the BOGs and, on the basis of recommendations of the Ethics Committee, penalties were also imposed on the fake faculties who had presented themselves before the MCI Inspection Team, as per CBI Report. Regarding the second part of action against the College for deploying fake faculties, this matter was also considered in the past, by the BOG's sub-Committee headed by Dr. K. Mohandas, which recommended action to be taken against the College under Section 8(3)(1)(d) of the IMC Act, 1956, i.e., debaring the College from admission of Students during this Academic Year and next Academic Year. After some discussion it was decided to debar the College, accordingly.

(ii) Sri Satya Sai Medical College & Research Institute

It was noted that the issue of show cause notice emanated from the CBI enquiry was considered in the past by the BOGs and referred to Ethics Committee, for recommendation on action to be taken against the fake faculties members, who presented themselves before the MCI Inspection Team as regular faculty members of

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the College, as per the CBI's Report. It was informed that the Ethics Committee is scheduled to discuss the matter at its meeting on 28.6.2013. Therefore, it was advised that the matter be resubmitted to the BOG immediately on receipt of Ethics Committee's recommendation. Further, it may be ascertained from CBI whether there are any pending investigation against the College with the CBI.

**Item No.4 : Deferred items of Approval of PG Committee minutes**

The Item was considered and decisions of the BOG are as mentioned at Annexure-B.

**Item No.5 : Finalization of Guidelines for drafting curriculum in PDCC Courses :**

It was decided that a presentation would be made on PDCC Courses after 15<sup>th</sup> July, 2013.

- 1) **Increase of seats in DM(Cardiology) course at Andhra Medical College, Visakhapatnam under Dr. NTR University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada u/s 10A of the IMC Act, .**

The Board of Governors reviewed the matter and decided to approve increase of seats with an annual intake of 01(one) to 02(two) seats in DM (Cardiology) course.

2. **Starting of M.Ch.(Neuro Surgery) course at Bangalore Medical College and Research Institute, Bangalore under Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences, Karnataka u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.**

The Board of Governors reviewed the matter and decided to approve annual intake of 02(two) seats per year for starting of M.Ch.(Neuro Surgery) course.

3. **Starting of DM(Cardiology) course at Bangalore Medical College and Research Institute, Bangalore under Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences, Karnataka u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.**

The Board of Governors reviewed the matter and decided not to approve starting of DM(Cardiology) course due to inadequate infrastructure and inadequate clinical material. The Institute may be directed to appear for personal hearing before Board of Governors, MCI in case they want to submit an explanation in this regard.

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4. **Starting of M.Ch.(CTVS) course at Bangalore Medical College and Research Institute, Bangalore under Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences, Karnataka u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.**

The Board of Governors reviewed the matter and decided not to approve starting of M.Ch.(CTVS) course due to gross deficiencies observed in the department of cardiology from the same institute. The Institute may be directed to appear for personal hearing before Board of Governors, MCI in case they want to submit an explanation in this regard.

5. **Increase of seats in M.Ch.(Surgical Gastroenterology) course at Bangalore Medical College and Research Institute, Bangalore under Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences, Karnataka u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.**

The Board of Governors reviewed the matter and decided to approve increase of seats in M.Ch.(Surgical Gastroenterology) course with an annual intake of 1(one) to 02(two) seats.

6. **Starting of DM(Cardiology) course at Deccan College of Medical Sciences, Hyderabad under Dr. NTR University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.**

The Board of Governors reviewed the matter and decided to approve starting of DM (Cardiology) course with an annual intake of 01(one) seat. The Institute is directed to improve on research and publications from the department.

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**7. Starting of DM(Gastroenterology) course at Deccan College of Medical Sciences, Hyderabad under Dr. NTR University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.**

The Board of Governors reviewed the matter and decided not to approve starting of DM(Gastroenterology) course due to following deficiencies :-

- 1) Inadequate staff to fulfill the criteria for one unit of Gastroenterology.
- 2) Both the consultants are shown in one unit, however both the consultants are working in two hospitals i.e. Princess Esra Hospital and Owaisi Goup of Hospitals respectively.
- 3) Inadequate workload of ERCPs, therapeutic GI procedures (biopsies, banding dilatation, polypectomies, metallic stenting etc.) in the department.
- 4) Inadequate instrumentation to perform and give training to the DM candidate.
- 5) Radiotherapy facility is outsourced.
- 6) No seminar room / side-lab / departmental office available.

The Institute may be directed to appear for personal hearing before Board of Governors, MCI in case they want to submit an explanation in this regard.

**8. Starting of DM(Nephrology) course at Deccan College of Medical Sciences, Hyderabad under Dr. NTR University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.**

The Board of Governors reviewed the matter and decided not to approve starting of DM(Nephrology) course due to following deficiencies :-

1. Inadequate Clinical material.
2. Renal Transplant programme not started yet.

The Institute may be directed to appear for personal hearing before Board of Governors, MCI in case they want to submit an explanation in this regard.

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9. **Starting of DM(Neurology) course at Deccan College of Medical Sciences, Hyderabad under Dr. NTR University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.**

The Board of Governors reviewed the matter and decided to approve starting of DM(Neurology) course with an annual intake of 01(one) seat.

10. **Increase of seats in M.Ch.(CTVS) course at G. B. Pant Hospital, Delhi under University of Delhi, Delhi u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.**

The Board of Governors reviewed the matter and decided to approve increase of seats in M.Ch.(CTVS) course with annual intake from 04(four) to 06(six) seats.

20. Increase of seats in M.Ch.(Urology) course at Kasturba Medical College, Manipal under Manipal University, Karnataka u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.

The Board of Governors reviewed the matter and decided to approve increase of seats in M.Ch.(Urology) course with annual intake of 02(two) to 03(three) seats.

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21. **Starting of DM(Cardiology) course at Mamata Medical College & Hospital, Khammam, Andhra Pradesh under Dr. NTR University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.**

The Board of Governors reviewed the matter and decided not to approve for starting of M.Ch.(Urology) course due to inadequate infrastructure and clinical material.

The Institute may be directed to appear for personal hearing before Board of Governors, MCI in case they want to submit an explanation in this regard.

23. **Increase of seats in M.Ch.(Neuro Surgery) course at Mamata Medical College & Hospital, Khammam, Andhra Pradesh under Dr. NTR University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.**

The Board of Governors reviewed the matter and decided not to approve for increase of seats in M.Ch.(Neuro Surgery) course as no details of publication and research done from the department are available.

The Institute may be directed to appear for personal hearing before Board of Governors, MCI to submit an explanation in this regard.

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24. Increase of seats in M.Ch.(Neuro Surgery) course at Nizams Institute of Medical Sciences, Hyderabad under NIMS Deemed University, Andhra Pradesh u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.
