**1. Minutes of the last meeting of the Postgraduate Committee - confirmation of.**

The minutes of the Postgraduate Committee meeting held on 16<sup>th</sup> & 17<sup>th</sup> September, 2002 were confirmed with the decision regarding item No.75 rephrased as under :-

**75. University of Bombay/Mumbai- Approval of L.T.M. Medical College, Mumbai for the award of M.Ch.(Plastic-Surgery) qualification.**

Read : the Council Inspector's report (January, 2002) on the standard of examination and other teaching facilities available at L.T.M. Medical College, Mumbai for approval of college for the award of M.Ch.(Plastic-Surgery) qualifications granted by University of Bombay/Mumbai.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Inspector's report (Jan., 2002) and decided to recommend that L.T.M.Medical College, Mumbai be approved for the award of M.Ch.(Plastic Surgery) qualification granted by University of Bombay/Mumbai restricting the number of admissions to 2(two) students per year.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the remainder agenda of the last meeting of the Postgraduate Committee held on 16<sup>th</sup> & 17<sup>th</sup> September, 2002.

**251. Starting of M.D.(Anaesthesia) & D.A. courses at M.G.M. Medical College Navi Mumbai affiliated to Mumbai University u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.**

Read : the Council Inspector's report (June, 2002) on the physical and other teaching facilities available at M.G.M.Medical College, Navi Mumbai for starting of M.D.(Anaesthesia) & D.A. courses u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Inspector's report (June, 2002) and decided to recommend to Central Government not to issue Letter of Intent for starting of M.D. (Anaesthesia) & D.A. courses at M.G.M.Medical College, Navi Mumbai affiliated to Mumbai University u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 because – i) the clinical material is inadequate, ii) equipments/instrumentation is also inadequate and iii) other deficiencies as pointed out in the inspection report.

**252. Starting of M.D.(Skin & V.D.) course at Deccan College of Medical Sciences, Hyderabad affiliated to N.T.R. University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.**

Read : the Council Inspector's report (May, 2002) on the physical and other teaching facilities available at Deccan College of Medical Sciences, Hyderabad for starting of M.D.(Skin & V.D.) course u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Inspector's report (May, 2002) and decided to recommend to Central Government not to issue Letter of Intent for starting of M.D. (Skin & V.D.) course at Deccan College of Medical Sciences, Hyderabad affiliated to N.T.R. University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 because – i) the Professor & Head has not been promoted as per MCI norms, ii) Dean of the institution is over the age of superannuation and hostel facilities are not available for the students in the institution and iii) DNB candidates are being registered in the speciality who would share the same infrastructural facilities as required for MD students.

**253. Starting of M.D.(Forensic Medicine) course at Siddhartha Medical College, Vijayawada affiliated to N.T.R. University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.**

Read : the Council Inspector's report (April, 2002) on the physical and other teaching facilities available at Siddhartha Medical College, Vijayawada for starting of M.D.(Forensic Medicine) course u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Inspector's report (April, 2002) and decided to recommend to Central Government not to issue Letter of Intent for starting of M.D. (Forensic Medicine) course at Siddhartha Medical College, Vijayawada affiliated to N.T.R. University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 because – i) infrastructural facilities in term of space in the department are not adequate, ii) equipments/instrumentation are inadequate and iii) other deficiencies as pointed out in the inspection report.

**254. Increase of seats in D.M.(Cardiology) course at Nizam's Institute of Medical Sciences, Hyderabad affiliated to Nizam's Institute of Medical Sciences, Hyderabad (Deemed University) u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.**

Read : the Council Inspector's report (June, 2002) on the physical and other teaching facilities available at Nizam's Institute of Medical Sciences, Hyderabad for increase of seats in D.M.(Cardiology) course u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Inspector's report (June, 2002) and having noted that the essentiality certificate does not reflect the extent of increase of seats sought; decided to seek clarification for the same. The Committee further decided to defer the consideration of the matter.

**255. Increase of seats in M.Ch.(Cardio-thoracic-Surgery) course at Nizam's Institute of Medical Sciences, Hyderabad affiliated to Nizam's Institute of Medical Sciences, Hyderabad (Deemed University) u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.**

Read : the Council Inspector's report (May, 2002) on the physical and other teaching facilities available at Nizam's Institute of Medical Sciences, Hyderabad for increase of seats in M.Ch.(Cardio-thoracic-Surgery) course u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Inspector's report (May, 2002) and having noted that the essentiality certificate does not reflect the extent of increase of seats sought; decided to seek clarification for the same. The Committee further decided to defer the consideration of the matter.

**256. Increase of seats in M.D.(Paediatrics) course at Sri Devraj Urs Medical College, Kolar affiliated to Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences, Bangalore u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.**

Read : the Council Inspector's report (June, 2002) on the physical and other teaching facilities available at Sri Devraj Urs Medical College, Kolar for increase of seats in M.D.(Paediatrics) course u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Inspector's report (June, 2002) and decided to recommend to Central Government to issue Letter of Permission for increase of seats in M.D (Paediatrics) course at Sri Devraj Urs Medical College, Kolar affiliated to Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences, Bangalore from 1 (one) to 3(three) per year prospectively u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 till the first batch admitted against the increased number appears for the final examination of the said course.

**257. Gujarat University – Approval of Smt. N.H.L. Municipal Medical College, Ahmedabad for the award of M.D.(Dermatology, Venereology & Leprosy) & D.V.D. qualifications.**

Read : the Council Inspector's report (June, 2002) on the standard of examination and other teaching facilities available at Smt. N.H.L. Municipal Medical College, Ahmedabad for approval of the college for the award of M.D.(Dermatology, Venereology & Leprosy) & D.V.D. qualifications granted by Gujarat University.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Inspector's report (June,2002) and decided to seek clarification from the authorities of Smt. NHL Municipal Medical College, Ahmedabad as regards (I) the status of the teaching faculty i.e. whether the teachers are working full time or only part time in the department and thereafter practising outside the hospital and (ii) the relationship of Smt. NHL Municipal Medical College, Ahmedabad with Seth K.M. School of PG Medicine & Research, Ahmedabad i.e. whether it is attached and is part of Smt. NHL Municipal Medical College, Ahmedabad.

The Committee further decided to defer the consideration of the matter till the required information is received.

**258. Starting of M.D.(Forensic Medicine) course at Deccan College of Medical Sciences, Hyderabad affiliated to N.T.R. University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.**

Read : the Council Inspector's report (June, 2002) on the physical and other teaching facilities available at Deccan College of Medical Sciences, Hyderabad for starting of M.D.(Forensic Medicine) course u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Inspector's report (June, 2002) and decided to recommend to Central Government not to issue Letter of Intent for starting of M.D. (Forensic Medicine) course at Deccan College of Medical Sciences, Hyderabad affiliated to N.T.R. University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 because – i) the post-mortums, so essential for any teaching institution for training of students, are not being conducted in the institution, ii) Dean of the institution is over the age of superannuation and hostel facilities are not available for the students in the institution and iii) other deficiencies as pointed out in the inspection report.

**259. Starting of M.D.(Biochemistry) course at Sri Devraj Urs Medical College, Kolar affiliated to Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences, Bangalore u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.**

Read : the Council Inspector's report (May, 2002) on the physical and other teaching facilities available at Sri Devraj Urs Medical College, Kolar for starting of M.D.(Biochemistry) course u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Inspector's report (May, 2002) and decided to recommend to Central Govt. to issue Letter of Intent for starting of M.D.(Biochemistry) course at Sri Devraj Urs Medical College, Kolar affiliated to Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences, Bangalore u/s 10A of the I.M.C.Act,1956 prospectively restricting the number of admissions to 1(one) student per year & further decided that the attention of the authorities be drawn towards the observations made by the Council Inspector in his inspection report.

**260. Starting of M.D.(Microbiology) course at Siddhartha Medical College, Vijayawada affiliated to N.T.R. University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.**

Read : the Council Inspector's report (June, 2002) on the physical and other teaching facilities available at Siddhartha Medical College, Vijayawada for starting of M.D.(Microbiology) course u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Inspector's report (June, 2002) and decided to recommend to Central Government to issue Letter of Permission for starting of M.D.(Microbiology) course at Siddhartha Medical College, Vijayawada affiliated to NTR University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 prospectively restricting the number of admissions to 2(two) students per year till the first batch admitted appears in the final examination of the said course. The institution be advised to apply for recognition of the qualification at the time of first available examination as per the provisions of Section 11(2) of the IMC Act, 1956.

**261. Consideration of period of initial training in P.G.diploma course towards duration of P.G. degree course - letter regarding.**

Read : the letter dated 12.6.2002 from the Controller of Examination, Swami Ramanand Teerth University, Nanded with regard to consideration of the period of initial training in diploma course towards the duration of MD degree course.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the letter dated 12.6.2002 from the Controller of Examination, Swami Ramanand Teerth University, Nanded and noting that in terms of Council's regulations on Postgraduate Medical Education 2000; the duration of training for postgraduate degree course is 3 years; decided not to agree to count any initial period of training in diploma course towards the mandatory 3-year training period for P.G. degree course by a student who initially gets admitted in diploma course & subsequently without completing the same; joins postgraduate degree course in the same subject.

**262. i) Bombay University – Approval of Goa Medical College, Bombolim, for the award of M.S.(Ophthalmology) qualification.**

**ii) Goa University – Recognition of M.S.(Ophthalmology) qualification in respect of students being trained at at Goa Medical College, Bombolim, Goa.**

Read : the Council Inspector's report (April, 2002) on the standard of examination and other teaching facilities available at Goa Medical College, Bombolim, Goa for purpose of i) approval of the college for the award of M.S.(Ophthalmology) qualification granted by Bombay University and also ii) for recognition of M.S.(Ophthalmology) qualification granted by Goa University.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Inspector's report (April, 2002) and decided to recommend that –

- i) Goa Medical College, Bombolim, Goa be approved for the award of M.S.(Ophthalmology) qualification granted by Bombay University.
- ii) M.S.(Ophthalmology) qualification granted by Goa University in respect of students trained at Goa Medical College, Bombolim, Goa be recognised and included in the first schedule to the IMC Act,1956 restricting the number of admissions to 2(two) students per year..

The attention of the authorities be drawn towards the implementation of the observations made by the Council Inspector in the inspection report.

**263. Nagpur University – Approval of Mahatma Gandhi Institute of Medical Sciences, Sevagram, Wardha for the award of M.D.(Forensic Medicine) qualification.**

Read : the Council Inspector's report (April, 2002) on the standard of examination and other teaching facilities available at Mahatma Gandhi Institute of Medical Sciences, Sevagram, Wardha for approval of the college for the award of M.D.(Forensic Medicine) qualification granted by Nagpur University.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Inspector's report (April, 2002) and decided not to approve Mahatma Gandhi Institute of Medical Sciences, Sevagram, Wardha for the award of M.D.(Forensic Medicine) qualification granted by Nagpur University because i) the Professor & HOD has not been promoted as per MCI norms, ii) the present teaching faculty in the department of Forensic Medicine is not sufficient even for the annual intake of undergraduate students for which the institution is recognised.

The Committee further decided to direct the institution authorities to henceforth stop admissions in M.D.(Forensic Medicine) course from the ensuing academic session.

**264. Starting of M.D.(Physical Medicine & Rehabilitation) course at Medical College, Kozhikode affiliated to Calicut University u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.**

Read : the Council Inspector's report (July, 2001) on the physical and other teaching facilities available at Medical College, Kozhikode for starting of M.D.(Physical Medicine & Rehabilitation) course u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Inspector's report (July, 2002) and decided to recommend to Central Government not to issue Letter of Intent for starting of M.D. (Physical Medicine & Rehabilitation) course at Medical College, Kozhikode affiliated to Calicut University u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 because - i) the department is not headed by a Professor, ii) there being only 2 Asstt. Professors; the teaching complement is not complete as per MCI norms i.e.. one Professor, one Assoc. Professor/Reader and a Lecturer and iii) other deficiencies as pointed out in the inspection report.

**265. Starting of M.Ch.(Paediatric Surgery) course at Institute of Child Health, Kolkata affiliated to Calcutta University u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.**

Read : the Council Inspector's report (June, 2002) on the physical and other teaching facilities available at Institute of Child Health, Kolkata for starting of M.Ch.(Paediatric Surgery) course u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Inspector's report (June, 2002) and decided to recommend to Central Government not to issue Letter of Intent for starting of M.Ch.( Paediatric Surgery) course at Institute of Child Health, Kolkata affiliated to Calcutta University u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 because – i) the associated services of the specialities of Anaesthesia, Pathology and Radiology are not available in the hospital round the clock, ii) many consultants are honorary in practice and iii) other deficiencies as pointed out in the inspection report.

**266. Starting of M.D.(Radio-Diagnosis) and D.M.R.D. courses at M.G.M. Medical College, Navi Mumbai affiliated to Mumbai University u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.**

Read : the Council Inspector's report (June, 2002) on the physical and other teaching facilities available at M.G.M.Medical College, Navi Mumbai for starting of M.D.(Radio-Diagnosis) and D.M.R.D. courses u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Inspector's report (June, 2002) and decided to recommend to Central Government not to issue Letter of Intent for starting of M.D. (Radio-Diagnosis) & D.M.R.D.courses at M.G.M.Medical College, Navi Mumbai affiliated to Mumbai University u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 because – i) the teaching material and clinical workload in the department of Radio-Diagnosis are grossly inadequate, ii) NMMC Hospital, Vashi is owned and managed by Municipal Corporation of Mumbai and its deptt. of Radiology, though having workload, has only one diploma holder Radiologist who is not a medical teacher, iii) the teaching faculty does not seem to be working full time and iv) other deficiencies as pointed out in the inspection report.

**267. Starting of M.S.(Orthopaedics) & D.Ortho. courses at M.G.M. Medical College, Navi Mumbai affiliated to Mumbai University u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.**

Read : the Council Inspector's report (July, 2002) on the physical and other teaching facilities available at M.G.M.Medical College, Navi Mumbai for starting of M.S.(Orthopaedics) & D.Ortho. courses u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Inspector's report (Julu, 2002) and decided to recommend to Central Government to issue Letter of Permission for starting of M.S.(Orthopaedics) & D.Ortho. courses at M.G.M.Medical College, Navi Mumbai affiliated to Mumbai University u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 prospectively restricting the number of admissions in each course to 2(two) students per year till the first batches admitted appear in the final examination of the said courses. The institution be advised to apply for recognition of the qualifications at the time of first available examination as per the provisions of Section 11(2) of the IMC Act, 1956.

**268. Starting of M.D.(Anatomy) course at Siddhartha Medical College, Vijayawada affiliated to N.T.R. University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.**

Read : the Council Inspector's report (June, 2002) on the physical and other teaching facilities available at Siddhartha Medical College, Vijayawada for starting of M.D.(Anatomy) course u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Inspector's report (June, 2002) and decided to recommend to Central Government to issue Letter of Permission for starting of M.D.(Anatomy) course at Siddhartha Medical College, Vijayawada affiliated to NTR University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 prospectively restricting the number of admissions to 2(two) students per year till the first batch admitted appears in the final examination of the said course. The institution be advised to apply for recognition of the qualification at the time of first available examination as per the provisions of Section 11(2) of the IMC Act, 1956.

**269. Starting of M.D.(Paediatrics) course at Siddhartha Medical College, Vijayawada affiliated to N.T.R. University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.**

Read : the Council Inspector's report (June, 2002) on the physical and other teaching facilities available at Siddhartha Medical College, Vijayawada for starting of M.D.(Paediatrics) course u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Inspector's report (June, 2002) and decided to recommend to Central Government to issue Letter of Permission for starting of M.D.(Paediatrics) course at Siddhartha Medical College, Vijayawada affiliated to NTR University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 prospectively restricting the number of admission, in consonance with the Paediatric Unit available in the institution's own hospital, to 1(one) student per year till the first batch admitted appears in the final examination of the said course. The institution be advised to apply for recognition of the qualification at the time of first available examination as per the provisions of Section 11(2) of the IMC Act, 1956.

**270. Starting of M.D.(S.P.M.) course at Siddhartha Medical College, Vijayawada affiliated to N.T.R. University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.**

Read : the Council Inspector's report (July, 2002) on the physical and other teaching facilities available at Siddhartha Medical College, Vijayawada for starting of M.D.(S.P.M.) course u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Inspector's report (July, 2002) and decided to recommend to Central Government not to issue Letter of Intent for starting of M.D.(S.P.M.) course at Siddhartha Medical College, Vijayawada affiliated to N.T.R. University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 because – i) teaching faculty is inadequate for training of postgraduate students, ii) urban health centre as required for the speciality of S.P.M. is not available/existing, iii) infrastructural facilities are deficient for training and iv) other deficiencies as pointed out in the inspection report.

**271. Starting of M.S.(Orthopaedics) course at Siddhartha Medical College, Vijayawada affiliated to N.T.R. University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.**

Read : the Council Inspector's report (June, 2002) on the physical and other teaching facilities available at Siddhartha Medical College, Vijayawada for starting of M.S.(Orthopaedics) course u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.

Medical College, Jhansi because (i) composition of none of the units in the department of Obst. & Gynae., in terms of teaching faculty, is as per MCI norms i.e. minimum of three teachers per unit, (ii) the examination was conducted with the external examiners who were from the same state which is not in consonance with the provisions of Postgraduate Medical Education Regulations,2000 and (iii) the other deficiencies pointed out in the inspection report.

**354. Rajasthan University – Recognition of M.D.(Microbiology) qualification in respect of students being trained at S.M.S. Medical College, Jaipur.**

Read : The Council Inspector's report (June, 2002) on standard of examination and other teaching facilities available at S.M.S. Medical College, Jaipur for purpose of recognition of M.D.(Microbiology) qualification granted by Rajasthan University.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Inspector's report (June, 2002) and decided to recommend that M.D.(Microbiology) qualification granted by Rajasthan University in respect of students being trained at S.M.S. Medical College, Jaipur be recognised and included in the 1<sup>st</sup> Schedule to the I.M.C. Act,1956 restricting the number of admissions to 2 (two) students per year.

**355. Shivaji University – Recognition of M.S.(Orthopaedics) & D.Ortho. qualifications in respect of students being trained at Krishna Institute of Medical Sciences, Karad.**

Read : The Council Inspector's report (July, 2002) on the standard of examination and other teaching facilities available at Krishna Institute of Medical Sciences, Karad for purpose of recognition of M.S.(Orthopaedics) & D.Ortho. qualifications granted by Shivaji University.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Inspector's report (July, 2002) and decided not to recommend recognition of M.S.(Orthopaedics) & D.Ortho. qualifications granted by Shivaji University in respect of students being trained at Krishna Institute of Medical Sciences, Karad as (i) the teaching complement of none of the units is as per MCI norms i.e. minimum of three teachers per unit and (ii) the other deficiencies pointed out in the inspection report.

**356. i) Punjab University –Approval of M.S.(Anatomy) qualification for the award of Pt. B.D. Sharma Postgraduate Institute of Medical Sciences, Rohtak.**

**ii) Kurukshetra University, B.N. Chakarvarti University, Rohtak University and Maharishi Dayanand University, Rohtak - Recognition of M.S.(Anatomy) qualification in respect of students being trained at Pt. B.D. Sharma Postgraduate Institute of Medical Sciences, Rohtak.**

Read : The Council Inspector's report (June, 2002) on the standard of examination and other teaching facilities available at Pt. B.D. Sharma Postgraduate Institute of Medical Sciences, Rohtak for purpose of i) approval of the college for the award of

M.S.(Anatomy) qualification granted by Punjab University and ii) for recognition of M.S.(Anatomy) qualification earlier granted by Kurukshetra University, B.N. Chakarvarti University, Rohtak University and now by the Maharishi Dayanand University, Rohtak.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Inspector's report (June, 2002) and decided to recommend that Pt. B.D. Sharma Postgraduate Institute of Medical Sciences, Rohtak be approved for the award of M.S.(Anatomy) qualification earlier granted by Punjab University.

The Committee further decided to recommend that M.S.(Anatomy) qualification earlier granted by Kurukshetra University, B.N. Chakarvarti University, Rohtak University and now by the Maharishi Dayanand University, Rohtak be recognised and included in the 1<sup>st</sup> schedule to the I.M.C. Act,1956 restricting the number of admissions to 2 (two) students per year.

**357. Maharishi Dayanand University, Rohtak - Recognition of M.D.(Forensic Medicine) qualification in respect of students being trained at Pt. B.D. Sharma Postgraduate Institute of Medical Sciences, Rohtak.**

Read : The Council Inspector's report (July, 2002) on the standard of examination and other teaching facilities available at Pt. B.D. Sharma Postgraduate Institute of Medical Sciences, Rohtak for purpose of recognition of M.D.(Forensic Medicine) qualification granted by Maharishi Dayanand University, Rohtak.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Inspector's report (July,2002) and decided not to recommend recognition of M.D.(Forensic Medicine) qualification granted by Maharishi Dayanand University, Rohtak in respect of students being trained at Pt. B.D. Sharma Postgraduate Institute of Medical Sciences, Rohtak because of the following:-

- (i) Promotion of HOD has not been as per the MCI norms i.e. minimum of five years as Assistant Professor and 4 years as Reader to be eligible for the posts of Reader and Professor respectively.
- (ii) HOD was not one of the internal examiners during M.D.(Forensic Medicine) practical examination as required as per the MCI norms.
- (iii) Mortuary requires improvement and
- (iv) The other observations as made in the inspection report.

**358. i) Punjab University -Approval of D.G.O. qualification for the award of Pt. B.D. Sharma Postgraduate Institute of Medical Sciences, Rohtak.**

- ii) **Kurukshetra University, B.N. Chakarvarti University, Rohtak University and Maharishi Dayanand University, Rohtak - Recognition of D.G.O. qualification in respect of students being trained at Pt. B.D. Sharma Postgraduate Institute of Medical Sciences, Rohtak.**

Read : The Council Inspector's report (July, 2002) on the standard examination and other teaching facilities available at Pt. B.D. Sharma Postgraduate Institute of Medical Sciences, Rohtak for purpose of i) approval of the institution for the award of D.G.O. qualification granted by Punjab University and ii) for recognition of D.G.O. qualification earlier granted by Kurukshetra University , B.N. Chakarvarti University, Rohtak University and now by the Maharishi Dayanand University, Rohtak.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Inspector's report (July, 2002) and decided to recommend that Pt. B.D. Sharma Postgraduate Institute of Medical Sciences, Rohtak be approved for the award of D.G.O. qualification earlier granted by Punjab University.

The Committee further decided to recommend that D.G.O. qualification earlier granted by Kurukshetra University , B.N. Chakarvarti University, Rohtak University and now by the Maharishi Dayanand University, Rohtak in respect of students being trained at Pt. B.D. Sharma Postgraduate Institute of Medical Sciences, Rohtak be recognised and included in the 1<sup>st</sup> schedule to the I.M.C. Act,1956 restricting the number of admissions to 6(six) students per year.

**359. Bangalore University and Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences, Bangalore – Approval of Dr. B.R. Ambedkar Medical College, Bangalore for the award of M.D.(Paediatrics) qualification –Consideration of compliance verification regarding.**

Read : The compliance verification report (June, 2002) togetherwith compliance and Council Inspector's report(Sept., 2000) on the standard of examination and other teaching facilities available at Dr.B.R.Ambedkar Medical College, Bangalore for purpose of approval of the college for the award of M.D.(Paediatrics) qualification earlier granted by Bangalore University and now by Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences, Bangalore.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the compliance verification inspection report (June, 2002) together with compliance and Council Inspector's report (Sept., 2000) and decided not to recommend approval of Dr. B.R. Ambedkar Medical College, Bangalore for the award of M.D.(Paediatrics) qualification earlier granted by Bangalore University and now by the Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences, Bangalore as the deficiencies pointed out on the basis of earlier inspection have not been found rectified.

The Committee noted that the institution had been directed to stop admissions in M.D.(Paediatrics) course vide its decision taken at its meeting held on 16.10.2001 and decided to direct the authorities of the institution to continue stop admissions in M.D.(Paediatric) course.

**360. University of Poona - Recognition of M.D.(Biochemistry) qualification in respect of students being trained at B.J. Medical College, Pune.**

Read : The Council Inspector's report (August, 2002) on the standard of examination and other teaching facilities available at B.J. Medical College, Pune for purpose of recognition of M.D.(Biochemistry) qualification granted by University of Poona.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Inspector's report (August,2002) and decided not to recommend recognition of M.D.(Biochemistry) qualification granted by University of Poona in respect of students being trained at B.J. Medical College, Pune as (I) HOD possesses non-medical qualification in Biochemistry and (ii) majority of the teaching faculty in the department also possesses non-medical qualification – both of which are not in consonance with the provisions of the Postgraduate Medical Education Regulations,2000,

**361. University of Bombay/Mumbai– Recognition of M.D.(Radiology/Radio-Diagnosis) qualification in respect of students being trained at T.N. Medical College, Mumbai.**

Read : The Council Inspector's report (August, 2002) on the standard of examination and other teaching facilities available at T.N. Medical College, Mumbai for purpose of recognition of M.D.(Radiology/Radio-Diagnosis) qualification granted by University of Bombay/Mumbai.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Inspector's report (August, 2002) and decided not to recommend recognition of M.D.(Radiology/Radio-Diagnosis) qualification granted by University of Bombay/Mumbai in respect of students being trained at T. N. Medical College, Mumbai because of (i) Professor & HOD does not possess recognised postgraduate qualification and (ii) the other deficiencies pointed out in the inspection report.

**362. Poona University – Recognition of D.M.(Cardiology) qualification in respect of Students being trained at Armed Forces Medical College, Pune- reconsideration regarding.**

Read : The Council Inspector's report (July, 2001) on the standard of examination and other teaching facilities available at Armed Forces Medical College, Pune for purpose of recognition of D.M.(Cardiology) qualification granted by Poona University as referred back by the General Body.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Inspector's report (July,2001) and decided not to recommend recognition of D.M.(Cardiology) qualification granted by Poona University in respect of students being trained at Armed Forces Medical College, Pune because of the following:-

- (i) HOD does not possess requisite experience and equivalent rank to be eligible as Professor.
- (ii) The department of Cardiology has 100 beds, all in one unit which is not as per MCI norms i.e. 20 to 50 beds per unit.
- (iii) Part of training for DM students is carried out in a private hospital.

**363. Andhra University, Nagarajuna University, Andhra Pradesh University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada & N.T.R. University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada – Recognition of M.D.(T.B. & Chest Dise./ T.B. & Resp. Dise.) qualification in respect of students being trained at Guntur Medical College, Guntur – reconsideration regarding.**

Read : The Council Inspector's report (May, 2001) on the standard of examination and other teaching facilities available at Guntur Medical College, Guntur for purpose of recognition of MD (T.B. & Chest Dise./T.B. & Resp. Dise.) qualification earlier granted by Andhra University, Nagarajuna University, Andhra Pradesh University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada & now by NTR University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada as referred back by the General Body.

The Postgraduate Committee reconsidered the Council Inspector's report (May, 2001) and decided not to recommend recognition of MD (T.B. & Chest Dise./T.B. & Resp. Dise.) qualification earlier granted by Andhra University, Nagarajuna University, Andhra Pradesh University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada & now by NTR University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada in respect of students being trained at Guntur Medical College, Guntur because (i) the equipments available in the department and the library facilities are inadequate and (ii) the other deficiencies pointed out in the inspection report.

**364. Eligibility qualification for admission to DM (Pulmonary Medicine & Critical Care Medicine) qualification for inclusion in the regulations of Council on Postgraduate Medical Education – reconsideration regarding.**

Read : The matter with regard to eligibility qualification for admission in DM(Pulmonary Medicine & Critical Care Medicine) course for inclusion in the regulations of Council on Postgraduate Medical Education in light of letter dated 9.6.2002 from Dr.Babu, Council Member as referred back by the General Body.

The Postgraduate Committee reconsidered the matter with regard to eligibility qualification for admission in DM(Pulmonary Medicine & Critical Care Medicine) course for inclusion in the regulations of Council on Postgraduate Medical Education and noted that the prescribed nomenclature in Postgraduate Regulations is D.M.(Pulmonary Medicine), and decided to recommend that for getting admission in D.M.(Pulmonary Medicine) course, one of the following be the prior eligibility qualification:-

1. M.D.(General Medicine)
2. M.D.(Paediatrics)
3. M.D.(T.B. & Respiratory Diseases)

**365. Permission to restart the P.G. courses started prior to amendment to IMC Act and discontinued afterwards – matter regarding.**

Read : The letter dated 16.7.2002 from the Principal, Bangalore Medical College, Bangalore vide letter dated 16.7.2002 regarding permission to restart the P.G. courses which had been started prior to amendment to IMC Act but discontinued afterwards.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the letter dated 16.7.2002 from the Principal, Bangalore Medical College, Bangalore regarding permission to restart the P.G. courses which had been started prior to amendment to IMC Act but were discontinued afterwards; and decided that this attracts attention of provisions of Section 10A of the I.M.C. Act,1956 and accordingly the institution need to apply u/s 10A of the IMC Act,1956 for permission of the Central Govt. to start the courses.

**366. Inclusion of Master degree in Applied Epidemiology and Master degree in Public Health qualifications granted by Sree Chitra Tirunal Institute of Medical Sciences & Technology, Thiruvananthapuram in the 1<sup>st</sup> Schedule to the IMC Act, 1956 – letters from the Registrar regarding .**

Read : The letter dated 19.12.2001 & 12.7.2002 from the Registrar, Sree Chitra Tirunal Institute of Medical Sciences & Technology, Thiruvananthapuram regarding inclusion of the “Master Degree in Applied Epidemiology” & “Master degree in Public Health” offered by the institutions in the 1<sup>st</sup> Schedule to the I.M.C. Act, 1956.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the letter dated 19.12.2001 & 12.7.2002 from the Registrar, Sree Chitra Tirunal Institute of Medical Sciences & Technology, Thiruvananthapuram regarding inclusion of the “Master Degree in Applied Epidemiology” & “Master degree in Public Health” in the 1<sup>st</sup> Schedule to the IMC Act,1956 and noted that (i) MCI has not prescribed any such courses with these nomenclatures in its Postgraduate Medical Education Regulations, 2000 (ii) the training for these short duration courses is not in consonance with PG Regulations,2000 i.e. duration of two years training period for Diploma courses and (iii) Section 24 of Sri Chitra Tirunal Institute of Medical Sciences & Technology, Trivandrum Act,1980; stipulates that the medical qualifications granted by the institution shall be recognised medical qualifications for purposes of IMC Act,1956 and shall be deemed to be included to the 1<sup>st</sup> Schedule to the IMC Act,1956.

The Committee, in view of the above, decided to obtain the legal opinion in the matter.

**367. Request for introduction of Super-Speciality/sub-speciality courses in Anaesthesiology – letter regarding.**

Read : The letter dated 22.4.2002 from the Secretary, ISA (Indian Society of Anaesthesiologists) vide his letter dated 22.4.2002 with regard to introduction of Super-speciality/sub-speciality courses in Anaesthesiology.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the letter dated 22.4.2002 from the Secretary, ISA (Indian Society of Anaesthesiologists) and decided to obtain:

(I) the following information from the Society:

- (i) the names of institutions/places where work relating to super speciality/sub-speciality courses in Anaesthesiology is being conducted.
- (ii) the availability of teachers for starting of such courses.
- (iii) the course curriculum and syllabus for such courses.

(II) the names of the five experts in these fields from Dr. V. Kanagaraj, member, PG Committee and thereafter to seek their opinion with regards to starting of super speciality courses in Anaesthesia.

**368. Request for introduction of DNB courses in recognised medical college – letter regarding.**

Read : The letter dated 22.7.2002 from the Addl. Director of Medical Education and Research, Gandhinagar vide his fax dated 25.7.2002 regarding introduction of DNB courses in recognised medical college.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the letter dated 25.07.2002 received from the Addl. Director of Medical Education and Research, Gandhinagar, Gujarat and decided not to agree with the request/suggestion for introduction of DNB courses in recognised medical colleges of the State.

**369. Approval of Medical College, Rohtak (now named Pt. B.D. Sharma Postgraduate Institute of Medical Sciences, Rohtak) for the award of M.D.(General Medicine) qualification – affiliation with Punjab University regarding.**

Read : the letter dated 27.4.2002 from the Director, Medical College, Rohtak (now named Pt. B.D. Sharma Postgraduate Institute of Medical Sciences, Rohtak) for necessary amendments regarding approval of the institution for the award of M.D.(General Medicine) qualification under Punjab University.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the letter dated 27.4.2002 from the Director, Medical College, Rohtak (now named Pt. B.D. Sharma Postgraduate Institute of Medical Sciences, Rohtak) and noted that –

- (i) the qualification of M.D.(General Medicine) earlier granted by Kurukshetra University, B.N.Chakravarti University, Rohtak University and now by the Maharishi Dayanand University, Rohtak in respect of Medical College, Rohtak (now named Pt. B.D. Sharma Postgraduate Institute of Medical Sciences, Rohtak) is recognised and included in the 1<sup>st</sup> Schedule to the IMC Act,1956.
- (ii) the Institution, prior to affiliation with Kurukshetra University, was affiliated with Punjab University, under which M.D.( General Medicine) is recognised in respect of other institutions but not in respect of the said institution at Rohtak.
- (iii) the Institution was affiliated to Punjab University when M.D.(General Medicine) course was started after due inspection and approval by the MCI.
- (iv) the recognition of M.D.(General Medicine) qualification was considered and thereafter approved by the Council in March, 1978 by which time there had been changeover in affiliation of the institution to Kurukshetra University/B.N.Chakrvarti University/Rohtak University; and now the request is for consideration of approval of the institution for the award of M.D.(General Medicine) qualification under Punjab University.

The Committee, in view of above facts, decided to recommend approval of Medical College, Rohtak (now named Pt. B.D. Sharma Postgraduate Institute of Medical Sciences, Rohtak) for the award of M.D.(General Medicine) under Punjab University.

**370. Nizam's Institute of Medical Sciences,(Deemed University), Hyderabad – Recognition of M.D.(Radio-Diagnosis) & D.M.R.D. qualifications – Consideration of compliance regarding.**

Read : the compliance togetherwith Council Inspector's report(Jan.,1996) on the standard of examination and other teaching facilities available at Nizam's Institute of Medical Sciences, Hyderabad for recognition of M.D.(Radio-Diagnosis) & D.M.R.D. qualifications granted by the Institute.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the compliance together with Council Inspector's report (January,1996) and decided to verify the same by way of an inspection.

**371. Request for addition of M.D.(Physical Medicine & Rehabilitation) as prior requirement for admission in D.M.(Neurology) and D.M.(Rheumatology) courses– Reg.**

Read : the letter dated 29.7.2002 from the President, Physiatrists Society, Calicut with regard to addition of M.D.(Physical Medicine & Rehabilitation) as prior requirement for admission in D.M.(Neurology) and D.M.(Rheumatology) courses.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the letter dated 29.7.2002 from the President, Psychiatrists Society, Calicut and did not agree for inclusion of M.D.(Physical Medicine & Rehabilitation), amongst the already included qualifications, as prior requirement for admissions in D.M.(Neurology) and D.M.(Rheumatology) courses.

**372. Starting of M.Ch.(Cardio-Thoracic Surgery) course at Andhra Medical College, Visakhapatnam affiliated to N.T.R. University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada u/s 10A of the I.M.C.Act, 1956.**

Read : the Council Inspector's report (May, 2002) on the physical and other teaching facilities available at Andhra Medical College, Visakhapatnam for starting of M.Ch.(Cardio-Thoracic Surgery) course u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Inspector's report (May,2002) and decided to recommend to the Central Govt. not to issue Letter of Intent for starting of M.Ch.(Cardio-Thoracic Surgery) course at Andhra Medical College, Visakhapatnam affiliated to N.T.R. University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada as (i) the Professor & HOD and also the other Professor do not possess recognised postgraduate qualification and (ii) the other deficiencies as pointed out by the Council Inspector in the inspection report.

**373. Starting of M.D.(Obst. & Gynae.) course at Govt. Medical College, Bhavnagar affiliated to Bhavnagar University u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.**

Read : the Council Inspector's report (August, 2002) on the physical and other teaching facilities available at Govt. Medical College, Bhavnagar for starting of M.D.(Obst. & Gynae.) course u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Inspector's report (August,2002) and decided to recommend to the Central Govt. not to issue Letter of Intent for starting of M.D.(Obst. & Gynae.) course at Govt. Medical College, Bhavnagar affiliated to Bhavnagar University u/s 10A of the I.M.C. Act,1956 because of (i) HOD is on leave and has applied for voluntary retirement, (ii) the facilities for endoscopies are very limited, (iii) the equipments in the department are inadequate, and (iv) the other deficiencies pointed out in the report .

**374. Starting of M.D.(Paediatrics) course at Govt. Medical College, Bhavnagar affiliated to Bhavnagar University u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.**

Read : the Council Inspector's report (August, 2002) on the physical and other teaching facilities available at Govt. Medical College, Bhavnagar for starting of M.D.(Paediatrics) course u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Inspector's report (August,2002) and decided to recommend to the Central Govt. to issue Letter of Permission for starting of M.D.(Paediatrics) course at Govt. Medical College, Bhavnagar affiliated to Bhavnagar University u/s 10A of the I.M.C. Act,1956 u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 prospectively restricting the number of admissions to 2 (two) students per year till the first batch admitted appears in the final examination of the said course. The institution be advised to apply for recognition of the qualification at the time of first available examination as per the provisions of Section 11(2) of the I.M.C. Act,1956.

The Committee further decided that the attention of the authorities of the institution be drawn towards the observations made by the Council Inspector in the inspection report.



**375. Increase of seats in M.D.(Forensic Medicine) course at Osmania Medical College, Hyderabad affiliated to N.T.R. University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.**

Read : the Council Inspector's report (August, 2002) on the physical and other teaching facilities available at Osmania Medical College, Hyderabad for increase of seats in M.D.(Forensic Medicine) course u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Inspector's report (August,2002) and decided to recommend to the Central Govt. not to issue Letter of Intent for increase of seats in M.D.(Forensic Medicine) course at Osmania Medical College, Hyderabad affiliated to N.T.R. University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 as there are only two faculty members in the department who have got recognised postgraduate qualification and the requisite experience to be eligible postgraduate teachers and the institution already has an annual intake of 2 (two) students commensurate with the available teaching faculty.

**376. Increase of seats in M.S.(E.N.T.) course at Osmania Medical College, Hyderabad affiliated to N.T.R. University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.**

Read : the Council Inspector's report (August, 2002) on the physical and other teaching facilities available at Osmania Medical College, Hyderabad for increase of seats in M.S.(E.N.T.) course u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Inspector's report (August,2002) and decided to recommend to the Central Govt. to issue Letter of Permission for increase of seats in M.S.(E.N.T.) course at Osmania Medical College, Hyderabad affiliated to N.T.R. University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada from 2 (two) to 3(three) per year prospectively, in consonance with the available teaching faculty with recognised postgraduate qualification and the requisite experience, u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 till the first batch admitted against the increased number appears for the final examination of the said course.

**377. Increase of seats in M.D.(Forensic Medicine) course at Kakatiya Medical College, Warangal affiliated to N.T.R. University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.**

Read : the Council Inspector's report (July, 2002) on the physical and other teaching facilities available at Kakatiya Medical College, Warangal for increase of seats in M.D.(Forensic Medicine) course u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Inspector's report (July,2002) and decided to recommend to the Central Govt. not to issue Letter of Intent for increase of seats in M.D.(Forensic Medicine) course at Kakatiya Medical College, Warangal affiliated to N.T.R. University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 because (i) Professor & HOD does not possess the recognised postgraduate qualification and (ii) the other deficiencies pointed out in the inspection report.
