1. **Minutes of the last meeting of the Postgraduate Committee – confirmation of.**

The minutes of the Postgraduate Committee meeting held on 29/7/2003 were confirmed.

2. **Minutes of the last meeting of the Postgraduate Committee – action taken thereon.**

The action taken on the minutes of the meeting of the Postgraduate Committee held on 29/7/2003 was noted and approved.

3. **Work output report of the requests received u/s 10A for the year 2003.**

Read : the work output report of the requests u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 for the year 2002-2003.

The Postgraduate Committee noted the satisfactory progress as reflected in the work output report on the requests u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 for the year 2002 - 2003 which were placed on table. The Committee resolved that where institutions have declined/postponed inspections, a reminder to them be sent for inspection and if no response is received after clear 15 days from the date of receipt of the communication, disapproval of the scheme be recommended to the Central Government.

4. **Starting of M.S.(Ophthalmology) course at Father Muller's Medical College, Mangalore affiliated to Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences, Bangalore u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.**

Read : the Council Inspector's report (July,2003) on the physical and other teaching facilities available at Father Muller's Medical College, Mangalore for consideration of starting of M.S.(Ophthalmology) u/s 10A of the IMC Act,1956.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Inspector's report (July, 2003) and noted that Unit-I is not as per MCI norms in terms of teaching faculty and decided to advise the institution authorities to re-organise the units as regards teaching faculty as per MCI norms.

The Committee further decided to defer the consideration till the information is received from the institution authorities.

5. Increase of seats in M.D.(Paediatrics) course at Shri B.M. Patil Medical College, Bijapur affiliated to Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences, Bangalore u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.

Read: the Council Inspector's report (July, 2003) on the physical and other teaching facilities available at Sri B.M.Patil Medical College, Bijapur for increase of seats in M.D.(Paediatrics) course u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.

Upon noting the satisfactory compliance made by the college authorities in regard to appointment of teaching faculty in the department of Radio-Diagnosis, the Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Inspector's report (July, 2003) and decided to recommend to Central Government not to issue Letter of Intent for increase of seats in M.D.(Paediatrics) course at Sri B.M. Patil Medical College, Bijapur u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 because the following deficiencies:-

- i) Clinical workload is inadequate.
- ii) OPD records are not maintained properly.
- iii) False and fictitious IPD data is recorded.
- iv) Other deficiencies/observations as pointed out in the inspection report.

6. Starting of M.D.(Skin & V.D.) course at Deccan College of Medical Sciences, Hyderabad affiliated to N.T.R. University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956- consideration of compliance verification regarding.

Read : the compliance verification report (July, 2003) togetherwith compliance and Council Inspector's report (May, 2002) on the physical and other teaching facilities available at Deccan College of Medical Sciences, Hyderabad for starting of M.D.(Skin & V.D.) course u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the compliance verification report (July, 2003) togetherwith compliance and Council Inspector's report (May, 2002) and reiterated its earlier decision taken at its meeting held on 27.2.2003 recommending to the Central Government not to issue Letter of Intent for starting of MD (Skin & VD) course at Deccan College of Medical Sciences, Hyderabad affiliated to NTR University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada u/s 10A of the IMC Act,1956.

The Committee further decided to recommend that in view of above, the Govt. may consider disapproving the proposal for starting of MD (Skin & VD) course. However, the institution is free to apply afresh after rectification of the deficiencies, in accordance with the Council's Regulation on Postgraduate Medical Education, 2000.

7. Starting of MD (Biochemistry) course at Deccan College of Medical Sciences, Hyderabad affiliated to N.T.R. University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956- consideration of compliance verification regarding.

Read : the compliance verification report (June,2003) togetherwith compliance and Council Inspector's report (July, 2002) on the physical and other teaching facilities available at Deccan College of Medical Sciences, Hyderabad for starting of M.D.(Biochemistry) course u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the compliance verification report (June,2003) togetherwith compliance and Council Inspector's report (July, 2002) and decided to recommend to the Central Government to issue Letter of Intent for starting of M.D. (Biochemistry) course at Deccan College of Medical Sciences, Hyderabad affiliated to NTR University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada u/s 10 A of the IMC Act, 1956 restricting the number of admissions to 2(two) students per year.

The attention of the authorities be drawn towards the implementation of the observations made by the Council Inspector in the inspection report.

8. Starting of M.S.(E.N.T.) course at Deccan College of Medical Sciences, Hyderabad affiliated to N.T.R. University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 – consideration of compliance verification regarding.

Read : the compliance verification report (April 2003) together with compliance and Council's Inspector's report (May 2002) on the physical and other teaching facilities available at Deccan College of Medical Sciences, Hyderabad for starting of M.S.(E.N.T.) course u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the compliance verification report (April 2003) together with compliance and Council's Inspector's report (May 2002) and decided to reiterate its earlier decision taken at its meeting held on 16/17.9.2002 recommending to Central Government not to issue Letter of Intent for starting of MS (ENT) course at Deccan College of Medical Sciences, Hyderabad affiliated to NTR University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 because the deficiencies pointed out earlier are still existing.

The Committee further decided to recommend that in view of above, the Govt. may consider disapproving the proposal for starting of MS (ENT) course. However, the institution is free to apply afresh after rectification of the deficiencies, in accordance with the Council's Regulation on Postgraduate Medical Education, 2000.

9. Starting of M.D.(S.P.M.) course at Deccan College of Medical Sciences, Hyderabad affiliated to N.T.R. University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 – consideration of compliance verification regarding.

Read : the compliance verification report (May, 2003) togetherwith compliance and Council Inspector's report (May, 2002) on the physical and other teaching facilities available at Deccan College of Medical Sciences, Hyderabad for starting of M.D.(S.P.M.) course u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the compliance verification report (May, 2003) togetherwith compliance and Council Inspector's report (May, 2002) and decided to reiterate its earlier decision taken at its meeting held on 27.2.2003 recommending to the Central Government not to issue Letter of Intent for starting of MD (SPM) course at Deccan College of Medical Sciences, Hyderabad affiliated to NTR University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada u/s 10A of the IMC Act,1956.

The Committee further decided to recommend that in view of above, the Govt. may consider disapproving the proposal for starting of MD (SPM) course. However, the institution is free to apply afresh after rectification of the deficiencies, in accordance with the Council's Regulation on Postgraduate Medical Education, 2000.

10. Starting of M.D.(Dermatology, Venereology & Leprosy) course at Govt. Medical College, Kota affiliated to Rajasthan University u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 – consideration of compliance regarding.

Read : the Council Inspector report (May 2002) on the physical and other teaching facilities available at Govt. Medical College, Kota together with compliance for starting of M.D.(Dermatology, Venereology & Leprosy) course u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Inspector report (May, 2002) together with compliance and decided to verify the compliance by way of an inspection.

11. Starting of M.D.(Pharmacology) course at Sher-I-Kashmir Institute of Medical Sciences, Srinagar affiliated to Sher-I-Kashmir Instt. of Medical Sciences, Srinagar (Deemed University) u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 – consideration of compliance regarding.

Read : the Council Inspector report (July 2002) on the physical and other teaching facilities available at Sher-I-Kashmir Institute of Medical Sciences, Srinagar together with compliance for starting of M.D.(Pharmacology) course u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Inspector's report (July, 2002) alongwith compliance and decided to reiterate its earlier decision taken at its meeting held on 27.2.2003 recommending to the Central Government not to issue Letter of Intent for starting of M.D.(Pharmacology) course at Sher-I-Kashmir Institute of Medical Sciences, Srinagar affiliated to Sher-I-Kashmir Institute of Medical Sciences, Srinagar (Deemed University) u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 because (i) the present teaching faculty in the deptt. of Pharmacology is not sufficient even for the annual intake of undergraduate students for which the institution is recognised (ii) other observations /deficiencies pointed out in the inspection report.

The Committee further decided to recommend that the Govt. may consider disapproving the proposal for starting of MD (Pharmacology) course. However, the institution is free to apply afresh after rectification of the deficiencies, in accordance with the Council's Regulation on Postgraduate Medical Education, 2000.

12. Starting of M.D.(Microbiology) course at Burdwan Medical College, Burdwan affiliated to Burdwan University u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 – consideration compliance regarding.

Read : the Council Inspector report (April, 2003) on the physical and other teaching facilities available at Burdwan Medical College, Burdwan together with compliance for consideration for starting of M.D.(Microbiology) course u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Inspector report (April, 2003) together with compliance and decided to verify the compliance by way of an inspection.

13. Starting of M.S.(Orthopaedics) course at Burdwan Medical College, Burdwan affiliated to Burdwan University u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 – consideration of compliance regarding.

Read : the Council Inspector report (April 2003) on the physical and other teaching facilities available at Burdwan Medical College, Burdwan together with compliance for consideration of starting of M.S.(Orthopaedics) course u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Inspector report (April, 2003) together with compliance and decided to verify the compliance by way of an inspection.

14. Starting of M.D.(Pathology) course at Burdwan Medical College, Burdwan affiliated to Burdwan University u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.

Read : the Council Inspector's report (June, 2003) on the physical and other teaching facilities available at Burdwan Medical College, Burdwan for consideration of starting of M.D.(Pathology) course u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Inspector's report (June, 2003) and decided to recommend to the Central Government not to issue Letter of Intent for starting of M.D. (Pathology) course at Burdwan Medical College, Burdwan u/s 10 A of the IMC Act, 1956 because of the following –

- (i) The Infrastructure facilities are not adequate

- (ii) Equipment like Cryostat, freezing Microtome, Automatic cell counter, automatic coagulometer, Cytospin, automatic tissue processor & Electrophoresis apparatus need to be procured.
- (iii) Double headed binocular microscopes was not available to teach the postgraduate students.
- (iv) Autopsy section needs to be established to train PG students the autopsy techniques and teach clinico-pathological correlation.
- (v) All pathology emergency work should be carried out by the staff of Pathology Deptt. and not by the Medical Officer.
- (vi) Proper hygiene should be maintained in the hospital campus, wards, OPD etc. and should follow the biomedical waste disposal scheme.
- (vii) There were only three eligible PG teachers in the Pathology deptt. yet to get recognition from Burdwan University, West Bengal.

15. Starting of M.D.(General Medicine) course at R.G. Kar Medical College, Kolkatta affiliated to University of Calcutta u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.

Read : the Council Inspector report (July 2003) on the physical and other teaching facilities available at R.G. Kar Medical College, Kolkatta for consideration of starting of M.D. (General Medicine) course u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Inspector's report (July, 2003) and decided to recommend to the Central Government not to issue Letter of Intent for starting of M.D. (General Medicine) course at R.G. Kar Medical College, Kolkatta u/s 10 A of the IMC Act, 1956 because of the following –

- (i) Teaching complement is not complete in Unit V & VI.
- (ii) Prof. & HOD is promoted not as per MCI norms.
- (iii) Incharges of Unit II and IV are promoted not as per MCI norms.
- (iv) Other deficiencies/observations as pointed out in the inspection report.

16. Starting of M.S.(General Surgery) course at R.G. Kar Medical College, Kolkatta affiliated to University of Calcutta u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.

Read : the Council Inspector's report (July, 2003) on the physical and other teaching facilities available at R.G. Kar Medical College, Kolkatta for consideration of starting of M.S.(General Surgery) course u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Inspector's report (July, 2003) and decided to recommend to the Central Government not to issue Letter of Intent for starting of M.S. (General Surgery) course at R.G. Kar Medical College, Kolkatta u/s 10 A of the IMC Act, 1956 because of the following –

- (i) Teaching complement is not complete in all the units except Unit IV.
- (ii) Other deficiencies/observations as pointed out in the inspection report.

17. Starting of M.D.(Community Medicine) course at N.B. Medical College, Darjeeling affiliated to University of North Bengal u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.

Read : the Council Inspector's report (July, 2003) on the physical and other teaching facilities available at N.B. Medical College, Darjeeling for consideration of starting of M.D. (Community Medicine) course u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Inspector's report (July, 2003) and decided to recommend to the Central Government to issue Letter of Permission for starting of M.D. (Community Medicine) course at N.B. Medical College, Darjeeling affiliated to University of North Bengal u/s 10 A of the IMC Act, 1956 prospectively restricting the number of admissions to 2(two) students per year till the first batch admitted appears in the final examination of the said course. The institution be advised to apply for recognition of the

qualification at the time of first available examination as per the provision of Section 11 (2) of the Act, 1956.

18. Starting of M.D.(Pathology) & D.C.P. courses at Dr.D.Y.Patil Pratishtan's Medical College for Women, Pune affiliated to Pune University u/s 10A of the I.M.C. Act, 1956.

Read : the Council Inspector's report (July, 2003) on physical and other teaching facilities available at Dr. D.Y.Patil Pratishtan's Medical College for Women, Pune for consideration of starting of M.D.(Pathology) & D.C.P. courses u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Inspector's report (July, 2003) and decided to obtain details of teaching experience of Prof. & Head of the department of Pathology and defer the consideration of the matter till such time the information as regards the details of teaching experience of HOD is received from the institution authorities.

19. Starting of M.D.(Dermatology, Venereology & Leprosy) & D.D.V.L. courses at Dr.D.Y.Patil Medical College for Women, Pune affiliated to Pune University u/s 10A of the I.M.C. Act, 1956.

Read : the Council Inspector's report (July, 2003) on the physical and other teaching facilities available at Dr.D.Y.Patil Medical College for Women, Pune for consideration of starting of M.D.(Dermatology, Venereology & Leprosy) & D.D.V.L. courses u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Inspector's report (July, 2003) and decided to recommend to the Central Government to issue Letter of Intent for starting of M.D. (Dermatology, Venereology & Leprosy) & D.D.V.L. courses at Dr.D.Y.Patil Medical College for Women, Pune affiliated to Pune University u/s 10 A of the IMC Act, 1956 prospectively restricting the number of admission to 1(one) student per year in each course.

The attention of the authorities be drawn towards the implementation of the observations made by the Council Inspector in the inspection report.

20. Increase of seats in M.S.(Orthopaedics) course at Nizam's Institute of Medical Sciences, Hyderabad affiliated to Nizam's Institute of Medical Sciences, Hyderabad (Deemed University) u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 – consideration of compliance verification regarding.

Read : the compliance verification report (July, 2003) togetherwith compliance and Council Inspector's report (May, 2002) on the physical and other teaching facilities available at Nizam's Institute of Medical Sciences, Hyderabad for increase of seats in M.S.(Orthopaedics) course u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the compliance verification report (July, 2003) togetherwith compliance and Council Inspector's report (May, 2002) and decided to recommend to Central Government to issue Letter of Permission for increase of seats in M.S.(Orthopaedics) course at Nizam's Institute of Medical Sciences, Hyderabad affiliated to Nizam's Institute of Medical Sciences, Hyderabad (Deemed University) u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 from 2(two) to 3(three) students per year prospectively till the first batch admitted against the increased number appears for the final examination of the said course.

Read : the Council Inspector's report ((June, 2002) on the physical and other teaching facilities available at Nizam's Institute of Medical Sciences, Hyderabad togetherwith compliance for increase of seats in D.M.(Cardiology) course u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Inspector report (June, 2002) together with compliance and decided to verify the compliance by way of an inspection.

22. i) **Increase of seats in M.D.(Pathology) course at Regional Institute of Medical Sciences, Imphal under Manipur University u/s 10A of the IMC Act,1956.**
- ii) **Manipur University- Recognition of M.D.(Pathology) qualification in respect of Regional Institute of Medical Sciences, Imphal granted by Manipur University.**

Read : the Council Inspector's report (July, 2003) on the standard of examination and other teaching facilities available at Regional Institute of Medical Sciences, Imphal for purpose of i) increase of seats in MD (Pathology) course at Regional Institute of Medical Sciences, Imphal ii) Recognition of MD (Pathology) qualification in respect of Regional institute of Medical Sciences, Imphal granted by Manipur University.

- (c) Facilities for frozen sectioning needs to be established.
- (d) Diagrams, charts and literature of mounted specimen on the rack of the museum need to be procured.
- (e) Postgraduate Students must maintain logbook.

Read : the Council Inspector's report (July,2002) on the standard of examination and other teaching facilities available at Pt.B.D.Sharma Postgraduate Institute of Medical Sciences, Rohtak togetherwith compliance for recognition of MD (Forensic Medicine) qualification granted by Maharishi Dayanand University, Rohtak

The Committee therefore reiterated its earlier decision to procure the same for further consideration.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Inspector's report (November, 2002) and decided not to approve Guru Gobind Singh Medical College, Faridkot for the award of MD (Psychiatry) qualification granted by Baba Farid University of Health Sciences, Faridkot because –

- (i) There is No Assoc. Prof. in the department.
- (ii) Teaching complement is not complete.
- (iii) Clinical material insufficient
- (iv) Number of journals inadequate.
- (v) Other observations/ deficiencies pointed out in the inspection report.

52. Bangalore University & Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences, Bangalore – Approval of Bangalore Medical College, Bangalore for award of MD (Dermatology) & DVD qualification – consideration of compliance verification regarding.

Read : the compliance verification report (April,2003) togetherwith compliance and Council Inspector's report (October,1997) on standard of examination and other teaching facilities available at Bangalore Medical College, Bangalore for purpose of recognition of MD (Dermatology) & DVD qualifications granted by Bangalore University.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the compliance verification report (April,2003) togetherwith compliance and Council Inspector's report (October,1997) and decided to recommend that Bangalore Medical College, Bangalore be approved for the award of MD (Dermatology) & DVD qualifications granted by Bangalore University. However, the authorities of the institution be directed to prospectively restrict the number of admissions to 4(four) students for degree and 2(two) students for diploma per year.

53. Mangalore University and Manipal Academy of Higher Education (Deemed University) Manipal – Recognition of D.M. (Neurology) qualification in respect of students being trained at Kasturba Medical College, Manipal.

Read : the Council Inspector report (July,2003) of standard of examination and other teaching facilities available at Kasturba Medical College, Manipal for purpose of recognition of D.M.(Neurology) qualification earlier granted by Mangalore University and now by Manipal Academy of Higher Education (Deemed University), Manipal.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Inspector report (July,2003) and decided not to recommend recognition of D.M (Neurology) qualification granted by Mangalore University in respect of students being trained at Kasturba Medical College, Manipal because –

- (i) The Prof. & HOD including Assoc. Prof. do not possess requisite recognised postgraduate qualification.
- (ii) Pattern of examination is not as per MCI norms.
- (iii) Other observations/ deficiencies pointed out in the inspection report.

The Committee in view of above decided to direct the institution authorities to henceforth stop admissions in DM (Neurology) qualification from the ensuing academic session.

54. The Tamilnadu Dr. M.G.R. Medical University, Chennai - Approval of Institute of Ophthalmology, Joseph Eye Hospital, Tiruchirapalli for the award of M.S.(Ophthalmology) & D.O. qualifications – consideration of compliance regarding.

Read : the Council Inspector's report (April, 2003) of standard of examination and other teaching facilities available at Institute of Ophthalmology, Joseph Eye Hospital, Tiruchirapalli togetherwith compliance for purpose of approval of the college for the award of M.S.(Ophthalmology) & D.O. qualifications granted by the Tamilnadu Dr. M.G.R. Medical University, Chennai.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Inspector's report (April, 2003) together with compliance and noted that the details of the teaching experience held by the faculty have not been provided as per the requirement to enable the Committee to decide in the matter.

The Committee, in view of above, decided that the Principal/Dean/Director of the institution be given an opportunity of personal hearing with the Secretary of MCI with the details of teaching faculty alongwith relevant teaching experience as per prescribed proforma.

The Committee further decided to defer the consideration of the matter till the required information is available.

55. Shivaji University-Recognition of M.S.(Ortho.) & D.Ortho. qualifications in respect of PG Institute of Swasthiyog Pratisthan, Miraj - consideration of compliance regarding.

Read : the Council Inspector's report (March, 2003) on the standard of examination and other teaching facilities available at P.G. Institute of Swasthiyog Pratisthan, Miraj togetherwith compliance for purpose of recognition of M.S.(Ortho.) & D.Ortho. qualifications granted by Shivaji university.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Inspector's report (March,2003) and decided to recommend that M. S.(Ortho.) & D.Ortho. qualifications granted by Shivaji university in respect of students being trained at P.G. Institute of Swasthiyog Pratisthan, Miraj be recognised and included in the 1st schedule to the I.M.C.Act,1956. However, the institution authorities are directed to prospectively restrict the number of admissions to 2 (two) for degree and 1 (one) for diploma in consonance with the Council Regulations on Postgraduate Medical Education,2000, as promotion of Unit II incharge is not as per MCI norms.

56. Mysore University - Recognition of M.D.(Pharmacology) qualification in respect of J.S.S. Medical College, Mysore.

Read : the letter dated 23.12.2002 from Principal, J.S.S. Medical College, Mysore with regard to recognition of M.D.(Pharmacology) qualification under Mysore University between 1993 to August,1999.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the letter dated 23.12.2002 from J.S.S. Medical College, Mysore and decided to recommend that MD(Pharmacology) qualification granted by Mysore University in respect of students trained at J.S.S. Medical College, Mysore be recognised and included in the 1st schedule to the I.M.C.Act,1956.

57. Approval of Goa Medical College, Goa for the award of M.D.(Psychiatry/Psychological Medicine) & DPM qualifications – affiliation with Bombay University regarding.

Read : the letter dated 8.7.2003 from Goa Medical College, Goa with regard to recognition of MD(Psychiatry/Psychological Medicine) & DPM qualifications under Bombay University as the said college initially was under the said university.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the letter dated 8.7.2003 from Goa Medical College, Goa and decided to recommend that Goa Medical College, Goa be approved for the award of MS (Psychiatry/Psychological Medicine) & DPM qualifications granted by Bombay University.

58. NTRUHS – Inspection of certain PG Degree course with nomenclature other than specified once –letter regarding.

Read : the letter dated 31.5.2003 with regard to change of nomenclature as M.Ch.(Cardio-Thoracic & Vascular Surgery) in place of already recognised subject M.Ch.(Cardio-Thoracic Surgery) and cancellation of inspection for starting of M.Ch.(Vascular Surgery).

The Postgraduate Committee considered the letter dated 31.5.2003 and decided that permission for starting of courses/increase in intake shall be as per the subjects/ nomenclature of the degrees included in the governing schedule of the Council.

- 59. i) Punjab University -Approval of Pt. B.D. Sharma Postgraduate Institute of Medical Sciences, Rohtak. For the award of M.D.(Pharmacology) qualification.**
- ii) Kurukshetra University, B.N. Chakarvarty University, Rohtak University and Maharishi Dayanand University, Rohtak - Recognition of M.D.(Pharmacology) qualification in respect of students being trained at Pt. B.D. Sharma Postgraduate Institute of Medical Sciences, Rohtak.**

Read : the Council Inspector's report (July, 2003) on the standard of examination and other teaching facilities available at Pt. B.D. The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Inspector's report (July, 2003) and decided to recommend that :-

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Inspector's report (May, 2003) and decided to recommend that MS (ENT) qualification granted by Kerala University in respect of students being trained at Medical College, Trivandrum be recognised and included in the first schedule to the IMC Act,1956 restricting the number of admissions to 2 (two) students per year.

61. Rajasthan University – Approval of S.N. Medical College, Jodhpur for the award of MS (Anatomy) qualification .

Read : the Council Inspector's report (May, 2003) on the standard of examination and other teaching facilities available at S.N. Medical College, Jodhpur together with compliance for purpose of approval of the college for the award of MS (Anatomy) qualification granted by Rajasthan University.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Inspector's report (May,2003) together with compliance and noted that the Prof. & HOD does not possess requisite recognised postgraduate qualification and decided to reiterate its earlier decision not to approve the S.N.Medical College, Jodhpur for the award of MS(Anatomy) qualification granted by Rajasthan University.

The Committee further decided that the authorities of the institution be directed to stop admission with immediate effect.

62. Delhi University - Approval of University College of Medical Sciences, Delhi for the award of M.D.(Forensic Medicine) qualification.

Read : the Council Inspector's report (April, 2001) on the standard of examination and other teaching facilities available at University College of Medical Sciences, Delhi togetherwith Advocate's letter dated 25/7/2003 for purpose of approval of the college for the award of M.D.(Forensic Medicine) qualification granted by Delhi University.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Inspector's report (April,2001) and decided to seek legal opinion in the matter.

63. Rajasthan University – Approval of J.L.N. Medical College, Ajmer for the award of M.D.(Dermatology, Venereology & Leprosy) qualification.

Read : the Council Inspector's report (July, 2003) on the standard of examination and other teaching facilities available at J.L.N. Medical College, Ajmer for purpose of approval of the college for the award of M.D.(Dermatology, Venereology & Leprosy) qualification granted by Rajasthan University.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Inspector's report (July,2003) and decided to recommend that JLN Medical College, Ajmer be approved for the award of M.D.(Dermatology, Venereology & Leprosy) qualification granted by Rajasthan University restricting the number of admission to 1 (one) student per year.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Inspector's report (June,2003) and decided to recommend that MD(Dermatology) qualification granted by Dibrugarh University in respect of students being trained at Assam Medical College, Dibrugarh be recognised and included in the first schedule to the IMC Act,1956 restricting the number of admissions to 2(two) students per years.

65. Calcutta University – Approval of Vivekanand Institute of Medical Sciences, Calcutta for the award of M.D.(Obst. & Gyane.) & D.G.O. qualifications.

Read : the Council Inspector's report (April, 2003) on the standard of examination and other teaching facilities available at Vivekanand Institute of Medical Sciences, Calcutta for purpose of approval of the college for the award of M.D.(Obst. & Gyane.) & D.G.O. qualifications granted by Calcutta University.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Inspector's report (April,2003) and noted that the teaching compliment is not complete in unit 1 & 2 and decided that the authorities of the institution be advised to reorganize the units as regards teaching faculty as per MCI norms.

The Committee further decided to defer the consideration till the information is received from the institution.

66. Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences, Bangalore – Approval of M.S. Ramaiah Medical College, Bangalore for the award of D.V.D. qualification .

Read : the Council Inspector's report (April, 2003) on the standard of examination and other teaching facilities available at M.S. Ramaiah Medical College, Bangalore for purpose of approval of the college for the award of D.V.D. qualification granted by Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences, Bangalore.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Inspector's report (April,2003) and decided to ascertain whether the college is running a P.G. degree course in Dermatology and with what sanctioned annual intake.

The Committee further decided to defer the consideration till the time the above information is received from the institution authorities.

67. University of Pune – Approval of Rural Medical College, Loni for award of MS (Ophthalmology) & DO qualifications.

Read : the Council Inspector's report (July,1997) on standard of examination and other teaching facilities available at Rural Medical College, Loni for purpose of approval of the college for the award of M.S.(Ophthalmology) & D.O. qualifications granted by University of Pune.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Inspector's report (July,1997) and decided to recommend that Rural Medical College, Loni be approved for the award of MS (Ophthalmology) & DO qualifications granted by University of Poona. However, the institution authorities are directed to prospectively restrict the number of admissions to 2 (two) for degree and 1 (one) for diploma in consonance with the Council Regulations on Postgraduate Medical Education,2000, as the incharge of Unit II does not possess recognised Postgraduate Medical Qualification.

68. University of Bombay/Mumbai – Approval of Institute of Navel Medicine, INHS, Aswini, Mumbai for the award of M.D.(Anaesthesia) qualification.

Read : the Council Inspector's report (January, 2003) on the standard of examination and other teaching facilities available at Institute of Navel Medicine, INHS, Aswini, Mumbai for purpose of approval of the college for the award of M.D.(Anaesthesia) qualification earlier granted by University of Bombay and now by University of Mumbai.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Inspector's report (January, 2003) and noted that the details of the teaching experience held by the faculty have not been provided as per the requirement to enable the Committee to decide in the matter.

The Committee, in view of above, decided that the Principal/Dean/Commandant of the institution be given an opportunity of personal hearing with the Secretary of MCI with the details of posting with respective institutions, dates and rank of the faculty alongwith the relevant teaching experience.

The Committee further decided to defer the consideration of the matter till the required information is available.

69. Standard format for use of Council Inspector for postgraduate inspections-consideration regarding.

Read : the standard format as prepared by the Sub-Committee for use of Council Inspector for postgraduate inspections.

The Postgraduate Committee considered a standard format as finalised by the Sub-Committee for use of Council Inspector for Postgraduate Inspections and decided to approve the format with the following modifications:-

1. Page No.4, format Sl.No.7 – Year-wise average daily patient attendance (during previous period three years).
2. Page No.10, item 5 – Year-wise available clinical material (during previous three years).
3. Part V of the format of the Deptt. of Psychiatry, a point Clinical Psychologist be added before Any other as well as in the Teachers Eligibility qualifications.

70. Setting up of a Postgraduate Institute of Medical Education & Research at Dr. R.M.L. Hospital, New Delhi.

Read : the Central Govt. letter dated 14.7.2003 with regard to setting up of a Postgraduate Institute of Medical Education & Research at Dr. R.M.L. Hospital, New Delhi.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Central Govt. letter dated 14.7.2003 and decided to seek legal opinion in the matter.

71. Delhi University - Approval of Maulana Azad Medical College, New Delhi for the award of D.G.O. qualification - consideration of compliance regarding.

Read : the Council Inspector's report (April, 2003) on the standard of examination and other teaching facilities available at Maulana Azad Medical College, New Delhi together with compliance for purpose of approval of the college for the award of D.G.O. qualification granted by Delhi University.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Inspector's report (April, 2003) together with compliance and decided to recommend that Maulana Azad Medical College, New Delhi be approved for the award of DGO qualification granted by Delhi University. However, the authorities of the institution are directed to prospectively restrict the number of admissions to 4 (four) students per year in consonance with the Council Regulations on Postgraduate Medical Education, 2000.

72. Lucknow University – Continuance of recognition of M.D.(Obst. & Gynae.) & D.G.O. qualifications in respect of students being trained at K.G. Medical College, Lucknow.

Read : the Council Inspector's report (May, 2003) on the standard of examination and other teaching facilities available at K.G. Medical College, Lucknow for purpose of continuance of recognition of M.D.(Obst. & Gynae.) & D.G.O. qualifications granted by Lucknow University.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Inspector's report (May,2003) and decided not to recommend continuation of recognition of MD(Obst. & Gynae.) & DGO qualifications granted by Lucknow University in respect of students being trained at K.G. medical College, Lucknow because of the following:-

1. The teaching compliment is incomplete in all the units.
2. Other deficiencies as pointed out in the inspection report.

In view of above, the Committee further decided that the authorities of the institution be directed to stop admission with immediate effect.

73. Increase of seats in M.D.(Anaesthesia) course at Regional Institute of Medical Sciences, Imphal under Manipur University u/s 10A of the IMC Act,1956.

Read : the Council Inspector report (July 2003) on the physical and other teaching facilities available at Regional Institute of Medical Sciences, Imphal for consideration of increase of seats in M.D.(Anaesthesia) course u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Inspector report (July,2003) and decided to recommend to Central Govt. to issue Letter of Permission for increase of seats in MD(Anaesthesia) course at Regional Institute of Medical Sciences, Imphal affiliated to Manipur University from 3(three) to 4(four) students per year prospectively u/s 10A of the IMC Act,1956 till the first batch admitted against the increased numbers appears for the final examination of the said course.

74. Starting of M.D.(Physical Medicine & Rehabilitation) course at S.V. Medical College, Tirupati affiliated to N.T.R. University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.

Read : the Council Inspector report (August, 2003) on the physical and other teaching facilities available at Guntur Medical College, Guntur for consideration of starting of M.Ch.(Neuro-Surgery) course u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Inspector report (August,2003) and decided to recommend to Central Govt. not to issue Letter of Intent for starting of M.Ch.(Neuro-Surgery) course at Guntur Medical College, Guntur affiliated to N.T.R. University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada u/s 10A of the IMC Act,1956 because of the following:-

1. ICU facilities are inadequate.
2. OPD poorly maintained.
3. Library facilities are also inadequate.
4. There is no Assoc. Prof. in the department
5. Teaching compliment is incomplete.
6. Other deficiencies pointed out in the inspection report.

76. Starting of M.D.(Physiology) course at N.B. Medical College, Darjeeling affiliated to University of North Bengal u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Inspector report (July,2003) and decided to recommend to Central Govt. to issue Letter of Permission for starting of M.D. (Physiology) course at N.B. Medical College, Darjeeling affiliated to University of North Bengal u/s 10A of the IMC Act,1956 prospectively restricting the number of admissions to 3 (three) students per year till the first batch admitted appears in the final examination of the said course. The institution be advised to apply for recognition of the qualification at the time of first available examination as per provision of Section 11(2) of the IMC Act,1956.

77. Starting of M.D.(Paediatrics) course at M.G.M. Medical College, Navi Mumbai affiliated to University of Mumbai u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.

Read : the Council Inspector report (August, 2003) on the physical and other teaching facilities available at M.G.M.Medical College, Navi Mumbai for consideration of starting of M.D.(Paediatrics) course u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Inspector report (August,2003) and decided to recommend to Central Govt. to issue Letter of Permission for starting of M.D. (Paediatrics) course at M.G.M. Medical College, Navi Mumbai affiliated to University of Mumbai u/s 10A of the IMC Act,1956 prospectively restricting the number of admissions to 3 (three) students per year till the first batch admitted appears in the final examination of the said course. The institution be advised to apply for recognition of the qualification at the time of first available examination as per provision of Section 11(2) of the IMC Act,1956.

78. Starting/Increase of seats in various postgraduate courses at Shri B.M. Patil Medical College, Bijapur affiliated to Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences, Bangalore u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.

Read : the matter together with teaching faculty of the department of radio-diagnosis supplied by institution vide letter dated 25.07.2003 with regard to Starting/Increase of seats in various postgraduate courses at Shri B.M. Patil Medical College, Bijapur affiliated to Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences, Bangalore u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the matter togetherwith list of teaching faculty of the department of Radio-Diagnosis with regard to starting/Increase of seats in the following postgraduate courses at Shri B.M. Patil Medical College, Bijapur affiliated to Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences, Bangalore u/s 10A of the IMC Act,1956 and noted that now the department of Radio-Diagnosis has sufficient teaching faculty for undergraduate intake of 150.

Read: the Council Inspector's report (May,2003) on the physical and other teaching facilities available at Shri B.M.Patil Medical College, Bijapur for increase of seats in M.D.(Pathology) course.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Inspector report (May,2003) and decided to recommend to Central Govt. to issue Letter of Permission for increase of seats in MD(Pathology) course at Shri B.M. Read : the Council Inspector report (October, 2002) on the physical and other teaching facilities available at Dr.M.G.R. Medical University Campus, Chennai together with compliance for consideration of starting of M.D.(Immuno Haematology & Blood Transfusion) course u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Inspector report (October,2002) together with compliance and decided to verify the compliance by way of inspection.

80. Sardar Patel University – Recognition of DCH qualification in respect of students being trained at Pramukhswami Medical College, Karamsad.

Read : the Council inspector's report (August, 2003) on the standard of examination and other teaching facilities available at Pramukhswami Medical College, Karamsad for purpose of recognition of DCH qualification granted by Sardar Patel University.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Inspector's report (August,2003) and noted that the department has no Peadiatric ICU and decided that operational status of fully equipped Peadiatric ICU be ascertained. The Committee further decided to defer the consideration till the information is received.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Inspector's report (March,2003) and decided to recommend that Christian Medical College, Vellore be approved for the award of MD(Biochemistry) qualification earlier granted by Madras University and now by The Tamilnadu Dr.M.G.R. Medical University, Chennai restricting the number of admission to 1(one) student per year.

- 84. i) Andhra University – Recognition of MD(SPM/Community Medicine) & DPH qualifications in respect of students being trained at Andhra Medical College, Visakhapatnam.**
- (ii) Andhra Pradesh University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada and N.T.R. University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada - Approval of Andhra Medical College, Visakhapatnam for the award of M.D.(SPM/Community Medicine) & DPH qualifications.**

Read : the Council Inspector report (May, 2001) on the standard of examination and other teaching facilities available at Andhra Medical College, Visakhapatnam together with compliance for i) recognition of MD(SPM/Community Medicine) & DPH qualifications granted by Andhra University and ii) approval of the college for the award of M.D.(SPM/Community Medicine) & DPH qualifications granted by Andhra Pradesh University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada & NTR University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Inspector report (May,2001) and decided not to recommend recognition/approval of Andhra Medical College, Visakhapatnam for the award of MD(SPM/Community Medicine) & DPH qualifications granted by Andhra Pradesh

University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada & NTR University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada because:-

1. The promotion of Prof. & HOD is not as per MCI norms.
2. Other deficiencies pointed out in the inspection report.

The Committee further decided that the authorities of the institution be directed to stop admission in MD (Community Medicine/SPM) & DPH courses with immediate effect.

85. University of Bombay/Mumbai – Approval of Institute of Navel Medicine, INHS, Aswini, Mumbai for the award of MD (Pathology) qualification .

Read : the Council inspector's report (July, 2003) on standard of examination and other teaching facilities available at Institute of Navel Medicine, INHS, Aswini, Mumbai for purpose of approval of the college for the award of MD (Pathology) qualification earlier granted by University of Bombay and now by University of Mumbai.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Inspector's report (July,2003) and noted that the details of the teaching experience held by the faculty have not been provided as per the requirement to enable the Committee to decide in the matter.

The Committee, in view of above, decided that the Principal/Dean/Commandant of the institution be given an opportunity of personal hearing with the Secretary of MCI with the details of posting with respective institutions, dates and rank of the faculty alongwith the relevant teaching experience.

The Committee further decided to defer the consideration of the matter till the required information is available.

Read : the Central Govt. letter dated 29.4.88 with regard to inclusion of Postgraduate degrees awarded by Shri Chitra Tirunal Institute of Medical Sciences & Technology in the first Schedule to the IMC Act,. 1956.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Central Govt. letter dated 29.4.88 with regard to inclusion of Postgraduate degrees awarded by Shri Chitra Tirunal Institute of Medical Sciences & Technology in the first Schedule to the IMC Act,. 1956 and decided to seek legal opinion in the matter.

88. MCI not recommending , starting or continuing DNB/Dip.NB course at its recognised medical Institution – request for reconsideration.

Read : the letter dated 8.8.2003 from Dr. K. M. Rameshchandra Babu, Member, MCI against stoppage of conducting DNB/Dip NB courses at MCI recognised medical institutions.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the letter dated 8.8.2003 and decided to refer the matter to Sub-Committee already constituted under the Chairmanship of Dr.L.S.Chawla.

89. Organizing Training and issuing an IAN Donald Diploma Course in Obstetrics & Gynaec., Ultrasound jointly by IFUMB & FOGSI and other diploma courses in Ultrasonography.

Read : the letter dated 4.8.2003 from Dr.Prashant K.Gupta, Meerut with regard to take an urgent action against short duration(3 days) diploma course in the field of Radiology.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the letter dated 4.8.2003 with regard to take an urgent action against short duration (3 days) diploma course in the field of Radiology and decided to seek the comments of the organisers as the date of conducting the course (15th August to 17th August) is already over.

90. 6 year Neurosurgical Training Programme – letter reg.
