1. **Minutes of the last meeting of the Postgraduate Committee–Confirmation of.**

The minutes of the Postgraduate Committee meeting held on 1st & 2nd July, 2003 were confirmed.

2. **Minutes of the last meeting of the Postgraduate Committee-action taken thereon.**

Action taken on the minutes of the last meeting of Postgraduate Committee was noted & approved.

3. **Work out put report of the requests received u/s 10A for the year 2002 to 2003.**

The Postgraduate Committee noted the work out put report of the requests u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 for the year 2001 to 2003 which were placed on table.

4. **Increase of seats in M.D. (Anaesthesia) & D.A. courses at J.S.S. Medical College, Mysore affiliated to Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences, Bangalore u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.**

Read : the Council Inspector's report (June, 2003) on the physical and other teaching facilities available at J.S.S. Medical College, Mysore for increase of seats in M.D.(Anaesthesia) & D.A. Courses.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Inspector's report (June, 2003) and decided to recommend to Central Government to issue Letter of Permission for increase of seats in M.D. (Anaesthesia) & D.A. courses at J.S.S. Medical College, Mysore affiliated to Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences, Bangalore u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 prospectively restricting the number of admissions to 5 (five) students per year in each course till the first batch admitted against the increased number appears for the final examinations of the said courses. The institution be advised to apply for recognition of the qualifications at the time of first available examinations as per the provision of Section 11(2) of the Act, 1956

5. Increase of seats in M.S.(General Surgery) course at J.S.S. Medical College, Mysore affiliated to Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences, Bangalore u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.

Read : the Council Inspector's report (July, 2003) on the physical and other teaching facilities available at J.S.S. Medical College, Mysore for increase of seats in M.S.(General Surgery) course u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Inspector's report (July, 2003). On going through the inspection report it was observed that some information in relation to the general facilities in the hospital as well as in the department of General Surgery have not been mentioned by the Inspector namely:-

- i) General: Central laundry, CSSD, central oxygen, central suction, surgical books available in central library, work load of central laboratory, work load of Radio-Diagnosis department, separate postgraduate hostels facilities, any other postgraduate courses running in the institution or not.
- ii) Departmental: Departmental seminar room, side lab. in surgical ward, teaching corners in surgery ward.
- iii) Whether super speciality departments other than Paediatric Surgery are existing in the institution or not and if any, where the postgraduate students will be trained for super speciality departments?

Under these circumstances the Committee recommends that a fresh inspection may be carried out.

6. Starting of M.D.(Radio-Diagnosis) & D.M.R.D. courses at Kempegowda Institute of Medical Sciences, Bangalore affiliated to Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences, Bangalore u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.

Read : the Council Inspector's report (May, 2003) on the physical and other teaching facilities available at Kempegowda Institute of Medical Sciences, Bangalore for consideration of starting of M.D.(Radio-Diagnosis) & D.M.R.D. courses u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Inspector's report (May, 2003) and decided to recommend to the Central Government not to issue Letter of Intent for starting of M.D. (Radio-Diagnosis) & DMRD courses at Kempegowda Institute of Medical Sciences, Bangalore u/s 10 A of the IMC Act, 1956 because of the following –

- i) Instrumentation is inadequate.
- ii) MRI is not available.
- iii) Medical Record Department needs computerization.
- iv) No coding of indexing of patients are done.
- v) Casualty requires more number of life saving and monitoring equipments including defibrillator, Monitors and emergency ventilator.
- vi) There is no separate kitchen for patients in the hospital.
- vii) Other deficiencies as pointed out in the inspection report.

7. Starting of M.S.(Ophthalmology) course at Shri B.M. Patil Medical College, Bijapur affiliated to Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences, Bangalore u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.

Read : the Council Inspector's report (June, 2003) on the physical and other teaching facilities available at Shri B.M.Patil Medical College, Bijapur for consideration of starting of M.S.(Ophthalmology) course u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Inspector's report (June,2003) and decided to defer the consideration of the matter till the receipt of the information as regards the details of teaching faculty in the department of Radio-Diagnosis which has already been requested while the matter of other subject of the institute was under consideration

8. Starting of MD(Psychiatry) course at Govt. Medical College, Rajkot affiliated to Saurashtra University u/s 10A of the I.M.C.Act,1956 – consideration of compliance verification regarding.

The institution be advised to apply for recognition of the qualification at the time of first available examination as per the provision of Section 11 (2) of the Act, 1956.

9. Starting of M.S.(General Surgery) course at Dr. D.Y.Patil Pratishtan's Medical College for Women, Pune affiliated to Pune University u/s 10A of the I.M.C. Act, 1956.

10. Starting of M.D.(Pharmacology) course at N.K.P. Salve Institute of Medical Sciences, Nagpur affilaited to Nagpur University u/s 10A of the I.M.C. Act, 1956.

Read : the Council Inspector report (June 2003) on the physical and other teaching facilities available at N.K.P. Salve Institute of Medical Sciences, Nagpur for consideration of starting of M.D.(Pharmacology) course u/s 10A of IMC Act, 1956.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Inspector's report (June, 2003) and decided to recommend to the Central Government not to issue Letter of Intent for starting of M.D. (Pharmacology) course at N.K.P. Salve Institute of Medical Sciences, Nagpur u/s 10 A of the IMC Act, 1956 because of the following –

- i) Prof. & HOD does not have requisite recognised postgraduate qualification.
- ii) Other deficiencies as pointed out in the inspection report.

- (vii) Other deficiencies pointed out in the inspection report.

Salve Institute of Medical Sciences, Nagpur affiliated to Nagpur University u/s 10 A of the IMC Act, 1956 prospectively restricting the number of admissions to 2(two) students per year till the first batch admitted appears in the final examination of the said course. The institution be advised to apply for recognition of the qualification at the time of first available examination as per the provision of Section 11 (2) of the Act, 1956.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Inspector's report (June, 2003) and decided to recommend to the Central Government not to issue Letter of Intent for starting of M.D. (Biochemistry) course at Govt. Medical College, Kolkata u/s 10 A of the IMC Act, 1956 because of the following observations of the Council Inspector–

- i) Biochemistry Lab. is not under the control of Head of Deptt. of Biochemistry.
- ii) Three fake teachers who were made to be present there on 30.6.2003 for physical verification were brought over there from some other medical colleges of Calcutta which has got four medical colleges in the city itself. Declaration forms of such teachers were not handed over to the inspector.
- iii) Third Professor named Dr. Shib Nath Banerjee is still posted at Burdwan Medical College, Burdwan, West Bengal and was asked to remain physically present in the medical college before inspection dates. Therefore the posting is also highly suspicious. That's why he has not mentioned exact dates from..to... in the declaration form.
- iv) The only 'Lecturer' present has already joined an upcoming Medical College at Dhamtari (Chattisgarh) as per the observation by the inspector.
- v) Other deficiencies pointed out in the inspection report.

28. Starting of M.D.(Obst. & Gynae.) course at R.G. Kar Medical College, Kolkata affiliated to University of Calcutta u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.

Read : the Council Inspector's report (June, 2003) on the physical and other teaching facilities available at R.G. Kar Medical College, Kolkata for consideration of starting of M.D. (Obst. & Gynae.) course u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Inspector's report (June, 2003) and decided to recommend to the Central Government to issue Letter of Permission for starting of M.D. (Obst. & Gynae.) course at R.G. Kar Medical College, Kolkata affiliated to University of Calcutta u/s 10 A of the IMC Act, 1956 prospectively restricting the number of admissions to 6(six) students per year till the first batch admitted appears in the final examination of the said course. The institution be advised to apply for recognition of the qualification at the time of first available examination as per the provision of Section 11 (2) of the Act, 1956.

The attention of the authorities be drawn towards the implementation of the observations made by the Council Inspector in the inspection report.

29. Starting of M.D.(Dermatology, Venereology & Leprosy) course at Madurai Medical College, Madurai affiliated to The Tamilnadu Dr.M.G.R. Medical University, Chennai u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 – compliance regarding.

Read : the Council Inspector report (March, 2003) on the physical and other teaching facilities available at Madurai Medical College, Madurai togetherwith compliance for consideration of starting of M.D.(Dermatology, Venereology & Leprosy) course u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Inspector report (March,2003) together with compliance and noted that there is no change from the previous report and deficiencies pointed out earlier have remained the same and decided to reiterate its earlier decision taken at its meeting held on 3.6.2003 to recommend to the Central Government not to issue Letter of Intent for starting of M.D. (Dermatology, Venereology & Leprosy) course at Madurai Medical College, Madurai affiliated to Dr.M.G.R. Medical University, Chennai u/s 10 A of the IMC Act, 1956.

30. Starting of M.S.(E.N.T.) course at Stanley Medical College, Chennai affiliated to The Tamilnadu Dr.M.G.R.Medical University u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.

Read : the Council Inspector's report (May, 2003) on the physical and other teaching facilities available at Stanley Medical College, Chennai for consideration of starting of M.S.(E.N.T.) course u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Inspector's report (May, 2003) and decided to recommend to the Central Government not to issue Letter of Intent for starting of M.S. (ENT) course at Stanley Medical College, Chennai u/s 10 A of the IMC Act, 1956 because of the following –

- i) The promotion of all the Professors including HOD and Addl. Professors are not as per MCI norms.
- ii) Teaching complement is incomplete.
- iii) Other deficiencies pointed out in the inspection report

31. Starting of various postgraduate courses at Padamshree D.Y.Patil Medical College, Navi Mumbai – permission of Central Govt. regarding.

Read : the matter for starting of M.D.(General Medicine), M.D.(Paediatrics) & D.C.H. courses at D.Y.Patil Medical College, Navi Mumbai u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 as the request received vide Central Govt. letter dated 21.2.2002.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the matter for starting of M.D.(General Medicine), M.D.(Paediatrics) & D.C.H. courses at D.Y.Patil Medical College, Navi Mumbai u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956, the request for which was received vide Central Govt. letter dated 21.2.2002 and as per provision of scheme deficient information/document were requested by this

Council vide letters dated 26.6.2002 and 16.1.2003. Since there has been no response from the authorities of the institution, the Postgraduate Committee decided to return the application to the Central Government, Ministry of Health & F.W., for necessary action after retaining the non-refundable fees submitted by the institution in pursuance of Clause 2 of the Scheme which states as under:

*“Scheme shall be submitted by registered post to the Secretary (Health), Ministry of Health & F.W., Deptt. of Health, Govt. of India, Nirman Bhawan, New Delhi alongwith the information and **non-refundable** application fee of Rs. 2 lakhs in the form of demand draft in favour of “Medical Council of India” and payable “at Delhi”. This fee is for registration, technical scrutiny and contingent charges and for inspections (two physical inspections for Diploma courses and three inspections for degree courses). Besides the above inspection, the normal inspection fee and the inspection fee for recognition of the course shall apply to the concerned medical college or institution” as notified in the Gazette of India dt. 7.10.2000.”*

32. Starting of M.Ch.(Plastic Surgery) course at Guntur Medical College, Guntur affiliated to N.T.R. University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Inspector’s report (May, 2003) and decided to recommend to the Central Government not to issue Letter of Intent for starting of M.Ch. (Plastic Surgery) course at Guntur Medical College, Guntur u/s 10 A of the IMC Act, 1956 because of the following –

- i) The promotion of Head of Department is not as per MCI norms.
- ii) Teaching complement is incomplete.
- iii) Other deficiencies pointed out in the inspection report.

33. Calcutta University – Approval of Vivekanand Institute of Medical Sciences, Calcutta for the award of M.D. (Paediatrics) & D.C.H. qualifications.

Read : the Council Inspector’s report (April, 2003) on the standard of examination and other teaching facilities available at Vivekanand Institute of Medical Sciences, Calcutta for purpose of approval of the college for the award of M.D. (Paediatrics) & D.C.H. qualifications granted by Calcutta University.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Inspector’s report (April, 2003) and observed that no MD/D.C.H. students in the subject of Pediatrics enrolled in this institute appeared for the examination, although the examination was conducted at Calcutta under the University of Calcutta.

The Committee therefore decided to obtain following information from the institute and separately from the University:

- (i) Details of students alongwith name admitted in this institute year-wise, course-wise since 1990 and
- (ii) Last examination conducted by the University of Calcutta in respect of students trained in the subject of Paediatric in this institute for MD & DCH.

34. Calcutta University – Approval of Vivekanand Institute of Medical Sciences, Calcutta for the award of M.S.(E.N.T.) & D.L.O. qualifications.

Read : the Council Inspector’s report (April,2003) on the standard of examination and other teaching facilities available at Vivekanand Institute of Medical Sciences, Calcutta togetherwith institution letter dated 30/6/2003 for purpose of approval of the college for the award of M.S.(E.N.T.) & D.L.O. qualifications granted by Calcutta University.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Inspector's report (April,2003) and decided not to approve Vivekanand Institute of Medical Sciences, Calcutta for the award of MS (ENT) and DLO qualifications granted by Calcutta University because of the following:-

- i) No Associate Professor in Unit No. I.
- ii) Teaching complement is incomplete.
- iii) Other deficiencies pointed out in the inspection report.

35. Sri Ramachandra Medical College & Research Institute (Deemed University) – Recognition of M.D. (Dermatology, Venereology & Leprosy) qualification in respect of Sri Ramachandra Medical College & Research Institute, Chennai.

Read : the Council Inspector's report (June, 2003) on the standard of examination and other teaching facilities available at Sri Ramachandra Medical College & Research Institute, Chennai for purpose of recognition of M.D. (Dermatology, Venereology & Leprosy) qualification granted by the Institute (Deemed University).

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Inspector's report (June, 2003) and decided to advise the institution authorities to re-organise the units as regards teaching faculty of the department of Dermatology, Venereology & Leprosy as per MCI norms.

The Committee further decided to defer the consideration of the matter till the institution reorganizes the units as per MCI norms and submits the compliance.

36. Madras University and The Tamilnadu Dr. M.G.R. Medical University, Chennai – Approval of Medical Research Foundation (Sankara Nethralaya), Chennai for the award of D.O. qualification – compliance regarding.

Read : the Council Inspector's report (April, 2003) on the standard of examination and other teaching facilities available at Medical Research Foundation (Sankara Nethralaya), Chennai togetherwith compliance for purpose of approval of the college for the award of D.O. qualification earlier granted by Madras University and now by The Tamilnadu Dr. M.G.R. Medical University, Chennai.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Inspector's report (April, 2003) together with compliance and noted that the details of the teaching experience held by the faculty have not been provided as per the requirement to enable the Committee to decide in the matter.

The Committee, in view of above, decided that the Principal/Dean/Director of the institution be given an opportunity of personal hearing with the Secretary of MCI with the details of teaching faculty alongwith relevant teaching experience as per prescribed proforma.

The Committee further decided to defer the consideration of the matter till the required information is available.

37. Kerala University – Recognition of MD (Psychiatry) qualification in respect of Medical College, Trivandrum.

Read : the Council Inspector's report (June, 2003) on the standard of examination and other teaching facilities available at Medical College, Trivandrum for purpose of recognition of M.D.(Psychiatry) qualification granted by Kerala University.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Inspector's report (June, 2003) and decided to advise the institution authorities to re-organise the units as regards teaching faculty in the department of Psychiatry as per MCI norms.

The Committee further decided to defer the consideration of the matter till the institution reorganize the units as per MCI norms and submit the compliance.

38. Bangalore University and Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences, Bangalore – Approval of Kempegowda Institute of Medical Sciences, Bangalore for the award of M.D.(Pharmacology) qualification - compliance regarding.

Read : the Council Inspector's report (April, 2002) on the standard of examination and other teaching facilities available at Kempegowda Instt. of Medical Sciences, Bangalore together with compliance for purpose of approval of the college for the award of M.D.(Pharmacology) qualification granted by Bangalore University and now by Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences, Bangalore.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Inspector's report (April, 2002) together with compliance report and decided to verify the compliance by way of an inspection.

39. Guwahati University – Recognition of MD (Pathology) in respect of students being trained at Guwahati Medical College, Guwahati.

Read : the Council Inspector's report (June, 2003) on the standard of examination and other teaching facilities available at Guwahati Medical College, Guwahati for purpose of recognition of M.D.(Pathology) qualification granted Guwahati University.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Inspector's report (June, 2003) and decided not to recommend recognition of M.D. (Pathology) qualification granted by Guwahati University in respect of students being trained at Guwahati Medical College, Guwahati because of the following –

- (i) The staff is insufficient even for undergraduate admissions of 156 annually permitted by MCI.
- (ii) Other observations/ deficiencies pointed out in the inspection report.

The Committee in view of above, decided to direct the authorities of the institution to henceforth stop admissions in MD (Pathology) course with prospective effect.

40. Recognition of Dr. S.R. Gurumurthy as Postgraduate Teacher in Biochemistry – Reg.

Read : the letter dated 7/12/2002 from Principal, Bangalore Medical College, Bangalore with regard to recognition as Postgraduate Teacher in the Department of Biochemistry of Dr. S.R. Gurumurthy, Prof. & HOD.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the letter dated 7.12.2002 from the Principal, Bangalore Medical College, Bangalore forwarding therewith the request of Dr. S.R. Gurumurthy, Prof. & Head of Deptt. of Biochemistry and noted that Dr. S.R. Gurumurthy has obtained Ph.D. qualification in 1991 from NIMHANS, Bangalore after obtaining MBBS qualification in 1973 and further that after initial lecturership, he was Asstt. Prof. in Biochemistry from 1993-99 and thereafter Professor from November, 99 till date. As such, he does not fulfill the prescribed eligibility in terms of the governing T.E.Q. Regulations, 1998 of the Council.

The Committee, in view of the above facts, decided not to recognise Dr. S.R. Gurumurthy as Postgraduate Teacher in Biochemistry.

41. Saurashtra University – Recognition of MD (Forensic Medicine) in respect of students being trained at M. P. Shah Medical College, Jamnagar.

Read : the Council Inspector's report (June, 2003) on the standard of examination and other teaching facilities available at M.P. Shah Medical College, Jamnagar for purpose of recognition of MD (Forensic Medicine) qualification granted Saurashtra University.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Inspector's report (June, 2003) and decided to recommend that MD (Forensic Medicine) qualification granted by Saurashtra University in respect of students being trained at M.P. Shah Medical College, Jamnagar be recognised and included in the first schedule to the IMC Act, 1956 restricting the number of admission to 1(one) student per year.

42. Gujarat University – Approval of Smt. NHL Municipal Medical College Ahmedabad for the award of M.Ch.(Plastic Surgery) qualification.

Read : the Council Inspector's report (May, 2003) on the standard of examination and other teaching facilities available at Smt. N.H.L. Municipal Medical College Ahmedabad for purpose of approval of the college for the award of M.Ch.(Plastic Surgery) qualification granted by Gujarat University.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Inspector's report (May, 2003) and decided to recommend that Smt. NHL Municipal Medical College, Ahmedabad be approved for the award of M.Ch. (Plastic Surgery) qualification granted by Gujarat University restricting the number of admissions to 4(four) students per year.

43 Increase of seats in M.S.(General Surgery) course at Shri B.M. Patil Medical College, Bijapur affiliated to Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences, Bangalore u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.

Read: the Council Inspector's report (June,2003) on the physical and other teaching facilities available at Shri B.M.Patil Medical College, Bijapur for increase of seats in M.S.(General Surgery) course.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Inspector's report (June,2003) and decided to defer the consideration of the matter till the receipt of the information as regards the details of teaching faculty in the department of Radio-Diagnosis which has already been requested while the matter of other subject of the institute was under consideration.

44. University of Bombay/Mumbai – Approval of Institute of Naval Medicine, INHS, Asvini, Mumbai for the award of M.D.(Paediatrics)-Compliance regarding.

Read: the Council Inspector's report (January, 2003) on the standard of examination and other teaching facilities available at Institute of Naval Medicine, INHS, Asvini, Mumbai togetherwith compliance for purpose of approval of the college for the award of M.D.(Paediatrics) qualification granted by Mumbai university.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Inspector's report (January, 2003) and noted that the details of the teaching experience held by the faculty have not been provided as per the requirement to enable the Committee to decide in the matter.

The Committee, in view of above, decided that the Principal/Dean/Commandant of the institution be given an opportunity of personal hearing with the Secretary of MCI with the details of posting with respective institutions, dates and rank of the faculty alongwith the relevant teaching experience.

The Committee further decided to defer the consideration of the matter till the required information is available.

45. University of Bombay/Mumbai – Approval of Institute of Naval Medicine, INHS, Asvini, Mumbai for the award of M.S.(Orthopaedics)-Compliance regarding.

The Committee, in view of above, decided that the Principal/Dean/Commandant of the institution be given an opportunity of personal hearing with the Secretary of MCI with the details of posting with respective institutions, dates and rank of the faculty alongwith the relevant teaching experience.

The Committee further decided to defer the consideration of the matter till the required information is available.

49. Starting of (i) MD (Dermatology, Venereology & Leprosy) and (ii) D.C.H courses at Bharati Vidyapeeth Medical College, Pune affiliated to Bharati Vidyapeeth (Deemed University) u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.

Read: (i) the letter dated 3.7.2003 from the Principal, Bharti Vidhyapeeth Medical College, Pune for starting of MD (Dermatology, Venereology & Leprosy) course and (ii) letter dated 3.7.2003 at Bharti Vidhyapeeth Medical College, Pune as already recommended by the P.G. Committee.

The Postgraduate Committee noted the information as desired vide Postgraduate Committee meeting held on 3.6.2003 received vide letters dated 3.7.2003 from the Principal, Bharti Vidhyapeeth Medical College, Pune for starting of (i) MD (Dermatology, Venereology & Leprosy) and (ii) D.C.H. courses at Bharti Vidhyapeeth Medical College, Pune have been received. The Committee decided that the decision taken by the earlier meeting of the Postgraduate Committee be communicated to the Central Government, Ministry of Health & F.W., New Delhi.

50. Postgraduate Medical Education reforms – representation regarding.

Read: the letter dated nil received from Dr.S.K.Sinha, Member, P.G. Committee with regard to some use full suggestions to maintain the Standard of Postgraduate Medical Education.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the letter received from Dr. S.K. Sinha, Member PG Committee alongwith observations of Chairman, PG Committee and other members of P.G. Committee made during the last meeting of the Postgraduate Committee held on 1st and 2nd July, 2003 and decided to circulate the same to all the members of the Postgraduate Committee for their opinion.
