1. Minutes of the last meeting of the Postgraduate Committee – confirmation of.

The minutes of the last meeting of the Postgraduate Committee held on 29.10.2004 were confirmed.

2. Minutes of the last meeting of the Postgraduate Committee – action taken thereon.

The Postgraduate Committee noted the action taken on the various items included in the minutes of the meeting of the Postgraduate Committee held on 29.10.2004.

3. Work output report of the requests received u/s 10A for the year 2003 and 2004.

Read : The work output report of the requests u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 for the year 2003 & 2004.

The Postgraduate Committee noted the work out put report of the requests received u/s 10A of the I.M.C. Act,1956 for the year 2003 & 2004.

The Postgraduate Committee perused the list prepared by the office of the cases which received u/s 10 A of the I.M.C. Act. The Committee observed that there are some cases where it was written that the reports from the Council Inspectors are awaited. The Committee instructed the office as under:-

1. An inspector appointed by the Council to carry out the inspection of starting/increase of the postgraduate course must be directed to cause the inspection within 30 days from the receipt of letter from the Council as the Postgraduate Committee is required to consider the applications received u/s 10A in a time bound manner.
2. Upon carrying out the inspection, the inspector must furnish the report to the Council within 10 days from the date of inspection and the report so received must be placed before the Postgraduate Committee for appropriate decision.
3. In case of an inspector failing to submit the report within 10 days from the date of inspection, the Council office shall remind him/her for submission of the same within 7 days indicating therein that non-submission shall result in non-reimbursement of T.A./D.A. by the Council including deletion of his/her name from the panel of Inspectors made by the Council.

4. Increase of seats in DO course at Al-Ameen Medical College, Bijapur affiliated to Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences, Bangalore u/s 10A of the IMC Act,1956-compliance verification regarding.

Read : The compliance verification inspection report (November, 2004) together with compliance and inspection report (April, 2002) on the physical and other teaching facilities available at Al-Ameen Medical College, Bijapur for increase of seats in D.O. course.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the compliance verification inspection report (November, 2004) together with compliance and inspection report (April, 2002) and noted that the compliance is unsatisfactory; decided to reiterate its earlier decision taken at its meeting held on 26.9.2002 recommending to the Central Govt. not to issue Letter of Intent for increase of seats in D.O. course at Al-Ameen Medical College, Bijapur affiliated to Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences, Bangalore u/s 10A of the I.M.C. Act,1956 because the following deficiencies are still persisting:-

- i) The available clinical material is just sufficient only for the present intake in the D.O. course.
- ii) There is need for improvement in availability of equipments/instruments in the department.
- iii) Other deficiencies pointed out by the Council Inspector in the inspection report.

The Committee further decided to recommend that in view of the above, the Central Govt. may consider disapproving the proposal for increase of seats in D.O. course. However, the institution is free to apply afresh after rectification of the deficiencies in accordance with the Council Regulations on Postgraduate Medical Education,2000.

5. Increase of seats in M.D.(General Medicine) course at Regional Institute of Medical Sciences, Imphal, Manipur affiliated to Manipur University u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956-consideration of compliance verification regarding.

Read : The compliance verification inspection report (October, 2004) together with compliance and inspection report (September, 2003) on the physical and other teaching facilities available at Regional Institute of Medical Sciences, Imphal, Manipur for consideration of increase of seats in M.D.(General Medicine) course.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the compliance verification inspection report (October, 2004) together with compliance and inspection report (September, 2003) and noted that units are still not organised as per MCI norms in terms of teaching faculty; decided to advise the institution authorities to re-organise the units as per MCI norms in terms of teaching faculty and submit the compliance.

The Committee further decided to defer the consideration of the matter till the information is received.

6. Increase of seats in M.D.(Paediatrics) course at S.C.B. Medical College, Cuttack (S.V.P. P.G. Institute of Paediatrics, Cuttack) affiliated to Utkal University u/s 10A of the I.M.C. Act, 1956.

Read : The Council Inspector's report (October, 2004) on the physical and other teaching facilities available at S.C.B. Medical College, Cuttack (S.V.P. P.G. Institute of Paediatrics, Cuttack) affiliated to Utkal University for consideration of increase of seats in M.D.(Paediatrics) course.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Inspector's report (October,2004) and decided to recommend to the Central Govt. not to issue Letter of Intent for increase of seats in M.D.(Paediatrics) course at S.C.B. Medical College, Cuttack (S.V.P. P.G. Institute of Paediatrics, Cuttack) affiliated to Utkal University u/s 10A of the I.M.C. Act,1956 because -

- (i) Teaching complement is incomplete in Unit-I as there is no Assoc.Prof.
- (ii) Other deficiencies/observations as pointed out in the inspection report.

The Committee further noted that the college has been making admissions in excess of the sanctioned intake which is 6 (six). Therefore, it was decided that action u/s 10B of the I.M.C. Act,1956 be initiated.

7. Starting of M.D.(General Medicine) course at Annasaheb Chavdaman Patil Memorial Medical College, Dhule affiliated to North Maharashtra University, Jalgaon u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956- consideration of compliance regarding.

Read : The compliance together with the inspection report (April, 2004) physical and other teaching facilities available at Annasaheb Chavdaman Patil Memorial Medical College, Dhule for consideration of starting of M.D.(General Medicine) course.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the compliance together with the inspection report (April,2004) and noted that the compliance is unsatisfactory; decided to reiterate its earlier decision taken at its meeting held on 22.5.2004 recommending to the Central Govt. not to issue Letter of Intent for starting of M.D.(General Medicine) course at Annasaheb Chavdaman Patil Memorial Medical College, Dhule affiliated to North Maharashtra University, Jalgaon u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 because the following deficiencies are still persisting:-

- (i) Clinical material is grossly inadequate.
- (ii) Teaching complement incomplete in all units.
- (iii) Unit-II Incharge does not possess requisite recognised postgraduate qualification.
- (iv) Histopathology workload is inadequate.
- (v) Investigative workload is inconsistent with the records of OPD, IPD and bed occupancy.
- (vi) Laundry is manual.
- (vii) Blood Bank located in Dental College, away from the medical college.
- (viii) Facilities for thyroid profile and other hormone estimations are not available.
- (ix) Incinerator not in use.
- (x) Other deficiencies/observations as pointed out in the inspection report.

The Committee further decided to recommend that in view of the above, the Central Govt. may consider disapproving the proposal for starting of M.D. (General Medicine) course. However, the institution is free to apply afresh after rectification of the deficiencies in accordance with the Council Regulations on Postgraduate Medical Education,2000.

8. Starting of M.D. (Paediatrics) course at Annasaheb Chaudaman Patil Memorial Medical College, Dhule affiliated to North Maharashtra University, Jalgaon u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956- consideration of compliance regarding.

Read : The compliance together with the inspection report (May, 2004) on the physical and other teaching facilities available at Annasaheb Chaudaman Patil Memorial Medical College, Dhule for consideration of starting of M.D.(Paediatrics) course.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the compliance together with the inspection report (May,2004) and noted that the compliance is unsatisfactory; decided to reiterate its earlier decision taken at its meeting held on 30.6.2004 recommending to the Central Govt. not to issue Letter of Intent for starting of M.D.(Paediatric) course at Annasaheb Chavdaman Patil Memorial Medical College, Dhule affiliated to North Maharashtra University, Jalgaon u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 because the following deficiencies are still persisting:-

- (i) Teaching complement is incomplete in Unit-I as there is no Assoc.Prof.
- (ii) Clinical material is inadequate.
- (iii) NICU-PICU is not well equipped.
- (iv) Central library facilities are inadequate.
- (v) Blood Bank is in Dental College.
- (vi) Other deficiencies/observations as pointed out in the inspection report.

The Committee further decided to recommend that in view of the above, the Central Govt. may consider disapproving the proposal for starting of M.D. (Paediatric) course. However, the institution is free to apply afresh after rectification of the deficiencies in accordance with the Council Regulations on Postgraduate Medical Education,2000.

9. Starting of M.S.(Orthopaedics) course at Annasaheb Chaudaman Patil Memorial Medical College, Dhule affiliated to North Maharashtra University, Jalgaon u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 - consideration of compliance regarding.

Read : The compliance together with the inspection report (May, 2004) on the physical and other teaching facilities available at Annasaheb Chaudaman Patil Memorial Medical College, Dhule for consideration of starting of M.S.(Orthopaedics) course.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the compliance together with the inspection report (May,2004) and noted that the compliance is unsatisfactory; decided to reiterate its earlier decision taken at its meeting held on 30.6.2004 recommending to the Central Govt. not to issue Letter of Intent for starting of M.S.(Orthopaedics) course at Annasaheb Chaudaman Patil Memorial Medical College, Dhule affiliated to North Maharashtra University, Jalgaon u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 because the following deficiencies are still persisting:-

- (i) Surgical workload is inadequate.
- (ii) Clinical material is grossly inadequate.
- (iii) No staff is recognised as PG teacher by the affiliating university.
- (iv) Other deficiencies/observations as pointed out in the inspection report.

The Committee further decided to recommend that in view of the above, the Central Govt. may consider disapproving the proposal for starting of M.S. (Orthopaedics) course. However, the institution is free to apply afresh after rectification of the deficiencies in accordance with the Council Regulations on Postgraduate Medical Education,2000.

10. Starting of M.S.(Ophthalmology) course at Annasaheb Chaudaman Patil Memorial Medical College, Dhule affiliated to North Maharashtra University, Jalgaon u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956- consideration of compliance regarding.

Read : The compliance together with the inspection report (April, 2004) on the physical and other teaching facilities available at Annasaheb Chaudaman Patil Memorial Medical College, Dhule for consideration of starting of M.S.(Ophthalmology) course.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the compliance together with the inspection report (April,2004) and noted that the compliance is unsatisfactory; decided to reiterate its earlier decision taken at its meeting held on 22.5.2004 recommending to the Central Govt. not to issue Letter of Intent for starting of M.S.(Ophthalmology) course at Annasaheb Chaudaman Patil Memorial Medical College, Dhule affiliated to North Maharashtra University, Jalgaon u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 because the following deficiencies are still persisting:-

- (i) Head of the department is also Principal of the college.
- (ii) Promotions of Professor & HOD and Associate Professor are not as per MCI norms.
- (iii) Assistant Professor/Lecturer does not possess recognised postgraduate qualification.
- (iv) Departmental library facilities are inadequate.
- (v) Other deficiencies/observations as pointed out in the inspection report.

The Committee further decided to recommend that in view of the above, the Central Govt. may consider disapproving the proposal for starting of M.S. (Ophthalmology) course. However, the institution is free to apply afresh after rectification of the deficiencies in accordance with the Council Regulations on Postgraduate Medical Education,2000.

11. Starting of M.D.(Microbiology) course at Annasaheb Chaudaman Patil Memorial Medical College, Dhule affiliated to North Maharashtra University, Jalgaon u/s 10A of the IMC Act,1956- consideration of compliance regarding.

Read : The compliance together with the inspection report (May, 2004) on the physical and other teaching facilities available at Annasaheb Chaudaman Patil Memorial Medical College, Dhule for consideration of starting of M.D.(Microbiology) course.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the compliance together with the inspection report (May,2004) and noted that the compliance is unsatisfactory; decided to reiterate its earlier decision taken at its meeting held on 22.5.2004 recommending to the Central Govt. not to issue Letter of Intent for starting of M.D.(Microbiology) course at Annasaheb Chaudaman

Patil Memorial Medical College, Dhule affiliated to North Maharashtra University, Jalgaon u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 because the following deficiencies are still persisting:-

- (i) Promotion of Professor & HOD and second Professor are not as per MCI norms.
- (ii) Investigative workload is inadequate.
- (iii) Other deficiencies/observations as pointed out in the inspection report.

The Committee further decided to recommend that in view of the above, the Central Govt. may consider disapproving the proposal for starting of M.D. (Microbiology) course. However, the institution is free to apply afresh after rectification of the deficiencies in accordance with the Council Regulations on Postgraduate Medical Education, 2000.

12. Starting of M.D.(Obst. & Gyane.) course at Annasaheb Chavdaman Patil Memorial Medical College, Dhule affiliated to North Maharashtra University, Jalgaon u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956- consideration of compliance regarding.

Read : The compliance together with the inspection report (April, 2004) on the physical and other teaching facilities available at Annasaheb Chavdaman Patil Memorial Medical College, Dhule for consideration of starting of M.D.(Obst. & Gyane.) course.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the compliance together with the inspection report (April, 2004) and noted that the compliance is unsatisfactory; decided to reiterate its earlier decision taken at its meeting held on 22.5.2004 recommending to the Central Govt. not to issue Letter of Intent for starting of M.D.(Obst. & Gyane.) course at Annasaheb Chavdaman Patil Memorial Medical College, Dhule affiliated to North Maharashtra University, Jalgaon u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 because the following deficiencies are still persisting:-

- (i) OPD space is inadequate.
- (ii) Class rooms and demonstration room facilities are inadequate.
- (iii) Instrumentation is inadequate.
- (iv) Departmental library facilities are inadequate and journals available in the departmental library are also inadequate.
- (v) Ward side laboratories are inadequate.
- (vi) Blood Bank facilities are inadequate.
- (vii) Laundry facilities are inadequate.
- (viii) Incinerator is not in use.
- (ix) There is no septic ward.
- (x) There is only one labour table available.
- (xi) Wards are congested.
- (xii) No seating space available for staff.
- (xiii) Other deficiencies/observations as pointed out in the inspection report.

The Committee further decided to recommend that in view of the above, the Central Govt. may consider disapproving the proposal for starting of M.D. (Obst. & Gyane.) course. However, the institution is free to apply afresh after rectification of the deficiencies in accordance with the Council Regulations on Postgraduate Medical Education, 2000.

13. Starting of M.S.(General Surgery) course at Annasaheb Chavdaman Patil Memorial Medical College, Dhule affiliated to North Maharashtra University, Jalgaon u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956- consideration of compliance regarding.

Read : The compliance together with the inspection report (April, 2004) on the physical and other teaching facilities available at Annasaheb Chavdaman Patil Memorial Medical College, Dhule for consideration of starting of M.S.(General Surgery) course.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the compliance together with the inspection report (April, 2004) and noted that the compliance is unsatisfactory; decided to reiterate its earlier decision taken at its meeting held on 22.5.2004 recommending to the Central Govt. not to issue Letter of Intent for starting of M.S.(General Surgery) course at Annasaheb Chavdaman Patil Memorial Medical College, Dhule affiliated to North Maharashtra University, Jalgaon u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 because the following deficiencies are still persisting:-

- (i) Histopathology workload is inadequate.

- (ii) Investigative workload is inconsistent with the records of OPD, IPD and bed occupancy.
- (iii) Clinical and Surgical workload is grossly inadequate.
- (iv) All beds in post-anaesthesia room were unoccupied.
- (v) Teaching complement is incomplete in all units.
- (vi) Laundry is manual.
- (vii) Blood Bank located in Dental College, away from the medical college.
- (viii) Facilities for thyroid profile and other hormone estimations are not available.
- (ix) Incinerator is not in use.
- (x) Other deficiencies/observations as pointed out in the inspection report.

The Committee further decided to recommend that in view of the above, the Central Govt. may consider disapproving the proposal for starting of M.S. (General Surgery) course. However, the institution is free to apply afresh after rectification of the deficiencies in accordance with the Council Regulations on Postgraduate Medical Education, 2000.

14. Starting of M.S. (General Surgery) course at Academy of Medical Sciences, Pariyaram affiliated to Kannur University u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956-consideration of compliance regarding.

Read : The compliance together with the inspection report (May, 2004) on the physical and other teaching facilities available at Academy of Medical Sciences, Pariyaram for consideration of starting of M.S.(General Surgery) course.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the compliance together with the inspection report (May, 2004) and noted that the compliance is unsatisfactory; decided to reiterate its earlier decision taken at its meeting held on 22.5.2004 recommending to the Central Govt. not to issue Letter of Intent for starting of M.S.(General Surgery) course at Academy of Medical Sciences, Pariyaram affiliated to Kannur University u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 because the following deficiencies are still persisting:-

- (i) Clinical material and surgical workload are grossly inadequate.
- (ii) Promotion of Incharge of Unit III is not as per MCI norms.
- (iii) Teaching complement is incomplete in Unit-III.
- (iv) No Internet and medlar facility available.
- (v) No Central Research lab.
- (vi) Library facilities are inadequate.
- (vii) No Nuclear Medicine Department.
- (viii) Other deficiencies/observations as pointed out in the inspection report.

The Committee further decided to recommend that in view of the above, the Central Govt. may consider disapproving the proposal for starting of M.S. (General Surgery) course. However, the institution is free to apply afresh after rectification of the deficiencies in accordance with the Council Regulations on Postgraduate Medical Education, 2000.

15. Starting of M.D. (Paediatrics) & D.C.H. courses at Academy of Medical Sciences, Pariyaram affiliated to Kannur University u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956-consideration of compliance regarding.

Read : The compliance together with the inspection report (April, 2004) on the physical and other teaching facilities available at Academy of Medical Sciences, Pariyaram for consideration of starting of M.D. (Paediatrics) & D.C.H. courses.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the compliance together with the inspection report (April, 2004) and noted that the compliance is unsatisfactory; decided to reiterate its earlier decision taken at its meeting held on 30.6.2004 recommending to the Central Govt. not to issue Letter of Intent for starting of M.D.(Paediatrics) & D.C.H. courses at Academy of Medical Sciences, Pariyaram affiliated to Kannur University u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 because the following deficiencies are still persisting:-

- (i) Clinical material is inadequate.
- (ii) Library facilities are poor.
- (iii) Hostel facilities are inadequate.
- (iv) Unit III is incomplete in terms of beds and teaching faculty.
- (v) Promotion of HOD is not as per MCI norms.
- (vi) Other deficiencies/observations as pointed out in the inspection report.

The Committee further decided to recommend that in view of the above, the Central Govt. may consider disapproving the proposal for starting of M.D. (Paediatric) & D.C.H. courses. However, the institution is free to apply afresh after rectification of the deficiencies in accordance with the Council Regulations on Postgraduate Medical Education,2000.

16. Starting of M.D. (OBG) & DGO courses at Academy of Medical Sciences, Pariyaram affiliated to Kannur University u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956-consideration of compliance regarding.

Read : The compliance together with the inspection report (April, 2004) on the physical and other teaching facilities available at Academy of Medical Sciences, Pariyaram for consideration of starting of M.D. (OBG) & DGO courses.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the compliance together with the inspection report (April, 2004) and noted that the compliance is unsatisfactory; decided to reiterate its earlier decision taken at its meeting held on 30.6.2004 recommending to the Central Govt. not to issue Letter of Intent for starting of M.D.(OBG) & D.G.O. courses at Academy of Medical Sciences, Pariyaram affiliated to Kannur University u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 because the following deficiencies are still persisting:-

- (i) Clinical material is inadequate.
- (ii) Library facilities are inadequate.
- (iii) Teaching complement is incomplete in Unit-I.
- (iv) DNB candidates are being registered in the speciality which is not permissible in the institution where MD/MS courses are being undertaken because this involves sharing the same infrastructural facilities.
- (v) Other deficiencies/observations as pointed out in the inspection report.

The Committee further decided to recommend that in view of the above, the Central Govt. may consider disapproving the proposal for starting of M.D. (OBG) & D.G.O. courses. However, the institution is free to apply afresh after rectification of the deficiencies in accordance with the Council Regulations on Postgraduate Medical Education,2000.

17. Starting of MD(Derm., Vene., & Leprosy) & DDVL courses at Academy of Medical Sciences, Pariyaram affiliated to Kannur University u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956-consideration of compliance regarding.

Read : The compliance together with the inspection report (April, 2004) on the physical and other teaching facilities available at Academy of Medical Sciences, Pariyaram for consideration of starting of MD(Derm., Vene., & Leprosy) & DDVL courses.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the compliance together with the inspection report (April, 2004) and noted that the compliance is unsatisfactory; decided to reiterate its earlier decision taken at its meeting held on 22.5.2004 recommending to the Central Govt. not to issue Letter of Intent for starting of M.D. (Derm., Vene., & Leprosy) & DDVL courses at Academy of Medical Sciences, Pariyaram affiliated to Kannur University u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 because the following deficiencies are still persisting:-

- (i) Promotion of HOD is not as per MCI norms.
- (ii) Teaching complement is incomplete in Unit-I.
- (iii) Associate Professor does not possess recognised postgraduate qualification.
- (iv) Library facilities are inadequate.
- (v) Other deficiencies/observations as pointed out in the inspection report.

The Committee further decided to recommend that in view of the above, the Central Govt. may consider disapproving the proposal for starting of M.D. (Derm., Vene., & Leprosy) & DDVL courses. However, the institution is free to apply afresh after rectification of the deficiencies in accordance with the Council Regulations on Postgraduate Medical Education,2000.

18. Starting of M.D.(General Medicine) course at Academy of Medical Sciences, Pariyaram affiliated to Kannur University u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956-consideration of compliance regarding.

Read : The compliance together with the inspection report (April, 2004) on the physical and other teaching facilities available at Academy of Medical Sciences, Pariyaram for consideration of starting of M.D.(General Medicine) course.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the compliance together with the inspection report (April, 2004) and noted that the compliance is unsatisfactory; decided to reiterate its earlier decision taken at its meeting held on 22.5.2004 recommending to the Central Govt. not to issue Letter of Intent for starting of M.D.(General Medicine) course at Academy of Medical Sciences, Pariyaram affiliated to Kannur University u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 because the following deficiencies are still persisting:-

- (i) Clinical material is inadequate.

19. Starting of M.D.(Pulmonary Medicine) course at Deccan College of Medical Sciences, Hyderabad affiliated to N.T.R. University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956-consideration of compliance regarding.

Read : The compliance together with the inspection report (September, 2004) on the physical and other teaching facilities available at Deccan College of Medical Sciences, Hyderabad affiliated to N.T.R. University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada for consideration of starting of M.D.(Pulmonary Medicine) course.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the compliance together with the inspection report (September, 2004) and noted that the compliance is unsatisfactory; decided to reiterate its earlier decision taken at its meeting held on 23.9.2004 recommending to the Central Govt. not to issue Letter of Intent for starting of M.D. (Pulmonary Medicine) course at Deccan College of Medical Sciences, Hyderabad affiliated to N.T.R. 20. Starting of M.Ch.(Urology) course at Deccan College of Medical Sciences, Hyderabad affiliated to N.T.R. University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956-consideration of compliance regarding.

The Committee further decided to recommend that in view of the above, the Central Govt. may consider disapproving the proposal for starting of M.Ch. (Urology) course. Read : The compliance together with the inspection report (September, 2004) on the physical and other teaching facilities available at Deccan College of Medical Sciences, Hyderabad affiliated to N.T.R. The Postgraduate Committee considered the compliance together with the inspection report (September, 2004) and noted that the compliance is unsatisfactory; decided to reiterate its earlier decision taken at its meeting held on 23.9.2004 recommending to the Central Govt. not to issue Letter of Intent for starting of M.Ch. (Plastic Surgery) course at Deccan College of Medical Sciences, Hyderabad affiliated to N.T.R. University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 because the following deficiencies are still persisting:-

- (i) Promotion of Prof. & HOD is not as per MCI norms.
- (ii) 2nd Professor is Honorary
- (iii) Teaching complement is incomplete.
- (iv) Clinical material is inadequate.
- (v) Surgical workload is inadequate.
- (vi) Other deficiencies/observations as pointed out in the inspection report.

The Committee further decided to recommend that in view of the above, the Central Govt. may consider disapproving the proposal for starting of M.Ch. (Plastic Surgery) course. However, the institution is free to apply afresh after rectification of the deficiencies in accordance with the Council Regulations on Postgraduate Medical Education,2000.

22. Starting of M.D.(Biochemistry) courses at Pramukhswami Medical College, Karmsad affiliated to Sardar Patel University u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956-consideration of compliance regarding.

Read : The compliance together with the inspection report (July,2004) on the physical and other teaching facilities available at Pramukhswami Medical College, Karmsad affiliated to Sardar Patel University for consideration of starting of M.D.(Biochemistry) course.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the compliance together with the inspection report (July,2004) and decided to verify the compliance by way of an inspection.

23. Increase of seats in D.M.(Nephrology) course at Nizam Institute of Medical Sciences, Hyderabad affiliated to Nizam's Institute of Medical Sciences, Hyderabad u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956-consideration of compliance regarding.

Read : The compliance together with the inspection report (July2004) on the physical and other teaching facilities available at Nizam's Institute of Medical Sciences, Hyderabad for consideration of increase of seats in D.M.(Nephrology) course.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the compliance together with the inspection report (July,2004) and noted that there is only one postgraduate teacher in the department. Since there is already one existing intake, decided to reiterate its earlier decision taken at its meeting held on 4.8.2004 recommending to the Central Govt. not to issue Letter of Intent for increase of seats in D.M.(Nephrology) course at Nizam's Institute of Medical Sciences, Hyderabad affiliated to Nizam's Institute of Medical Sciences, Hyderabad u/s 10A of the I.M.C. Act, 1956.

The Committee further decided to recommend that in view of the above, the Central Govt. may consider disapproving the proposal for increase of seats in D.M. (Nephrology) course. However, the institution is free to apply afresh after rectification of the deficiencies in accordance with the Council Regulations on Postgraduate Medical Education,2000.

24. University of Bombay/Mumbai – Approval of Institute of Naval Medicine, INHS, Asvini, Mumbai for the award of M.D.(Radiology/Radio-Diag.) qualification – compliance regarding.

Read : The compliance together with the Council Inspector's report (July, 2004) on the standard of examination and other teaching facilities available at Institute of Naval Medicine, INHS, Asvini, Mumbai for purpose of approval of the college for the award of M.D.(Radiology/Radio-Diag.) qualification earlier granted by Bombay University and now by Mumbai University.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the compliance together with the Council Inspector's report (July, 2004) and noted that the compliance is unsatisfactory; decided to reiterate its earlier decision taken at its meeting held on 23.9.2004 deciding not to approve Institute of Naval Medicine, INHS, Asvini, Mumbai for the award of M.D.(Radiology/Radio-Diag.) qualification earlier granted by Bombay University and now by Mumbai University because the following deficiencies are still persisting:-

- (i) HOD does not possess the requisite required experience of five years as Advisor.
- (ii) Other deficiencies/observations as pointed out in the inspection report.

25. Starting of M.D.(Radio-Diagnosis) & D.M.R.D. courses at Mahatma Gandhi Mission's Medical College, Aurangabad under Dr. Baba Saheb Ambedkar Marathwada University, Aurangabad.

Read : The Council Inspector's report (October, 2004) on the physical and other teaching facilities available at Mahatma Gandhi Mission's Medical College, Aurangabad under Dr. Baba Saheb Ambedkar Marathwada University, Aurangabad for consideration of starting of M.D.(Radio-Diagnosis) & D.M.R.D. courses.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Inspector's report (October, 2004) and decided to recommend to the Central Govt. not to issue Letter of Intent for starting of M.D.(Radio-Diagnosis) & D.M.R.D. courses at Mahatma Gandhi Mission's Medical College, Aurangabad under Dr. Baba Saheb Ambedkar Marathwada University, Aurangabad u/s 10A of the I.M.C. Act,1956 because of the following:-

- (i) HOD is not possessing recognised postgraduate qualification.
- (ii) Instrumentation is inadequate as there is no MRI machine.
- (iii) Other deficiencies/observations as pointed out in the inspection report.

26. Non-teaching Hospital – Recognition of Vivekanand Polyclinic Ramakrishna Mission Sevashram, Vivekananda Puri, Lucknow for housemanship.

Read : The inspection report (May, 2004) of physical facilities available at Vivekanand Polyclinic Ramakrishna Mission Sevashram, Vivekananda Puri, Lucknow for purpose of continuance of recognition of the hospital for housemanship in various subjects.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Inspector's report (May,2004) and decided to recommend that Vivekanand Polyclinic Ramakrishna Mission Sevashram, Vivekananda Puri, Lucknow be recognised for housemanship in Anaesthesia with 2 houseposts.

27. Gujarat University – Recognition of M.Ch. (Paediatrics Surgery) qualification in respect of students being trained at Smt. NHL Municipal Medical College, Ahmedabad.

Read : The Council Inspector's report (October, 2004) on the standard of examination and other teaching facilities available at Smt. NHL Municipal Medical College, Ahmedabad for purpose of recognition of M.Ch.(Paediatric Surgery) qualification granted by Gujarat University.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Inspector's report (October,2004) and decided to recommend that M.Ch.(Paediatric Surgery) qualification granted by Gujarat University in respect of students being trained at Smt. NHL Municipal Medical College, Ahmedabad be recognised and included in the 1st Schedule to the Indian Medical Council Act,1956 restricting the number of admissions to 2 (two) students per year.

28. Madras University and The Tamilnadu Dr. M.G.R. Medical University, Chennai – Approval of Kilpauk Medical College, Chennai for the award of M.Ch.(Plastic Surgery) qualification.

Read : The Council Inspector's report (September, 2001) on the standard of examination and other teaching facilities available at Kilpauk Medical College, Chennai for purpose of approval of the college for the award of M.Ch.(Plastic Surgery) qualification earlier granted by Madras University and now by The Tamilnadu Dr. M.G.R. Medical University, Chennai.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the compliance along with Council Inspector's report (Sept.,2001) and decided to verify the compliance by way of an inspection.

29. Sardar Patel University – Recognition of M.D.(Obst. & Gynae.) qualification in respect of students being trained at Pramukhswami Medical College, Karamsad.

Read : The Council Inspector's report (October, 2004) on the standard of examination and other teaching facilities available at Pramukhswami Medical College, Karamsad for purpose of recognition of M.D.(Obst. & Gynae.) qualification granted by Sardar Patel University.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Inspector's report (October,2004) and decided to recommend that M.D.(Obst. & Gynae.) qualification granted by Sardar Patel University in respect of students being trained at Pramukhswami Medical College, Karamsad be recognised and included in the 1st Schedule to the Indian Medical Council Act,1956 restricting the number of admissions to 2 (two) students per year.

30. Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences, Bangalore – restarting of M.Ch.(Paed. Surgery) qualification at Bangalore Medical College, Bangalore.

Read : The Council Inspector's report (Sept., 2004) on the physical and other teaching facilities available at Bangalore Medical College, Bangalore for purposes of restart of M.Ch.(Paediatrics Surgery) qualification granted by Bangalore University.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Inspector's report (Sept., 2004) and decided not to recommend restarting of M.Ch.(Paediatrics Surgery) course at Bangalore Medical College, Bangalore under Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences, Bangalore because of the following:-

- (i) Promotion of Professor & HOD and second Professor are not as per MCI norms.
- (ii) Resultantly teaching complement is incomplete.
- (iii) Other deficiencies/observations as pointed out in the inspection report.

In view of above, the Committee further decided to reiterate its earlier decision taken at its meeting held on 18th & 19th Feb.,1998 which reads as under:-

"The Postgraduate Committee decided not to recommend recognition of M.Ch.(Paediatric Surgery) qualification granted by Bangalore University in respect of students being trained at Bangalore Medical College, Bangalore as department is not headed by a Professor and the required teaching complement of three teachers is deficient.

The Committee further decided to direct the authorities to stop admission in the subject with immediate effect till a full time Professor as Head of the department possessing recognised postgraduate qualification with requisite experience is appointed and compliance to that effect sent."

Read : The compliance together with the inspection report (April, 2004) on the physical and other teaching facilities available at Christian Medical College, Vellore for consideration of increase of seats in M.S.(E.N.T.) course.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the compliance together with the inspection report (April,2004) and decided to recommend to the Central Govt. to issue Letter of Permission for increase of seats in M.S.(ENT) course at Christian Medical College, Vellore affiliated to The Tamilnadu Dr.MGR Medical University, Chennai u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 prospectively i.e. from the academic session 2005-2006 from 2 (two) to 4 (four) students per year till the first batch admitted against the increased number appears for the final examination of the said course.

33. Increase of seats in M.Ch.(Genito Urinary Surgery) course at Christian Medical College, Vellore affiliated to T.N. Dr.M.G.R. Medical University, Chennai u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956-consideration of compliance regarding.

Read : The compliance together with the inspection report (May, 2004) on the physical and other teaching facilities available at Christian Medical College, Vellore for consideration of increase of seats in M.Ch. (Genito Urinary Surgery) course.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the compliance together with the inspection report (May,2004) and decided to recommend to the Central Govt. to issue Letter of Permission for increase of seats in M.Ch.(Genito Urinary Surgery) course at Christian Medical College, Vellore affiliated to The Tamilnadu Dr.MGR Medical University, Chennai u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 prospectively i.e. from the academic session 2005-2006 from 2 (two) to 3 (three) students per year till the first batch admitted against the increased number appears for the final examination of the said course.

Read : The compliance together with the inspection report (August, 2004) on the physical and other teaching facilities available at Padamshree Dr. D.Y.Patil Medical College, Navi Mumbai for consideration of starting of M.D.(Biochemistry) course.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the compliance together with inspection report (August,2004) and decided to verify the compliance by way of an inspection.

- (ii) Other deficiencies/observations as pointed out in the inspection report.

The Committee further decided to recommend that in view of the above, the Central Govt. may consider disapproving the proposal for starting of M.D. (Microbiology) course. However, the institution is free to apply afresh after rectification of the deficiencies in accordance with the Council Regulations on Postgraduate Medical Education,2000.

36. Starting of M.D.(Obst.Gynae.) & DGO courses at Padmashree Dr. D.Y. Patil Medical College, Navi Mumbai (Deemed University) u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956-consideration of compliance regarding.

Read : The compliance together with the inspection report (August, 2004) on the physical and other teaching facilities available at Padmashree Dr. D.Y. Patil Medical College, Navi Mumbai (Deemed University) for consideration of starting of M.D.(Obst.Gynae) & DGO courses.

Read : The compliance together with the inspection report (August, 2004) on the physical and other teaching facilities available at Pt. Deen Dayal Upadhyay Medical College, Rajkot affiliated to Saurashtra University for consideration of starting of M.S.(General Surgery) course.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the compliance together with the inspection report (August,2004) and decided to verify the compliance by way of an inspection.

42. Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences, Bangalore – Approval of St. John’s Medical College, Bangalore for the award of D.M. (Cardiology) qualification.

Read : The compliance verification inspection report (October,2003) on the standard of examination and other teaching facilities available at St.John’s Medical College, Bangalore for purpose of approval of the college for the award of D.M.(Cardiology) qualification.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the compliance verification inspection report (October,2003) along with compliance and decided to verify the compliance by way of an inspection.

- (i) Promotion of HOD is not as per MCI norms.
- (ii) Both the Assistant Professors do not possess requisite postgraduate degree.
- (iii) Teaching complement is incomplete.
- (iv) Other deficiencies/observations as pointed out in the inspection report.

The Committee further decided to recommend that in view of the above, the Central Govt. may consider disapproving the proposal for starting of M.D. (T.B. & Resp. Diseases) & D.T.C.D. courses. However, the institution is free to apply afresh after rectification of the deficiencies in accordance with the Council Regulations on Postgraduate Medical Education,2000.

44. Starting of M.D.(Physiology) course at Pramukhswami Medical College, Karamsad affiliated to Sardar Patel University u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956-consideration of compliance regarding.

Read : The compliance together with the inspection report (July, 2004) on the physical and other teaching facilities available at Pramukhswami Medical College, Karamsad affiliated to Sardar Patel University for consideration of starting of M.D.(Physiology) course.

- (iv) Staff is deficient even for UG.
- (v) Other deficiencies/observations as pointed out in the inspection report.

The Committee further decided to recommend that in view of the above, the Central Govt. may consider disapproving the proposal for starting of M.D. (Physiology) course. However, the institution is free to apply afresh after rectification of the deficiencies in accordance with the Council Regulations on Postgraduate Medical Education,2000.

45. Starting of M.D.(Pharmacology) course at Pramukhswami Medical College, Karamsad, Gujarat affiliated to Sardar Patel University u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956-consideration of compliance regarding.

Read : The compliance together with the inspection report (August, 2004) on the physical and other teaching facilities available at Pramukhswami Medical College, Karamsad, Gujarat affiliated to Sardar Patel University for consideration of starting of M.D.(Pharmacology) course.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the compliance together with the inspection report (August,2004) and decided to verify the compliance by way of an inspection.

46. Starting of M.D.(Anatomy) course at Pramukhswami Medical College, Karamsad, Gujarat affiliated to Sardar Patel University u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956-consideration of compliance regarding.

Read : The compliance together with the inspection report (August, 2004) on the physical and other teaching facilities available at Pramukhswami Medical College, Karamsad, Gujarat affiliated to Sardar Patel University for consideration of starting of M.D.(Anatomy) course.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the compliance together with the inspection report (August, 2004) and noted that the compliance is unsatisfactory; decided to reiterate its earlier decision taken at its meeting held on 23.9.2004 recommending to the Central Govt. not to issue Letter of Intent for starting of M.D.(Anatomy) course at Pramukhswami Medical College, Karamsad, Gujarat affiliated to Sardar Patel University u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 because the following deficiencies are still persisting:-

- (i) Prof. & HOD does not possess requisite recognised postgraduate qualification.
- (ii) Promotion of Associate Professor is not as per MCI norms.
- (iii) Non-medical staff is more than the permissible limit of 30%.
- (iv) Other deficiencies/observations as pointed out in the inspection report.

The Committee further decided to recommend that in view of the above, the Central Govt. may consider disapproving the proposal for starting of M.D. (Anatomy) course. However, the institution is free to apply afresh after rectification of the deficiencies in accordance with the Council Regulations on Postgraduate Medical Education,2000.

47. Starting of M.D.(General Medicine) course at Siddhartha Medical College, Vijayawada affiliated to N.T.R. University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 – compliance verification regarding.

Read : The compliance verification inspection report (Nov., 2004) & previous compliance verification report (February, 2003) together with the inspection report (June, 2002) on the physical and other teaching facilities available at Siddhartha Medical College, Vijayawada for starting of M.D.(General Medicine) course.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the compliance verification inspection report (Nov.,2004), previous compliance verification report (Feb.,2003) together with the inspection report (June,2002) and decided to recommend to the Central Govt. to issue Letter of Permission for starting of M.D.(General Medicine) course at Siddhartha Medical College, Vijayawada affiliated to N.T.R. University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada u/s 10A of the I.M.C. Act,1956 prospectively i.e. from the academic session 2005-2006 restricting the number of admissions to 4 (four) students per year till the first batch admitted appears in the final examination of the said course. The institution be advised to apply for recognition of the qualification at the time of first available examination as per the provision of Section 11(2) of the I.M.C. Act,1956.

48. Starting of M.D.(Immuno Haematology & Blood Transfusion) course at Dr.M.G.R. Medical University Campus, Chennai affiliated to The Tamilnadu Dr.M.G.R. Medical University u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.

Read : The Central Govt. letter dated letter dated 5.11.2004 has requested the Council for clarification whether the present recommendations regarding starting of M.D. (Immuno Haematology & Blood Transfusion) course at Dr.M.G.R. Medical University Campus, Chennai affiliated to The Tamilnadu Dr.M.G.R. Medical University contained in the Council letter dated 12.10.2004 are for LOI or LOP.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the letter dated 5.11.2004 received from the Central Govt. and decided that the recommendations earlier sent by the Council regarding starting of M.D. (Immuno Haematology & Blood Transfusion) course at Dr.M.G.R. Medical University Campus, Chennai affiliated to The Tamilnadu Dr.M.G.R. Medical University contained in the Council letter dated 12.10.2004 be treated for Letter of Permission with annual intake of 2(two) students per year prospectively i.e. from the academic session 2005-2006 till the first batch admitted appears in the final examination of the said course. The institution be advised to apply for recognition of the qualification at the time of first available examination as per the provision of Section 11(2) of the I.M.C. Act,1956.

49. Starting of MD(Paediatrics) & DCH courses at J.L.N. Medical College, Swangi, Wardha affiliated to Nagpur University u/s 10A of the IMC Act,1956 – Compliance verification regarding.

Read : The compliance verification inspection report (June,2004) together with compliance and inspection report (September,2003) on the physical and other teaching facilities available at J.L.N.Medical College, Swangi, Wardha for consideration of starting of MD(Paediatrics) & DCH courses.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the compliance verification inspection report (June,2004) together with compliance and inspection report (Sept.,2003) and decided to verify the compliance by way of an inspection.

50. Increase of seats in M.D.(Radio-Diagnosis) course at Sri Devraj Urs Medical College, Kolar affiliated to Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences, Bangalore u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956-consideration of compliance regarding.

Read : The compliance together with the inspection report (August, 2004) on the physical and other teaching facilities available at Sri Devraj Urs Medical College, Kolar affiliated to Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences, Bangalore for consideration of increase of seats in M.D.(Radio-Diagnosis) course.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the compliance together with the inspection report (August, 2004) and noted that the compliance is unsatisfactory; decided to reiterate its earlier decision taken at its meeting held on 23.9.2004 recommending to the Central Govt. not

to issue Letter of Intent for increase of seats in M.D.(Radio-Diagnosis) course at Sri Devraj Urs Medical College, Kolar affiliated to Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences, Bangalore u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 because the following deficiencies are still persisting:-

- (i) Instrumentation is inadequate, as no mammography unit & MRI machine.
- (ii) Other deficiencies/observations as pointed out in the inspection report.

The Committee further decided to recommend that in view of the above, the Central Govt. may consider disapproving the proposal for increase of seats in M.D. (Radio-Diagnosis) course. However, the institution is free to apply afresh after rectification of the deficiencies in accordance with the Council Regulations on Postgraduate Medical Education,2000.

51. Increase of seats in M.D.(General Medicine) course at J.S.S. Medical College, Mysore affiliated to Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences, Bangalore u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 –consideration of compliance verification for issuance of LOP regarding.

Read : The compliance verification report (March,2004 & November,2004) together with compliance and Council Inspector's report (August, 2003) on the physical and other teaching facilities available at J.S.S. Medical College, Mysore for consideration of increase of seats in M.D.(General Medicine) course.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the compliance verification report (March,2004) together with compliance and Council Inspector's report (August,2003) and decided to recommend to the Central Govt. to issue Letter of Permission for increase of seats in M.D.(General Medicine) course at J.S.S. Medical College, Mysore affiliated to Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences, Bangalore u/s 10A of the I.M.C. Act,1956 prospectively i.e. from the academic session 2005-2006 from 6 (six) to 8 (eight) students per year till the first batch admitted against the increased number appears for the final examination of the said course.

52. Increase of seats in M.S.(Ophthalmology) & D.O. courses at Arvind Eye Hospital, Madurai affiliated to The Tamilnadu Dr.M.G.R. Medical University, Chennai u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 – Consideration of Central Govt.'s letter regarding.

Read : The Central Govt.'s letter dated 04.10.2004 together with the inspection report (March, 2003) on the physical and other teaching facilities available at Arvind Eye Hospital, Madurai togetherwith report of the Sub-committee for consideration of increase of seats M.S.(Ophthalmology) & D.O. courses.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Central Govt.'s letter dated 04.10.2004 together with the inspection report (March,2003) and report of the Sub-Committee and decided that a personal hearing be given to the authorities of Arvind Eye Hospital, Madurai to deliberate in the matter.

53. H.N.B. Garhwal University – Recognition of MS (General Surgery) qualification in respect of students being trained at Himalayan Institute of Medical Sciences, Dehradun.

Read : The Council Inspector's report (November, 2004) on the standard of examination and other teaching facilities available at Himalayan Institute of Medical Sciences, Dehradun for purpose of recognition of MS(General Surgery) qualification granted by H.N.B. Garhwal University.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Inspector's report (November,2004) and decided to recommend that M.S.(General Surgery) qualification granted by H.N.B. Garhwal University in respect of Himalayan Institute of Medical Sciences, Dehradun be recognised and included in the First Schedule to the Indian Medical Council Act,1956 restricting the number of admissions to 2 (two) students per year.

55. Starting of M.D.(Microbiology) course at Sri Venkateswara Institute of Medical Sciences, Tirupati (Deemed University) u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 - Consideration of reinspection report regarding.

Read : The Council Inspector's report (Nov., 2004) on the physical and other teaching facilities available at Sri Venkateswara Institute of Medical Sciences, Tirupati for consideration of starting of M.D.(Microbiology) course.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Inspector's report (Nov., 2004) and decided to recommend to the Central Govt. to issue Letter of Permission for starting of M.D.(Microbiology) course at Sri Venkateswara Institute of Medical Sciences, Tirupati (Deemed University) u/s 10A of the I.M.C. Act,1956 prospectively i.e. from the academic session 2005-2006 restricting the number of admission to 1 (one) student per year till the first batch admitted appears in the final examination of the said course. The institution be advised to apply for recognition of the qualification at the time of first available examination as per the provision of Section 11(2) of the I.M.C. Act,1956.

56. Starting of M.Ch.(Surgical Oncology) course at Osmania Medical College, Hyderabad affiliated to N.T.R. University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956-compliance regarding.

Read : The compliance together with the inspection report (December, 2003) on the physical and other teaching facilities available at Osmania Medical College, Hyderabad for starting of M.Ch.(Surgical Oncology) course.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the compliance together with the inspection report (Dec.,2003) and decided to verify the compliance by way of an inspection.

57. Increase of seats in M.Ch.(Genito-Urinary-Surgery) course at Nizam's Institute of Medical Sciences, Hyderabad (Deemed University) u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 – compliance regarding.

Read : The compliance together with the inspection report (July, 2004) on the physical and other teaching facilities available at Nizam's Institute of Medical Sciences, Hyderabad (Deemed University) for consideration of increase of seats in M.Ch.(Genito Urinary Surgery) course.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the compliance together with the inspection report (July, 2004) and noted that the compliance is unsatisfactory; decided to reiterate its earlier decision taken at its meeting held on 23.9.2004 recommending to the Central Govt. not to issue Letter of Intent for increase of seats in M.Ch.(Genito Urinary Surgery) course at Nizam's Institute of Medical Sciences, Hyderabad (Deemed University) u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 because -

- (i) Assoc. Prof. does not possess requisite recognised postgraduate qualification.
- (ii) There are two honorary teachers (Dr. P.V.L.N. Murthy, Prof. & HOD and Dr. Viyas Narayan Rao, Professor).
- (iii) Other deficiencies/observations as pointed out in the inspection report.

The Committee further decided to recommend that in view of the above, the Central Govt. may consider disapproving the proposal for increase of seats in M.Ch.(Genito Urinary Surgery) course. However, the institution is free to apply afresh after rectification of the deficiencies in accordance with the Council Regulations on Postgraduate Medical Education,2000.

58. Starting of M.Ch.(Vascular Surgery) course at Nizam's Institute of Medical Sciences, Hyderabad under the Nizam's Institute of Medical Sciences, Hyderabad (Deemed University) u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 – compliance regarding.

Read : The compliance together with the inspection report (July, 2004) on the physical and other teaching facilities available at Nizam's Institute of Medical Sciences, Hyderabad under the Nizam's Institute of Medical Sciences, Hyderabad (Deemed University) for consideration of starting of M.Ch. (Vascular Surgery) course.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the compliance together with the inspection report (July, 2004) and noted that the compliance is unsatisfactory; decided to reiterate its earlier decision taken at its meeting held on 23.9.2004 recommending to the Central Govt. not to issue Letter of Intent for starting of M.Ch.(Vascular Surgery) course at Nizam's Institute of Medical Sciences, Hyderabad (Deemed University) u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 because the following deficiencies are still persisting:-

- (i) None of the teaching faculty possesses requisite concerned super-speciality qualification, resultantly teaching complement is incomplete.
- (ii) Other deficiencies/observations as pointed out in the inspection report.

The Committee further decided to recommend that in view of the above, the Central Govt. may consider disapproving the proposal for starting of M.Ch.(Vascular Surgery) course. However, the institution is free to apply afresh after rectification of the deficiencies in accordance with the Council Regulations on Postgraduate Medical Education,2000.

59. Increase of seats in D.M.(Cardiology) course at Nizam's Institute of Medical Sciences, Hyderabad affiliated to Nizam's Institute of Medical Sciences, Hyderabad (Deemed University) u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 – consideration of compliance verification regarding.

Read : The compliance verification inspection report (August, 2004) together with compliance and inspection report (June, 2002) on the physical and other teaching facilities available at Nizam's Institute of Medical Sciences, Hyderabad for increase of seats in D.M.(Cardiology) course.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the compliance verification inspection report (August,2004) together with compliance and inspection report (June,2002) and decided to advise the institution to re-organise the units in terms of teaching faculty as per MCI norms.

The Committee further decided to defer the consideration of the matter till the information is received.

60. Recognition of postgraduate medical qualifications granted by Delhi University in respect of various medical colleges (non-teaching hospitals) –consideration of request u/s 11(2) of the IMC Act, 1956.

Read : The matter along with report of the sub-committee regarding recognition of postgraduate medical qualifications granted by Delhi University in respect of various medical colleges (non-teaching hospitals).

The Postgraduate Committee considered and accepted the report of the Sub-Committee with regard to recognition of postgraduate medical qualifications granted by Delhi University in respect of various medical colleges (non-teaching hospitals).

The Committee further decided that draft amendment to the Postgraduate Regulations proposed in 2001, may be notified by Govt. of India.

The Committee further noted the letter No. V-11015/4/2004-ME(P-I), dated 10th December,2004 received from the Central Govt. wherein the recommendation of the Council

is expeditiously sought; decided that the matter be placed before the members of the General Body through circulation for onward transmission to Govt. of India.

61. Regarding provision of Maternity Leave to Postgraduate Female students in respect of criterion of minimum required 80% attendance 'yearwise' for eligibility to appearing for Degree/Diploma Courses.

Read : The letter dated 3.9.2004 from the Principal & Controller, S.M.S. Medical College, Jaipur with regard to provision of Maternity Leave to postgraduate Female students in respect of criterion of minimum required 80% attendance 'yearwise' for eligibility to appearing for Degree/Diploma Courses

The Postgraduate Committee decided to obtain legal opinion to deliberate further in the matter.

62. Permission to make admissions after the last date of admission to PG courses in respect of Pt. Deen Dayal Upadhyay Medical College, Rajkot – Reg.

Read : The letter dated 4.11.2004 from the Dean, Pt. Deen Dayal Upadhyay Medical College, Rajkot regarding the permission to make admissions after the last date of admissions to PG courses.

The Postgraduate Committee noted the letter dated 4.11.2004 from the Dean, Pt. Deen Dayal Upadhyay Medical College, Rajkot regarding the permission to make admissions after the last date of admissions to PG courses.

63. Tamilnadu Dr. M.G.R. Medical University, Chennai – Recognition of M.D.(Physical Medicine & Rehabilitation) qualification in respect of students being trained at Christian Medical College, Vellore

Read : The Council Inspector's report (April, 2004) along with the compliance on the standard of examination and other teaching facilities available at Christian Medical College, Vellore for purpose of recognition of M.D.(Physical Medicine & Rehabilitation) qualification earlier granted by The Tamilnadu Dr. M.G.R. Medical University, Chennai.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Inspector's report (April,2004) along with the compliance and decided to recommend that M.D.(Physical Medicine & Rehabilitation) qualification granted by The Tamilnadu Dr. M.G.R. Medical University in respect of students being trained at Christian Medical College, Vellore be recognised and included in the First Schedule to the Indian Medical Council Act,1956 restricting the number of admission to 1(one) student per year.

64. Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences, Bangalore – Approval of St. John's Medical College, Bangalore for the award of MD(Obst. & Gynae.) & DGO qualification in respect of increased intake capacity.

Read : The Council Inspector's report (October, 2004) on the standard of examination and other teaching facilities available at St. John's Medical College, Bangalore for purpose of approval of the college for the award of M.D.(Obst. & Gynae.) & DGO qualification in respect of increased intake i.e. from 2(two) to 3 (three) granted by Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences, Bangalore.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Inspector's report (October,2004) and noted that institution already stands approved for the award of M.D.(Obst. & Gynae.) and D.G.O. qualifications with 2 (two) students per year in each course and the matter under consideration is for approval of the institution for increased intake subsequently permitted by the Central Govt. and decided to recommend that St. John's Medical College, Bangalore be approved for the award of M.D.(Obst. & Gynae.) and D.G.O. qualifications granted by Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences, Bangalore restricting the number of admissions to 3(three) students per year in each course.

65. Annamalai University – Recognition of MD(Physiology) qualification in respect of students being trained at Rajah Muthiah Medical College, Annamalaiagar.

Read : The Council Inspector's report (September, 2004) along with the compliance on the standard of examination and other teaching facilities available at Rajah Muthiah

Medical College, Annamalainagar for purpose of recognition of MD(Physiology) qualification granted by Annamalai University.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Inspector's report (September,2004) along with the compliance and decided to verify the compliance by way of an inspection.

66. Mumbai University – Recognition of D.M.(Medical Oncology) qualification in respect of students being trained at Tata Memorial Hospital, Mumbai.

Read : The Council Inspector's report (July, 2004) along with the compliance on the standard of examination and other teaching facilities available at Tata Memorial Hospital, Mumbai for purpose of recognition of D.M. (Medical Oncology) qualification granted by Mumbai University.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Inspector's report (July,2004) along with the compliance and decided to verify the compliance by way of an inspection.

67. Rajasthan University – Approval of J.L.N. Medical College, Ajmer for the award of M.D.(SPM) qualification.

Read : The Council Inspector's report (September/October, 2004) on the standard of examination and other teaching facilities available at J.L.N. Medical College, Ajmer for purpose of approval of the college for the award of M.D (SPM) qualification granted by Rajasthan University.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Inspector's report (September/October,2004) along with the compliance and decided to verify the compliance by way of an inspection.

68. Mysore University/Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences, Bangalore - Approval of Govt. Medical College, Mysore for the award of M.D.(Radio-Diagnosis) qualification.

Mysore University – Recognition of DMRD qualification in respect of Govt. Medical College, Mysore and also approval of the college for the same diploma under Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences, Bangalore.

Read : The Council Inspector's report (Sept., 1997) on the standard of examination and other teaching facilities available at Govt. Medical College, Mysore along with the court order for the award of M.D.(Radio-Diagnosis) and recognition of D.M.R.D. qualifications granted by Mysore University.

The Postgraduate Committee noted the order vide W.A. No. 3098-3873-84/2004 of the Hon'ble High Court of Karnataka wherein no direction was given to MCI with regard to recognition/approval of Govt. Medical College, Mysore for the award of M.D.(Radio-Diagnosis) & D.M.R.D. qualifications.

69. Rajasthan University – Approval of J.L.N. Medical College, Ajmer for the award of M.D.(Physiology) qualification.

Read : The Council Inspector's report (September, 2004) on the standard of examination and other teaching facilities available at J.L.N. Medical College, Ajmer for purpose of approval of the college for the award of M.D.(Physiology) qualification granted by Rajasthan University.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Inspector's report (September,2004) together with compliance and noted that the compliance is unsatisfactory; decided to reiterate its earlier decision taken at its meeting held on 29.10.2004 deciding not to approve J.L.N. Medical College, Ajmer for the award of M.D.(Physiology) qualification granted by Rajasthan University because the following deficiencies are still persisting:-

1. Staff is insufficient even for UG.
2. Museum is inadequate.
3. No separate Clinical Physiology Lab.
4. Other deficiencies/observations as pointed out in the inspection report.

The Committee further decided to direct the institution authorities to henceforth stop admissions prospectively in M.D.(Physiology) course with immediate effect.

Read : The Council Inspector's report (August, 2004) along with the compliance on the standard of examination and other teaching facilities available at Regional Institute of Medical Sciences, Imphal for purpose of recognition of MD (Community Medicine) qualification in respect of Regional Institute of Medical Sciences, Imphal granted by Manipur University.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Inspector's report (August, 2004) along with the compliance and noted that the compliance is unsatisfactory; decided not to recommend recognition of MD (Community Medicine) qualification granted by Manipur University in respect of students being trained at Regional Institute of Medical Sciences, Imphal.

71. University of Delhi - Approval of Army Hospital Delhi Cantt., Delhi for the award of D.G.O. qualification.

Read : The Council Inspector's report (April, 2004) on the standard of examination and other teaching facilities available at Army Hospital Delhi Cantt., Delhi for purpose of approval of the college for the award of D.G.O. qualification granted by University of Delhi.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Inspector's report (April,2004) and decided to recommend that Army Hospital Delhi Cantt., Delhi be approved for the award of D.G.O. qualification granted by Delhi University restricting the number of admissions to 2(two) students per year.

72. University of Delhi - Approval of Army Hospital Delhi Cantt., Delhi for the award of M.S. (General Surgery) qualification.

Read : The Council Inspector's report (Oct., 2003) on the standard of examination and other teaching facilities available at Army Hospital Delhi Cantt., Delhi for purpose of approval of the college for the award of M.S.(General Surgery) qualification granted by University of Delhi.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Inspector's report (Oct.,2003) along with compliance and decided to obtain faculty details from the institution in the proforma prescribed by the Council.

The Committee further decided to obtain the details of teaching faculty of the department of General Surgery as per the prescribed proforma and deferred the consideration of the matter till the information is received.

73. Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences, Bangalore – Approval of the Fr. Muller Medical College, Mangalore for the award DCP qualification.

Read : The Council Inspector's report (November, 2004) on the standard of examination and other teaching facilities available at Fr. Muller Medical College, Mangalore for purpose of approval of the college for the award of DCP qualification granted by Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences, Bangalore.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Inspector's report (November,2004) and decided to recommend that Fr. Muller Medical College, Mangalore be approved for the award of DCP qualification granted by Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences, Bangalore restricting the number of admissions to 2(two) per year.

74. Andhra University/Andhra Pradesh University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada and N.T.R. University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada - Approval of Andhra Medical College, Visakhapatnam for the award of M.D.(SPM/Community Medicine) & DPH qualifications.

Read : The inspection report (May, 2001) along with the compliance and compliance verification report on the standard of examination and other teaching facilities available at Andhra Medical College, Visakhapatnam for purpose of approval of the college for the award of M.D.(SPM/Community Medicine) & DPH qualifications granted by Andhra University, Andhra Pradesh University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada & NTR University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the inspection report (May,2001) along with the compliance and compliance verification report (Nov.,2004) and noted that the compliance is unsatisfactory; decided to reiterate its earlier decision taken at its meeting held on 2.9.2003 which reads as under:-

"The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Inspector's report (May,2001) and decided not to recommend recognition/approval of Andhra Medical College, Visakhapatnam for the award of M.D.(SPM/Community Medicine) & DPH qualifications granted by Andhra Pradesh University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada & NTR University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada because -

1. Promotion of Prof. & HOD is not as per MCI norms.
2. Other deficiencies pointed out in the inspection report.

The Committee further decided that the authorities of the institution be directed to stop admission in M.D.(Community Medicine/SPM) & DPH courses with immediate effect."

75. Recognition of Postgraduate degree "Arzt fur Nuklear – Medizin" Germany u/s 13(3) of the IMC Act, 1956 – Dr. B.K. Das.

Read : The letter dated 29/6/2004 from Sanjay Gandhi Postgraduate Instt. of Medical Sciences, Lucknow with regard to recognition of Postgraduate degree "Arzt fur Nuklear – Medizin" Germany u/s 13(3) of the IMC Act, 1956.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the letter dated 29.6.2004 from Sanjay Gandhi Postgraduate Instt. of Medical Sciences, Lucknow with regard to recognition of Postgraduate degree "Arzt fur Nuklear – Medizin" Germany u/s 13(3) of the IMC Act, 1956 and decided to reiterate its earlier decision taken at its meeting held on 15.12.2003 wherein the earlier decision dated 06.11.1996 was reiterated which reads as under:-

"The Postgraduate Committee reviewed the earlier Committee's decision taken at its meeting held on 18.10.1995 permitting Dr. B.K. Das to be a postgraduate teacher with "Arzt fur Nuclear Medicine", Germany as a special case.

The Postgraduate Committee feels that a person having unrecognised qualification should not be considered as a recognised postgraduate teacher.

In view of the fact that Committee decided to reiterate the earlier decision because of the fact that the degree possessed by Dr. B.K. Das cannot be equated with postgraduate degree of Indian Universities as there is no examination for the award of said degree."

76. Confirmation of MCI recognition in respect of Dr. A.N. Sontakke.

Read : The letter dated 17/7/2004 received from Dr. D.L. Ingole, Dean, Dr. D.Y. Patil Medical College, Pimpri, Pune regarding eligibility of Dr. A.N. Sonatakke as PG teacher.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the letter dated 17/7/2004 received from Dr. D.L. Ingole, Dean, Dr. D.Y. Patil Medical College, Pimpri, Pune regarding eligibility of Dr. A.N. Sonatakke as PG teacher and decided to refer the matter to the Teachers' Eligibility Qualifications Sub-Committee.

77. Sardar Patel University – Recognition of M.S.(Orthopaedics) qualification in respect of students being trained at Pramukhswami Medical College, Karamsad.

Read : The Council Inspector's report (August, 2004) along with the compliance on standard of examination and other teaching facilities available at Pramukhswami Medical College, Karamsad for purpose of recognition of M.S.(Orthopaedics) qualification.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Inspector's report (August,2004) along with compliance and decided to verify the compliance by way of an inspection.

78. Sardar Patel University – Recognition of M.S.(General Surgery) qualification in respect of students being trained at Pramukhswami Medical College, Karamsad.

Read : The Council Inspector's report (August, 2004) along with the compliance on the standard of examination and other teaching facilities available at Pramukhswami Medical College, Karamsad for purpose of recognition of M.S.(General Surgery) qualification granted by Sardar Patel University.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Inspector's report (August,2004) along with compliance and decided to verify the compliance by way of an inspection.

79. H.N.B. Garhwal University – Recognition of MD(community Medicine) qualification in respect of students being trained at Himalayan Institute of Medical Sciences, Dehradun.

Read : The Council Inspector's report (Dec., 2004) on the standard of examination and other teaching facilities available at Himalayan Institute of Medical Sciences, Dehradun for purpose of recognition of MD(Community Medicine) qualification granted by H.N.B. Garhwal University.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Inspector's report (Dec.,2004) and decided to recommend that M.D.(Community Medicine) qualification granted by H.N.B. Garhwal University in respect of students being trained at Himalayan Institute of Medical Sciences, Dehradun be recognised and included in the First Schedule to the Indian Medical Council Act,1956 restricting the number of admissions to 2 (two) students per year.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Inspector's report (Nov.,2004) and decided to recommend that M.D.(Microbiology) qualification granted by H.N.B. Garhwal University in respect of students being trained at Himalayan Institute of Medical Sciences, Dehradun be recognised and included in the First Schedule to the Indian Medical Council Act,1956 restricting the number of admissions to 2 (two) students per year.

81. H.N.B. Garhwal University – Recognition of MD(Paediatrics) qualification in respect of students being trained at Himalayan Institute of Medical Sciences, Dehradun.

86. Increase of seats in M.D.(Obstetrics & Gynecology) course at Kakatiya Medical College, Warangal affiliated to NTR University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.

Read : The Council Inspector's report (December, 2003) on the physical and other teaching facilities available at Kakatiya Medical College, Warangal affiliated to NTR University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada for consideration of increase of seats in M.D.(Obstetrics & Gynecology) course.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Inspector's report (December,2003) and decided to recommend to the Central Govt. not to issue Letter of Intent

for increase of seats in M.D.(Obstetrics & Gynaecology) course at Kakatiya Medical College, Warangal affiliated to NTR University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada u/s 10A of the I.M.C. Act,1956 because of the following-

- (i) Teaching complement is incomplete in both the units.
- (ii) There is no central OBG department.
- (iii) There are no ward side laboratories.
- (iv) Departmental library facilities are inadequate.
- (v) There is no laboratory technician.
- (vi) Space, teaching & training is incomplete.
- (vii) Other deficiencies/observations as pointed out in the inspection report.

The Committee further decided to direct the institution authorities to henceforth stop admissions prospectively in M.D.(Obst. & Gynae.) course with immediate effect.

87. Inclusion of M.D.(Emergency Medicine) in the regulations of the Council on Postgraduate Medical Education, 2000 – consideration of N.T.R. University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada –regarding.

Read : The letter dated 3.11.2004 received from the Registrar, NTR University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada requesting the Council for starting of M.D.(Emergency Medicine) course. The said course is not included in the regulations of the Council on Postgraduate Regulations, 2000.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the letter dated 3.11.2004 received from the Registrar, NTR University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada and noted that M.D.(Emergency Medicine) is not included in the regulations of the Council on Postgraduate Medical Education,2000; decided to constitute a Sub-Committee to look into the matter consisting of the following members:-

1. Dr. L.S. Chawla
2. Dr. S.B. Siwach

88. H.N.B. Garhwal University – Recognition of MD(Radio-Diagnosis) qualification in respect of students being trained at Himalayan Institute of Medical Sciences, Dehradun.

The Committee decided to issue show cause notice to the concerned authorities wherever the violation is made.

98. NBE - Equivalence of Board's qualification with that of MD/MS/DM/M.Ch. of other Universities for the purpose of appointment as teachers - Regarding.

Read : The letter dated 20.12.2004 from the Central Govt. regarding equivalence of National Board of Examination's qualification with that of MD/MS/DM/M.Ch. of other Universities for the purpose of appointment of teachers.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the letter dated 20.12.2004 and decided that opinion may be sought from the Director, AIIMS, New Delhi; PGI, Chandigarh; SGPGI, Lucknow; JIPMER, Pondicherry; Sri Chithra Tirunel Institute of Medical Sciences & Technology, Trivandrum; K.G. Medical College, Lucknow (Deemed University) etc. The decisions of the General Body and Postgraduate Committee in this regard from time to time may also be enclosed for ready reference.

99. Postgraduate courses permitted u/s 10A of the I.M.C. Act,1956 but no recognition sought u/s 11(2) of the Act - Regarding.

The Chairman of the Committee brought out that under the permissions which are granted for starting/increase in intake capacity of postgraduate medical courses u/s 10A of the Indian Medical Council Act,1956, the applicant college is required to seek recognition of the same u/s 11(2) of the Act when the first admitted batch appears for the University examinations.

There may be good number of cases where the institutions that have been granted permission for starting/increase in intake of postgraduate courses, might not have sought recognition for the same u/s 11(2) of the Act and may be continuing with the admissions to the postgraduate courses. As such necessary information in this regard be sought by the Council office from the concerned colleges through an appropriate circular for further consideration of the Postgraduate Committee.
