76 **Madras University and The Tamilnadu Dr. M.G.R. Medical University, Chennai- Approval of Cancer Institute, Adyar, Chennai for the award of DMRT qualification.**

Read : The Council Inspector report (February, 2005) of standard of examination and other teaching facilities available at Cancer Institute, Adyar, Chennai for purpose of approval of the college for the award of DMRT qualifications earlier granted by Madras University and now by The Tamilnadu Dr. M.G.R. Medical University, Chennai.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Inspector report (February, 2005) and decided to recommend that Cancer Institute, Adyar, Chennai be approved for the award of DMRT qualification earlier granted by Madras University and now by The Tamilnadu Dr. M.G.R. Medical University, Chennai restricting the number of admissions to 2 (two) students per year.

78 **Pondicherry University – Recognition of DM(Cardiology) qualification in respect of students being trained at Jawaharlal Nehru Instt. of Postgraduate Medical Education & Research, Pondicherry.**

Read: The Council Inspector report (March, 2005) of standard of examination and other teaching facilities available at Jawaharlal Nehru Instt. of Postgraduate Medical Education & Research, Pondicherry for recognition of DM(Cardiology) qualification granted by Pondicherry University.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Inspector report (March, 2005) and decided not to recommend recognition DM(Cardiology) qualification granted by Pondicherry University in respect of students being trained at Jawaharlal Nehru Instt. of Postgraduate Medical Education & Research, Pondicherry because of the following deficiencies :

- i) Teaching complement is incomplete for the want of an Assistant Professor/Lecturer.
- ii) Teaching experience of 2nd Professor is not as per MCI Norms.
- iii) Other deficiencies pointed out in the inspection report.

The Postgraduate Committee further decided to direct the college authorities to stop the admissions in the said course with immediate effect.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Inspector report (March, 2005) and decided to recommend to the Central Government to issue Letter of Permission for starting of M.D.(OBG) course at Yenepoya Medical College, Mangalore affiliated to Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences, Bangalore u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 prospectively i.e. from the academic session 2005-2006 restricting the number of admission to 2(two) students per year till the first batch admitted appears in the final examination of the said course. The institution be advised to apply for recognition of the qualification at the time of first available examination as per the provision of Section 11 (2) of the Act, 1956.

80. Starting of M.S.(Ortho.) course at Yenepoya Medical College, Mangalore under Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences, Bangalore u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.

(Orthopaedics) course at Yenepoya Medical College, Mangalore affiliated to under Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences, Bangalore u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 prospectively i.e. from the academic session 2005-2006 restricting the number of admission to 1(one) student per year commensurate with the clinical and surgical material till the first batch admitted appears in the final examination of the said course. The institution be advised to apply for recognition of the qualification at the time of first available examination as per the provision of Section 11 (2) of the Act, 1956.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Inspector's report (March, 2005) and decided to recommend to the Central Govt. not to issue Letter of Intent for Starting of M.S.(ENT) course at Yenepoya Medical College, Mangalore under Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences, Bangalore u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 because of the following :

- i) Professor & HOD does not possess requisite teaching qualification.
- ii) Other deficiencies pointed out in the Inspection Report.

“The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Inspector's Report (March, 2005) and decided to recommend to the Central Govt. to issue Letter of Permission for starting of M.S. The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Inspector report (March, 2005) and decided to recommend to Central Govt. not to issue Letter of Intent for starting of M.S.(Anatomy) courses at Kameneni Instt. of Medical Sciences, Narketpally under NTR University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 because of the following deficiencies :

- i) The available teaching faculty is just sufficient for permitted undergraduate intake.
- ii) Additional complement of staff for postgraduate courses is not available.
- iii) Other deficiencies/observations as pointed out in the inspection report.

88. Increase of seats in M.D.(General Medicine) course at Himalayan Instt. of Medical Sciences, Dehradun under H.N.Gerhwal University u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.

Read : The Council Inspector report (March, 2005) on the physical and other teaching facilities available at Himalayan Instt. of Medical Sciences, Dehradun under H.N.Gerhwal University for consideration of increase of seats in M.D.(General Medicine) course u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.

Gerhwal University u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 prospectively i.e. from the academic session 2005-2006 restricting the number of admissions from 5 (five) to 8 (Eight) students in each course per year till the first batch admitted against the increased number appears for the final examinations of the said courses.”

89. Increase of seats in M.S.(General Surgery) courses at Himalayan Instt. of Medical Sciences, Dehradun under H.N.Gerhwal University u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.

Read : The Council Inspector report (March, 2005) on the physical and other teaching facilities available at Himalayan Instt. of Medical Sciences, Dehradun under H.N.Gerhwal University for consideration of increase of seats in M.S.(General Surgery) courses u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.

“The Postgraduate Committee considered the Compliance verification (March, 2005) and decided to recommend to the Central Govt. to issue Letter of Permission for increase of seats in MS (Gen. Surgery) course at Himalayan Instt. of Medical Sciences, Dehradun affiliated to H. N. Gerhwal University u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 prospectively i.e. from the academic session 2005-2006 restricting the number of admissions from 5 (five) to 8 (Eight) students in each course per year till the first batch admitted against the increased number appears for the final examinations of the said courses.”

90. Increase of seats in M.D.(Social & Preventive Medicine) course at Osmania Medical College, Hyderabad affiliated to N.T.R. University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 – consideration of compliance verification regarding.

Read : The compliance verification report (March, 2005) together with compliance and Council Inspector’s report (July, 2002) on the physical and other teaching facilities available at Osmania Medical College, Hyderabad for increase of seats in M.D.(Social & Preventive Medicine) course u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the compliance verification report (March, 2005) together with compliance and Council Inspector’s report (July, 2002) and decided to reiterate its earlier decision of the Postgraduate Committee taken at its meeting held on 02.09.2003 recommending to the Central Govt. not to issue Letter of Intent for increase of seats in M.D.(Social & Preventive Medicine) course at Osmania Medical College, Hyderabad affiliated to N.T.R. University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada because the compliance verification report is unsatisfactory.

The Postgraduate Committee further decided to recommend that in view of the above, the Govt. may consider disapproving the proposal for increase of seats in M.D.(Social & Preventive Medicine) course at Osmania Medical College, Hyderabad. However, the institution is free to apply afresh after rectification of the deficiencies, in accordance with the Council’s Regulation on Post Graduation Medical Education, 2000.

91. Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences, Bangalore – Permitting intake in M.D.(General Medicine) course in respect of students being trained at Adichunchanagiri Instt. of Medical Sciences, Bellur .

Read : The Council Inspector report (February, 2005) on physical and other teaching facilities available at Adichunchanagiri Instt. of Medical Sciences, Bellur for purpose of permitting of intake in MD(General Medicine) qualification granted by Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences, Bangalore as well as the inspection report (21-22 March 2005) carried out for undergraduate purposes.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Inspector report (February, 2005) together with the inspection report (21-22 March, 2005) carried out for undergraduate purposes and decided to permit the authorities of Adichunchanagiri

Institute of Medical Sciences, Bellur prospectively with an annual intake capacity of 4(four) students for M.D.(General Medicine) course under Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences, Bangalore.

92 The Tamilnadu Dr. M.G.R. Medical University, Chennai – Approval of Chengalpattu Medical College, Chengalpattu for the award of M.S.(General Surgery) qualification – Consideration of compliance verification regarding.

Read : The compliance verification report (March, 2005) togetherwith compliance and Council Inspector's report (March, 2003) on the standard of examination and other teaching facilities available at Chengalpattu Medical College, Chengalpattu for purpose of approval of the college for the award of M.S.(General Surgery) qualification granted by The Tamilnadu Dr.M.G.R. Medical University, Chennai.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the compliance verification report (March, 2005) togetherwith compliance and Council Inspector's report (March, 2003) and decided to recommend Chengalpattu Medical College, Chengalpattu be approved for the award of for the award of M.S.(General Surgery) qualification granted by The Tamilnadu Dr. M.G.R. Medical University, Chennai restricting the number of admissions to 1 (one) student per year.

93. Exemption to in-service candidates of the state of Kerala from appearing for PG common entrance examination or to fix the minimum percentage of marks (40%) for their eligibility in admissions in PG courses.

Read: The letter dated 10.11.2004 from the Principal Secretary, Govt. of Thiruvanthapuram and a letter dated 15.3.2005 and subsequent letter dt. 26.3.2005 from the Kerala Govt. Medical Officers, Association regarding exemption to in service candidates of the state of Kerala from appearing for PG common entrance examination or to fix the minimum percentage of marks(40%) for their eligibility in admissions in the PG courses.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the letter dated 10.11.2004 subsequest letter dt. 26.3.2005 from the Principal Secretary, Govt. of Thiruvanthapuram and a letter dated 15.3.2005 from the Kerala Govt. Medical Officers, Association and decided to obtain legal opinion and action be initiated in accordance with the legal opinion so obtained.

94 Starting of M.D.(Microbiology) course at Sri Venkateswara Institute of Medical Sciences, Tirupati (Deemed University) u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 - Consideration of reinspection report regarding.

Read : The compliance and Council Inspector's report (Nov., 2004) on the physical and other teaching facilities available at Sri Venkateswara Institute of Medical Sciences, Tirupati for consideration of starting of M.D.(Microbiology) course.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the compliance and Council Inspector's report (Nov., 2004) and decided to reiterate its earlier decision taken at its meeting held on 23.12.2004 recommending to the Central Government to issue Letter of Permission for starting of MD (Microbiology) course at Sri Venkateswara Institute of Medical Sciences, Tirupati (Deemed University) u/s 10A of the I.M.C.Act,1956 prospectively i.e. from the academic session 2005-2006 restricting the number of admission to 1 (one) student per year till the first batch admitted appears in the final examination of the said course. The institution be advised to apply for recognition of the qualification at the time of first available examination as per the provision of Section 11(2) of the I.M.C. Act, 1956.

95. Starting of M.D.(Physiology) course at Pt.Deen Dayal Upadhyay Medical College, Rajkot affiliated to Saurashtra University u/s 10A of the I.M.C. Act,1956-compliance verification regarding.

Read : The compliance verification report (March, 2005) together with compliance and Council Inspector's report (August, 2004) on the physical and other teaching facilities available at Padamshree Dr. D.Y.Patil Medical College, Navi Mumbai for consideration of starting of M.D.(Biochemistry) course u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the compliance verification report (March., 2005) togetherwith compliance and Council Inspector's report (August, 2004) and decided to recommend to the Central Govt. not to issue Letter of Intent for starting of MD (Biochemistry) course at Padamshree Dr. D.Y.Patil Medical College, Navi Mumbai (Deemed University) u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 because of the following-

- (i) Prof. & HOD does not possess requisite recognised postgraduate qualification.
- (ii) Other deficiencies/observations as pointed out in the inspection report.

The Postgraduate Committee further decided to recommend that in view of the above, the Govt. may consider disapproving the proposal for starting of MD (Biochemistry) course. However, the institution is free to apply afresh after rectification of the deficiencies, in accordance with the Council's Regulation on Post Graduation Medical Education, 2000.
