4. Part time clinical Psychologist is available, but standard development screening kit is not available so as to offer early stimulation and intervention programmes to high risk new born.
5. Blood component therapy is not available.
6. Asthma clinic is the need of the day, with a competent team, who can train the patient about the use of devices.
7. Other deficiencies as pointed out in the inspection report.

**73. Increase of seats in MS(Ophthalmology) course at J.L.N. Medical College, Swangi, Wardha under Datta Meghe Institute of Medical Sciences (Deemed University) u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.**

Read: The Council Inspector's report (September, 2006) on the physical and other teaching facilities available at J.L.N. Medical College, Swangi, Wardha under Datta Meghe Institute of Medical Sciences (Deemed University) for consideration of increase of seats in MS(Ophthalmology) course u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Inspector's Report (September,2006) and noted that the present intake of 1(one) seat for MS (Ophthalmology) & DO per year is commensurate with the available clinical material and therefore decided to recommend to the Central Govt. not to issue Letter of Intent for Increase of seats in M.S.(Ophthalmology) course at J.L.N. Medical College, Swangi, Wardha under Datta Meghe Institute of Medical Sciences (Deemed University) u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.

**74. Increase of seats in MD(General Medicine) course at J.L.N. Medical College, Swangi, Wardha under Datta Meghe Institute of Medical Sciences (Deemed University) u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.**

Read: The Council Inspector's report (September, 2006) on the physical and other teaching facilities available at J.L.N. Medical College, Swangi, Wardha under Datta Meghe Institute of Medical Sciences (Deemed University) for consideration of increase of seats in MD(General Medicine) course u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Inspector's report (September, 2006) and decided to recommend to the Central Govt. to issue Letter of Intent for increase of seats in MD(Gen. Medicine) course at JLN Medical College, Swangi, Wardha under Datta Meghe Institute of Medical Sciences (Deemed University) prospectively i.e. from the academic session 2007-2008 u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 from 3(three) to 6(six) students per year.

The Committee further decided to draw the attention of the observations made in the inspection report regarding the class rooms attached to wards and space for faculty.

*Dr. Ved Prakash Mishra rejoined the proceedings.*

**75. Inclusion of Geriatric Mental Health as a super-speciality subject in the “Post-Graduate Medical Education Regulation, 2000” Schedule.**

Read: The letter dated 19/9/2006 received from Dr. Hari Gautam, Vice-Chancellor, King George’s Medical University, Lucknow requesting the Council to include the Geriatric Mental Health as a super-specialty department in the Postgraduate Medical Education Regulations.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the letter dated 19/9/2006 received from Dr. Hari Gautam, Vice-Chancellor, King George’s Medical University, Lucknow and decided to constitute a Sub-Committee with the following members to submit its report:

2. Dr. Indirajit Ray

**76. Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences, Bangalore – Approval of Sri Devraj Urs Medical College, Tamaka, Kolar for the award of M.S. (General Surgery) qualification in respect of increased intake.**

Read: The compliance together with the Council Inspector’s report (May, 2006) on the standard of examination and other teaching facilities available at Sri Devraj Urs Medical College, Tamaka, Kolar for purpose of approval of the college for the award of M.S.(General Surgery) qualification in respect of increased intake granted by Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences, Bangalore.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the compliance together with the Council Inspector’s report (May, 2006) and noted that Sri Devraj Urs Medical College, Tamaka, Kolar already stands approved for the award of MS (General Surgery) qualification with 1(one) seat and now the matter is for consideration of approval of the college in respect of increased intake; decided to recommend that Sri Devraj Urs Medical College, Tamaka, Kolar be approved for the award of M.S. (General Surgery) qualification granted by Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences, Bangalore restricting the number of admissions to 2 (two) students per year.

**77. Bhavnagar University – Recognition of MD (Anatomy) qualification in respect of students being trained at Govt. Medical College, Bhavnagar.**

Read: The Council Inspector’s report (September, 2006) on the standard of examination and other teaching facilities available at Govt. Medical College, Bhavnagar for purpose of recognition of M.D. (Anatomy) qualification granted by Bhavnagar University.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Inspector’s report (September, 2006) and decided to recommend that MD (Anatomy) qualification granted by Bhavnagar University in respect of students being trained at Govt. Medical College, Bhavnagar be recognized and included in the 1<sup>st</sup> Schedule to the IMC Act, 1956 restricting the number of admissions to 2 (Two) students per year.

**78. Bhavnagar University – Recognition of MD (General Medicine) qualification in respect of students being trained at Govt. Medical College, Bhavnagar.**

Read: The Council Inspector’s report (Oct., 2006) on the standard of examination and other teaching facilities available at Govt. Medical College, Bhavnagar for purpose of recognition of M.D. (General Medicine) qualification granted by Bhavnagar University.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Inspector’s report (October, 2006) and decided to recommend that MD (General Medicine) qualification granted by Bhavnagar University in respect of students being trained at Govt. Medical College, Bhavnagar be recognized and included in the 1<sup>st</sup> Schedule to the IMC Act, 1956 restricting the number of admissions to 2 (Two) students per year.



**79. Pondicherry University – Recognition of DM(Cardiology) qualification in respect of students being trained at Jawaharlal Nehru Instt. of Postgraduate Medical Education & Research, Pondicherry.**

Read: The compliance verification inspection report (August, 2006) together with the Council Inspector's report (March, 2005) on the standard of examination and other teaching facilities available at Jawaharlal Nehru Instt. of Postgraduate Medical Education & Research, Pondicherry for recognition of DM(Cardiology) qualification granted by Pondicherry University.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the compliance verification inspection report (August, 2006) together with the Council Inspector's report (March, 2005) and decided to recommend that DM (Cardiology) qualification granted by Pondicherry University in respect of students being trained at Jawaharlal Nehru Instt. of Postgraduate Medical Education & Research, Pondicherry be recognized and included in the 1<sup>st</sup> Schedule to the IMC Act, 1956 restricting the number of admission to 1 (One) student per year.

**80. Approval to admit the students under the Postgraduate teachers who are under suspension – order of the Hon'ble High Court of Bombay in Writ Petition (L) No. 2296 of 2006 – Dr. Kalyan Munde Vs. State of Maharashtra & Anrs.**

Read: The letter dated 4/10/2006 received from the Director of Medical Education & Research, Mumbai regarding approval to admit the students under the Postgraduate teachers who are under suspension.

The Postgraduate Committee pursuant to the order passed by the Hon'ble High Court of Bombay on 28.09.2006 in Writ Petition (L) No. 2296 of 2006 – Dr. Kalyan Munde Vs. State of Maharashtra & Anrs. noted the operative part of the order as under:-

*".....2. The respondents had issued brochure for admission in which the number of seats for DM (Cardiology) in GMC, Mumbai were shown as 3. On behalf of the State Government learned Associate Advocate General points out that the admissions are based on teacher ratio i.e. one teacher for one student. In the instant case though there are four teachers two of them are suspended and as such they can only admit two students whom they have admitted. Under the Brochure issued in July,2006 the number of seats are only two.*

*3. The issue, therefore, arises as to whether a teacher who is under suspension can be considered for the purpose of filling in the seat. There were four teachers and therefore four seats. If two teachers are suspended can they be counted for the purpose of filling in the seats. Considering this controversy we have informed both parties that it will be appropriate that the Medical Council of India decides as to whether the teacher who is under suspension can be considered for the purpose of filling in seats. Till such decision by the Medical Council of India respondents can grant provisional admission subject to the decision of M.C.I. Learned Counsel for the petitioner has informs that the petitioner herein has been admitted to the course in D.M.(Nephrology) and that he proposes to give up the same. If his name is considered on merit for D.M. in Cardiology in the event M.C.I. holds that the two seats cannot be filled in, then he takes the risk of losing both the seats. Shri Thorat on taking instructions from the petitioner who is present in the Court states that the petitioner is willing to take such risk. In the light of that the following order:-*

*[i] Respondents are directed to fill in provisionally the additional two seats for D.M. Cardiology subject to the decision of the Medical Council of India.*

- [ii] *The respondents to refer the matter to Medical Council of India within one week from today. The Medical Council of India to take decision thereafter within four weeks.*
- [iii] *In the event the Medical Council of India holds that the posts of suspended teachers can be considered for determining the number of seats to be filled in, then the provisional admission to be confirmed. In the event the M.C.I. holds otherwise the provisional admission granted to the students so admitted to be cancelled.....”*

The above matter refers to allotment of a seat to a student for the course of D.M.(Cardiology) against two teachers – one in Grant Medical College, Mumbai and L.T.M. Medical College, Mumbai in the subject of D.M.(Cardiology) who have been suspended.

Clause 11(1) pertaining to the teaching faculty as mentioned in the Postgraduate Medical Education Regulations, 2000 reads as under:-

### **11.1 Staff – Faculty**

- “(a) *A clinical department or its unit training candidates for broad or super specialities, shall have a minimum of three full time faculty members belonging to the concerned disciplines of whom one shall be a Professor, one Associate Professor/Reader and one Assistant Professor/Lecturer, possessing the qualification and experience prescribed by the Medical Council of India:*

*Provided that the second or subsequent additional unit may be headed by an Associate Professor.*

*Of these faculty members only those who possess a total of eight years teaching experience, out of which at least five years teaching experience as Assistant Professor/Lecturer gained after obtaining postgraduate degree, shall be recognized as postgraduate teachers.*

- (b) *In each department training candidates for super specialities, there shall be a minimum of three faculty members with requisite postgraduate qualification and experience – One Professor, One Associate Professor/ Reader and One Assistant Professor/Lecturer, with at least two of them holding the degree of D.M./M.Ch. in the concerned discipline.*

*Of these faculty members only those who possess eight years teaching experience out of which at least five years teaching experience as Assistant Professor/Lecturer gained after obtaining the higher speciality degree shall be recognized as postgraduate teachers:*

*Provided that in the case of super speciality courses which are being newly instituted relaxation of qualification and experience of postgraduate teachers may be granted by the Medical Council of India for sufficient cause.*

- (c) *In addition to the faculty staff, the strength of Residents/Registrars/Tutors/Demonstrators, as well as technical and other para medical staff shall be as per the staff strength prescribed for 50 or 100 or 150 students in the “Minimum Requirements for 50/100/150 MBBS Admissions Annually Regulations”.*

Clause 12(4) pertaining to the Number of Postgraduate Students to be admitted as included in the Postgraduate Medical Education Regulations, 2000 reads as under:-

*“12(4) The number of students to be admitted in case of postgraduate degree (Super speciality) courses shall be one student per year per recognized postgraduate teacher in a department having a minimum of three faculty members (one Professor, one Associate Professor/Reader and one Asstt. Professor/ Lecturer) and twenty beds. If the number of Postgraduate teachers in the unit is more than one then the number of students may be increased proportionately but not more than two in a unit per*

*year in any circumstances. For this purpose one student should associate with one postgraduate teacher:*

*Provided that no postgraduate seats left unfilled in an academic year, shall be carried forward to the next of subsequent academic years, an academic year being from 1<sup>st</sup> January to 31<sup>st</sup> December of any calendar year.”*

Reading Clause 11(1) with 12.4 makes it abundantly clear that the number of students to be admitted in the case of postgraduate super speciality degree courses shall be one student per year per recognized postgraduate teacher in a department having a minimum of 3 faculty members (one Professor, one Associate Professor/Reader and one Asstt. Professor/Lecturer) and twenty beds. Such teachers shall also be full time faculty members. The purpose of these Regulations is to make sufficient number of postgraduate teachers available so that not only the ratio of 1:1 is maintained but also adequate number of teachers should be available in the department on full time basis for imparting postgraduate teaching; more particularly so in super speciality courses.

Full time teachers in super speciality departments are mandatorily required as the emphasis in super speciality has always been on direct instructions and demonstration and explanation of theoretical principle in necessarily small batches for which the requisite number of teachers are required to be made available in the medical institutions on full time basis.

It should also be noted that a teacher who is suspended and is thus not available in the department either for clinical work related with patient care or for any teaching or training activity related with postgraduate student during the period of suspension, creates a deficiency in the minimum requirements stipulated by the statutory regulations.

In view of above, the Postgraduate Committee after due deliberations decided that students cannot be allocated to the teachers who are suspended from the work and as such the posts of suspended teachers cannot be counted for determining the number of seats for admission to super speciality courses.

**81. Manipal Academy of Higher Education (Deemed University), Manipal – Recognition of M.Ch.(Neuro-Surgery) qualification in respect of students being trained at Kasturba Medical College, Manipal.**

Read: The matter with regard to recognition of M.Ch.(Neuro-Surgery) qualification granted by Manipal Academy of Higher Education (Deemed University), Manipal in respect of students being trained at Kasturba Medical College, Manipal.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the matter with regard to recognition of M.Ch.(Neuro-Surgery) qualification granted by Manipal Academy of Higher Education (Deemed University), Manipal and decided to carry out fresh inspection of the institution for evaluation of physical facilities thereto.

**82. Mysore University, Mangalore University and Manipal Academy of Higher Education(Deemed University), Manipal – Recognition of D.M.R.T. qualification in respect of students being trained at Kasturba Medical College, Manipal.**

Read: The matter with regard to recognition of DMRT qualification granted by Mysore University, Mangalore University and Manipal Academy of Higher Education (Deemed University) in respect of students being trained at Kasturba Medical College, Manipal.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the matter with regard to recognition of DMRT qualification granted by Manipal Academy of Higher Education (Deemed University), Manipal and decided to carry out fresh inspection of the institution for evaluation of physical facilities thereat.

**83. Starting of MD(Community Medicine) & DCM courses at Era’s Lucknow Medical College & Hospital, Lucknow granted by Dr. Ram Manohar Lohia Avadh University, Faizabad u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.**

Read: The Council Inspector's report (October 2006) on the physical and teaching facilities available at Era's Lucknow Medical College, Lucknow for starting of MD(Community Medicine) & DCM courses granted by Dr. Ram Manohar Lohia Avadh University, Faizabad.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Inspector's report (October,2006) and decided to recommend to the Central Govt. not to issue Letter of Intent for starting of MD(Community Medicine) & DCM courses granted by Dr. Ram Manohar Lohia Avadh University, Faizabad u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 because of the following:-

1. The additional teaching complement for P.G. is not available.
2. Accommodation for residents is inadequate.
3. There is no Public Health Research Lab.
4. Other deficiencies as pointed out in the inspection report.

**84. Starting of MD(Microbiology) courses at Aarupadai Veedu Medical College & Hospital, Kirumampakkam, Pondicherry granted by Vinayaka Mission's Research Foundation, Deemed University u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.**

Read: The Council Inspector's report (October 2006) on the physical and teaching facilities available at Aarupadai Veedu Medical College & Hospital, Kirumampakkam, Pondicherry for the award of MD(Microbiology) course granted by Vinayaka Mission's Research Foundation, Deemed University.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Inspector's report (October,2006) and decided to recommend to the Central Govt. not to issue Letter of Intent for starting of MD(Microbiology) course granted by Vinayaka Mission's Research Foundation, Deemed University u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 because of the following:-

1. Promotion of Prof. & H.O.D. is not as per MCI norms.
2. The additional teaching complement for P.G. is not available.
3. Other deficiencies as pointed out in the inspection report.

**85. Starting of MS(ENT) course at Aarupadai Veedu Medical College & Hospital, Kirumampakkam, Pondicherry granted by Vinayaka Mission's Research Foundation, Deemed University u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.**

Read: The Council Inspector's report (October 2006) on the physical and teaching facilities available at Aarupadai Veedu Medical College & Hospital, Kirumampakkam, Pondicherry for the award of MS(ENT) course granted by Vinayaka Mission's Research Foundation, Deemed University

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Inspector's report (October,2006) and decided to recommend to the Central Govt. not to issue Letter of Intent for starting of MS(ENT) course granted by Vinayaka Mission's Research Foundation, Deemed University u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 because of the following:-

1. Promotion of Prof. & H.O.D. is not as per MCI norms.
2. Resultantly, teaching complement is incomplete.
3. Other deficiencies as pointed out in the inspection report.

**86. Starting of MD(Anesthesia) courses at Aarupadai Veedu Medical College & Hospital, Kirumampakkam, Pondicherry granted by Vinayaka Mission's Research Foundation, Deemed University u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.**

Read: The Council Inspector's report (October 2006) on the physical and teaching facilities available at Aarupadai Veedu Medical College & Hospital, Kirumampakkam, Pondicherry for the award of MD(Anesthesia) course granted by Vinayaka Mission's Research Foundation, Deemed University.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Inspector's report (October,2006) and decided to recommend to the Central Govt. not to issue Letter of Intent for starting of

MD(Anaesthesia) course granted by Vinayaka Mission's Research Foundation, Deemed University u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 because of the following:-

1. Number of major surgeries require improvement.
2. Surgical workload is inadequate.
3. Arrangements for training in associated super-specialities are not available.
4. Other deficiencies as pointed out in the inspection report.

**87. Madras University and The Tamilnadu Dr. MGR Medical University, Chennai – Approval of Medical Research Foundation (Sankara Nethralaya), Chennai for the award of D.O. qualification – consideration of compliance regarding.**

Read: The compliance submitted by the Director, Medical Research Foundation (Sankara Nethralaya), Chennai alongwith an inspection report (April 2003) for consideration of its approval for the award of DO qualification granted by Madras University and The Tamilnadu Dr. MGR Medical University, Chennai.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the compliance submitted by the institute alongwith an inspection report (April 2003) and decided to recommend that Medical Research Foundation (Sankara Nethralaya), Chennai be approved for the award of D.O. qualification granted by Madras University and The Tamilnadu Dr. MGR Medical University, Chennai restricting the number of admissions to 4 (four) students per year.

**88. University of Bombay/Mumbai – Approval of Instt. of Navel Medicine, INHS, Mumbai for the award of MD(General Medicine) qualification.**

Read: The compliance submitted by the authorities of Instt. of Navel Medicine, INHS, Mumbai for its approval for the award of MD(General Medicine) qualification granted by University of Bombay/Mumbai.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the compliance submitted by the authorities of Instt. of Navel Medicine, INHS, Mumbai and decided to recommend that Instt. of Navel Medicine, INHS, Mumbai be approved for the award of MD (General Medicine) qualification granted by University of Bombay/Mumbai.

The Postgraduate Committee further decided to restrict the number of admissions to 6 (six) students per year prospectively in M.D(General Medicine) qualification.

**89. Increase of seats in MD(Anaesthesia) course at S.N. Medical College, Jodhpur under University of Rajasthan, Jaipur u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.**

Read: The Council Inspector's report (Oct., 2006) on the physical and other teaching facilities available at S.N. Medical College, Jodhpur under University of Rajasthan for consideration of increase of seats in MD(Anaesthesia) course u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Inspector's report (Oct., 2006) and decided to recommend to the Central Govt. not to issue Letter of Intent for increase of seats in M.D. (Anaesthesia) course at S.N. Medical College, Jodhpur under University of Rajasthan u/s 10A of the I.M.C. Act,1956 because of the following:

1. Number of operation theatres are less even towards undergraduate requirements.
2. Each O.T. has more than two tables, which is not permissible.
3. Number of books in the departmental library are inadequate.
4. Other deficiencies as pointed out in the inspection report.

**90. Starting of MS(General Surgery) course at N.K.P. Salve Institute of Medical Sciences & Research Center, Nagpur under Maharashtra University of Health Sciences, Nashik u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.**

Read: The Council Inspector's report (September, 2006) on the physical and other teaching facilities available at N.K.P. Salve Instt. of Medical Sciences & Research Centre, Nagpur under Maharashtra University of Health Sciences, Nashik for consideration of starting of MS(General Surgery) course u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Inspector's report (September, 2006) and decided to recommend to the Central Govt. to issue Letter of Intent for starting of M.S. (General Surgery) course at N.K.P. Salve Instt. of Medical Sciences & Research Centre, Nagpur under Maharashtra University of Health Sciences, Nashik u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 prospectively i.e. from the academic session 2007-2008 restricting the number of admissions to 4 (four) students per year.

The Committee further decided to draw the attention of the college authorities to the observations made by the Council Inspector in the inspection report regarding Research Lab., museum, sitting space and Blood Bank requirement.

**91. Starting of MD(Physiology) course at Era's Lucknow Medical College & Hospital, Lucknow granted by Dr. Ram Manohar Lohia Avadh University, Faizabad u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.**

Read: The Council Inspector's report (September, 2006) on the physical and other teaching facilities available at Era's Lucknow Medical College & Hospital, Lucknow for consideration of starting of MD(Physiology) course granted by Dr. Ram Manohar Lohia Avadh University, Faizabad u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.

Read: The Council Inspector's report (September, 2006) on the physical and other teaching facilities available at Era's Lucknow Medical College & Hospital, Lucknow for consideration of starting of MD(Dermatology, Venereology & Leprosy) & DDVL courses granted by Dr. Ram Manohar Lohia Avadh University, Faizabad u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Inspector's report (September,2006) and decided to recommend to the Central Govt. not to issue Letter of Intent for starting of MS(ENT) & DLO courses granted by NTR University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 because of the following:-

1. Promotion of Prof. & H.O.D. is not as per MCI norms.
2. Resultantly, teaching complement is incomplete.
3. Other deficiencies as pointed out in the inspection report.

**94. Starting of MD(Pharmacology) course at Era's Lucknow Medical College & Hospital, Lucknow granted by Dr. Ram Manohar Lohia Avadh University, Faizabad u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.**

Read: The Council Inspector's report(September, 2006) on the physical and other teaching facilities available at Era's Lucknow Medical College & Hospital, Lucknow for consideration of starting of MD(Pharmacology) course granted by Dr. Ram Manohar Lohia Avadh University, Faizabad u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.
