Apology for absence was received from Dr. S.R.Maralihalli and the leave of absence was granted by the Committee.

1. Minutes of the last meeting of the Postgraduate Committee – confirmation of.

2. Minutes of the last meeting of the Postgraduate Committee – action taken thereon.

The Postgraduate Committee noted the action taken on the various items included in the minutes of the meeting of the Postgraduate Committee held on 18/10/2006.

3. Work output report of the requests received u/s 10A for the year 2006.

The Postgraduate Committee noted the work output report of the requests received u/s 10A of for the year 2005-2006 and 2006-2007.

4. Starting of DLO course at Santosh Medical College, Ghaziabad under Choudhary Charan Singh University, Meerut u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.

Read: The Council Inspector's report (October, 2006) on the physical and other teaching facilities available at Santosh Medical College, Ghaziabad under Choudhary Charan Singh University, Meerut for consideration of starting of D.L.O. course u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Inspector's report (October, 2006) and decided to recommend to the Central Govt. to issue Letter of Permission for starting of D.L.O. course at Santosh Medical College, Ghaziabad under Choudhary Charan Singh University, Meerut u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 prospectively i.e. from the academic session 2007-2008 restricting the number of admissions to 2 (two) students per year till the first batch admitted appears in the final examination of the said course. The institution be advised to apply for recognition of the qualification at the time of first available examination as per the provision of Section 11(2) of the IMC Act, 1956.

5. Starting of MD(OBG) & D.G.O. courses at Santosh Medical College, Ghaziabad under Ch.Charan Singh University u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.

Read: The compliance verification reports (Oct., 2006 & Feb., 2006) together with the compliance and Council Inspector's report (March, 2005) on the physical and other teaching facilities available at Santosh Medical College, Ghaziabad under Ch.Charan Singh University for consideration of starting of MD (OBG) & D.G.O. courses u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the compliance verification reports (Oct., 2006 & Feb., 2006) together with the compliance and Council Inspector's report (March, 2005) and decided to recommend to the Central Govt. to issue Letter of Permission for starting of MD (OBG) & D.G.O. courses at Santosh Medical College, Ghaziabad under Ch.Charan Singh University u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 prospectively i.e. from the academic session 2007-2008 restricting the number of admissions to 2 (two) students per year in each course till the first batch admitted appears in the final examination of the said course. The institution be advised to apply for recognition of the qualification at the time of first available examination as per the provision of Section 11(2) of the IMC Act, 1956.

6. Starting of MD(General Medicine) course at Era's Lucknow Medical College & Hospital, Lucknow under Dr. Ram Manohar Lohia Avadh University, Faizabad u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.

Read: The Council Inspector report (Oct., 2006) on the physical and other teaching facilities available at Era's Lucknow Medical College & Hospital, Lucknow under Dr. Ram Manohar Lohia Avadh University, Faizabad for consideration of starting of MD(General Medicine) course u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Inspector's report (Oct., 2006) and decided to recommend to the Central Govt. not to issue Letter of Intent for starting of MD(General Medicine) course granted by Dr. Ram Manohar Lohia Avadh University, Faizabad u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 because of the following:-

1. The Central Oxygen and suction are provided in the ICU and the casualty area only (and not in wards of Medicine) and even there the central suction was not in working order. Lot of equipment like monitors/infusion pumps bore no marks what-so-ever to identify/record/distinguish them, and had no stock register entries.
2. The TMT though installed for two years earlier had been put to function only on the day of inspection, with a patient tied up but having no hospital card or record or indication for testing. There were no records of any previous tests being done.
3. There are no refrigerators in casualty/Medical Ward.
4. The endoscopes (upper gastro-intestinal or bronchoscope) are carried out infrequently in the main surgical O.T. and there was no provision for marking a dedicated space in the Medicine Department.
5. The bio-medical waste disposal facilities were inadequate, with insufficient number of the colour-coded bins, non-availability in the areas of use, insufficient awareness or knowledge amongst the staff, and non-functionality & non-use of needle cutters as part of universal precautions.
6. The Central library has paucity of up-to-date books pertaining to Medicine, the existing ones being and old editions and inadequate. The 'newer' books are not catalogued with accession & catalogue numbers nor do they bear college stamp on the inside page(s). The same hold true for the foreign journals, with no college stamps or umbers.
7. OPD space is inadequate. There were no name plates indicative of doctors sitting in OPD rooms. There are no dedicated rooms for procedure or treatment. Teaching area in OPD are inadequate. Nursing staff is not posted in OPD.
8. Patients admitted to ICU on the day of inspection were not particularly sick for ICU care.

7. **Starting of MD(Dermatology, Venereology & Leprosy) course at Kilpauk Medical College, Kilpauk under the Tamilnadu Dr. MGR Medical University, Chennai u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.**

Read: The Council Inspector report (September, 2006) on the physical and other teaching facilities available at Kilpauk Medical College, Kilpauk under The Tamilnadu Dr. MGR Medical University, Chennai for consideration of starting of M.D.(Dermatology, Venereology & Leprosy) course u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Inspector's report (September,2006) and decided to recommend to the Central Govt. not to issue Letter of Intent for starting of M.D.(Dermatology, Venereology & Leprosy) course at Kilpauk Medical College, Kilpauk u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 because of the following:-

1. Bed strength is not as per MCI norms.
2. Promotion of Prof. & HOD is not as per MCI norms.
3. No Assoc. Prof. in Unit I is available.
4. All units have two faculty members.
5. Teaching complement is incomplete in all units.
6. Instrumentation is inadequate. PUVA chambers is not available.
7. Other deficiencies as pointed out in the inspection report.

At this point, Dr.Ved Prakash Mishra disassociated from the consideration of the next item i.e. number 8.

8. **Increase of seats in MS(Orthopaedics) course at J.L.N. Medical College, Swangi, Wardha under Datta Meghe Institute of Medical Sciences (Deemed University) u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.**

Read: The Council Inspector report (October, 2006) on the physical and other teaching facilities available at J.L.N. Medical College, Swangi, Wardha under Datta Meghe Institute of Medical Sciences (Deemed University) for consideration of increase of seats in MS(Orthopaedics) course u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Inspector's report (October, 2006) and decided to recommend to the Central Govt. to issue Letter of Permission for increase of seats in MS(Orthopaedics) course at J.L.N. Medical College, Swangi, Wardha under Datta Meghe Institute of Medical Sciences (Deemed University) u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 prospectively i.e.from the academic session 2007-2008 from 1(one) to 3 (three) students per year till the first batch admitted against the increased number appears in the final examination of the said course.

Dr. Ved Prakash Mishra rejoined the proceedings.

9. **Sri Venkateswara Institute of Medical Sciences,(Deemed University) Tirupati – Recognition of D.M.(Nephrology) qualification in respect of students being trained at Sri Venkateswara Institute of Medical Sciences,Tirupati.**

Read: The Council Inspector report (Aug., 2006) on the standard of examination and other teaching facilities available at Sri Venkateswara Institute of Medical Sciences, Tirupati for purpose of recognition of D.M.(Nephrology) qualification granted by Sri Venkateswara Institute of Medical Sciences,(Deemed University) Tirupati.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Inspector's report (Aug.,2006) and decided to recommend that D.M.(Nephrology) qualification granted by Sri Venkateswara Institute of Medical Sciences,(Deemed University) Tirupati be recognized and included in the 1st Schedule to the I.M.C. Act, 1956 restricting the number of admission to 1(one) student per year.

At this point, Dr.Ved Prakash Mishra disassociated from the consideration of the next item i.e. number 10.

10. Increase of seats in MD(Anaesthesia) course at J.L.N. Medical College, Swangi, Wardha under Datta Meghe Institute of Medical Sciences (Deemed University) u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.

Read: The Council Inspector report (Oct., 2006) on the physical and other teaching facilities available at J.L.N. Medical College, Swangi, Wardha under Datta Meghe Institute of Medical Sciences (Deemed University) for consideration of increase of seats in MD(Anaesthesia) course u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Inspector's report (Oct.,2006) and decided to recommend to the Central Govt. to issue Letter of Permission for increase of seats in MD(Anaesthesia) course at J.L.N. Medical College, Swangi, Wardha under Datta Meghe Institute of Medical Sciences (Deemed University) u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 prospectively i.e. from the academic session 2007-2008 from 2(two) to 4 (four) students per year till the first batch admitted against the increased number appears in the final examination of the said course.

11. Starting of MD(Psychiatry) course at Govt. Medical College, Bhavnagar under Bhavnagar University u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Inspector's report (Oct., 2006) and decided to recommend to the Central Govt. to issue Letter of Permission for starting of MD (Psychiatry) course at Govt. 12. Starting of MD(Paediatics) & D.C.H. courses at Era's Lucknow Medical College & Hospital, Lucknow granted by Dr. Ram Manohar Lohia Avadh University, Faizabad u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956..

Read: The Council Inspector report (Oct., 2006) on the physical and other teaching facilities available at Era's Lucknow Medical College & Hospital, Lucknow under Dr. Ram Manohar Lohia Avadh University, Faizabad for starting of MD(Paediatics) & DCH courses u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Inspector's report (Oct.,2006) and decided to recommend to the Central Govt. not to issue Letter of Intent for starting of MD (Paediatics) & DCH courses at Era's Lucknow Medical College & Hospital, under Dr. Ram Manohar Lohia Avadh University, Faizabad u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 because of the following:-

1. Teaching facilities are inadequate.
2. Bio-medical wastes disposal needs improvement.
3. There is no proper arrangement for neonatal resuscitation.
4. There is no facility for lying in ward for newborn babies.
5. Other deficiencies as pointed out in the inspection report.

13. Increase of seats in MD(Paediatics) course at D.Y. Patil Medical College, Kolhapur (Deemed University) u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.

Read: The Council Inspector report (Oct., 2006) on the physical and other teaching facilities available at D.Y. Patil Medical College, Kolhapur (Deemed University) for consideration of increase of seats in MD(Paediatics) course u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Inspector's report (Oct.,2006) and decided to recommend to the Central Govt. not to issue Letter of Intent for increase of seats in MD (Paediatrics) course at D.Y. Patil Medical College, Kolhapur (Deemed University) u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 because of the following:-

1. Instrumentation is inadequate.
2. Training tools are also inadequate. Cardiocograph for Foetal maintaining is not available in the labour room. Facilities for neonatal resuscitation are inadequate.
3. Clinical material as reported by the Inspector is inadequate.
4. Other deficiencies as pointed out in the inspection report.

14. The Tamilnadu Dr. M.G.R. Medical University, Chennai – Recognition of M.Ch.(Cardio-Thoracic-Surgery) qualification in respect of students being trained at Madurai Medical College, Madurai.

Read: The Council Inspector report (August, 2006) on the standard of examination and other teaching facilities available at Madurai Medical College, Madurai for purpose of recognition of M.Ch.(Cardio-Thoracic-Surgery) qualification granted by the Tamilnadu Dr. M.G.R. Medical University, Chennai.

15. Starting of MD(Psychiatry) course at D.Y. Patil Medical College, Kolhapur (Deemed University) u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Inspector's report (Oct.,2006) and decided to recommend to the Central Govt. not to issue Letter of Intent for starting of D.M(Medical Oncology) course at Madurai Medical College, Madurai under The Tamilnadu Dr. MGR Medical University, Chennai u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 because of the following:-

1. Instrumentation is inadequate.
2. No separate leukemias and Neutropenias ward for adult.
3. Bone Marrow transplant facilities are not available.
4. Pathology Deptt. has no facilities for Tumor marker study.
5. No Nuclear Medicine Deptt. in the Institute.
6. Linear accelerator is not available..

17. Starting of DM(Neonatology) course at Madurai Medical College, Madurai under The Tamilnadu Dr. MGR Medical University, Chennai u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.

Read: The Council Inspector report (Oct., 2006) on the physical and other teaching facilities available at Madurai Medical College, Madurai for consideration of DM(Neonatology) course granted by The Tamilnadu Dr. MGR Medical University, Chennai u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Inspector's report (Oct.,2006) and decided to recommend to the Central Govt. not to issue Letter of Intent for starting of DM(Neonatology) course at Madurai Medical College, Madurai under The Tamilnadu Dr. MGR Medical University, Chennai u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 because of the following:-

1. NICU needs upgradation and so also Neonatal Resuscitation areas.
2. Faculty does not possess requisite super-speciality/PG qualification.
3. Other deficiencies as pointed out in the inspection report.

18. Starting of MD(Psychiatry) & D.P.M. course at J.L.N. Medical College, Swangi, Wardha under Datta Meghe Institute of Medical Sciences (Deemed University) u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.

Read: The Council Inspector report (September, 2006) on the physical and other teaching facilities available at J.L.N. Medical College, Swangi, Wardha under Datta Meghe Institute of Medical Sciences (Deemed University) for consideration of starting of M.D.(Psychiatry) & D.P.M. courses u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.

22. Increase of seats in M.Ch.(Paediatrics Surgery) course at Madurai Medical College, Madurai granted by The Tamilnadu Dr. MGR Medical University, Chennai u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.

Read: The Council Inspector report (Oct., 2006) on the physical and other teaching facilities available at Madurai Medical College, Madurai under The Tamilnadu Dr. MGR Medical University, Chennai for consideration of increase of seats in M.Ch.(Paediatrics Surgery) course u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.

1. Histopathology and cytology specimens are very less.
2. There is lack of specialized investigation in Hematology, Cytology and Histopathology.
3. Workload in Oncopathology, Neuropathology and Dermatopathology is grossly inadequate.
4. Other deficiencies as pointed out in the inspection report.

24. Starting of MS(General Surgery) course at Era's Lucknow Medical College & Hospital, Lucknow under Dr. Ram Manohar Lohia Avadh University, Faizabad u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.

Read: The Council Inspector report (Oct., 2006) on the physical and other teaching facilities available at Era's Lucknow Medical College & Hospital, Lucknow under Dr. Ram Manohar Lohia Avadh University for consideration of starting of MS(General Surgery) course u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Inspector's report (October,2006) and decided to recommend to the Central Govt. not to issue Letter of Intent for starting of MS(General Surgery) course at Era's Lucknow Medical College & Hospital, Lucknow under Dr. Ram Manohar Lohia Avadh University u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 because of the following:-

1. Clinical material is inadequate. OPD attendance is only 50-80/day.
2. Other deficiencies as pointed out in the inspection report.

25. Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences, Bangalore – Approval of J.J.M. Medical College, Davangere for the award of M.S. (Ophthalmology) qualification in respect of increased intake.

Read: The Council Inspector report (May, 2006) on the standard of examination and other teaching facilities available at J.J.M. Medical College, Davangere for purpose of approval of the college for the award of M.S. (Ophthalmology) qualification granted by Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences, Bangalore against the increased intake.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Inspector's report (May,2006) and decided not to approve J.J.M. Medical College, Davangere for the award of M.S. (Ophthalmology) qualification granted by Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences, Bangalore against the increased intake because –

1. Instrumentation is inadequate.
2. Unit-wise bed distribution is not as per MCI norms.
3. Ward facilities are inadequate.
4. Special clinics are inadequate. Phacoemulsification & LASER are not available.

50. Mangalore University & Manipal Academy of Higher Education (Deemed University), Manipal – Recognition of D.M.(Neurology) qualification in respect of students being trained at Kasturba Medical College, Manipal.

Read: The legal opinion obtained from Advocate, J.S. Bhasin, Retainer of Council together with the Council Inspector report (July, 2003) on the standard of examination and other teaching facilities available at Kasturba Medical College, Manipal for purpose of recognition of D.M.(Neurology) qualification earlier granted by Mangalore University and now by Manipal Academy of Higher Education (Deemed University), Manipal.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Inspector's report (July, 2003) and decided to carry out fresh inspection of the institution for evaluation of physical facilities thereat.

51. Homi Bhabha National Institute (Deemed University), Mumbai – Recognition of DRM qualification in respect of student being trained at Tata Memorial Center, Mumbai.

Read: The letter dated 9/11/2006 received from the Dean, Homi Bhabha National Institute, Mumbai for recognition of DRM qualification under Homi Bhabha National Institute (Deemed University), Mumbai being a change of affiliating university i.e. Mumbai University.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the letter dated 09.11.2006 and noted that DRM qualification already stands recognized under Mumbai University and included in the 1st Schedule to the I.M.C. Act,1956 and now the matter is under consideration for recognition of the said qualification under Homi Bhabha National Institute (Deemed University) being the change of name of University; decided to recommend that DRM qualification granted by Homi Bhabha National Institute (Deemed University) in respect of students being trained at Tata Memorial Centre, Mumbai be recognized and included in the 1st Schedule to the I.M.C. Act,1956.

52. Gujarat University - Recognition of D.M.(Nephrology) qualification in respect of students being trained at Institute of Kidney Diseases and Research Center attached with B.J. Medical College, Ahmedabad.

Read: The Council Inspector's report (October, 2006) on the standard of examination and other teaching facilities available at Institute of Kidney Diseases and Research Center attached with B.J. Medical College, Ahmedabad for purpose of recognition of D.M.(Nephrology) qualification granted by Gujarat University.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Inspector's report (October, 2006) and decided to advise the college authorities to reorganize the units in the Deptt. of Nephrology in terms of teaching faculty and bed strength as per MCI norms.

The Committee further decided to defer the consideration of the matter till the compliance is received.

53. Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences, Bangalore – Approval of Sri Devraj Urs Medical College, Tamaka, Kolar for the award of M.S.(Orthopaedics) qualification in respect of increased intake.

Read: The Council Inspector's report (October, 2006) on the standard of examination and other teaching facilities available at Sri Devraj Urs Medical College, Tamaka, Kolar for purpose of approval of the college for the award of M.S.(Orthopaedics) qualifications granted by Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences, Bangalore for increased intake.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Inspector's report (October,2006) and decided not to recommend approval of Sri Devraj Urs Medical College, Tamaka, Kolar for the award of M.S.(Orthopaedics) qualification granted by Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences, Bangalore against the increased intake because of the following:-

1. There is no Associate Professor in Unit-I.
2. Promotion of Associate Professor in Unit-II is not as per MCI norms.
3. Assistant Professor in Unit-II does not possess requisite postgraduate medical qualification.
4. Resultantly teaching complement is incomplete in both the Units.
5. Clinical material is inadequate.
6. Other deficiencies as pointed out in the inspection report.

In view of above, the Committee further decided to direct the institution authorities to henceforth stop admissions in M.S.(Orthopaedic) course from the ensuing academic session.

54. Punjab University – Recognition of MD (PSM/Community Medicine) qualification in respect of Govt. Medical College, Chandigarh.

Read: The Council Inspector's report (October, 2006) on the standard of examination and other teaching facilities available at Govt. Medical College, Chandigarh for purpose of recognition of M.D.(PSM/Community Medicine) qualification granted by Punjab University.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Inspector's report (October, 2006) and decided not to recommend recognition of M.D.(PSM/Community Medicine) qualification granted by Punjab University in respect of students being trained at Govt. Medical College, Chandigarh because of the following:-

1. One Associate Professor is on deputation to WHO and is not available.
2. Additional teaching complement for postgraduate is not available.
3. Indoor facilities at RHTC are not available.
4. Other deficiencies as pointed out in the inspection report.

In view of above, the Committee further decided to direct the institution authorities to henceforth stop admissions in M.D.(PSM/Community Medicine) course from the ensuing academic session.

55. Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences, Bangalore – Approval of MS(Orthopaedics) qualification in respect of students being trained at Sree Siddhartha Medical College, Tumkur.

Read: The compliance together with the Council Inspector's report (November, 2004) on the standard of examination and other teaching facilities available at Sree Sidhartha Medical College, Tumkur for purpose of approval of the college for the award of MS (Orthopaedics) qualification granted by Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences, Bangalore.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the compliance together with Council Inspector's report (November,2004) and decided not to recommend approval of Sree Sidhartha Medical College, Tumkur for the award of M.S.(Orthopaedics) qualification granted by Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences, Bangalore because of the following:-

1. Promotion of Professor & HOD is not as per MCI norms.
2. There is no Associate Professor in Unit-I.
3. Resultantly, teaching complement is incomplete.
4. Other deficiencies as pointed out in the inspection report.

In view of above, the Committee further decided to direct the institution authorities to henceforth stop admissions in M.S.(Orthopaedic) course from the ensuing academic session.

56. Calcutta University – Approval of Vivekanand Institute of Medical Sciences, Calcutta for the award of M.S (General Surgery) qualification.

Read: The compliance together with the Council Inspector's report (April, 2006) on the standard of examination and other teaching facilities available at Vivekanand Institute of Medical Sciences, Calcutta for purpose of approval of the college for the award of M.S.(General Surgery) qualification granted by Calcutta University.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the compliance together with the Council Inspector's report (April,2006) and decided to recommend that Vivekanand Institute of Medical Sciences, Calcutta be approved for the award of M.S.(General Surgery) qualification granted by Calcutta University restricting the number of admission to 1 (one) student per year.

57. Madras University – Approval of dr. A.L.M. PG Institute of Basic Medical Sciences, Taramani, Chennai for the award of MD (Pathology) & DCP qualifications.

Read: The letter dated 13/6/2006 from the Director of the Institute together with the Council Inspector's report (March, 2000) on the standard of examination and other teaching facilities available at Postgraduate Institute of Medical Sciences, Taramani, Chennai for approval of MD(Pathology) & DCP qualifications granted by Madras University.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the letter dated 13/6/2006 from the Director of the Institute together with the Council Inspector's report (March, 2000) and decided to carry out a fresh inspection.

58. Himachal Pradesh University – Recognition of D.Ortho. qualification in respect of students being trained at Indira Gandhi Medical College, Shimla.

Read: The compliance verification report (October, 2006) together with the Council Inspector's report (July, 2004) on the standard of examination and other teaching facilities available at Indira Gandhi Medical College, Shimla for purpose of recognition of D.Ortho. qualification granted by Himachal Pradesh University.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the compliance verification inspection report (October,2006) together with the Council Inspector's report (July,2004) and decided to reiterate its earlier decision taken at its meeting held on 04.08.2004 recommending not to recognize D.Ortho. qualification granted by Himachal Pradesh University in respect of students being trained at Indira Gandhi Medical College, Shimla because the following deficiencies are still persisting:-

1. Promotion of Professor & HOD is not as per MCI norms.
2. No Associate Professor in Unit-I.
3. Promotion of Incharge Unit-II is not as per MCI norms.
4. Resultantly teaching complement is incomplete in both the units in terms of faculty.
5. Other deficiencies/observations as pointed out in the inspection report.

In view of above, the Committee further decided to direct the institution authorities to henceforth stop admissions in D.Ortho. course from the ensuing academic session.

59. Marathwada University/Dr.Babasaheb Ambedkar Marathwada University – Approval of S.R.T.R. Medical College, Ambajogai for the award of M.S.(Ophthalmology) & D.O./D.O.M.S. qualifications.

Read: The compliance together with the Council Inspector's report (September, 2003) on the standard of examination and other teaching facilities available at S.R.T.R. Medical College, Ambajogai for purpose of approval of the college for the award of M.S.(Ophthalmology) & D.O./D.O.M.S. qualifications earlier granted by Marathwada University and now by Dr.Babasaheb Ambedkar Marathwada University.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the compliance together with the Council Inspector's report (September,2003) and decided to verify the compliance by way of an inspection.

60. Starting of MD(Anaesthesia) & D.A. courses at Era's Lucknow Medical College & Hospital, Lucknow under Dr. Ram Manohar Lohia Avadh University, Faizabad u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.

Read: The Council Inspector's report (Oct., 2006) on the physical and other teaching facilities available at Era's Lucknow Medical College & Hospital, Lucknow under Dr. Ram Manohar Lohia Avadh University, Faizabad for consideration of starting of MD(Anaesthesia) & D.A. courses u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Inspector's report (October,2006) and decided to recommend to the Central Govt. not to issue Letter of Intent for starting of MD(Anaesthesia) & D.A. courses at Era's Lucknow Medical College & Hospital, Lucknow under Dr. Ram Manohar Lohia Avadh University, Faizabad u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 because of the following:-

1. Facilities for Cardiac Anaesthesia training are not available.
2. Other deficiencies as pointed out in the inspection report.

61. Starting of P.G. courses at K.S. Hegde Medical Academy, Mangalore – Permission of Central Govt. – Regarding.

9. Infrastructure facilities are inadequate.
10. Other deficiencies as pointed out in the inspection report.

2. Laboratory facilities are not adequate.
3. Departmental library facilities are inadequate.
4. Other deficiencies as pointed out in the inspection report.

The Postgraduate Committee further decided to direct the college authorities to henceforth stop admissions in M.S.(Orthopaedics) & D.Ortho. courses from the ensuing academic session.

132. Starting of MS(General Surgery) course at KAP Vishwanathan Medical College, Trichy under The Tamilnadu Dr. MGR Medical University, Chennai u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.
