**5. Dr. NTR University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada - Recognition of DGO qualification in respect of students being trained at Narayana Medical College, Nellore.**

Read: The Council inspector report (July, 2008) on the standard of examination and other teaching facilities available at Narayana Medical College, Nellore for purpose of recognition of DGO qualification granted by Dr. NTR University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council inspector report (July, 2008) and decided to recommend that DGO qualification granted by Dr. NTR University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada in respect of students being trained at Narayana Medical College, Nellore be recognized and included in the 1<sup>st</sup> Schedule to the I.M.C. Act,1956 restricting the number of admissions to 3 (three) students per year.

**6. Dr. NTR University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada - Recognition of DO qualification in respect of students being trained at Narayana Medical College, Nellore.**

Read: The Council inspector report (July, 2008) on the standard of examination and other teaching facilities available at Narayana Medical College, Nellore for purpose of recognition of DO qualification granted by Dr. NTR University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Inspector's Report (July, 2008) and decided not to recognise DO qualification granted by Dr. NTR University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada in respect of students being trained at Narayana Medical College, Nellore because of the following:-

1. Dr. G. Chandra Sekhar, Assoc.Prof. and Dr. O. Gopala Krishna, Asstt.Prof. of Unit-I are not having recognized postgraduate qualifications.
2. Dr. G. Kiran Kumar, Asstt.Prof. of Unit II is not having recognized postgraduate qualification.
3. Promotion of Dr. T. Ajay Chakravarthi, Assoc.Prof. of Unit II is not as per MCI norms.
4. Resultantly, teaching complement of Unit II is incomplete.

5. Keratoplasty facilities are not available.
6. Other deficiencies as pointed out in the inspection report.

In view of above, the Committee further decided to direct the institution authorities to henceforth stop admissions in DO course from the academic session 2009-2010.

7. **Dr. NTR University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada - Recognition of DCH qualification in respect of students being trained at Narayana Medical College, Nellore.**

Read: The Council inspector report (July, 2008) on the standard of examination and other teaching facilities available at Narayana Medical College, Nellore for purpose of recognition of DCH qualification granted by Dr. NTR University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council inspector report (July, 2008) and decided to recommend that DCH qualification granted by Dr. NTR University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada in respect of students being trained at Narayana Medical College, Nellore be recognized and included in the 1<sup>st</sup> Schedule to the I.M.C. Act,1956 restricting the number of admissions to 2 (two) students per year.

8. **Dr. NTR University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada - Recognition of DMRD qualification in respect of students being trained at Narayana Medical College, Nellore.**

Read: The Council inspector report (July, 2008) on the standard of examination and other teaching facilities available at Narayana Medical College, Nellore for purpose of recognition of DMRD qualification granted by Dr. NTR University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council inspector report (July, 2008) and decided to recommend that DMRD qualification granted by Dr. NTR University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada in respect of students being trained at Narayana Medical College, Nellore be recognized and included in the 1<sup>st</sup> Schedule to the I.M.C. Act,1956 restricting the number of admissions to 2 (two) students per year.

9. **Dr. NTR University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada - Recognition of D.Ortho. qualification in respect of students being trained at Narayana Medical College, Nellore.**

Read: The Council inspector report (July, 2008) on the standard of examination and other teaching facilities available at Narayana Medical College, Nellore for purpose of recognition of D.Ortho. qualification granted by Dr. NTR University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Inspector's Report (July, 2008) and noted that Dr. M. Kiran Kumar Asstt. Prof. of Unit-III is not having recognized postgraduate qualification; however, even without him the teaching complement is complete and decided to recommend that D.Ortho. qualification granted by Dr. NTR University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada in respect of students being trained at Narayana Medical College, Nellore be recognized and included in the 1<sup>st</sup> Schedule to the I.M.C. Act,1956 restricting the number of admission to 1 (One) student per year.

10. **Dr. NTR University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada - Recognition of DA qualification in respect of students being trained at Narayana Medical College, Nellore.**

Read: The Council inspector report (July, 2008) on the standard of examination and other teaching facilities available at Narayana Medical College, Nellore for purpose of recognition of DA qualification granted by Dr. NTR University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council inspector report (July, 2008) and decided to recommend that DA qualification granted by Dr. NTR University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada in respect of students being trained at Narayana Medical College, Nellore be recognized and included in the 1<sup>st</sup> Schedule to the I.M.C. Act,1956 restricting the number of admissions to 2 (two) students per year.

11. **Kakatiya University, Osmania University & Dr. NTR University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada- Recognition of MD (Dermatology, Vene. & Leprosy/ Dermatology) qualification in respect of students being trained at Kakatiya Medical College, Warangal.**

Read: The Council inspector report (July, 2008) on the standard of examination and other teaching facilities available at Kakatiya Medical College, Warangal for purpose of recognition of MD (Dermatology, Vene. & Leprosy/ Dermatology) qualification earlier granted by Kakatiya University, Osmania University and now by Dr. NTR University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Inspector's Report (July, 2008) and noted that Dr. G. Venkataramana, Assoc. Prof. is not having recognized postgraduate qualification; however, even without him the teaching complement is complete and decided to recommend that MD (Dermatology, Vene. & Leprosy/ Dermatology) qualification earlier granted by Kakatiya University, Osmania University and now by Dr. NTR University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada in respect of students being trained at Kakatiya Medical College, Warangal be recognized and included in the 1<sup>st</sup> Schedule to the I.M.C. Act,1956 restricting the number of admission to 1 (One) student per year.

12. **Kakatiya University, Osmania University & Dr. NTR University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada- Recognition of MD (Paediatrics) qualification in respect of students being trained at Kakatiya Medical College, Warangal.**

Read: The Council inspector report (July, 2008) on the standard of examination and other teaching facilities available at Kakatiya Medical College, Warangal for purpose of recognition of MD (Paediatrics) qualification earlier granted by Kakatiya University, Osmania University and now by Dr. NTR University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Inspector's Report (July, 2008) and noted that Dr. Ch. Ravi Kumar, Prof. does not possess recognized postgraduate qualification; however, even without him the teaching complement is complete and decided to recommend that MD (Paediatrics) qualification earlier granted by Kakatiya University, Osmania University & now by Dr. NTR University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada in respect of students being trained at Kakatiya Medical College, Warangal be recognized and included in the 1<sup>st</sup> Schedule to the I.M.C. Act,1956 restricting the number of admission to 2 (Two) students per year.

**13. Sardar Patel University - Recognition of D.Ortho. qualification in respect of students being trained at Pramukhswami Medical College, Karamsad.**

Read: The compliance verification report (July, 2008) togetherwith the Council Inspector's report (March, 2004) and previous inspection report (April, 2003) carried out for recognition of D.Ortho. qualification in respect of students being trained at Pramukhswami Medical College, Karamsad under Sardar Patel University.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the compliance verification report (July, 2008) togetherwith the Council Inspector's report (March, 2004) and previous inspection report (April, 2003) and decided to recommend that D.Ortho. qualification granted by Sardar Patel University in respect of students being trained at Pramukhswami Medical College, Karamsad be recognized and included in the 1<sup>st</sup> Schedule to the I.M.C. Act,1956 restricting the number of admissions to 2 (two) students per year.

**14. Sardar Patel University - Recognition of MD(Radio Diagnosis) qualification in respect of students being trained at Pramukhswami Medical College, Karamsad.**

Read: The compliance verification report (May, 2008) togetherwith the Council Inspector's report (December,2004) of standard of examination and other teaching facilities available at Pramukhswami Medical College, Karamsad for purposes of recognition of MD(Radio-Diagnosis) qualification granted by Saurashtra University.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the compliance verification report (May, 2008) togetherwith the Council Inspector's report (December,2004) and decided not to recognise MD(Radio-Diagnosis) qualification granted by Saurashtra University in respect of students being trained at Pramukhswami Medical College, Karamsad because of the following:-

1. Dr. Usha Maheshwari, Assoc.Prof. is not having recognized postgraduate qualification.
2. Dr. Jayesh Bhatt, Assoc.Prof. was not physically present on the day of inspection.
3. Dr. Deepak Mehta, Asstt.Prof. is not having prescribed postgraduate qualification.
4. Resultantly, teaching faculty is inadequate for postgraduate teaching by 1 Assoc.Prof. and 2 Tutors.
5. Other deficiencies as pointed out in the inspection report.

In view of above, the Committee further decided to direct the institution authorities to henceforth stop admissions in MD(Radio-Diagnosis) course from the academic session 2009-2010.

**15. Dr. NTR University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada - Recognition of DA qualification in respect of students being trained at SVS Medical College, Mahabubnagar.**

Read: The Council inspector report (July, 2008) on the standard of examination and other teaching facilities available at SVS Medical College, Mahabubnagar for purpose of recognition of DA qualification granted by Dr. NTR University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council inspector report (July, 2008) and decided to recommend that DA qualification granted by Dr. NTR University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada in respect of students being trained at SVS Medical College, Mahabubnagar be recognized and included in the 1<sup>st</sup> Schedule to the I.M.C. Act,1956 restricting the number of admissions to 2 (two) students per year.



**16. SRT Marathwada University - Recognition of MS (General Surgery) qualification in respect of students being trained at Government Medical College, Nanded.**

Read :The Council inspector report (July, 2008) on the standard of examination and other teaching facilities available at Government Medical College, Nanded for purpose of recognition of MS (General Surgery) qualification granted by SRT Marathwada University.

Read: The Council inspector report (July/August, 2008) on the standard of examination and other teaching facilities available at SRTR Medical College, Ambajogai for purpose of recognition of MD (Biochemistry) qualification granted by Dr. Baba Saheb Ambedkar Marathwada University & Maharashtra University of Health Sciences, Nashik.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council inspector report (July/August, 2008) and decided to recommend that MD (Biochemistry) qualification granted by Dr. Baba Saheb Ambedkar Marathwada University & Maharashtra University of Health Sciences, Nashik in respect of students being trained at SRTR Medical College, Ambajogai be recognized and included in the 1<sup>st</sup> Schedule to the I.M.C. Act,1956 restricting the number of admissions to 2 (Two) students per year.

**106. University of Calicut - Recognition of M.Ch. (Neuro-Surgery) qualification in respect of students being trained at Calicut Medical College, Calicut.**

Read: the compliance togetherwith the compliance verification report (July, 2008) and the Council Inspector report (April, 2004) on the standard of examination and other teaching facilities available at Calicut Medical College, Calicut for purpose of recognition of M.Ch.(Neuro-Surgery) qualification granted by University of Calicut.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the compliance togetherwith the compliance verification report (July, 2008) and the Council Inspector report (April, 2004) and decided not to recognise M.Ch.(Neuro-Surgery) qualification granted by University of Calicut in respect of students being trained at Calicut Medical College, Calicut because of the following:-

1. Promotion of Prof. & HOD is not as per MCI norms.
2. Other deficiencies as pointed out in the inspection report.

In view of above, the Committee further decided to direct the institution authorities to henceforth stop admission in M.Ch. (Neuro-Surgery) course from the academic session 2009-2010.

**107. Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences, Bangalore - Approval of Al-Ameen Medical College, Bijapur for the award of M.S.(General Surgery) qualification.**

Read: the compliance togetherwith the compliance verification report and the inspection report (October, 2006) of the standard of examination and other teaching facilities available at Al-Ameen Medical College, Bijapur for purpose of approval of the college for the award of M.S. (General Surgery) qualification granted by Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences, Bangalore.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the compliance togetherwith the compliance verification report and the inspection report (October, 2006) and decided not to approve Al-Ameen Medical College, Bijapur for the award of M.S. (General Surgery) qualification granted by Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences, Bangalore because of the following:-

1. Clinical material is inadequate.
2. Surgical workload is inadequate.
3. Indoor surgical ward has inadequate space.
4. ICU is not properly maintained.
5. Nursing staff is inadequate.
6. Other deficiencies/Observations as pointed out in the inspection report.

In view of above, the Committee further decided to direct the institution authorities to henceforth stop admissions in MS (General Surgery) course from the academic session 2009-2010.

**108. Inclusion of the name of KLE University (Deemed University) for the award of various postgraduate qualifications in respect of students being trained at J.L.N. Medical College, Belgaum in the first schedule of the IMC Act, 1956.**

Read: The letter dated 27.02.2008 from the Registrar, KLE University (Deemed University) with copy of notification dated 13.06.2006 issued by HRD Ministry stating that JLN Medical College, Belgaum was earlier affiliated to Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences, Bangalore after the KLE University came into existence, the J.N. Medical College, Belgaum became the constituent college of the KLE University. The KLE University is admitting students for PG Degree and PG Diploma Courses from the academic year 2006-07.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the letter dated 27.02.2008 received from the Registrar, KLE University for inclusion of the name of KLE University (Deemed University) for the award of MBBS and various postgraduate qualifications in respect of students being trained at J.L.N. Medical College, Belgaum in the first schedule of the IMC Act, 1956 and observed that the Executive Committee at its meeting held in June, 1988 had decided as under:-

*"No inspection is required where there is change of name and change of affiliation of the University or the college whose medical qualifications are already recognized and included in the 1<sup>st</sup> Schedule to the I.M.C. Act,1956 unless the Executive Committee decides otherwise."*

The Postgraduate Committee observed that KLE University is admitting the students for Undergraduate, Postgraduate Degree and Postgraduate Diploma courses from the academic year 2006-07 onwards. Under these circumstances, the first batch appearing for the final examination would be during the year 2010-11, 2009-10 and 2008-09 respectively for Undergraduate, Postgraduate Degree and Postgraduate Diploma courses.

In view of above, the Postgraduate Committee decided that the KLE University be recognized and included in the Ist Schedule to the Indian Medical Council Act,1956 and forwarded to the Govt. of India for appropriate Notification of the same.

**109. Inclusion of various postgraduate qualifications under Padmashree Dr. D.Y. Patil University, Navi Mumbai in the schedule to the I.M.C. Act, 1956-regarding.**

Read: The letter dated 29.11.2006 from the Registrar, Padmashree Dr. D.Y. Patil University informed that in pursuance of U.G.C. Notification No. F/9.21/2003-U-3 dated 20/06/2006, the name of the University "Padmashree Dr.D.Y. Patil Vidyapeeth (Deemed University)" has been changed with immediate effect.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the letter dated 29.11.2006 from the Registrar, Padmashree Dr. D.Y. Patil University for inclusion of various postgraduate qualifications under Padmashree Dr. D.Y. Patil University, Navi Mumbai in the schedule to the I.M.C. Act, 1956 and observed that the Executive Committee at its meeting held in June, 1988 had decided as under:-

*"No inspection is required where there is change of name and change of affiliation of the University or the college whose medical qualifications are already recognized and included in the 1<sup>st</sup> Schedule to the I.M.C. Act,1956 unless the Executive Committee decides otherwise."*

In view of above, the Postgraduate Committee decided that the name of the University "Padmashree Dr. D.Y. Patil Vidyapeeth" be recognized and included in the

Ist Schedule to the Indian Medical Council Act,1956 and forwarded to the Govt. of India for appropriate Notification of the same.

**110. Inclusion of Rajasthan University of Health Sciences, Jaipur in the Schedule to the IMC Act, 1956 - recognition of Medical Qualifications (PG - regarding).**

Read: The Central Govt. letter dated 06.11.2007 along with a copy of letter dated 06.09.2006 received from the Registrar, University of Health Sciences, Jaipur informed that University has been established by Act. No. 1 of 2005 of the State Government and included in the list of Universities maintained by the University Grants Commission u/s 2F of the UCG Act, 1956.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the letter dated 6.11.2007 received from the Central Government, Ministry of Health & F.W., New Delhi for inclusion of Rajasthan University of Health Sciences, Jaipur in the Schedule to the IMC Act, 1956 and observed that the Executive Committee at its meeting held in June, 1988 had decided as under:-

*"No inspection is required where there is change of name and change of affiliation of the University or the college whose medical qualifications are already recognized and included in the 1<sup>st</sup> Schedule to the I.M.C. Act,1956 unless the Executive Committee decides otherwise."*

In view of above, the Postgraduate Committee decided that the name of the University "Rajasthan University of Health Sciences, Jaipur" be recognized and included in the Ist Schedule to the Indian Medical Council Act,1956 and forwarded to the Govt. of India for appropriate Notification of the same.

**111. Renaming the King George's Medical University, Lucnow as "Chhatrapati Shahuji Maharaj Medical University, U.P, Lucknow" through the King George's Medical University "Amendment Ordinance, 2007 (U.P. Ordinance No. 3 of 2007) vide Gazett Notification No. 789/LXXIV-V-1-2 (KA)-3-2007 dated June 02, 2007.**

Read: The letter dated 25.07.2007 from the Vice-Chancellor, Dr. Hari Gautam, regarding renaming the King George's Medical University, Lucnow as "Chhatrapati Shahuji Maharaj Medical University, U.P, Lucknow."

The Postgraduate Committee considered the letter dated 25.07.2007 received from the Vice-Chancellor, Dr. Hari Gautam regarding renaming the King George's Medical University, Lucnow as "Chhatrapati Shahuji Maharaj Medical University, U.P, Lucknow and observed that the General Body of the Council at its meeting held on 18.2.2006 had approved the following decision of the Executive Committee meeting held on 14<sup>th</sup> and 15<sup>th</sup> June, 2005 as under:-

*"The members of the Adhoc Committee appointed by the Hon'ble Supreme Court and of the Executive Committee of the Council considered the Central Govt.'s letter dated 18<sup>th</sup> May,2005 forwarding the request of Registrar, King George's Medical University, Lucknow u/s 11(2) of the I.M.C. Act,1956 for recognition of MBBS and Postgraduate courses under King George's Medical University, Lucknow being change of name of University from Chhatrapati Shahuji Maharaj Medical University, Lucknow.*

*The members of the Adhoc Committee appointed by the Hon'ble Supreme Court and of the Executive Committee of the Council in view of the decision taken by the Executive Committee at its meeting held in June,1988 viz "No inspection is required where there is change of name and change of affiliation of the University or the college whose medical qualifications are already recognised and included in the 1<sup>st</sup> Schedule to the I.M.C.*

*Act,1956 unless the Executive Committee decides otherwise" decided to recommend that M.B.B.S. and following postgraduate courses be recognised and included in the first schedule to the I.M.C. The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council inspector report (June, 2008) and decided to recommend that MD (SPM/Community Medicine) qualification granted by Bombay University/Mumbai University in respect of students being trained at Grant Medical College, Mumbai be recognized and included in the 1<sup>st</sup> Schedule to the I.M.C. Act, 1956 restricting the number of admissions to 2 (two) student per year.

The Committee further decided to recommend that DPH qualification granted by Maharashtra University of Health Sciences, Nashik in respect of students being trained at Grant Medical College, Mumbai be recognized and included in the 1<sup>st</sup> schedule to the I.M.C. Act, 1956 restricting the number of admission to 4 (four) student per year.

**113. Dr. NTR University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada - Approval of Osmania Medical College, Hyderabad for the award of MD (Forensic Medicine) qualification in respect of increased intake.**

Read: The Council inspector report (July, 2008) on the standard of examination and other teaching facilities available at Osmania Medical College, Hyderabad for purpose of approval of the college for the award of MD (Forensic Medicine) qualification granted by Dr. NTR University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada in respect of increased intake.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Inspector's Report (July, 2008) and noted that Osmania Medical College, Hyderabad already stands approved for the award of MD (Forensic Medicine) qualification with 2 (two) seats and now the matter is under consideration for approval of the college against the increased intake; decided to recommend that Osmania Medical College, Hyderabad be approved for the award of MD (Forensic Medicine) qualification granted by Dr. NTR University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada in respect of increased intake in respect of increased intake restricting the number of admissions to 2 (two) to 5 (Five) students per year.

**114. Dr. NTR University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada - Approval of Osmania Medical College, Hyderabad for the award of MD (General Medicine) qualification in respect of increased intake.**

Read: the Council inspector report (July, 2008) on the standard of examination and other teaching facilities available at Osmania Medical College, Hyderabad for purpose of approval of the college for the award of MD (General Medicine) qualification granted by Dr. NTR University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada in respect of increased intake.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Inspector's Report (July, 2008) and decided to recommend that Osmania Medical College, Hyderabad be approved for the award of MD (General Medicine) qualification granted by Dr. NTR University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada in respect of increased intake restricting the number of admissions to 7 (seven) to 9 (nine) students per year.

**115. Dr. NTR University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada - Recognition of MD (Anaesthesia) qualification in respect of students being trained at Siddhartha Medical College, Vijayawada.**

Read: The Council inspector report (July, 2008) on the standard of examination and other teaching facilities available at Siddhartha Medical College, Vijayawada for purpose of recognition of MD (Anaesthesia) qualification granted by Dr. NTR University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council inspector report (July, 2008) and decided to recommend that MD (Anaesthesia) qualification granted by Dr. NTR University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada in respect of students being trained at Siddhartha Medical College, Vijayawada be recognized and included in the 1<sup>st</sup> Schedule to the I.M.C. Act, 1956 restricting the number of admissions to 2 (two) students per year.

**116. Dr. NTR University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada - Recognition of MD (DVL) qualification in respect of students being trained at Siddhartha Medical College, Vijayawada.**

Read: the Council inspector report (July, 2008) on the standard of examination and other teaching facilities available at Siddhartha Medical College, Vijayawada for purpose of recognition of MD (DVL) qualification granted by Dr. NTR University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council inspector report (July, 2008) and decided not to recognise MD (DVL) qualification granted by Dr. NTR University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada in respect of students being trained at Siddhartha Medical College, Vijayawada because of the following:-

1. Dr.M.P.Balanarasinabuha, Asstt.Prof. Unit II is not having recognized postgraduate qualification.
2. Resultantly, teaching complement of Unit II is incomplete
3. No PUVA therapy.
4. No contact dermatitis clinic.
5. Other deficiencies as pointed out in the inspection report.

In view of above, the Committee further decided to direct the institution authorities to henceforth stop admission in MD(DVL) course from the academic session 2009-2010.

**117. Dr. NTR University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada - Approval of Rangaraya Medical College, Kakinada for the award of MD (DVL) qualification in respect of increased intake.**

Read: the Council inspector report (July, 2008) on the standard of examination and other teaching facilities available at Rangaraya Medical College, Kakinada for purpose of approval of the college for the award of MD (DVL) qualification granted by Dr. NTR University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada in respect of increased intake.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council inspector report (July, 2008) and decided not to approve Rangaraya Medical College, Kakinada for the award of MD (DVL) qualification granted by Dr. NTR University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada in respect of increased intake from 1 (one) to 2 (two) seats commensurating with the available PG teachers.

118. i) Andhra University- Recognition of M.D. (Physiology) qualification in respect of students being trained at Rangaraya Medical College, Kakinada,
- ii) Andhra Pradesh University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada and N.T.R. University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada - Approval of Rangaraya Medical College, Kakinada for the award of M.D. (Physiology) qualification.

Read: the compliance verification report (July, 2008) togetherwith the compliance and the Council Inspectors report (May, 2005) on the standard of examination and other teaching facilities available at Rangaraya Medical College, Kakinada for purpose of i) recognition of M.D. (Physiology) qualification earlier granted by Andhra University & ii) also approval of the college for the award of M.D. (Physiology) qualification earlier granted by Andhra Pradesh University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada and now by N.T.R. University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the compliance verification report (July, 2008) togetherwith the compliance and the Council Inspectors report (May, 2005) and decided to recommend that -

- i) MD (Physiology) qualification earlier granted by Andhra Pradesh University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada and now by N.T.R. University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada in respect of students being trained at Rangaraya Medical College, Kakinada be recognized and included in the 1<sup>st</sup> Schedule to the I.M.C. Act,1956.
- ii) Rangaraya Medical College, Kakinada be approved for the award of M.D.(Physiology) qualification granted by Andhra Pradesh University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada & NTR University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada restricting the number of admission to 1 (one) student per year.

119. Dr. NTR University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada - Approval of Andhra Medical College, Vishakapatnam for the award of MD (OBG)) qualification in respect of increased intake.

Read: the Council inspector report (July, 2008) on the standard of examination and other teaching facilities available at Andhra Medical College, Vishakapatnam for purpose of approval of the college for the award of MD (OBG) qualification granted by Dr. NTR University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada in respect of increased intake.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Inspector's Report (July, 2008) and decided to recommend that MD (OBG) qualification granted by Dr. NTR University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada in respect of increased intake in respect of students being trained at Andhra Medical College, Vishakapatnam be approved and included in the 1<sup>st</sup> Schedule to the I.M.C. Act, 1956 restricting the number of admission to 5 (five) students per year prospectively commensurate with number of available PG teachers.

120. Kakatiya University, Osmania University & Dr. NTR University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada- Recognition of MD (Microbiology) qualification in respect of students being trained at Kakatiya Medical College, Warangal.

Read: The Council inspector report (July, 2008) on the standard of examination and other teaching facilities available at Kakatiya Medical College, Warangal for purpose of recognition of MD (Microbiology) qualification earlier granted by Kakatiya



University, Osmania University and now by Dr. NTR University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council inspector report (July, 2008) and decided to recommend that MD (Microbiology) qualification earlier granted by Kakatiya University, Osmania University and now by Dr. NTR University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada in respect of students being trained at Kakatiya Medical College, Warangal be recognized and included in the 1<sup>st</sup> Schedule to the I.M.C. Act, 1956 restricting the number of admissions to 2 (two) students per year.

**121. Osmania University, Andhra Pradesh University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada & NTR University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada - Approval of Gandhi Medical College, Hyderabad for the award of MD (Paediatrics) & D.C.H. qualifications.**

Read: the compliance verification report (July, 2008) togetherwith the compliance and the compliance verification report (June, 2006) together with the compliance and Council Inspector's report (May, 2001) on the standard of examination and other teaching facilities available at Gandhi Medical College, Hyderabad for purpose of approval of the college for the award of MD( Paediatrics) & D.C.H. qualifications granted by Osmania University, Andhra Pradesh University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada & NTR University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the compliance verification report (July, 2008) togetherwith the compliance and the compliance verification report (June, 2006) together with the compliance and Council Inspector's report (May, 2001) and noted that Dr. Usha Rani, Asstt. Prof. is not having recognized postgraduate qualification; however even without her the teaching complement is complete and decided to approve Gandhi Medical College, Hyderabad for the award of MD( Paediatrics) & D.C.H. qualifications granted by Osmania University, Andhra Pradesh University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada & NTR University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada restricting the number of admissions 2 (two) students for degree & 4 (four) students for diploma course per year.

**122. Andhra University, Nagarajuna University, Andhra Pradesh University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada & N.T.R. University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada - Recognition of M.D.(T.B. & Chest Dise./ T.B. & Resp. Dise.) qualification in respect of students being trained at Guntur Medical College, Guntur - reconsideration regarding.**

Read: the compliance verification report (July, 2008) togetherwith the compliance and the Council Inspector's report (May, 2001) on the standard of examination and other teaching facilities available at Guntur Medical College, Guntur for purpose of recognition of MD (T.B. & Chest Dise./T.B. & Resp. Dise.) qualification earlier granted by Andhra University, Nagarajuna University, Andhra Pradesh University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada & now by NTR University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the compliance verification report (July, 2008) togetherwith the compliance and the Council Inspector's report (May, 2001) and decided to advise the institution authorities to re-organise the units in terms of beds as per MCI norms.

The Committee further decided to defer the consideration of the matter till the information is received.

**123. Dr. NTR University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada - Recognition of MD (Microbiology) qualification in respect of students being trained at Mamta Medical College, Khammam.**

Read: the Council inspector report (July, 2008) on the standard of examination and other teaching facilities available at Mamta Medical College, Khammam for purpose of recognition of MD (Microbiology) qualification granted by Dr. NTR University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council inspector report (July, 2008) and decided not to recognise MD (Microbiology) qualification granted by Dr. NTR University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada in respect of students being trained at Mamta Medical College, Khammam because of the following:-

1. Dr. Neelam Sharma, Prof. & HOD does not possess requisite recognized postgraduate qualification.
2. Other deficiencies as pointed out in the inspection report.

In view of above, the Committee further decided to direct the institution authorities to henceforth stop admission in MD (Microbiology) course from the academic session 2009-2010.

**124. Madras University and The Tamilnadu Dr. MGR Medical University, Chennai - Recognition of DM (Cardiology) qualification in respect of students being trained at Stanley Medical College, Chennai.**

Read: The Council inspector report (August, 2008) on the standard of examination and other teaching facilities available at Stanley Medical College, Chennai for purpose of recognition of DM (Cardiology) qualification earlier granted by Madras University and now by The Tamilnadu Dr. MGR Medical University, Chennai.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council inspector report (August, 2008) and decided to recommend that DM (Cardiology) qualification earlier granted by Madras University and now by The Tamilnadu Dr. MGR Medical University, Chennai in respect of students being trained at Stanley Medical College, Chennai be recognized and included in the 1<sup>st</sup> Schedule to the I.M.C. Act,1956 restricting the number of admissions to 2 (two) students per year.

**125. Madurai University, Madurai Kamraj University, Madras University and The Tamilnadu Dr. MGR Medical University, Chennai - Recognition of DM (Neurology) qualification in respect of students being trained at Madurai Medical College, Madurai.**

Read: The Council inspector report (August, 2008) on the standard of examination and other teaching facilities available at Madurai Medical College, Madurai for purpose of recognition of DM (Neurology) qualification earlier granted by Madurai University, Madurai Kamraj University, Madras University and now by The Tamilnadu Dr. MGR Medical University, Chennai.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council inspector report (August, 2008) and decided to recommend that DM (Neurology) qualification earlier granted by Madurai University, Madurai Kamraj University, Madras University and now by The Tamilnadu Dr. MGR Medical University, Chennai in respect of students being trained at Madurai Medical College, Madurai be recognized and included in the 1<sup>st</sup> Schedule to the I.M.C. Act,1956 restricting the number of admissions to 2 (two) students per year.

**126. Proposal for recognition of postgraduate medical qualifications granted by medical institutions outside India Under Section 13 of the IMC Act, 1956 outside the scheme of reciprocity.**

The Postgraduate Committee considered the report of the Sub-Committee regarding proposal for recognition of postgraduate medical qualifications granted by medical institutions outside India Under Section 13 of the IMC Act, 1956 outside the scheme of reciprocity and approved the same. The report of the Committee is as under:-

*"The present committee came to be constituted by the Postgraduate Medical Education Committee of the Council at its meeting held on 12.06.2008 while confirming the minutes of the Postgraduate Committee held on 14.04.2008, wherein the notification dated 07.03.2008 issued by the Govt. of India, Ministry of Health recognizing the postgraduate qualifications granted by medical institutions outside India u/s 13 of the I.M.C. Act, 1956 outside the scheme of reciprocity in respect of Australia, Canada, New Zealand, U.K. and USA u/s 13(4) of the I.M.C. Act, 1956 was noted.*

*The present Committee is required to look into this matter and submit its report. On perusal of the relevant records it is worthwhile to note that the Ministry of Health & F.W., Govt. of India vide their communication dated 27.06.2007 had brought out that "the medical institutions abroad with postgraduate courses where the medium of instruction is English should be considered for unilateral recognition by the MCI as well as Central Govt. so that Indian students have a choice to study there and then return to India to work in various medical fields of specialization. For this purpose, Central Govt./MCI need not physically inspect all the foreign facilities."*

*It was brought out therein that "to begin with, foreign postgraduate degrees recognized by their own respective national regulatory authorities of countries like U.S.A., U.K., Canada, Australia, New Zealand, Singapore and European Union can be considered by MCI towards recognizing these foreign postgraduate medical qualifications of these countries for inclusion in Part-II of the Third Schedule to the I.M.C. Act, 1956."*

*The Council was thereby requested to "collect requisite information and details of credible foreign postgraduate degrees from the foreign countries through their Health Ministries/our Embassies on priority basis and forward to the Govt. of India along with its recommendations under the provisions of I.M.C. Act, 1956 for recognition of foreign postgraduate medical qualifications of the countries stated above in Part-II of the Third Schedule appended to I.M.C. Act, 1956."*

*The said communication was considered by the Postgraduate Committee at its meeting dated 17.07.2007 and it decided to constitute a Committee comprising of Dr. Ved Prakash Mishra, the then Chairman, PG Committee as Chairman with Dr. C.V. Bhirmanandham, Chairman, Teachers' Eligibility Qualifications Sub-Committee and Dr. D.K. Sharma, Chairman, Registration & Equivalence Committee as its members.*

*The said Committee at its meeting held on 24.07.2007 taking stock of the entire situation formulated its detailed report wherein citing various reasons, the Committee categorically brought out that in its considered opinion "it would not be prudent to concede to unilateral recognition of postgraduate qualifications granted by the foreign countries and incorporation thereof in Part-II of the Third Schedule without physical verification of the standards thereat".*

*The said report was considered by the Postgraduate Committee at its meeting held on 06.09.2007, wherein it was approved. The recommendations of the Postgraduate Committee in regard to adoption of the said report of the Sub-Committee was approved by the General Body of the Council at its meeting held on 16.11.2007. Accordingly, a communication No.MCI-23(1)/2007-Med./17005, dated 05.10.2007 was sent to the Govt. of India making it known to them the views of the Council in regard to the inclusion of postgraduate medical qualifications in Part-II of the Third Schedule appended to the I.M.C. Act, 1956.*

*It needs to be borne in mind that in terms of provisions at Section 13(4) of the Act, it is imperative for the Central Govt. to have consultation with the Council and then notify in the Official Gazette any amendment to Part-II of the Third Schedule, so as to include therein any qualification granted by a medical institution outside India which is not included in the Schedule.*

*In spite of the Council communicating to the Govt. of India the reasons as to why unilateral recognition was not called for and would not be conducive to the fair and legitimate interests of the medical education in our country, the Govt. of India have come out with notification dated 07.03.2008 in terms of Section 13(4) of the I.M.C. Act, 1956 notifying inclusion of postgraduate medical qualifications awarded in Australia, Canada, New Zealand, U.K. and U.S.A. which are recognized for enrolment as medical practitioners in the concerned specialities in those countries as recognized qualifications to be included vide an amendment in Part-II of the Third Schedule appended to the I.M.C. Act, 1956.*

*The Committee is of the considered opinion that the said notification which has been issued by the Govt. of India in consultation with MCI, obviously in operation has resulted in negation of the expert opinion rendered by the Council. The concerns that were unequivocally ventilated by the Council have remained unanswered and stand negated by the issuance of the notification by the Govt. of India.*

*It is therefore, necessary for the Council to inform the Govt. of India that the opinion rendered by it was an expert opinion. The negation of an expert opinion without assigning any reason thereto cannot be said to be a healthy practice and hence, the Council seeks to know the reasons and basis by which the expert opinion that was rendered by the Council in terms of acceptance of the Sub-Committee report by the Postgraduate Committee and the General Body of the Council was negated and the notification has been issued by the Govt. claiming that it is with due consultation with MCI.*

*During the pendency of the same i.e. the Council seeking reasons and basis from the Govt. of India and the same being made known to the Council, the notification so issued be sought to be held in abeyance, and in case the reasons and the basis which that have been availed by the Govt. of India to negate the expert opinion of the Council is found to be unsound, then the Govt. of India may be asked to "recall" the said notification."*

The Committee further decided that the above report may be placed before the General Body meeting of the Council for approval.

**127. The Tamilnadu Dr. M.G.R. Medical University, Chennai- Approval of Stanley Medical College, Chennai for the award of D.C.P. qualification.**

Read: the compliance verification report (August, 2008) togetherwith the compliance and the Council Inspector's report (August, 2005) on the standard of examination and other teaching facilities available at Stanley Medical College, Chennai for purpose of approval of the college for the award of D.C.P. qualification granted by The Tamilnadu Dr. M.G.R. Medical University, Chennai.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the compliance verification report (August, 2008) togetherwith the compliance and the Council Inspector's report (August, 2005) and decided to recommend that Stanley Medical College, Chennai be approved for the award of DCP qualification granted by The Tamilnadu Dr. M.G.R. Medical University, Chennai restricting the number of admissions to 4 (four) students per year.

**128. Andhra University, Andhra Pradesh University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada & NTR University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada - Recognition of M.Ch.(Urology/Genito-Urinary Surgery) qualification in respect of students being trained at Andhra Medical College, Visakhapatnam.**

Read: the compliance verification report (August, 2008) togetherwith the compliance and the Council Inspector's report (June, 2001) on the standard of

examination and other teaching facilities available at Andhra Medical College, Visakhapatnam for purpose of recognition of M.Ch. (Urology/Genito-Urinary Surgery) qualification granted by Andhra University, Andhra Pradesh University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada & NTR University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the compliance verification report (August, 2008) togetherwith the compliance and the Council Inspector's report (June, 2001) and noted that Dr. M. Prabhakararao, Asstt. Prof. do not possess requisite recognized postgraduate qualification; however, even without him the teaching complement is complete and decided to recommend that M.Ch.(Urology/Genito-Urinary Surgery) qualification granted by Andhra University, Andhra Pradesh University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada & NTR University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada in respect of students being trained at Andhra Medical College, Visakhapatnam be recognized and included in the 1<sup>st</sup> Schedule to the I.M.C. Act,1956 restricting the number of admission to 1 (One) student per year.

**129. The Tamilnadu Dr. MGR Medical University, Chennai - Recognition of M.Ch. (Surgical Oncology) qualification in respect of students being trained at Kilpauk Medical College, Chennai.**

Read: the Council inspector report (August, 2008) on the standard of examination and other teaching facilities available at Kilpauk Medical College, Chennai for purpose of recognition of M.Ch. (Surgical Oncology) qualification granted by The Tamilnadu Dr. MGR Medical University, Chennai.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council inspector report (August, 2008) and decided not to recognize M.Ch. (Surgical Oncology) qualification granted by The Tamilnadu Dr. MGR Medical University, Chennai in respect of students being trained at Kilpauk Medical College, Chennai because of the following:-

1. OT instruments of advance nature i.e. C-arm, lasic laser are not available.
2. No papers have been published in any journal & no research project is ongoing and submitted.
3. Support staff - Head Clerk, Steno, STA, Lab. attendant are not available.
4. OT & PG record keeping may include more information.
5. No Endoscopy and surgical specialist services are available.
6. Other deficiencies as pointed out in the inspection report.

In view of above, the Committee further decided to direct the institution authorities to henceforth stop admission in M.Ch. (Surgical Oncology) course from the academic session 2009-2010.

**130. Dr. NTR University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada - Approval of Osmania Medical College, Hyderabad for the award of MD (Paediatrics) qualification in respect of increased intake.**

Read: the Council inspector report (July, 2008) on the standard of examination and other teaching facilities available at Osmania Medical College, Hyderabad for purpose of approval of the college for the award of MD (Paediatrics) qualification granted by Dr. NTR University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada in respect of increased intake.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council inspector report (July, 2008) and decided not to approve Osmania Medical College, Hyderabad for the award of MD (Paediatrics) qualification granted by Dr. NTR University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada in respect of increased intake because of the following:-

1. Dr.D.Ranganath, Prof. & incharge of Unit IV is not having prescribed academic qualification.
2. Dr.T.Hima Bindu Singh, Assoc. Prof. and incharge of Unit V is not having recognized postgraduate qualification.
3. Resultantly, both the units IV & V are incomplete.
4. Other deficiencies as pointed out in the inspection report.

In view of above, the Committee further decided to direct the institution authorities to henceforth stop admissions in MD (Paediatrics) course from the academic session 2008-2009.

131. i) **Andhra University, Andhra Pradesh University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada & N.T.R. University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada - approval of Guntur Medical College, Guntur for the award of M.D.(Paediatrics) qualification.**
- ii) **Nagarjuna University - Recognition of MD (Paediatrics) qualification in respect of students being trained at Guntur Medical College, Guntur.**

Read: the compliance verification report (August, 2008) togetherwith the compliance and the Council Inspector's report (May, 2001) on the standard of examination and other teaching facilities available at Guntur Medical College, Guntur for purpose of i) approval the college for the award of MD (Paediatrics) qualification granted by Andhra University, Andhra Pradesh University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada & NTR University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada and ii) recognition of MD (Paediatrics) qualification granted by Nagarjuna University.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the compliance verification report (August, 2008) togetherwith the compliance and the Council Inspector's report (May, 2001) and decided to recommend that -

- i) MD (Paediatrics) qualification granted by Nagarjuna University in respect of students being trained at Guntur Medical College, Guntur be recognized and included in the 1<sup>st</sup> Schedule to the I.M.C. Act,1956.
- ii) Guntur Medical College, Guntur be approved for the award of M.D.(Paediatrics) qualification granted by Andhra University, Andhra Pradesh University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada & NTR University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada restricting the number of admission to 2 (two) students per year.

132. **Guru Nanak Dev University - Recognition of MD (Forensic Medicine) qualification in respect of students being trained at Govt. Medical College, Amritsar.**

Read: the compliance verification report (August, 2008) togetherwith the compliance and the Council Inspector's report (Oct, 1998) on the standard of examination and other teaching facilities available at Govt. Medical College, Amritsar for purpose of recognition of MD (Forensic Medicine) qualification granted by Guru Nanak Dev University.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the compliance verification report (August, 2008) togetherwith the compliance and the Council Inspector's report (Oct, 1998) and decided not to recognise MD (Forensic Medicine) qualification granted by Guru Nanak Dev University in respect of students being trained at Govt. Medical College, Amritsar because of the following:-

1. Prof. & HOD is the Principal of the Institute. There is no other Professor in the department.
2. There is shortage of 2 Asstt. Professors.

3. Resultantly, teaching complement is inadequate by 1 Professor & 2 Asstt.Prof. which is inadequate even for Undergraduate course.
4. Other deficiencies as pointed out in the inspection report.

In view of above, the Committee further decided to direct the institution authorities to henceforth stop admissions in M.D.(Forensic Medicine) course from the academic session 2009-2010.

**133. A.P./NTR University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada - Recognition of DM(Endocrinology) qualification in respect of students being trained at Osmania Medical College, Hyderabad.**

Read: the compliance verification report (August, 2008) togetherwith the compliance and the inspection report (June 2006) carried out to assess the standard of examination and other teaching facilities available at Osmania Medical College, Hyderabad for purpose of recognition of DM(Endocrinology) qualification granted by A.P./NTR University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the compliance verification report (August, 2008) togetherwith the compliance and the inspection report (June 2006) and decided to recommend that DM (Endocrinology) qualification granted by A.P./NTR University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada in respect of students being trained at Osmania Medical College, Hyderabad be recognized and included in the 1<sup>st</sup> Schedule to the I.M.C. Act,1956 restricting the number of admission to 1 (one) student per year.

**134. Dr. NTR University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada - Approval of Osmania Medical College, Hyderabad for the award of MD (Pathology) qualification in respect of increased intake.**

Read: the Council inspector report (July, 2008) on the standard of examination and other teaching facilities available at Osmania Medical College, Hyderabad for purpose of approval of the college for the award of MD (Pathology) qualification granted by Dr. NTR University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada in respect of increased intake.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Inspector's Report (July, 2008) and decided to recommend that MD (Pathology) qualification granted by Dr. NTR University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada in respect of increased intake in respect of students being trained at Osmania Medical College, Hyderabad be recognized and included in the 1<sup>st</sup> Schedule to the I.M.C. Act, 1956 restricting the number of admission to 7 (seven) students per year prospectively commensurate with number of available PG teachers.

**135. Dr. NTR University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada - Recognition of MD (Psychiatry) & DPM qualification in respect of students being trained at Deccan College of Medical Sciences, Hyderabad.**

Read: the Council inspector report (July, 2008) on the standard of examination and other teaching facilities available at Deccan College of Medical Sciences, Hyderabad for purpose of recognition of MD (Psychiatry) & DPM qualification granted by Dr. NTR University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council inspector report (July, 2008) and noted that Dr. Rene De Souza, Assoc. Prof. is not having recognized postgraduate qualification; however, even without Dr. De Souza the teaching complement is completed and hence decided to recommend that MD (Psychiatry) & DPM qualification granted by Dr. NTR University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada in respect

of students being trained at Deccan College of Medical Sciences, Hyderabad be recognized and included in the 1<sup>st</sup> Schedule to the I.M.C. Act,1956 restricting the number of admission to 1 (one) student per year in each course.

**136. Dr. NTR University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada - Recognition of MS (General Surgery qualification in respect of students being trained at Kamineni Institute of Medical Sciences, Narkatpally.**

Read: the Council inspector report (July, 2008) on the standard of examination and other teaching facilities available at Kamineni Institute of Medical Sciences, Narkatpally for purpose of recognition of MS (General Surgery) qualification granted by Dr. NTR University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council inspector report (July, 2008) and decided to recommend that MS (General Surgery) qualification granted by Dr. NTR University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada in respect of students being trained at Kamineni Institute of Medical Sciences, Narkatpally be recognized and included in the 1<sup>st</sup> Schedule to the I.M.C. Act,1956 restricting the number of admission to 4 (four) students per year.

**137. A.P. Singh University - Permitting intake in M.S. (Ortho.) & D.Ortho. courses at S.S. Medical College, Rewa - Regarding Writ Petition No. 13939/06 - Dr. Vishal Bansal Vs. State of MP & Ors.**

Read: consider the letter dated 24.08.2008 from Sh. Anoop Nair, Advocate, Jabalpur regarding some clarification raised by the Hon'ble Court with regard to permitting intake in M.S. (Ortho) & D.Ortho. courses at S.S. Medical College, Rewa under A.P. Singh University.

The Postgraduate Committee perused the communication dated 24.08.2008 received from Mrs. Indira Nair, Sr. Advocate, Jabalpur in the matter of WP13939/06 - Vishal Bansal Vs. State of MP & Ors. in which the Sr. Advocate has stated that the Hon'ble Court wants the following information:-

- “1. Who are the members of the PG Committee and what are their designations. (Kindly mention the name and designation of the members of the PG Committee).
2. In para 4 of our reply we have mentioned the following:-
  1. OT days are now 4 per week which is inadequate. (Kindly enlarge the provision under which the PG committee has recommended inadequacy of 4 days OT. Kindly quote the rule/Regulation)
  2. Operation work load is less. (8 major and 8 minor procedure per week).
  3. Average OPD attendance is 75. Kindly quote what should be OPD attendance and the regulation pertaining to this subject.
3. In page 11 we have mentioned that “It is further submitted that the clinical material, particularly the operative work load, is one of the most important teaching and training component for the postgraduate courses of M.S. (Orthopaedics. It is this compliment which is grossly inadequate at this institute/college as only 8 major and 8 minor procedures are carried out per week”. What should be the number as well as the regulation supporting this plea”.

The Postgraduate Committee further observed that the requirement of the staff, training facilities, beds strength, out patient department, laboratory facilities and equipment etc. are prescribed in **Regulations 11 of Postgraduate Medical Education Regulations, 2000** which reads as under:-



### ***“11 Departmental training Facilities:-***

*A department having an independent academic entity of a teaching institution, consisting of one or more units, each having the prescribed minimum strength of faculty, staff and beds shall be recognised for Post Graduate training.*

#### ***11.1 Staff - Faculty***

*(a) A clinical department or its unit training candidates for broad or super specialities, shall have a minimum of three full time faculty members belonging to the concerned disciplines of whom one shall be a Professor, one Associate Professor/ Reader/ and one Asst. Professor/ Lecturer, possessing the qualification and experience prescribed by the Medical Council of India;*

*Provided that the second or subsequent additional unit may be headed by an Associate professor.*

*Of these faculty members only those who possess a total of eight years teaching experience, out of which at least five years teaching experience as Assistant Professor/Lecturer gained after obtaining Post Graduate degree, shall be recognised as Post Graduate teachers.*

*(b) In each department, training candidates for super specialities, there shall be a minimum of three faculty members with requisite Post Graduate qualification and experience - One Professor, One Associate Professor / Reader and one Assistant Professor / Lecturer, with atleast two of them holding the degree of D.M./M.Ch. in the concerned discipline.*

*Of these faculty members only those who possess eight years teaching experience out of which at least five years teaching experience as Assistant Professor / Lecturer gained after obtaining the higher speciality degree shall be recognised as Post Graduate teachers; Provided that in the case of super speciality courses which are being newly instituted relaxation of qualification and experience of Post Graduate teachers may be granted by the Medical Council of India for sufficient cause.*

*(c) In addition to the faculty staff, the strength of Residents / Registrars / Tutors / Demonstrators, as well as technical and other para medical staff shall be as per the staff strength prescribed for 50 or 100 or 150 students in the “Minimum Requirements for 50/100/150 MBBS Admissions Annually Regulations.’*

#### ***11.2 Minimum requirements for a Post Graduate institution :***

*(a) An institution conducting both undergraduate and Post Graduate teaching shall satisfy the minimum requirement for undergraduate training as prescribed by the Medical Council of India and shall also fulfil additional requirements for Post Graduate training depending on the type of work being carried out in the department. The extra staff required to be provided in various departments shall be as given in Appendix-I.*

*(b) A Department imparting only Post Graduate training shall:-*

*(i) Provide facilities consistent with the all round training including training in basic medical science and other departments related to the subject of training as recommended by the Medical Council of India.*

*(ii) have as many autopsies, biopsies and cytopsies as possible for teaching purposes; and*

*(iii) make available facilities of ancillary department for coordination of Training.*

#### ***11.3 Bed Strength in Clinical Departments***

*A department to be recognised for training of Post Graduate students, shall have not less than 60 (Sixty) beds each of General Medicine, General Surgery, Obstetrics and Gynecology, 30 (thirty) beds each for others incase of M.D/M.S. and diploma and 20 (twenty) beds each in case of D.M./M.Ch.*

*Explanation: - A unit shall consist of 30 beds for MD/MS and 20 beds for DM/M.Ch. respectively.*

#### **11.4 Out – patient departments**

*There shall be adequate space and sufficient number of examination cubicles available in the out – patient Department. Besides the general outpatient services, Speciality Clinics shall also be available for the training of post-graduate students in the relevant broad and super speciality;*

*To determine the number of students who may be admitted for training, outpatient attendance, work turnover and ambulatory care also have to be taken into consideration.*

#### **11.5 Laboratory Facilities**

*The institution shall have adequate laboratory facilities for the training of the Post Graduate students, and such laboratories shall provide all the investigative facilities required and shall be regularly updated keeping in view the advancement of knowledge and technology and research requirements, and for training of students in non-clinical departments, proper and contemporary laboratory facilities shall be made available.*

#### **11.6 Equipment**

*The department shall have adequate number of all equipments including the latest ones necessary for training and as may be prescribed by the Council for each speciality from time to time."*

It was further observed that the conduct of teaching and training programmes is prescribed under **Regulations 13 of Postgraduate Medical Education Regulations, 2000** which reads as under:-

#### **“13. Training Programme**

13.1 *The training given with due care to the Post Graduate students in the recognised institutions for the award of various Post Graduate medical degrees / diplomas shall determine the expertise of the specialist and / or medical teachers produced as a result of the educational programme during the period of stay in the institution.*

13.4 (c) *Post Graduate students shall maintain a record (log) book of the work carried out by them and the training programme undergone during the period of training including details of surgical operations assisted or done independently by M.S./M.Ch. candidates.*

13.8 (c) *Diplomas In – service training, with students being given graded clinical responsibility; Lectures, Seminars, Journal Clubs, Group Discussions and participation in clinical and Clinico-Pathological Conferences, practical training to manage independently common problems in the speciality; and training in the Basic Medical Sciences”.*

The Postgraduate Committee further observed that no specific criteria have been prescribed in the Postgraduate Regulations for quantification of clinical material. However, the following criteria pertaining to clinical material have been prescribed under “Minimum Standard Requirements for the Medical College for 100 Admissions Annually Regulations, 1999”:-

#### **“B. TEACHING HOSPITAL**

B.1 *General Remarks*

B.1.7 *There shall be a minimum OPD attendance of 8 patients per day (old & new) per student intake.*

B.1.8 *Indoor beds occupancy – Average occupancy of indoor beds shall be a minimum of 80% per annum."*

In view of above and as a consistent practice based upon experience while evaluating the available facilities in an institute for starting/recognition of Postgraduate

courses, the minimum clinical material required in major clinical disciplines has been quantified by the Postgraduate Committee from time to time as under:-

- (1) OPD - Average OPD attendance not less than 100-125 in major clinical disciplines like Medicine, Surgery, Paediatrics, Orthopaedics & Obst. & Gynae.
- (2) Bed Occupancy - Average bed occupancy not less than 80%.
- (3) Operative workload: Atleast 1 major and 2 minor operation per day per teaching faculty and residents i.e. in a given unit having 3 teaching faculty members, the operative workload should be atleast 3 major and 6 minor operations per day. The operation theatre should function daily. If more than one unit are allocated operation theatres on a given day, the number of operations should be increased proportionately

Further in view of above, in a week having 6 working days the operative workload is minimum of 18 major and 36 minor operations per week.

The Postgraduate Committee further observed that the above mentioned criteria are applied uniformly in all cases of permission/recognition of Postgraduate courses surgical disciplines including **Orthopaedics**.

The Postgraduate Committee further directed the Secretary to communicate the above clarifications/observations to the Council Advocate at Jabalpur.

**138. Sanjay Gandhi Postgraduate Institute of Medical Sciences (Deemed University), Lucknow - Recognition of M.Ch. (CTVS) qualification in respect of Sanjay Gandhi Postgraduate Institute of Medical Sciences, Lucknow - regarding amendment in the notification of Government of India.**

Read: the letter 18.08.2008 from Dr. Abha Chandra, Professor (CTVS) at Sri Vanketeswara Institute of Medical Sciences, Tirupati regarding change in the date of earlier notification of Government of India in respect of M.Ch. (CTVS) of Sanjay Gandhi Postgraduate Institute of Medical Sciences, Lucknow.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the application of Dr. Abha Chandra and decided to obtain the clarification from the Dean of the Institute regarding the year of commencement of the course.

The Postgraduate Committee deferred the remaining items to the next Postgraduate Committee meeting.
