The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Inspector's report (June, 2009) and noted that Dr. Chandrasekhar, Prof., does not possess recognized postgraduate qualification.

However, the teaching faculty complement other than the teacher mentioned above is adequate and complete and hence decided to recommend that Narayana Medical College, Nellore be approved for the award of MS (Ophthalmology) qualification granted by Dr. NTR University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada.

The Committee further decided that commensurate with the availability of PG teachers with recognized qualifications the Institute be directed to restrict the total number of students admitted in the course to 1(one) student per year from the academic session 2010-2011.

13. **Dr. NTR University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada - Approval of Gandhi Medical College, Secunderabad for the award of M.D.(Forensic Medicine) qualification in respect of increased intake.**

Read: the Council Inspector's report (June, 2009) on the standard of examination and other teaching facilities available at Gandhi Medical College, Secunderabad for

purpose of approval of the college for the award of M.D.(Forensic Medicine) qualification granted by Dr. NTR University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada in respect of increased intake.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Inspector's report (June, 2009) and decided to recommend that Gandhi Medical College, Secunderabad be approved for the award of M.D.(Forensic Medicine) qualification granted by Dr. NTR University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada in respect of increased intake restricting the number of admissions from 2 (two) to 3 (three) students per year.

14. Veer Narmed South Gujarat University, - Recognition of M.S. (Obst. & Gynae) qualification in respect of students being trained at Surat Municipal Institute of Medical Education & Research, Surat .

Read: the Council Inspector's report (May, 2009) on the standard of examination and other teaching facilities available at Surat Municipal Institute of Medical Education & Research, Surat for purpose of recognition of M.S. (Obst. & Gynae) qualification granted by Veer Narmed South Gujarat University, Surat.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Inspector's report (May, 2009) and decided not to recognize M.S. (Obst. & Gynae) qualification granted by Veer Narmed South Gujarat University, Surat in respect of students being trained at Surat Municipal Institute of Medical Education & Research, Surat because of the followings:-

1. Dr. Milind Wadekar, Asst.Prof. of Unit-II, does not possess required academic qualification.
2. Resultantly, teaching faculty component is incomplete.
3. Other deficiencies as pointed out in the inspection report.

In view of above, the Committee further decided to direct the institution authorities to henceforth stop admission in M.S. (Obst. & Gynae.) course from the academic session 2010-2011.

15. D.Y. Patil University, Kolhapur - Recognition of M.D.(General Medicine) qualification in respect of students being trained at D.Y.Patil Medical College, Kolhapur.

Read: the Council Inspector's report (May, 2009) on the standard of examination and other teaching facilities available at D.Y.Patil Medical College, Kolhapur for purpose of recognition of M.D.(General Medicine) qualification granted by D.Y. Patil University, Kolhapur.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Inspector's report (May, 2009) and decided not to recognize M.D.(General Medicine) qualification granted by D.Y. Patil University, Kolhapur in respect of students being trained at D.Y.Patil Medical College, Kolhapur because of the followings:-

1. The Institute has shown 6 Sr. Residents who are 3rd year Residents which is not as per MCI norms. Hence, none of the Sr. Residents possesses the required experience of 3 years as per Regulations.
2. The quality of publications by the faculty needs to be improved.
3. Other deficiencies as pointed out in the inspection report.

In view of above, the Committee further decided to direct the institution authorities to henceforth stop admission in M.D.(General Medicine) course from the academic session 2010-2011.

16. Dr. NTR University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada - Approval of Narayana Medical College, Nellore for the award of MD (General Medicine) qualifications

Read: the Council Inspector's report (June, 2009) on the standard of examination and other teaching facilities available at Narayana Medical College, Nellore for purpose of approval of the college for the award of MD (General Medicine) qualification granted by Dr. NTR University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Inspector's report (June, 2009) and decided not to approve Narayana Medical College, Nellore for the award of MD (General Medicine) qualification granted by Dr. NTR University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada because of the followings:-

1. Dr. G. Srinivas, Assoc.Prof. of Unit-I, Dr. M.Rajesh Kumar, Assoc.Prof. & Incharge of Unit-IV, Dr. N.R. Sai Kumar, Assoc.Prof. & Incharge of Unit-VI and Dr. V. Pavan Kumar do not possess recognized postgraduate qualification.
2. Resultantly, teaching faculty component is incomplete.
3. Other deficiencies/observations as pointed out in the inspection report.

In view of above, the Committee further decided to direct the institution authorities to henceforth stop admissions in M.D.(General Medicine) course from the academic session 2010-2011.

17. Dr. NTR University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada - Approval of Narayana Medical College, Nellore for the award of MD (Paediatrics) qualifications

Read: the Council Inspector's report (June, 2009) on the standard of examination and other teaching facilities available at Narayana Medical College, Nellore for purpose of approval of the college for the award of MD (Paediatrics) qualification granted by Dr. NTR University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Inspector's report (June, 2009) and decided to recommend that Narayana Medical College, Nellore be approved for the award of MD (Anaesthesia) qualification granted by Dr. NTR University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada restricting the number of admissions to 2 (two) students per year.

20. Dr. NTR University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada - Approval of Alluri Sitarama Raju Academy of Medical Sciences, Eluru for the award of DA. qualifications

Read: the Council Inspector's report (June, 2009) on the standard of examination and other teaching facilities available at Alluri Sitarama Raju Academy of Medical Sciences, Eluru for purpose of approval of the college for the award of DA qualification granted by Dr. NTR University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Inspector's report (June, 2009) and noted that promotion of Dr. B.K. Gahalot, Assoc. Prof. is not as per MCI norms.

However, the teaching faculty complement other than the teacher mentioned above is adequate and complete and hence decided to recommend that Alluri Sitarama Raju Academy of Medical Sciences, Eluru be approved for the award of DA qualification granted by Dr. NTR University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada restricting the number of admissions to 2(Two) students per year.

21. Dr. NTR University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada - Approval of Alluri Sitarama Raju Academy of Medical Sciences, Eluru for the award of DCH. qualifications

Read: the Council Inspector's report (June, 2009) on the standard of examination and other teaching facilities available at Alluri Sitarama Raju Academy of Medical Sciences, Eluru for purpose of approval of the college for the award of DCH qualification granted by Dr. NTR University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada.

22. Dr. NTR University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada - Approval of Kamineni Institute of Medical Sciences, Narketpally for the award of MD (Psychiatry) qualifications

Read: the Council Inspector's report (June, 2009) on the standard of examination and other teaching facilities available at Kamineni Institute of Medical Sciences, Narketpally for purpose of approval of the college for the award of MD (Psychiatry) qualification granted by Dr. NTR University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Inspector's report (June, 2009) and decided to recommend that Kamineni Institute of Medical Sciences, Narketpally be approved for the award of MD (Psychiatry) qualification granted by Dr.

NTR University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada restricting the number of admissions to 1 (one) student per year.

23. Dr. NTR University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada – Approval of Deccan College of Medical Sciences, Hyderabad for the award of MD (Paediatrics) qualifications

Read: the Council Inspector's report (June, 2009) on the standard of examination and other teaching facilities available at Deccan College of Medical Sciences, Hyderabad for purpose of approval of the college for the award of MD (Paediatrics) qualification granted by Dr. NTR University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Inspector's report (June, 2009) and decided to recommend that Deccan College of Medical Sciences, Hyderabad be approved for the award of MD (Paediatrics) qualification granted by Dr. NTR University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada restricting the number of admissions to 2 (two) students per year.

24. Sardar Patel University – Recognition of Diploma in Microbiology qualification in respect of students being trained at Pramukh Swami Medical College, Karamsad.

Read: the Council Inspector's report (June, 2009) on the standard of examination and other teaching facilities available at Pramukh Swami Medical College, Karamsad for purpose of recognition of Diploma in Microbiology qualification granted by Sardar Patel University.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Inspector's report (June, 2009) and decided not to recognize Diploma in Microbiology qualification granted by Sardar Patel University in respect of students being trained at Pramukh Swami Medical College, Karamsad because of the following:-

1. There is no individual designated Bacteriology, Mycology, Virology, Serology, Immunology & TB functioning laboratories in the department - in the college.
2. Disposal & washing facilities from sterile media preparation need to separate physically in separate rooms with restricted entry.
3. B.O.D. Incubators for different temperature is not available.
4. Separate incubation is required for mycology & TB.
5. Inverted microscopy is not available for Virology set up.
6. Resultantly, instrumentation is inadequate.
7. Other deficiencies as pointed out in the inspection report.

In view of above, the Committee further decided to direct the institution authorities to henceforth stop admission in Diploma in Microbiology course from the academic session 2010-2011.

25. Sardar Patel University – Recognition of MD (Biochemistry) qualification in respect of students being trained at Pramukh Swami Medical College, Karamsad.

Read: the Council Inspector's report (May, 2009) on the standard of examination and other teaching facilities available at Pramukh Swami Medical College, Karamsad for purpose of recognition of MD (Biochemistry) qualification granted by Sardar Patel University.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Inspector's report (May, 2009) and decided not to recognize MD (Biochemistry) qualification granted by Sardar Patel University in respect of students being trained at Pramukh Swami Medical College, Karamsad because of the following:-

1. Research facilities need to be developed.
2. Resultantly, infrastructure is inadequate.
3. There is only 1 publication in last 5 years by the whole department.
4. PG training needs improvement in practical training - no special training in practicals.
5. There is no evidence of log book.
6. Resultantly, research & training are inadequate.
7. Dr. K.J. Mathai, Prof., is more than 65 years old, hence could not be considered as a teaching faculty.
8. Other deficiencies as pointed out in the inspection report.

In view of above, the Committee further decided to direct the institution authorities to henceforth stop admission in MD (Biochemistry) course from the academic session 2010-2011.

26. Dr. D.Y. Patil University Pune - Approval Dr. D.Y. Patil Medical college, Pimpri, Pune for award of DO qualification in respect of increased intake.

Read: the Council Inspector's report (May, 2009) on the standard of examination and other teaching facilities available at Dr. D.Y. Patil Medical college, Pimpri, Pune for purpose of approval of the college for the award of DO qualification granted by Dr. D.Y. Patil University, Pune in respect of increased intake.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Inspector's report (May, 2009) and decided to recommend that Dr. D.Y. Patil Medical college, Pimpri, Pune be approved for the award of DO qualification granted by Dr. D.Y. Patil University, Pune in respect of increased intake restricting the number of admissions from 1 (one) to 2(two) students per year.

27. Dr. D.Y. Patil University, Pune - Recognition of MD(Biochemistry) qualification in respect of students being trained at Dr. D.Y. Patil Medical college, Pimpri, Pune.

Read: the Council Inspector's report (May, 2009) on the standard of examination and other teaching facilities available at Dr. D.Y. Patil Medical college, Pimpri, Pune for purpose of Recognition of MD (Biochemistry) qualification granted by Dr. D.Y. Patil University, Pune.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Inspector's report (May, 2009) and decided to recommend that MD (Biochemistry) qualification granted by Dr. D.Y. Patil University, Pune in respect of students being trained at Dr. D.Y. Patil Medical college, Pimpri, Pune be recognized and included in the 1st Schedule to the I.M.C. Act, 1956 restricting the number of admissions to 1 (one) students per year prospectively commensurate with available PG teacher.

28. Dr. NTR University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada - Approval of Alluri Sitarama Raju Academy of Medical Sciences, Eluru for the award of DTCD qualification

1. Unit wise distribution of beds are not as per MCI norms.
2. Composition of units are not as per MCI norms.
3. There are only five available PG teachers with recognized qualification while total intake is 9 degree & 9 diploma students annually.
4. Other deficiencies as pointed out in the inspection report.

In view of above, the Committee further decided to direct the institution authorities to henceforth stop admission in DCH course from the academic session 2010-2011.

95. Maharashtra University of Health Sciences, Nashik - Approval of NKP Salve Institute of Medical Sciences & Research Centre, Nagpur for the award of DO qualifications

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Inspector's report (June, 2009) and noted that Dr.Sunanda, Asstt. Prof., Unit I and Dr. Anima Devi, Asstt. Prof. Unit II do not possess prescribed academic qualification.

However, However, the teaching faculty complement other than the teacher mentioned above is adequate and complete and hence decided to recommend that Gandhi Medical College, Secunderabad be approved for the award of M.D.(Obst. & Gynae) qualification granted by Dr. NTR University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada in respect of increased intake restricting the number of admissions to 5 (five) to 10 (ten) students per year.

101. Ch. Charan Singh University, Meerut - Approval of Santosh Medical College, Ghaziabad for the award of M.S.(Ortho.) & D.Ortho. qualification.

Read: the Council Inspector report (May,2009) on the standard of examination and other teaching facilities available at Santosh Medical College, Ghaziabad for purpose of approval of the college for the award of M.S.(Ortho.) & D. Charan Singh University , Meerut.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Inspector report (May, 2009) and decided to recommend that :

Charan Singh University, Meerut restricting the number of admissions to 2(Two) students per year.

104. Ch. Charan Singh University, Meerut - Approval of Santosh Medical College, Ghaziabad for the award of M.D.(General Medicine) qualification.

Read: the Council Inspector report (May,2009) on the standard of examination and other teaching facilities available at Santosh Medical College, Ghaziabad for purpose of approval of the college for the award of M.D.(General Medicine) qualification granted by Ch. Charan Singh University , Meerut.

2. The Lab. Investigations workload is inadequate and not commensurate with the number of patients claimed to be attending the hospital in outdoor and indoor.
3. Only 15 books of latest edition have been purchased in last 3 years which is inadequate.
4. Other deficiencies/observations as pointed out in the inspection report.

In view of above, the Committee further decided to direct the institution authorities to henceforth stop admission in M.D.(General Medicine) course from the academic session 2010-2011.

105. Ch. Charan Singh University, Meerut - Approval of Santosh Medical College, Ghaziabad for the award of DGO qualification.

Read: the Council Inspector report (May,2009) on the standard of examination and other teaching facilities available at Santosh Medical College, Ghaziabad for purpose of approval of the college for the award of DGO qualification granted by Ch. Charan Singh University , Meerut.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Inspector report (May,2009) and decided not to approve Santosh Medical College, Ghaziabad for the award of DGO qualification granted by Ch. Charan Singh University, Meerut because of the following:-

1. Invitro Fertilizer services are inadequate.
2. Gynaecological Endo Crinology clinic is not run by the department.
3. Resultantly, Clinical material is inadequate.

4. There is no departmental museum.
5. Other deficiencies/observations as pointed out in the inspection report.

In view of above, the Committee further decided to direct the institution authorities to henceforth stop admission in DGO course from the academic session 2010-2011.

106. Ch. Charan Singh University, Meerut - Approval of Santosh Medical College, Ghaziabad for the award of DCH qualification.

Read: the Council inspector report (June,2009) on the standard of examination and other teaching facilities available at Santosh Medical College, Ghaziabad for purpose of approval of the college for the award of DCH qualification granted by Ch. Charan Singh University, Meerut.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council inspector report (June,2009) and noted that promotion of Dr. Alka Agarwal, Prof. of Unit-II, is not as per MCI norms.

However, the teaching faculty complement other than the teacher mentioned above is adequate and complete and hence decided to recommend that Santosh Medical College, Ghaziabad be approved for the award of DCH qualification granted by Ch. Charan Singh University, Meerut restricting the number of admissions to 2(Two) students per year.

107. Ch. Charan Singh University, Meerut - Approval of Santosh Medical College, Ghaziabad for the award of M.D.(Anesthesiology) qualification.

Read: the Council inspector report (June,2009) on the standard of examination and other teaching facilities available at Santosh Medical College, Ghaziabad for purpose of approval of the college for the award of M.D.(Anesthesiology) qualification granted by Ch. Charan Singh University, Meerut.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council inspector report (June,2009) and decided not to approve Santosh Medical College, Ghaziabad for the award of M.D.(Anesthesiology) qualification granted by Ch. Charan Singh University, Meerut because of the following:-

1. There is no departmental museum.
2. There is no research laboratory.
3. Other deficiencies/observations as pointed out in the inspection report.

In view of above, the Committee further decided to direct the institution authorities to henceforth stop admissions in M.D.(Anesthesiology) course from the academic session 2010-2011.

108. Ch. Charan Singh University, Meerut - Approval of Santosh Medical College, Ghaziabad for the award of M.S.(General Surgery) qualification.

Read: the Council inspector report (July,2009) on the standard of examination and other teaching facilities available at Santosh Medical College, Ghaziabad for purpose of approval of the college for the award of M.S.(General Surgery) qualification granted by Ch. Charan Singh University, Meerut.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council inspector report (July,2009) and decided not to approve Santosh Medical College, Ghaziabad for the award of M.S.(General Surgery) qualification granted by Ch. Charan Singh University, Meerut because of the following:-

1. The Lab. Investigations workload is inadequate and not commensurate with the number of patients claimed to be attending the hospital in outdoor and indoor.

2. Special Services are inadequate as none are available for head injury, trauma etc.
3. The speciality clinics run by the department are inadequate as only breast checkup and Proctoscopy clinics are provided.
4. There is no departmental museum.
5. Other deficiencies/observations as pointed out in the inspection report.

In view of above, the Committee further decided to direct the institution authorities to henceforth stop admissions in M.S.(General Surgery) course from the academic session 2010-2011.

109. Starting of M.Ch.(Surgical Gastroenterology) course at Chhatrapati Shahu Ji Maharaj Medical University, Lucknow under Chhatrapati Shahu Ji Maharaj Medical University, Lucknow u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.

Read: the compliance together with the Council Inspector's report (May, 2009) on the physical and other teaching facilities available at Chhatrapati Shahu Ji Maharaj Medical University, Lucknow under Chhatrapati Shahu Ji Maharaj Medical University, Lucknow for starting of M.Ch.(Surgical Gastroenterology) course u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the compliance together with the Council Inspector's report (May, 2009) and decided to reiterate its earlier decision taken at its meeting held on 12/6/2009 recommending to the Central Govt. not to issue Letter of Intent for starting of M.Ch.(Surgical Gastroenterology) course at Chhatrapati Shahu Ji Maharaj Medical University, Lucknow under Chhatrapati Shahu Ji Maharaj Medical University, Lucknow u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 as the following deficiencies are still persisting:-

- (i) Dr. Anup K Wahal, Prof. & HoD, does not possess prescribed academic qualification.
- (ii) Resultantly, teaching faculty component is incomplete.
- (iii) There is no Ventilator and Defibrillator in the intensive surgical care unit of the department.
- (iv) The operation theatre does not have equipments like invasive/non-invasive monitors with capnography, Argon, Bean/Coagulator & Ultrasonic Sealpel.
- (v) Resultantly, instrumentation is inadequate.
- (vi) There is only 3 Foreign & 1 Indian Journal of surgical Gastroenterology. The library needs to be upgraded with surgical gastroenterology oriented journals.
- (vii) Framing a well knot teaching programme and implementing if needs to be done for a good academic and research orientation.
- (viii) Other deficiencies/observations as pointed out in the inspection report.

In view of the Govt. of India letter dated 15.3.2005 issued after the directions of the Hon'ble Supreme Court in case of Mridul Dhar V/s UOI & Ors. requesting the Council to strictly adhere to the time schedule prescribed under the Regulations, and as per the Schedule prescribed in the opening of a New or Higher course of study or training (including postgraduate course of study or training) and increase of admission capacity in any course of study or training (including a postgraduate course of study or training), Regulations, 2000, the last date for sending the recommendations of the MCI for grant of Letter of Permission to the Central Govt. for starting any super-speciality course being 15th June, the Members of the Postgraduate Committee decided to reiterate its earlier decision taken at its meeting held on 12/06/2009 to return the application to the Central Govt. recommending disapproval of the Scheme for starting of M.Ch.(Surgical Gastroenterology) course at Chhatrapati Shahu Ji Maharaj Medical University, Lucknow under Chhatrapati Shahu Ji Maharaj Medical University, Lucknow u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.

110. Starting of DM(Endocrinology) course at Sher-I-Kashmir Institute of Medical Sciences, Srinagar under Sher-I-Kashmir Institute of Medical Sciences, Srinagar u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.

Read: the compliance together with the Council Inspector's report (May, 2009) on the physical and other teaching facilities available at Sher-I-Kashmir Institute of Medical Sciences, Srinagar under Sher-I-Kashmir Institute of Medical Sciences, Srinagar for starting of DM(Endocrinology) course.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the compliance together with the Council Inspector's report (May, 2009) and decided to recommend to the Central Govt. to issue Letter of Permission for starting of DM(Endocrinology) course at Sher-I-Kashmir Institute of Medical Sciences, Srinagar under Sher-I-Kashmir Institute of Medical Sciences, Srinagar u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 prospectively i.e. from the academic session 2010-2011 restricting the number of admission to 2(Two) students per year, till the first batch admitted appears in the final examination of the said course. The institution be advised to apply for recognition of the qualification at the time of first available examination as per the provision of Section 11(2) of the IMC Act, 1956.

111. Starting of M.Ch.(Surgical Gastroenterology) course at Amrita School of Medicine, Kochi under Amrita Vishwa Peetham University u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.

Read: the letter dated 15/6/2009 received from the Principal, Amrita School of Medicine, Kochi together with the Council Inspector's report (June, 2009) on the physical and other teaching facilities available at Amrita School of Medicine, Kochi under Amrita Vishwa Peetham University for starting of M.Ch.(Surgical Gastroenterology) course u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the letter dated 15/6/2009 received from the Principal, Amrita School of Medicine, Kochi together with the Council Inspector's report (June, 2009) and noted that the compliance is unsatisfactory and decided to reiterate its earlier decision taken at its meeting held on 12.06.2009 recommending to the Central Govt. not to issue Letter of Intent for starting of M.Ch.(Surgical Gastroenterology) course at Amrita School of Medicine, Kochi under Amrita Vishwa Peetham University u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.

112. Admission made in various postgraduate medical courses after the last date for the academic session 2009-2010 as prescribed in the Postgraduate Medical Education Regulation, 2000.

Read: as per the judgement of the Hon'ble Supreme Court in Madhu Singh's case, the college/institution authorities conducting postgraduate courses were requested to supply the admissions made in the various postgraduate courses with date of admissions for the year 2009-2010.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the matter with regard to admissions made in various Postgraduate medical courses after the last date for the academic session 2009-2010 and noted that the following medical colleges admitted the students after the last date prescribed in the Postgraduate Medical Education Regulations i.e. 31st May, 2009; thus violating the prescribed regulatory schedule of admissions by the Council.

The members of the Postgraduate Committee also observed that Regulation 9 (3) pertaining to the time schedule of the admission process reads as under:-

"3. (i) The Universities and other authorities concerned shall organize admission process in such a way that teaching in postgraduate courses starts by 2nd May and by 1st August for super speciality courses each year. For this purpose, they shall follow the time schedule indicated in Appendix-III.

(ii) There shall be no admission of students in respect of any academic session beyond 31st May for postgraduate courses and 30th September for super speciality courses under any circumstances. They Universities shall not register any student admitted beyond the said date.

(iii) The Medical Council of India may direct, that any student identified as having obtained admission after the last date for closure of admission be discharged from the course of study, or any medical qualification granted to such a student shall not be a recognized qualification for the purpose of the Indian Medical Council Act, 1956.

The institution which grants admission to any student after the last date specified for the same shall also be liable to face such action as may be prescribed by MCI including surrender of seats equivalent to the extent of such admission made from its sanctioned intake capacity for the succeeding academic year."

In view of above, the Postgraduate Committee decided to initiate action by issuing discharge notice in respect of the above mentioned students.

113. Admissions made in various Postgraduate medical courses in excess the admission capacity fixed by the Council for academic session 2009-10.

Read: the judgment of the Hon'ble Supreme Court in Madhu Singh's case, the college/institutions authorities conducting Postgraduate courses were requested to supply the information regarding admissions made in the various postgraduate courses in the year 2009-2010.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the matter with regard to admission made in various postgraduate medical courses in excess of the admission capacity fixed by the Council for the academic session 2009-10 and noted that the following medical colleges admitted the students over and above the sanctioned intake capacity violating the prescribed binding regulations which being statutory Regulations are binding and mandatory in character.

The members of the Postgraduate Committee observed that Regulation 9 of Medical Council of India (criteria for identification of students admitted in excess of admission capacity of medical colleges) Regulations 1997, pertaining to the excess admission reads as under:-

"9 Identification of excess admission & non-recognition of medical qualifications:- The Council shall find out the excess admissions in a medical college and no medical qualification granted to any identified student of the medical college which comes under the excess admission shall be recognized medical qualification for the purpose of Indian Medical Council Act, 1956 (102 of 1956). The names and other particulars of students so identified shall be intimated by the Council to all concerned for taking action under the provisions of the Act. Any dispute in the matter of identification of excess admission of students(s) in a medical institution shall be referred to the Central Govt., for decision."

In view of above, the members of the postgraduate Committee decided to initiate action by issuing the discharge notice in respect of the students who have been admitted in excess of the permissible intake.

The members of the Postgraduate Committee also decided that in respect of those cases wherein irregularities in admission which are contrary to statutory regulations have been observed, the action including issuance of discharge notice should be taken by the office in accordance with the Regulations and the matter should be brought before the Postgraduate Committee at its next meeting for information and ratification.

114. W.P. No. 10889/2009 - Dr. M.A. Gaffar & Ors. - Vs. - Medical Council of India & Anr. Before the Hon'ble High Court of Andhra Pradesh at Hyderabad.

Read: Writ Petition filed by Dr. M.A. Gaffar & Ors. In the Hon'ble High Court of Andhra Pradesh at Hyderabad praying for an order or direction of Andhra Pradesh Medical Council in not registering the additional qualification of the Petitioners as M.D. (Dermatology, Venereology and Leprosy) in terms of the clarification letter No. MCI-12(1)/2005-Med.Misc. dated 5.08.2005.

The members of the Postgraduate Committee observed that the General Body of the Council at its meeting held on 18th February, 2006 had approved the following recommendations of the Postgraduate Committee:-

“The Postgraduate Committee considered the matter togetherwith W.P. W.P.No.3372/2005 – Dr.B.Naravana Reddy & 28 others – Vs. – The Medical Council of India & Ors. in the High Court of AP at Hyderabad and decided to recommend that MD (Derm.)/MD (Ven.)/MD (Derm. & Ven.) be treated at par with the combined speciality i.e. MD Dermatology, Venerology, Leprosy.”

It was observed that the qualification of MD (Dermatology, Venereology and Leprosy) has been included in the Schedule to the I.M.C. Act, 1956. This qualification of MD (Dermatology, Venereology and Leprosy) comprehensively covers all the three branches i.e. Dermatology, Venereology and Leprosy. It also observed that the above cited decision covered the qualification awarded by the nomenclature of Dermatology and Venerology.

In view of above and after due deliberations, the members of the postgraduate Committee decided that the qualification of MD (Venerology) is also covered in the above cited decision and it should be treated at par with the combined speciality as is being done for the candidates having MD(Dermatology) qualification.

115. Bifurcation of departments of Radiology at various medical colleges - Qualification of DMRE.

Read: letter dt.5.11.96 received from Dr.V.P. Mishra and Dr.B.P. Dubey, members of the postgraduate Committee/Council with regard to bifurcation of departments of Radiology and Pathology at various medical colleges.

The members of the Council at its meeting held on 27.2. 1997 had approved the following recommendations of the Postgraduate Committee with regard to the bifurcation of Department of Radiology:-

“The postgraduate Committee considered the letter – from Dr.V.P. Mishra and Dr.B.P. Dubey (members of the postgraduate Committee/Council) and decided to agree with the proposal that upon bifurcation of departments of Radiology into separate independent departments of Radio-Diagnosis and Radio-therapy, the department of Radio-therapy only shall require inspection at the time of examination for its recognition. The department of Radio-Diagnosis shall stand covered for recognition by way of a periodical inspection as and when carried out.”

It was observed that this decision is squarely applicable for both degree and diploma courses in the erstwhile Radiology department.

In view of above, the members of the postgraduate Committee decided that the qualification of DMRD be also included as a recognized qualification in respect of those institutes wherein earlier the qualification of DMRE has been recognized by MCI and where the change of nomenclature has been effected by the concerned University/Institute in accordance with recommendations of the Council.

The agenda item Nos.112,113,114 & 115 were read and confirmed in the meeting itself.
