Minutes of the adjourned meeting of the Postgraduate Medical Education Committee held on Friday the 6<sup>th</sup> November, 2009 at 11.30 a.m. in the Office of the Medical Council of India, Pocket-14, Sector-8, Dwarka, New Delhi

**124. Discrimination by Medical Council of India (MCI) towards DNB postgraduates working in medical colleges of India.**

Read: the letter dated 20/10/2009 received from the Ministry of Health and Family Welfare alongwith the representation from Dr. Vikram Shetty from Mangalore addressed to Hon'ble Prime Minister of India regarding Discrimination by Medical Council of India (MCI) towards DNB postgraduates working in medical colleges of India.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the letter dated 20/10/2009 received from the Ministry of Health and Family Welfare forwarding representation received from Dr. Vikram Shetty, Mangalore on the subject of discrimination by Medical Council of India (MCI) towards DNB postgraduates working in medical colleges of India.

The members of the Postgraduate Committee observed that vide letter dt.13<sup>th</sup> March,2009, the Council has already forwarded its request to the Central Govt., to consider the withdrawal/recall of the notification dt. 20<sup>th</sup> Feb.,2009 being contrary to the statutory provisions of the Indian Medical Council Act, 1956 under statutory regulations made thereunder.

It was further observed that the Medical Council of India has never submitted any further proposal to the Govt. of India in this regard and as such there was neither any occasion nor any permissibility for the Govt. of India for unilaterally issuing the above mentioned notification dt.20.02.09, which is not only in direct conflict with the regulations prescribed by the MCI with the prior approval of the Govt. of India but is also in violation of the principles laid down in this regard by the Hon'ble Supreme Court, equally applicable to the Govt. of India.

The Postgraduate Committee further observed that at the time of the meeting of Hon'ble Health & Family Welfare Minister with MCI on 19.08.09 regarding the amendment of MCI's Regulations, the following position on the captioned matter is recorded in the minutes of the meeting circulated by the Central Govt., vide its letter dt. 9<sup>th</sup> September, 2009:-

*"3. Minimum Qualification for Teachers in Medical Institutions Regulation,1998*

.....iv) Equivalence of DNB with MD/MS/DM/Mch.: The Medical Council of India impressed upon the Central Government the need to recall the Central Government notification dated 20<sup>th</sup> February, 2009 for maintaining the standards of medical education in the country. It was pointed out that there is no structured residency programme of DNB and majority of the centres of DNB are private and semi-private organizations which are non teaching in character. It was agreed to revoke the above said notification and withdraw letters dated 17.08.2004 and 04.01.2006."

In view of above, the member of the Postgraduate Committee decided that the allegations made by Dr.Vikram Shetty in his complaint are baseless and devoid of any merit. This may be communicated to the Central Government.

**125. Recasting the already drafted MD/MS/ Diploma curricula into the competency mode, for which the template has been developed by the MCI-nominated group of experts.**

Read: the matter along with the recommendations of the academic cell with regard to recasting the already drafted MD/MS/Diploma curricula into the competency mode, for which the template has been developed by the MCI.

The Postgraduate Committee approved the curricula which have been converted to the competency mode in respect of postgraduate degree/diploma courses in the following subjects marked as Annexure A-U (Colly) annexed herewith.

## 126. Recommendations of the Boards of Specialty of PG/superspecialty curricula

Read: the matter along with the recommendations of the academic cell with regard to curricula of the boards of speciality / superspecialty curricula

The Postgraduate Committee considered the matter with regard to curricula of the boards of speciality/superspecialty curricula and perused the report of the Academic Cell incorporating the recommendations made by the Boards of Speciality constituted for developing the curricula for various postgraduate degree/diploma courses which reads as under:-

*“The Academic Cell constituted various Boards of Specialty to modify the existing Postgraduate Curricula or develop Curricula in Specialties where these were not drafted earlier. The members of the Board of Specialty met at the Office of the Medical Council of India to finalize the curricula. During the meeting, some of the Specialty Boards made specific recommendations. These are given below under various headings.*

### **A. New Courses to be started:**

*The respective Boards of Specialty recommended as under:*

- *A new postdoctoral course – ‘DM in Pulmonary & Critical Care Medicine’ - should be started: the curriculum for the course was prepared by the Board when they were preparing curriculum for MD for Tuberculosis and Pulmonary Medicine.*
- *The DM course in Clinical Haematology should be split into DM in Clinical haematology and DM in Haematopathology. The eligibility criteria for DM in Clinical Haematology would be MD Medicine and MD Paediatrics and for DM Haematopathology, would be MD Pathology.*
- *A unified course in ‘MD Tropical and Infectious Diseases’ may be started. Justification for starting the course has been given.*

### **B. Abolition of Course**

- *Board of Specialty for MD in Medical Genetics have recommended that MD in Medical Genetics should not be held because DM in Medical Genetics is already ongoing.*

### **C. Change in nomenclature of Course**

*The respective Boards of Specialty recommended as under:*

- *The name of the Course – ‘MD in Tuberculosis and Respiration Medicine or Pulmonary Medicine’ - may be changed to M.D. Pulmonary Medicine. Similarly, the name ‘Diploma course in Tuberculosis and Chest Diseases’ may be changed to ‘Diploma in Pulmonary Diseases’.*
- *The name of the Course ‘MD (Radiotherapy)’ may be replaced by ‘MD (Clinical Oncology)’ to keep in tune with international nomenclature.*
- *The title of the course ‘Diploma in Health Education (D.H.E)’ may be changed to ‘Post graduate Diploma in Health Promotion and Education (P.G.D.H.P.E)’*

- The 'DM course in 'Neuro-radiology' should be changed to 'DM in Neuro-imaging, Interventional and Therapeutic Neuroradiology'.

**D. Suggestion for change in Curriculum title/contents**

- The Board of Specialty in Community Medicine did not prepare a curriculum for Diploma in Community Medicine since such a course is not offered in the country. The Board recommended a common curriculum for Diploma in Public Health and Community Medicine.

**E. Recommendation to include components of discipline in MD/MS Curriculum.**

- Board of Specialty in Geriatrics which met on 25<sup>th</sup> July, 2008 has given recommendations to consider including components of Geriatrics in MD General Medicine Curriculum.  
Curriculum for MD General Medicine was already prepared (5<sup>th</sup> July) before the above suggestion by the Board of Specialty in Geriatrics."

After due and detailed deliberations, the members of the Postgraduate Committee decided to refer the matter back to the Academic Cell to resubmit with clear cut recommendations.

**127. Inclusion of Geriatric Mental Health as a subject in Post Graduate Medical Education Regulations 2000 of Medical Council of India.**

Read: the matter along with the recommendations of the Academic Cell with regard to Inclusion of Geriatric Mental Health as a subject in Postgraduate Medical Education Regulations 2000 of Medical Council of India.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the matter along with the recommendations of the Academic Cell of the Postgraduate Committee with regard to Inclusion of Geriatric Mental Health as a subject in Postgraduate Medical Education Regulations 2000 of Medical Council of India and observed that the report of the Academic Cell does not specifically mention whether Geriatric Mental Health should be included as a subject in Postgraduate Medical Education Regulations, 2000 or not. Hence it was decided to refer the matter back to the Academic Cell to resubmit with clear cut recommendations.

**128. Representation of Dr. P. Samikrishnan, General Secretary, Postgraduate Association, Madras Medical College, Chennai, Tamil Nadu - Suggestion for the change of nomenclature for DM Postgraduate Degree Course.**

Read: the matter along with the recommendations of the academic cell with regard to change of nomenclature of DM Postgraduate degree course.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the matter along with the recommendations of the academic cell with regard to change of nomenclature of DM Postgraduate degree course and observed that the Academic Cell of the Postgraduate Committee at its meeting held on 8.10.09 while considering the matter of changing the nomenclature of DM/Postgraduate degree courses has decided as under:-

“The Academic Cell of the Postgraduate Committee met on 08.10.2009 in the Council office and discussed the above matter.

Dr. P. Samirkrishnan, General Secretary, Postgraduate Association, Madras Medical College, Chennai, Tamil Nadu has represented the Tamilnadu Dr. MGR Medical University, Chennai to modify the MD expansion as Doctor of Medicine and DM expansion as Doctorate of Medicine, whereas the Academic Board of the Tamilnadu Dr. MGR Medical University, Chennai has recommended that MD may be expanded as Medicine Doctor and DM may be expanded as Doctor of Medicine.

Only the Tamilnadu Dr. MGR Medical University, Chennai has forwarded its recommendations. It is better to seek the opinion of other universities including health universities as well as relevant national associations before concluding matter”.

After due deliberations, the members of the Postgraduate Committee decided to approve the report of the Academic Cell of the Postgraduate Committee and directed the office to obtain the opinion from other Universities having Faculty of Medicine in the above matter.

**129. Change of nomenclature of Postgraduate and Diploma course from M.D. (Radio-Therapy) to M.D. (Radio-Therapy and Oncology)**

Read: the matter along with the recommendations of the academic cell with regard to Change of nomenclature of Postgraduate and Diploma course from M.D. (Radio-Therapy) to M.D. (Radio-Therapy and Oncology).

The Postgraduate Committee considered the matter along with the recommendations of the Academic Cell of the Postgraduate Committee with regard to Change of nomenclature of Postgraduate and Diploma course from M.D. (Radio-Therapy) to M.D. (Radio-Therapy and Oncology) and observed that the Academic Cell of the Postgraduate Committee has not specifically made any recommendations in the matter of change of nomenclature of degree/diploma courses in Radio-therapy and hence decided to refer the matter back to the Academic Cell of the Postgraduate Committee to consider the matter with clear cut recommendations.

**130. Starting a new course in M.Ch (Head & Neck Oncology) in India**

Read: the matter along with the recommendations of the academic cell with regard to Starting a new course in M.Ch (Head & Neck Oncology) in India

The Postgraduate Committee considered the matter along with the recommendations of the academic cell with regard to Starting a new course in M.Ch (Head & Neck Oncology) in India and observed that the Academic Cell of the Postgraduate Committee while considering the matter of starting of new courses in M.Ch. (Head & Neck Oncology) has decided as under:-

“The Academic Cell of Postgraduate Committee considered the above matter at its meeting held on 08.10.2009 and submitted the following report:

- M.Ch. Course in Surgical and Gynecological Oncology are already in the Schedule.

- DM Course in Medical Oncology is also included in the Schedule.
- The request for starting a new course – M.Ch. in Head & Neck Oncology is based on the high incidence of Head & Neck Cancers and also the development of new and complex surgical skills.
- Since Head and Neck Oncology is already included in the curriculum of M.Ch. Surgical Oncology, the Committee feels that a separate course in M.Ch. Head & Neck Oncology is not required at present. Recent advances in Skull base and Cranio-Facial Surgery can be added to the existing curriculum”.

After due and detailed deliberations, the members of the Postgraduate Committee decided to approve the report of the Academic Cell that *“a separate course in M.Ch. (Head & Neck Oncology) is not required at present. Recent advances in Skull based and Critical surgery can be added to the existing curricula of M.Ch. (Surgical Oncology).”*

**131. Rajasthan University/Rajasthan University of Health Sciences, Jaipur – Approval of J.L.N. Medical College, Ajmer for the award of MD(Microbiology) qualification.**

Read: the Council Inspector’s report (September, 2009) on the standard of examination and other teaching facilities available at J.L.N. Medical College, Ajmer for purpose of recognition of MD(Microbiology) qualification earlier granted by Rajasthan University & now by Rajasthan University of Health Sciences, Jaipur.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Inspector’s report (September, 2009) and decided to recommend that J.L.N. Medical College, Ajmer be approved for the award of MD(Microbiology) qualification earlier granted by Rajasthan University & now by Rajasthan University of Health Sciences, Jaipur restricting the number of admission to 1(One) student per year.

The Postgraduate Committee further decided that the attention of the institute be drawn to Clauses 6.4 and 6.6 of the Postgraduate Medical Education (Amendment) Regulations, 2000, Part-II, dated 21<sup>st</sup> July, 2009 and act accordingly at appropriate time, which reads as under:-

“ .....

6.4 *The recognition so granted to a Post Graduate Course shall be for a maximum period of 5 years, upon which it shall have to be renewed.*

6.6 *Failure to seek timely renewal of recognition as required in sub-clause-4 shall invariably result in stoppage of admissions to the concerned Post Graduate Course.*

... ..”

**132. Increase of seats in Postgraduate Medical courses in view of increase of allocation of seats as per teachers students ratio.**

Read: The information received from the various Government medical colleges / institutions with regard to number of Professors, No. of Units & bed strength in each Post Graduate Speciality together with the Central Government Gazette notification dated 24/07/2009 regarding amendments in clause 12(1), (2), (3) & (4) of the Postgraduate Medical Education Regulations 2000:-

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Central Government Gazette notification dated 24/07/2009 regarding amendments in clause 12(1), (2), (3) & (4) of the Postgraduate Medical Education Regulations 2000 and noted the following:-

1. The ratio of recognized postgraduate teacher to the number of students to be admitted for the degree course where diploma is not prescribed shall be 1:2 for a Professor and 1:1 for other cadres in each unit per year subject to a maximum of 4 PG seats for the degree per unit per academic year provided a complement of 10 teaching beds is added to the prescribed bed strength of 30 for the unit for broad specialities.
2. The ratio of recognized postgraduate teacher to the number of students to be admitted for the degree course in broad specialities where diploma is prescribed shall be 1:2 for a Professor and 1:1 for other cadres in each unit per

year subject to a maximum of 4 PG seats including diploma per unit per academic year provided a complement of 10 teaching beds is added to the prescribed bed strength of 30 for the unit.

3. The requirement of units and beds shall not apply in the case of Postgraduate degree or diploma courses in Basic and para-clinical departments.

Provided that against the very same units, teaching personnel and infrastructure, no other postgraduate courses under any other streams like National Board of Examinations, College of Physicians & Surgeons etc. are permitted.

4. The ratio of PG teacher to the number of students to be admitted for super specialities course shall be 1:2 for Professor/Assoc. Professor and 1:1 for remaining cadre in each unit per year subject to a maximum of 4 PG seats for the course per unit per academic year provided the complement of 10 teaching beds per seat is added to the prescribed bed strength of 20 for the unit."

Provided that against the very same units, teaching personnel and infrastructure, no other postgraduate courses under any other streams like National Board of Examinations, College of Physicians & Surgeons etc. are permitted.

Accordingly a circular was sent by the Council Office to the Health Secretaries of all the states on 15/09/2009 and 24/09/2009 requesting to direct the Deans/Principals to send the information as regards availability of Professors in the subjects of broad specialties and availability of Professors and Assoc Professors in respect of super specialties and also unit wise number of teaching beds and students.

The Committee taking into consideration the Gazette Notification dated 24.07.2009 and the information furnished by the college / institution authority decided to enhance the number of post graduate seats in various broad specialties as mentioned against each college:
