Read: the Council Inspector's report (January 2010) on the physical and other teaching facilities available at the Maharaja's Institute of Medical Sciences, Vizianagaram for starting of MS(Ophthalmology) course under the Dr. NTR University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Inspector's report (January 2010) and decided to recommend to the Central Govt. to issue Letter of Permission for starting of MS(Ophthalmology) course at Maharaja's Institute of Medical Sciences, Vizianagaram under Dr. NTR University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 prospectively i.e. from the academic session 2010-2011 restricting the number of admission to 1(One) student per year, till the first batch admitted appears in the final examination of the said course. The institution be advised to apply for recognition of the qualification at the time of first available examination as per the provision of Section 11(2) of the IMC Act, 1956.

**06. Starting of MD(Radio Diagnosis) & DMRD courses at Maharaja's Institute of Medical Sciences, Vizianagaram u/s 10 A of the Indian Medical Council Act, 1956.**

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Inspector's report (January 2010) and decided to recommend to the Central Govt. to issue Letter of Permission for starting of MD(Radio Diagnosis) & DMRD courses at Maharaja's Institute of Medical Sciences, Vizianagaram under Dr. NTR University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 prospectively i.e. from the academic session 2010-2011 restricting the number of admission to 2(Two) students per year in each course, till the first batch admitted appears in the final examination of the said courses. The institution be advised to apply for recognition of the qualifications at the time of first available examination as per the provision of Section 11(2) of the IMC Act, 1956.

**07. Starting of MD(Community Medicine) course at Bharati Vidyapeeth University Medical College, Pune u/s 10 A of the Indian Medical Council Act, 1956.**

Read: the compliance verification report (January 2010) along with the previous inspection report (November 2009) on the physical and other teaching facilities available at Bharati Vidyapeeth University Medical College, Pune for starting of MD(Community Medicine) course under Bharati Vidyapeeth University u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the compliance verification report (January 2010) along with the previous inspection report (November 2009) and decided to recommend to the Central Govt. to issue Letter of Permission for starting of MD(Community Medicine) course at Bharati Vidyapeeth University Medical College, Pune under Bharati Vidyapeeth University u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 prospectively i.e. from the academic session 2010-2011 restricting the number of admission to 5(Five) students per year, till the first batch admitted appears in the final examination of the said course. The institution be advised to apply for recognition of the qualification at the time of first available examination as per the provision of Section 11(2) of the IMC Act, 1956.

**08. Starting of MD(Obstetrics & Gynaecology) course at Army Hospital Research & Referral, New Delhi.**

Act, 1956 prospectively i.e. from the academic session 2010-2011 from 3(Three) to 6(Six) students per year till the first batch admitted against the increased number appears in the final examination of the said course. The institution be advised to apply for recognition of the qualification for the additional increased intake at the time of first available examination as per the provision of Section 11(2) of the IMC Act, 1956.

**10. Increase of seats in MS(Orthopaedics) course at Narayana Medical College, Nellore, u/s 10 A of the Indian Medical Council Act, 1956.**

Read: the Council Inspector's report (January 2010) on the physical and other teaching facilities available at the Narayana Medical College, Nellore for Increase of seats in MS(Orthopaedics) course at under Dr. N.T.R University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Inspector's report (January 2010) and decided to recommend to the Central Govt. to issue Letter of Permission for increase of seats in MS(Orthopaedics) course at Narayana Medical College, Nellore under Dr. N.T.R University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada u/s 10A of the I.M.C. Act, 1956 prospectively i.e. from the academic session 2010-2011 from 3(Three) to 5(Five) students per year till the first batch admitted against the increased number appears in the final examination of the said course. The institution be advised to apply for recognition of the qualification for the additional increased intake at the time of first available examination as per the provision of Section 11(2) of the IMC Act, 1956.

**11. Increase of seats in MS (ENT) at Pt. B. D. Sharma PGIMS, Rohtak, u/s 10 A of the Indian Medical Council Act, 1956.**

Read: the Compliance along with the Council Inspector's report (September 2009) on the physical and other teaching facilities available at Pt. B. D. Sharma PGIMS, Rohtak for Increase of seats in MS(ENT) Course under Pt. B. D. Sharma University of Health Sciences, Rohtak u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the compliance along with the Council Inspector's report (September 2009) and decided to recommend to the Central Govt. to issue Letter of Permission for increase of seats in MS(ENT) course at Pt. B. D. Sharma PGIMS, Rohtak under Pt. B. D. Sharma University of Health Sciences, Rohtak u/s 10A of the I.M.C. Act, 1956 prospectively i.e. from the academic session 2010-2011 from 3(Three) to 4(Four) students per year till the first batch admitted against the increased number appears in the final examination of the said course. The institution be advised to apply for recognition of the qualification for the additional increased intake at the time of first available examination as per the provision of Section 11(2) of the IMC Act, 1956.

**12. Increase of seats in MD(Radio-Diagnosis) and D.M.R.D. at Sri Siddhartha Medical College, Tumkur u/s 10 A of the Indian Medical Council Act, 1956.**

**13. Increase of seats in MS(ENT) at Father Muller's Institute of Medical Education and Research, Mangalore u/s 10 A of the Indian Medical Council Act, 1956.**

Read: the compliance verification report (November 2009) along with the previous inspection report (September 2009) on the physical and other teaching facilities available at Father Muller's Institute of Medical Education and Research, Mangalore for increase of seats in MS(ENT) course under Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences, Bangalore u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 .

The Postgraduate Committee considered the compliance verification report (November 2009) along with the previous inspection report (September 2009) and decided to recommend to the Central Govt. to issue Letter of Permission for increase of seats in MS(ENT) course at Father Muller's Institute of Medical Education and Research, Mangalore under Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences, Bangalore u/s 10A of the I.M.C. Act, 1956 prospectively i.e. from the academic session 2010-2011 from 1(One) to 2(two) students per year till the first batch admitted against the increased number appears in the final examination of the said course. The institution be advised to apply for recognition of the qualification for the additional increased intake at the time of first available examination as per the provision of Section 11(2) of the IMC Act, 1956.

**14. Increase of seats in Postgraduate Medical courses in view of increase of allocation of seats as per teachers students ratio.**

Read: the information received from the various Government medical colleges / institutions with regard to number of Professors, No. of Units & bed strength in each Post Graduate Speciality together with the Central Government Gazette notification dated 24/07/2009 regarding amendments in clause 12(1), (2), (3) & (4) of the Postgraduate Medical Education Regulations 2000.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Central Government Gazette notification dated 24/07/2009 regarding amendments in clause 12(1), (2), (3) & (4) of the Postgraduate Medical Education Regulations 2000 and noted the following:-

1. The ratio of recognized postgraduate teacher to the number of students to be admitted for the degree course where diploma is not prescribed shall be 1:2 for a Professor and 1:1 for other cadres in each unit per year subject to a maximum of 4 PG seats for the degree per unit per academic year provided a complement of 10 teaching beds is added to the prescribed bed strength of 30 for the unit for broad specialities.
2. The ratio of recognized postgraduate teacher to the number of students to be admitted for the degree course in broad specialities where diploma is prescribed shall be 1:2 for a Professor and 1:1 for other cadres in each unit per year subject to a maximum of 4 PG seats including diploma per unit per academic year provided a complement of 10 teaching beds is added to the prescribed bed strength of 30 for the unit.
3. The requirement of units and beds shall not apply in the case of Postgraduate degree or diploma courses in Basic and para-clinical departments.

Provided that against the very same units, teaching personnel and infrastructure, no other postgraduate courses under any other streams like National Board of Examinations, College of Physicians & Surgeons etc. are permitted.

4. The ratio of PG teacher to the number of students to be admitted for super specialities course shall be 1:2 for Professor/Assoc. Professor and 1:1 for remaining cadre in each unit per year subject to a maximum of 4 PG seats for the course per unit per academic year provided the complement of 10 teaching beds per seat is added to the prescribed bed strength of 20 for the unit."

Provided that against the very same units, teaching personnel and infrastructure, no other postgraduate courses under any other streams like National Board of Examinations, College of Physicians & Surgeons etc. are permitted.

Accordingly a circular was sent by the Council Office to the Health Secretaries of all the states on 15/09/2009 and 24/09/2009 requesting to direct the Deans/Principals to send the information as regards availability of Professors in the subjects of broad specialties and availability of Professors and Assoc Professors in respect of super specialties and also unit wise number of teaching beds and students.

The Committee taking into consideration the Gazette Notification dated 24.07.2009 and the information furnished by the college / institution authority decided to enhance the number of post graduate seats in various broad specialties as mentioned against each college:

The college authorities were also requested to send compliance within the stipulated period. However, compliance from some of the Medical Colleges have not yet been received.

It was further observed that the matter is time bound u/s 10(A) of the I.M.C. Act,1956 and the Council has to send its recommendations for grant of Letter of Permissions to the Central Government by 28<sup>th</sup> February,2010 for the academic session 2010-2011 as per the time schedule prescribed in the Regulation.

It was also observed that the Council office has to place the compliance received from the institute before appropriate authorities, to arrange for inspection in case the compliance is found satisfactory, to obtain the inspection report from the Inspector and to process it for placing it before the Postgraduate Committee for which the minimum period of 2 weeks is required.

In view of above and after due deliberations, the Postgraduate Committee decided that only those compliances received from the medical colleges/institutions up to 10.02.2010 would be considered for further necessary action by the Council for the academic year 2010-2011.
