10. There is no wardside laboratory.

12. Specialised services like ICCU, ICU, and dialysis are not provided by the department.

- (ix) There is no wardside laboratory.
- (x) Resultantly, infrastructure is inadequate.
- (xi) Other deficiencies/observations as pointed out in the inspection report.

**20. Starting of MD(Biochemistry) course at ESI-PGIMSR, Rajajinagar, Bangalore u/s 10 A of the Indian Medical Council Act, 1956.**

- (5) Fungal stock cultures are not available.
- (6) Other deficiencies/observations as pointed out in the inspection report.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Inspector's report (December, 2009) and decided to recommend to the Central Govt. not to issue Letter of Intent for increase of seats in MD(General Medicine) course at Sri Siddharath Medical College, Tumkur under Sri Siddharath University u/s 10A of the I.M.C. Act, 1956 because of the following reasons:-

- (i) Emergency/Casualty Department - infrastructure, staff & equipments - inadequate. Central oxygen & central suction was not in working condition.
- (ii) Number of patients attended in casualty were not matching with clinical scenario (e.g. - on record there were 43 patient examined in casualty by one Casualty Medical Officer on day of inspection from 9.00 am to 12.00 noon, during OPD hours.
- (iii) ICD coding not followed.
- (iv) Clinical material - it appears that computer record were tampered to meet the requirements. In OPD - on the day of inspection, name of patient written in Medicine OPD Register (hand written) were not matching with name of Medicine OPD patients in computer data maintained at OPD registration counter. In ward - number of non-specific admissions were more than specific admissions (i.e. - Many patient were admitted for simple headache, control of BP, General debility, one day fever, on clinical point of view these patients do not require hospitalization.
- (v) ICU - number of beds inadequate, only one ventilator was in working condition, patient having surgical problem were admitted, no central cardiac monitoring station available, blood gas analyzer machine is not in working condition, none of the staff was familiar with ICU procedures like central venous line insertion, no data of ICU patient maintained in Medical Record Section.
- (vi) No specialty clinics except one day hypertension clinic & one day geriatric OPD.
- (vii) Departmental library - not a single journal available.
- (viii) Departmental museum is not available.
- (ix) OPD equipment & facilities - inadequate. (Only 2 BP apparatus, No Hammer, No torch, no tongue depressor, no CNS examination tray).
- (x) Specialized investigation & diagnostic facilities - inadequate.
- (xi) There is no Associate Professor in Unit-I.
- (xii) Other deficiencies/observations as pointed out in the inspection report.

In view of above, the Committee further decided to direct the institution authorities to henceforth stop admission in MD(General Medicine) course from the academic session 2010-2011

**29. Increase of seats in MS(General Surgery) at Mahatama Gandhi Medical College & Research Institute, Pondicherry u/s 10 A of the Indian Medical Council Act, 1956.**

The Postgraduate Committee considered the compliance report alongwith Council Inspector's report (October, 2009) and decided to reiterate its earlier decision taken at its meeting held on 30.10.2009 recommending to the Central Govt. not to issue Letter of Intent for increase of seats in MD(Dermatology, Venereology & Leprosy) course at NDMVP Samaj Medical College, Nashik under Maharashtra University of Health Sciences, Nashik u/s 10A of the I.M.C. Act, 1956, as the available clinical material is just adequate for the present annual intake of 1(One) student in M.D.(DVL) & 1(One) student in D.D.V.L.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the compliance verification report (December 2009) alongwith Council Inspector's report (October, 2009) and decided to recommend to the Central Govt. to issue Letter of Permission for increase of seats in MD(Radio-Diagnosis) course at Katuri Medical College & Hospital, Guntur under Dr. NTR University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada u/s 10A of the I.M.C. Act, 1956 prospectively i.e. from the academic session 2010-2011 from 1(One) to 3(Three) students per year till the first batch admitted against the increased number appears in the final examination of the said course. However, the teaching faculty complement other than the teachers mentioned above is adequate and complete; and hence decided to recommend to the Central Govt. to issue Letter of Permission for starting of MD(Biochemistry) course at Dayanand Medical College & Hospital, Ludhiana under Baba Farid University of Health Sciences, Faridkot u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 prospectively i.e. from the academic session 2010-2011 restricting the number of admission to 2(Two) students per year, till the first batch admitted appears in the final examination of the said course. The institution be advised to apply for recognition of the qualification at the time of first available examination as per the provision of Section 11(2) of the IMC Act, 1956.

**39. Starting of MD(Radiodiagnosis) at Meenakshi Medical College Hospital & Research Institute, Tamilnadu u/s 10 A of the Indian Medical Council Act, 1956.**

The ratio of recognized postgraduate teacher to the number of students to be admitted for the degree course where diploma is not prescribed shall be 1:2 for a Professor and 1:1 for other cadres in each unit per year subject to a maximum of 4 PG seats for the degree per unit per academic year provided a complement of 10 teaching beds is added to the prescribed bed strength of 30 for the unit for broad specialities.
2. The ratio of recognized postgraduate teacher to the number of students to be admitted for the degree course in broad specialities where diploma is prescribed shall be 1:2 for a Professor and 1:1 for other cadres in each unit per year subject to a maximum of 4 PG seats including diploma per unit per academic year provided a complement of 10 teaching beds is added to the prescribed bed strength of 30 for the unit.
3. The requirement of units and beds shall not apply in the case of Postgraduate degree or diploma courses in Basic and para-clinical departments.  
Provided that against the very same units, teaching personnel and infrastructure, no other postgraduate courses under any other streams like National Board of Examinations, College of Physicians & Surgeons etc. are permitted.
4. The ratio of PG teacher to the number of students to be admitted for super specialities course shall be 1:2 for Professor/Assoc. Professor and 1:1 for remaining cadre in each unit per year subject to a maximum of 4 PG seats for

the course per unit per academic year provided the complement of 10 teaching beds per seat is added to the prescribed bed strength of 20 for the unit.”

Provided that against the very same units, teaching personnel and infrastructure, no other postgraduate courses under any other streams like National Board of Examinations, College of Physicians & Surgeons etc. are permitted.

Accordingly a circular was sent by the Council Office to the Health Secretaries of all the states on 15/09/2009 and 24/09/2009 requesting to direct the Deans/Principals to send the information as regards availability of Professors in the subjects of broad specialties and availability of Professors and Assoc Professors in respect of super specialties and also unit wise number of teaching beds and students.

*Therefore in view of the above, the College authorities has requested to re-look the matter."*
