3. **Increase of seats in MD(Anaesthesia) course at Agartala Government Medical College, Agartala under Tripura University, Agartala u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.**

Read: the Council Assessor's report (22nd January, 2014) on the physical and other teaching facilities available at Agartala Government Medical College, Agartala under Tripura University, Agartala for Increase of seats in MD(Anaesthesia) course u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Assessor's report (22nd January, 2014) and decided to recommend to the Central Govt. to disapprove the scheme for Increase of seats in MD(Anaesthesia) course at Agartala Government Medical College, Agartala under Tripura University, Agartala u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 because of the following reasons:-

1. There is no Dean, Dr. H. Sharmah, Professor & HoD of Forensic Medicine is also working as i/c Principal.
2. Shortage of faculty for PG: (a) Asst. Prof.: 1
3. Total operative workload of major operations is 25 for all O.T.s combined; daily average is 2.2 / OT / day.
4. Monitored anaesthetic care is not available.
5. More equipment like multipara monitors with ETCO 2, are needed.
6. Number of journals in Central Library are only 80 against requirement of 100. No Indian journals are available after 2010.
7. There is no ICCU
8. Other deficiencies pointed out in the Assessment Report.

4. **Increase of seats in MS(Ophthalmology) course at Agartala Government Medical College, Agartala under Tripura University, Agartala u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.**

Read: the Council Assessor's report (21st January, 2014) on the physical and other teaching facilities available at Agartala Government Medical College, Agartala under Tripura University, Agartala for Increase of seats in MS(Ophthalmology) course u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Assessor's report (21st January, 2014) and decided to recommend to the Central Govt. to disapprove the scheme for Increase of seats in MS(Ophthalmology) course at Agartala Government Medical College, Agartala under Tripura University, Agartala u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 because of the following reasons:-

1. There is no Dean, Dr. H. Sharmah, Professor & HoD of Forensic Medicine is also working as i/c Principal.
2. Postgraduate degree of Dr. D.S. Pan, professor & HOD is not recognized.
3. Keratoplasty & Eye bank are not available.
4. Clinical material data of last 3 years not provided in report.

5. Other deficiencies pointed out in the Assessment Report.

**5. Increase of seats in MD(Radio-Diagnosis) course at Bharati Vidyapeeth Medical College & Hospital, Pune under Bharati Vidyapeeth Deemed University,Pune u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.**

Read: the Council Assessor's report (08th January, 2014) on the physical and other teaching facilities available at Bharati Vidyapeeth Medical College & Hospital, Pune under Bharati Vidyapeeth Deemed University,Pune for Increase of seats in MD(Radio-Diagnosis) course u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Assessor's report (08th January, 2014) and decided to recommend to the Central Govt. to disapprove the scheme for Increase of seats in MD(Radio-Diagnosis) course at Bharati Vidyapeeth Medical College & Hospital, Pune under Bharati Vidyapeeth Deemed University,Pune u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 because of the following reasons:-

1. Promotion of Dr. S. Chaudhary as Associate Professor is not as per regulations. Promoted after 4 years and 2 months. His publications are after his promotion period.
2. 3 Static X-ray Units are short.
3. Other deficiencies pointed out in the Assessment Report.

**6. Increase of seats in MS(OBG) course at Bharati Vidyapeeth Medical College & Hospital, Pune under Bharati Vidyapeeth Deemed University,Pune u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.**

Read: the Council Assessor's report (18th January, 2014) on the physical and other teaching facilities available at Bharati Vidyapeeth Medical College & Hospital, Pune under Bharati Vidyapeeth Deemed University,Pune for Increase of seats in MS(OBG) course u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Assessor's report (18th January, 2014) and decided to recommend to the Central Govt. to disapprove the scheme for Increase of seats in MS(OBG) course at Bharati Vidyapeeth Medical College & Hospital, Pune under Bharati Vidyapeeth Deemed University,Pune u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 because of the following reasons:-

1. On day of assessment, only 1 mother was going to be delivered; no other cases seen in labor room. No mother was seen in Eclampsia room.
2. There is no record of Gynaecology major operation done on & from 07/01/2014 to 17/01/2014 in O.T. register. On 16/01/2014 there was no major operation performed. In OPD there were 16 new & 44 old antenatal cases in Obstetrics & 42 total (PNC + Gynaecological) cases in Gynaecology. Record keeping in O.T. is very poor. No separate register maintained for major & minor operations. There is only 1 register for all operations.
3. No record seen & no register maintained for postgraduate teaching activities like seminars, case presentations, journal club, etc.
4. There are 120 beds but distribution into different sections like antenatal ward, Gynaecological ward, postnatal ward, etc. is not seen. All mothers are mixed up in all the wards.
5. No USG machine seen in indoor patients department.
6. In departmental library, no issue register seen. There is not a single journal.
7. Gynaec Endocrine clinic is not available.
8. Other deficiencies pointed out in the Assessment Report.

7. **Increase of seats in MD(Psychiatry) course at Burdwan Medical College, Burdwan under The West Bengal University of Health Sciences, Kolkata u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.**

Read: the Council Assessor's report (20th January, 2014) on the physical and other teaching facilities available at Burdwan Medical College, Burdwan under The West Bengal University of Health Sciences, Kolkata for Increase of seats in MD(Psychiatry) course u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Assessor's report (20th January, 2014) and decided to recommend to the Central Govt. to issue Letter of Permission for Increase of seats in MD(Psychiatry) course at Burdwan Medical College, Burdwan under The West Bengal University of Health Sciences, Kolkata u/s 10A of the I.M.C. Act, 1956 prospectively i.e. from the academic session 2014-2015 from 2 (Two) to 3 (Three) students per year till the first batch admitted against the increased number appears in the final examination of the said course. The institution be advised to apply for recognition of the qualification for the additional increased intake at the time of first available examination as per the provision of Section 11(2) of the IMC Act, 1956.

8. **Increase of seats in MD(Paediatrics) course at Burdwan Medical College, Burdwan under The West Bengal University of Health Sciences, Kolkata u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.**

Read: the Council Assessor's report (20th January, 2014) on the physical and other teaching facilities available at Burdwan Medical College, Burdwan under The West Bengal University of Health Sciences, Kolkata for Increase of seats in MD(Paediatrics) course u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Assessor's report (20th January, 2014) and decided to recommend to the Central Govt. to disapprove the scheme for Increase of seats in MD(Paediatrics) course at Burdwan Medical College, Burdwan under The West Bengal University of Health Sciences, Kolkata u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 because of the following reasons:-

1. Paramedical staff like Child Psychologist, Health Educator & Medical Social Worker are not available.
2. Total no. of patients in OPD & IPD has declined in last 3 years.
3. Shortage of senior residents by 2.
4. Other deficiencies pointed out in the Assessment Report.

9. **Increase of seats in MD(Anaesthesia) course at Burdwan Medical College, Burdwan under The West Bengal University of Health Sciences, Kolkata u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.**

Read: the Council Assessor's report (20th January, 2014) on the physical and other teaching facilities available at Burdwan Medical College, Burdwan under The West Bengal University of Health Sciences, Kolkata for Increase of seats in MD(Anaesthesia) course u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Assessor's report (20th January, 2014) and decided to recommend to the Central Govt. to disapprove the scheme for Increase of seats in MD(Anaesthesia) course at Burdwan Medical College, Burdwan under The West Bengal University of Health Sciences, Kolkata u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 because of the following reasons:-

1. Deficiency of faculty for PG: (a) Asst. Prof.: 1.
2. Foreign journals are available only upto December 2012.
3. Total number of minor surgeries & deliveries has declined in last 3 years.

4. Other deficiencies pointed out in the Assessment Report.

**10. Increase of seats in MD(Community Medicine) course at Burdwan Medical College, Burdwan under The West Bengal University of Health Sciences, Kolkata u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.**

Read: the Council Assessor's report (20th & 21st January, 2014) on the physical and other teaching facilities available at Burdwan Medical College, Burdwan under The West Bengal University of Health Sciences, Kolkata for Increase of seats in MD(Community Medicine) course u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Assessor's report (20th & 21st January, 2014) and decided to recommend to the Central Govt. to issue Letter of Permission for Increase of seats in MD(Community Medicine) course at Burdwan Medical College, Burdwan under The West Bengal University of Health Sciences, Kolkata u/s 10A of the I.M.C. Act, 1956 prospectively i.e. from the academic session 2014-2015 from 5 (Five) to 6 (Six) students per year till the first batch admitted against the increased number appears in the final examination of the said course. The institution be advised to apply for recognition of the qualification for the additional increased intake at the time of first available examination as per the provision of Section 11(2) of the IMC Act, 1956.

**11. Starting of MD(Radio-Diagnosis) course at Burdwan Medical College, Burdwan under The West Bengal University of Health Sciences, Kolkata u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.**

Read: the Council Assessor's report (20th January, 2014) on the physical and other teaching facilities available at Burdwan Medical College, Burdwan under The West Bengal University of Health Sciences, Kolkata for Starting of MD(Radio-Diagnosis) course u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Assessor's report (20th January, 2014) and decided to recommend to the Central Govt. to issue Letter of Permission for Starting of MD(Radio-Diagnosis) course at Burdwan Medical College, Burdwan under The West Bengal University of Health Sciences, Kolkata u/s 10A of the I.M.C. Act, 1956 prospectively i.e. from the academic session 2014-2015 restricting the number of admissions to 4 (Four) students per year, till the first batch admitted appears in the final examination of the said course. The institution be advised to apply for recognition of the qualification at the time of first available examination as per the provision of Section 11(2) of the IMC Act, 1956.

**12. Increase of seats in MS(OBG) course at Burdwan Medical College, Burdwan under The West Bengal University of Health Sciences, Kolkata u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.**

Read: the Council Assessor's report (20th January, 2014) on the physical and other teaching facilities available at Burdwan Medical College, Burdwan under The West Bengal University of Health Sciences, Kolkata for Increase of seats in MS(OBG) course u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Assessor's report (20th January, 2014) and decided to recommend to the Central Govt. to issue Letter of Permission for Increase of seats in MS(OBG) course at Burdwan Medical College, Burdwan under The West Bengal University of Health Sciences, Kolkata u/s 10A of the I.M.C. Act, 1956 prospectively i.e. from the academic session 2014-2015 from 6 (Six) to 10 (Ten) students per year till the first batch admitted against the increased number appears in the final examination of the said course. The institution be advised to apply

for recognition of the qualification for the additional increased intake at the time of first available examination as per the provision of Section 11(2) of the IMC Act, 1956.

**13. Increase of seats in MS(General Surgery) course at Burdwan Medical College, Burdwan under The West Bengal University of Health Sciences, Kolkata u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.**

Read: the Council Assessor's report (20th January, 2014) on the physical and other teaching facilities available at Burdwan Medical College, Burdwan under The West Bengal University of Health Sciences, Kolkata for Increase of seats in MS(General Surgery) course u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Assessor's report (20th January, 2014) and decided to recommend to the Central Govt. to disapprove the scheme for Increase of seats in MS(General Surgery) course at Burdwan Medical College, Burdwan under The West Bengal University of Health Sciences, Kolkata u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 because of the following reasons:-

1. Out of 6 units, 3 units are having only 2 teaching faculty.
2. Shortage of Senior Resident: 2.
3. Postgraduate degree of Dr. K.N. Majumdar in Unit II, professor is not recognized. Hence, this Unit cannot be counted.
4. Unit VI has only 24 beds.
5. Other deficiencies pointed out in the Assessment Report.

**14. Increase of seats in MD(General Medicine) course at Burdwan Medical College, Burdwan under The West Bengal University of Health Sciences, Kolkata u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.**

Read: the Council Assessor's report (17th January, 2014) on the physical and other teaching facilities available at Burdwan Medical College, Burdwan under The West Bengal University of Health Sciences, Kolkata for Increase of seats in MD(General Medicine) course u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Assessor's report (17th January, 2014) and decided to recommend to the Central Govt. to disapprove the scheme for Increase of seats in MD(General Medicine) course at Burdwan Medical College, Burdwan under The West Bengal University of Health Sciences, Kolkata u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 because of the following reasons:-

1. There are only 4 working Units against requirement of 6. Unit II & Unit IV have only 2 faculty each; hence cannot be considered as PG Units.
2. All faculty except 3 could not produce original documents for verification till end of assessment.
3. Shortage of Senior resident: 1.
4. There are no Residents from Medicine in emergency area which is managed by RMO. Resuscitation equipment like ECG, Nebulizer or AMBU bag, etc. are not available in emergency area.
5. There is no ICCU in hospital campus.
6. Teaching room for students in OPD is in messy condition, very small in size and is not having chairs. There was no examination couch.
7. Casualty is very primitive.
8. Record section is partly computerized.
9. Teaching space in OPD is inadequate.
10. Journals are available only upto 2012.
11. Dr. R. Sarkar Asso. Professor was absent.
12. Other deficiencies pointed out in the Assessment Report.

**15. Increase of seats in MD(Pathology) course at Chettinad Hospital & Research Institute, Kanchipuram, Tamilnadu under Chettinad Academy of Research & Education (Deemed to be University) u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.**

Read: the Council Assessor's report (05th December 2013) on the physical and other teaching facilities available at Chettinad Hospital & Research Institute, Kanchipuram, Tamilnadu under Chettinad Academy of Research & Education (Deemed to be University) for Increase of seats in MD(Pathology) course u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Assessor's report (05th December 2013) and decided to recommend to the Central Govt. to disapprove the scheme for Increase of seats in MD(Pathology) course at Chettinad Hospital & Research Institute, Kanchipuram, Tamilnadu under Chettinad Academy of Research & Education (Deemed to be University) u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 because of the following reasons:-

1. Dr. S.P. Subiah, Professor is shown as Professor of Transfusion Medicine. No teaching experience in pathology is shown & he cannot be considered as faculty. Resultantly, deficiency of teaching faculty is (a) Asso. Prof.: 1; (b) Tutor: 1.
2. Annual specimens processed from cytology have decline over a period of last 3 years.
3. Although number of major surgeries has decreased over a period of last 3 years, annual specimens processed for surgical Pathology have increased 2 ½ times over the same period which is not feasible. There is a data mismatch.
4. Other deficiencies pointed out in the Assessment Report.

**16. Increase of seats in MD(Paediatrics) course at Chittaranjan Seva Sadan Hospital, Kolkata under The West Bengal University of Health Sciences, Kolkata u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.**

Read: the Council Assessor's report (18th January, 2014) on the physical and other teaching facilities available at Chittaranjan Seva Sadan Hospital, Kolkata under The West Bengal University of Health Sciences, Kolkata for Increase of seats in MD(Paediatrics) course u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Assessor's report (18th January, 2014) and decided to recommend to the Central Govt. to disapprove the scheme for Increase of seats in MD(Paediatrics) course at Chittaranjan Seva Sadan Hospital, Kolkata under The West Bengal University of Health Sciences, Kolkata u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 because of the following reasons:-

1. Facilities for blood component are not available in the institute.
2. Postgraduate degree of Dr. Tarpada Ghosh, Asso. Prof. in Unit II is not recognized.
3. Indian journals in Central Library are inadequate.
4. Hostels for students and Central Research Laboratory are available in IPGMER and not in the institute.
5. Paediatric Gastroenterology, Cardiology, Echocardiography & Neurology are not available.
6. ICCU & ICU are not available in the institute.
7. Radiological and laboratory investigations are grossly inadequate in the institute.
8. There is no website.
9. MRD is not computerized.
10. MOU of laundry not available.

11. Other deficiencies pointed out in the Assessment Report.

**17. Increase of seats in MS(OBG) course at Chittaranjan Seva Sadan Hospital, Kolkata under The West Bengal University of Health Sciences, Kolkata u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.**

Read: the Council Assessor's report (20th January, 2014) on the physical and other teaching facilities available at Chittaranjan Seva Sadan Hospital, Kolkata under The West Bengal University of Health Sciences, Kolkata for Increase of seats in MS(OBG) course u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Assessor's report (20th January, 2014) and decided to recommend to the Central Govt. to disapprove the scheme for Increase of seats in MS(OBG) course at Chittaranjan Seva Sadan Hospital, Kolkata under The West Bengal University of Health Sciences, Kolkata u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 because of the following reasons:-

1. Facilities for blood component are not available in the institute.
2. There is no Asso. Prof. in Unit I; Resultantly, teaching complement is incomplete in Unit I.
3. No unit wise registers maintained for major operative workload. Cleanliness and sterility are not maintained properly in major OT. Minor OT procedures are done in major OT. There is a single changing room with improper doors.
4. Hysteroscopy is not available. Artificial insemination is not available.
5. CSSD is in poor condition. There is no bifurcation of soiled & clean linen.
6. No registers are maintained for family planning work.
7. There is no website.
8. Office space for faculty is inadequate. There is a single room with 2 chairs for all Asst. Prof.
9. Major operation specimens are sent outside with no registers. There is no separate register of operations for the department.
10. Labour room hygiene and cleanliness are poor. Parturition registers are maintained by staff nurses with incomplete entries. There is suboptimal working. Instruments are sterilized by boiling method with less number of delivery sets. There is no separate enema room or septic labour room.
11. Emergency & casualty patients are not examined in no instruments available.
12. OPD is very congested with no privacy for PV examination. Registers are poorly documented. Gynaec OPD speciality clinic boards not available with no registers. Gynaec Endocrine Clinic is not functional.
13. MRD is not computerized.
14. Documentation in Radiodiagnosis is inadequate.
15. MOU of laundry not available.
16. Other deficiencies pointed out in the Assessment Report.

**18. Increase of seats in MD(Paediatrics) course at Dr. B.C. Roy Postgraduate Institute of Paediatrics Sciences, Kolkata under The West Bengal University of Health Sciences, Kolkata u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.**

Read: the Council Assessor's report (20th January, 2014) on the physical and other teaching facilities available at Dr. B.C. Roy Postgraduate Institute of Paediatrics Sciences, Kolkata under The West Bengal University of Health Sciences, Kolkata for Increase of seats in MD(Paediatrics) course u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Assessor's report (20th January, 2014) and decided to recommend to the Central Govt. to disapprove the scheme for Increase of seats in MD(Paediatrics) course at Dr. B.C. Roy Postgraduate Institute of Paediatrics Sciences, Kolkata under The West Bengal University of Health Sciences, Kolkata u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 because of the following reasons:-



1. Total beds are 326 in 3 Units which is not as per Regulations.
2. Paediatric Gastroenterology & Cardiology are not available.
3. No Auditorium is available.
4. Postgraduate degree of Dr. Rita Chaterjee, Dr. D.K. Paul & Dr. K. Mondal is not recognized.
5. Promotion of Dr. Sushma Sahoo, Assoc. Professor is not as per regulation (Promoted after 4 years 5 months as Asst. Professor without publications.)
6. Other deficiencies pointed out in the Assessment Report.

**19. Increase of seats in MS(General Surgery) course at Dr. Somervell Memorial CSI Hospital & Medical College Thiruvananthapuram under Kerala University of Health & Allied Sciences, Thrissur u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.**

Read: the Council Assessor's report (22nd January, 2014) on the physical and other teaching facilities available at Dr. Somervell Memorial CSI Hospital & Medical College Thiruvananthapuram under Kerala University of Health & Allied Sciences, Thrissur for Increase of seats in MS(General Surgery) course u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Assessor's report (22nd January, 2014) and decided to recommend to the Central Govt. to disapprove the scheme for Increase of seats in MS(General Surgery) course at Dr. Somervell Memorial CSI Hospital & Medical College Thiruvananthapuram under Kerala University of Health & Allied Sciences, Thrissur u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 because of the following reasons:-

1. There are only 2 faculty in Unit II & IV each; hence they cannot be accepted as PG Unit.
2. Bed Occupancy is 70-75%.
3. Other deficiencies pointed out in the Assessment Report.

Read: the Council Assessor's report (27th January 2014) on the physical and other teaching facilities available at Dr. Ulhas Patil Medical College & Hospital, Jalgaon, Maharashtra under Maharashtra University of Health Sciences, Nashik for Starting of MD(Paediatrics) course u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Assessor's report (27th January 2014) and decided to recommend to the Central Govt. to disapprove the scheme for Starting of MD(Paediatrics) course at Dr. Ulhas Patil Medical College & Hospital, Jalgaon, Maharashtra under Maharashtra University of Health Sciences, Nashik u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 because of the following reasons:-

1. Postgraduate degree of Dr. J.M. Kulkarni, Professor & HOD is not recognized.
2. Average daily OPD is 87 for Unit I or 78 for Unit II. There is only one unit working in OPD per day. Resultantly, average OPD attendance is inadequate.
3. PaediatricHaematology service is not available.
4. Other deficiencies pointed out in the Assessment Report.

**188. Starting of MD(Pathology) & Diploma in Clinical Pathology course at Govt. Medical College, Akola under Maharashtra University of Health Sciences, Nashik u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.**

Read: the Council Assessor's report (03rd February 2014) on the physical and other teaching facilities available at Govt. Medical College, Akola under Maharashtra University of Health Sciences, Nashik for Starting of MD(Pathology) & Diploma in Clinical Pathology course u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Assessor's report (03rd February 2014) and decided to recommend to the Central Govt. to disapprove the scheme for Starting of MD(Pathology) & Diploma in Clinical Pathology course at Govt. Medical College, Akola under Maharashtra University of Health Sciences, Nashik u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 because of the following reasons:-

1. PG hostel is under construction.
2. No journals are available for 2013 in Central Library.
3. There are no publications from the department in indexed journals in last 3 years.
4. Annual surgical specimens processed from Pathology are only 932 (i.e. < 3 / day). Annual specimens processed for cytology are only 1334 (i.e. < 4 / day).
5. Bone marrow biopsy is not performed.
6. Facilities for special investigations of urine samples are not available.
7. Other deficiencies pointed out in the Assessment Report.

**189. Increase of seats in MD(TB & Respiratory Medicine) course at Govt. Medical College, Kolkata under The West Bengal University of Health Sciences, Kolkata u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.**

Read: the Council Assessor's report (30th January, 2014) on the physical and other teaching facilities available at Govt. Medical College, Kolkata under The West Bengal University of Health Sciences, Kolkata for Increase of seats in MD(TB & Respiratory Medicine) course u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Assessor's report (30th January, 2014) and decided to recommend to the Central Govt. to issue Letter of Permission for Increase of seats in MD(TB & Respiratory Medicine) course at Govt. Medical College, Kolkata under The West Bengal University of Health Sciences, Kolkata u/s 10A of the I.M.C. Act, 1956 prospectively i.e. from the academic session 2014-2015 from 1 (One) to 2 (Two) students per year till the first batch admitted against the increased number appears in the final examination of the said course. The institution be advised to apply for recognition of the qualification for the additional increased intake at the time of first available examination as per the provision of Section 11(2) of the IMC Act, 1956.

**190. Starting of MD(Psychiatry) course at Geetanjali Medical College & Hospital, Udaipur under Geetanjali University, Udaipur, Rajasthan u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.**

Read: the Council Assessor's report (28th January 2014) on the physical and other teaching facilities available at Geetanjali Medical College & Hospital, Udaipur under Geetanjali University, Udaipur, Rajasthan for Starting of MD(Psychiatry) course u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Assessor's report (28th January 2014) and decided to recommend to the Central Govt. to disapprove the scheme for Starting of MD(Psychiatry) course at Geetanjali Medical College & Hospital, Udaipur under Geetanjali University, Udaipur, Rajasthan u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 because of the following reasons:-

1. Clinical material (both OPD & IPD) not adequate.
2. Other deficiencies pointed out in the Assessment Report.

**191. Starting of MD(Anaesthesia) course at Geetanjali Medical College & Hospital, Udaipur under Geetanjali University, Udaipur, Rajasthan u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.**

Read: the Council Assessor's report (24th January 2014) on the physical and other teaching facilities available at Geetanjali Medical College & Hospital, Udaipur under Geetanjali University, Udaipur, Rajasthan for Starting of MD(Anaesthesia) course u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Assessor's report (24th January 2014) and decided to recommend to the Central Govt. to disapprove the scheme for Starting of MD(Anaesthesia) course at Geetanjali Medical College & Hospital, Udaipur under Geetanjali University, Udaipur, Rajasthan u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 because of the following reasons:-

1. Dr. S.S. Jairawat, Professor & HOD was appointed as Asso. Prof. without any teaching experience as Asst. Prof. which is not as per Regulations.
2. Promotion of Dr. RakeshKushwaha, Asso. Prof. is not as per Regulations as he has been promoted as Asso. Prof. only with an experience of 4 y 3 m as Asst. Prof.
3. Resultantly, there is deficiency of 2 Asso. Prof.
4. Average total daily major operations are 27.95 distributed in 11 OTs, giving an average of 2.5 major operations/ day/ OT which is inadequate.
5. Other deficiencies pointed out in the Assessment Report.

**192. Increase of seats in MD(Community Medicine) course at Hind Institute of Medical Sciences, Uttar Pradesh under Dr. R.M.L Avadh University, Faizabad, U.P. u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.**

Read: the Council Assessor's report (31st January & 1st February 2014) on the physical and other teaching facilities available at Hind Institute of Medical Sciences, Uttar Pradesh under Dr. R.M.L Avadh University, Faizabad, U.P. for Increase of seats in MD(Community Medicine) course u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Assessor's report (31st January & 1st February 2014) and decided to recommend to the Central Govt. to disapprove the scheme for Increase of seats in MD(Community Medicine) course at Hind Institute of Medical Sciences, Uttar Pradesh under Dr. R.M.L Avadh University, Faizabad, U.P. u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 because of the following reasons:-

1. Infrastructure is deficient as the room of Professor & HOD is smaller than the prescribed norm of 18 sq.m. Similarly, the rooms of faculty members are smaller in size.
2. There is very little space for paramedical sections of the department. Department office is not available.
3. There is no demonstration room of 45 sq. m. with chairs and audiovisual aids to accommodate 50 -60 students.
4. Paramedical staff are deficient and many of them are not qualified for the post held by them - e.g. Health Inspector, Medical Social Worker, Health Educator, etc.
5. Books & journals on the subject are inadequate in Central & Departmental Library.
6. MRD did not show 24 hour census of patients. OPD attendance was observed to be < 300. Trained staff like MRO & MRT are not available. MRD is not computerized & it does not use ICD X classification of diseases.
7. UHC is located in 3 rooms of a hospital without any dedicated staff. Catchment area of UHC is not shown. Neither socio-demographic profile of families in UHC work area are available.
8. RHTC is shown in a hospital without any dedicated staff. It works as outreach centre of the main hospital. Demographic profile is not available. Family folders of the families in the catchment area are available.
9. Field practice area of UHC & RHTC are providing only OPD services but not implementing or imparting training in any national Health programme. Training programme for PG is not available.
10. Epidemiologist cum lecturer is not available. Statistician cum Lecturer is not available.
11. In item # 12, Part II, it is mentioned that medical social workers available are 2 male & 2 female in RHTC, 2 male & 2 female in UHC & 1 in main department. However, in Item # 4 in Part II, in the list of paramedical staff, no medical social worker is shown in the main department. No female medical social worker is shown either in UHC or RHTC.
12. Other deficiencies pointed out in the Assessment Report.

**193. Starting of MD(Physiology) course at Hind Institute of Medical Sciences, Uttar Pradesh under Dr. R.M.L Avadh University, Faizabad, U.P. u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.**

Read: the Council Assessor's report (31st February, 2014) on the physical and other teaching facilities available at Hind Institute of Medical Sciences, Uttar Pradesh under Dr. R.M.L Avadh University, Faizabad, U.P. for Starting of MD(Physiology) course u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Assessor's report (31st February, 2014) and decided to recommend to the Central Govt. to disapprove the scheme for Starting of MD(Physiology) course at Hind Institute of Medical Sciences,

Uttar Pradesh under Dr. R.M.L Avadh University, Faizabad, U.P. u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 because of the following reasons:-

1. Equipment like Polygraph machines, Bicycle Ergometers, Arc perimeters are non-functional.
2. CPSEA guidelines on animal house are not followed. No explanation is given by the institute why the question of following CPSEA guidelines does not arise.
3. Other deficiencies pointed out in the Assessment Report.

**194. Increase of seats in MD(Pathology) course at Hind Institute of Medical Sciences, Uttar Pradesh under Dr. R.M.L Avadh University, Faizabad, U.P. u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.**

Read: the Council Assessor's report (1st February 2014) on the physical and other teaching facilities available at Hind Institute of Medical Sciences, Uttar Pradesh under Dr. R.M.L Avadh University, Faizabad, U.P. for Increase of seats in MD(Pathology) course u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.

1. Postgraduate Degree of the Dr. Safiya, Professor & HOD is not recognized.
2. There are no publications from the department in indexed journals in last 3 years.
3. Dark ground microscopy is not available.
4. Other deficiencies pointed out in the Assessment Report.

**196. Starting of MD(Microbiology) course at North Bengal Medical College, Darjeeling, West Bengal under The West Bengal University of Health Sciences, Kolkata u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.**

Read: the Council Assessor's report (27th January 2014) on the physical and other teaching facilities available at North Bengal Medical College, Darjeeling, West Bengal

under The West Bengal University of Health Sciences, Kolkata for Starting of MD(Microbiology) course u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Assessor's report (27th January 2014) and decided to recommend to the Central Govt. to disapprove the scheme for Starting of MD(Microbiology) course at North Bengal Medical College, Darjeeling, West Bengal under The West Bengal University of Health Sciences, Kolkata u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 because of the following reasons:-

1. One of the Asst. Prof., Dr. N.K. Tudu is on deputation to BankuraSammilani Medical College since 02/05/2013.
2. Deficiency of faculty is as under: (a) Asso. Prof.: 1; (b) Tutor: 2
3. No new books have been purchased in departmental library in last 3 years.
4. Animal house is not available.
5. Stock culture & test sera are not available.
6. There is no separate postgraduate laboratory.
7. Other deficiencies pointed out in the Assessment Report.

1. Frozen Section is not available.
2. Average daily workload total of major & minor surgeries is shown as 41.26 while average daily Histopathological workload is shown as 75 which is not feasible.
3. Total number of major & minor surgeries in 2013 is shown as 10,804 while annual specimens processed for surgical pathology are shown as 16,789 which is not feasible.
