2. CSSD needs to be modernized. Staff & equipment are inadequate.

4. Other deficiencies pointed out in the assessment report.

1. There is only 1 Unit against requirement of 2 Units as per Regulations.
2. There is no Professor. Faculty complement is incomplete.
3. C.T. scan is not available.
4. The institute has shown 3 affiliated hospitals – viz., at Parel, Worli & Mulund. However there are only 5 beds each at Worli & Mulund hospitals and hence cannot be considered as teaching hospitals.
5. Dr. V.H. Jokhi, shown as Asso. Prof. is not qualified to hold the post as he possesses experience of only 2 y as Asst. Prof. His experience as a Consultant cannot be equated as teaching experience in terms of Section 11(1)(d) of PG Medical Education Regulations, 2000 as amended as it is applicable to only those specialists who were working in hospitals where PG teaching was being imparted in accordance with Section 8(1A) which is not the case with this institute.
6. Major operations have decreased at MGM Hospital from 144 in 2011 to 62 in 2013 which is grossly inadequate.
7. Other deficiencies pointed out in the assessment report.

4. Adequate number of books on the subject are not available in Central library.
5. Average daily workload of major operations for major operations is only 20-25 which is inadequate.
6. The figures of clinical material quoted by the institute are not commensurate with number of investigations and blood units consumed daily.
7. Equipment in PICU & NICU is not adequate.
8. There are only 40 books in the departmental library.
9. Anaesthesia equipment in some of the O.T.s are not available.
10. Periodic appraisal of PG students is not done. Examination is conducted partly as per MCI norms.

4. Seating capacity in the library is grossly inadequate.
5. 3 years clinical data is not provided.

3. OPD attendance shown in their reports & registers seem inflated. On day of assessment, there were about 100 patients in OPD against claimed attendance of 280 - 300.
4. O.T. & Surgical load: Figures of Surgical load seem to be grossly inflated. In the O.T. which was supposed to be for spine and replacement Surgery, the O.T. register records showed 28 patients operated in 2 weeks from 15/05/2014 to 28/05/2014. On specifically asked where are these patients kept postoperatively, it was told "in ICU". But none of the records of these patients were found in ICU & even none of these patients were found admitted in Orthopaedics wards. The O.T. was not functioning on day of assessment. This indicates total cooking up of data provided to assessor.
5. Recovery Room: There were only 2 beds in recovery room which is used as preoperative room, postoperative room & resuscitation room in O.T. complex. No resuscitation equipment is available in this room. It is grossly insufficient for O.T. load shown.
6. Occupational therapy: No occupational therapy Unit & facilities are existing.
7. Total number of major Surgeries has decreased from 4,695 in 2012 to 3,634 in 2013. Total number of minor surgeries has decreased from 1,935 in 2012 to 593 in 2013.
8. Other deficiencies pointed out in the assessment report.
