1. Minutes of the last meeting of the Postgraduate Committee - confirmation of.

The Postgraduate Committee confirmed the minutes of the Postgraduate Committee meeting held on 20th & 21st February, 2014.

2. Minutes of the last meeting of the Postgraduate Committee - action taken thereon.

The Postgraduate Committee noted & approved the action taken on the minutes of the meeting of the Postgraduate Committee held on 20th & 21st February, 2014.

3. Increase of seats in MD(Paediatrics) course at Government Medical College, Patiala under Baba Farid University of Health Sciences, Faridkot u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.

Read: the Council Assessor's report (15/02/2014) on the physical and other teaching facilities available at Government Medical College, Patiala under Baba Farid University of Health Sciences, Faridkot for Increase of seats in MD(Paediatrics) course u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Assessor's report (15/02/2014) and decided to recommend to the Central Govt. to disapprove the scheme for Increase of seats in MD(Paediatrics) course at Government Medical College, Patiala under Baba Farid University of Health Sciences, Faridkot u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 because of the following reasons:-

1. Central Research laboratory is not available.
2. There are only 74 beds against requirement of 90 beds; crib beds cannot be considered because they are non-teaching beds and not assigned to Units.
3. Promotion of Dr. Dharam Pal, Professor in Unit I as Asso. Prof. is not as per Regulations as he has been promoted as Asso. Prof. with experience of only 1 y 10 m as Asst. Prof.; resultantly faculty complement is inadequate in Unit I. Unit II & III have only 2 faculty each; hence cannot be considered as PG Units.
4. Resultantly none of the Units qualifies as PG Unit.
5. There are no Senior residents; Shortage of Senior Residents: 5.
6. Average daily OPD is 65 only.
7. PICU is not available.
8. No. of new Paediatric Books and Paediatric Journals are few. No foreign journals are available after 2012.
9. MRD is not computerized.
10. No new books have been purchased in last 3 years.
11. Community Paediatric services are not available.
12. Endoscopy, Echocardiography for the children are not available in the department.
13. Diarrhoea clinic is not run by the department.
14. No specific clinics are being run.
15. No Paediatric intensive care facility.
16. Other deficiencies pointed out in the assessment report.

4. Increase of seats in MD(Community Medicine) course at Government Medical College, Patiala under Baba Farid University of Health Sciences, Faridkot u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.

Read: the Council Assessor's report (10th & 11th February, 2014) on the physical and other teaching facilities available at Government Medical College, Patiala under Baba Farid University of Health Sciences, Faridkot for Increase of seats in MD(Community Medicine) course u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Assessor's report (10th & 11th February, 2014) and decided to recommend to the Central Govt. to disapprove the scheme for Increase of seats in MD(Community Medicine) course at Government Medical College, Patiala under Baba Farid University of Health Sciences, Faridkot u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 because of the following reasons:-

1. Promotion of Dr. Praveen Mittal is not as per Regulations as he has been promoted after 3 years and 7 Months as Asst. Professor.
2. Though there are 7 faculty on record, one is involved full time in MS office activities and another at DMER, Chandigarh. In effect, there are

- only 5 faculty (including 1 each at UHTC & RHTC) which is inadequate.
3. Deficiency of faculty: (a) Asst. Prof.: 1; (b) Epidemiologist cum lecturer: 1; (c) Tutors: 4; (d) Lady Medical Officer at both RHTC & UHTC.
 4. Paramedical sections like Health Education, Epidemiology, etc. do not exist. Paramedical staff is grossly inadequate.
 5. There is lack of sufficient space for faculty & staff members in the department.
 6. Vehicle is not available in the department.
 7. Books and journals in Central & Departmental Library are grossly inadequate. No journals are available after 2012. No new books have been purchased in departmental library in last 3 years.
 8. MEU exists on paper only. No faculty from the department is trained Medical Education technology. No training for PG students in research methodology, thesis writing, etc. is conducted for PG students.
 9. Department laboratory is not in use. Classes are conducted in museum also. Museum needs upgradation with new charts, diagrams, etc.
 10. UHC is located in a small room in Tripuri CHC. Administrative control of Dean is only on paper. It needs upgradation and more involvement in national health programmes.
 11. Administrative control of RHTC Bhandson to the college exists on paper only.
 12. Family folders are not available either at UHC or at RHTC.
 13. Internship is for 15 days duration each at RHTC & UHC. It is non-residential and is left to CMO of CHC, Bhandson.
 14. PG teaching and training is not conducted as per MCI norms.
 15. Central research Laboratory is not available.
 16. Capacity of Demonstration Room is 20 only.
 17. Promotion of Dr. R.S. Balgir is not as per Regulations.
 18. Other deficiencies pointed out in the assessment report.
5. **Starting of MD(Community Medicine) course at Hassan Institute of Medical Sciences, Hassan under Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences, Karnataka u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.**

Read: the Council Assessor's report (10th & 11th February, 2014) on the physical and other teaching facilities available at Hassan Institute of Medical Sciences, Hassan under Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences, Karnataka for Starting of MD(Community Medicine) course u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Assessor's report (10th & 11th February, 2014) and decided to recommend to the Central Govt. to disapprove the scheme for Starting of MD(Community Medicine) course at Hassan Institute of Medical Sciences, Hassan under Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences, Karnataka u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 because of the following reasons:-

1. Promotions of Dr. G. Venkatesh & Dr. G. Praveen are not as per Regulations.
 2. Deficiency of faculty: (a) Epidemiologist cum Lecturer: 1; (b) Lecturer cum M.O.: 1
 3. Other deficiencies pointed out in the assessment report.
6. **Starting of MD(Forensic Medicine) course at Hassan Institute of Medical Sciences, Hassan under Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences, Karnataka u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.**

Read: the Council Assessor's report (10/02/2014) on the physical and other teaching facilities available at Hassan Institute of Medical Sciences, Hassan under Rajiv

Gandhi University of Health Sciences, Karnataka for Starting of MD(Forensic Medicine) course u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Assessor's report (10/02/2014) and decided to recommend to the Central Govt. to disapprove the scheme for Starting of MD(Forensic Medicine) course at Hassan Institute of Medical Sciences, Hassan under Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences, Karnataka u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 because of the following reasons:-

1. Equipment for autopsy examination is not available.
2. Deficiency of faculty: (a) Tutor: 2 (Department is conducting > 500 post-mortems).
3. No Foreign Journals.
4. Other deficiencies pointed out in the assessment report.

7. **Starting of MD(Forensic Medicine) course at Mandya Institute of Medical Sciences, Mandya, Karnataka under Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences, Karnataka u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.**

Read: the Council Assessor's report (13/02/2014) on the physical and other teaching facilities available at Mandya Institute of Medical Sciences, Mandya, Karnataka under Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences, Karnataka for Starting of MD(Forensic Medicine) course u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Assessor's report (13/02/2014) and decided to recommend to the Central Govt. to issue Letter of Permission for Starting of MD(Forensic Medicine) course at Mandya Institute of Medical Sciences, Mandya, Karnataka under Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences, Karnataka u/s 10A of the I.M.C. Act, 1956 prospectively i.e. from the academic session 2014-2015 restricting the number of admissions to 1 (One) student per year, till the first batch admitted appears in the final examination of the said course. The institution be advised to apply for recognition of the qualification at the time of first available examination as per the provision of Section 11(2) of the IMC Act, 1956.

8. **Starting of MD(DVL) course at Mandya Institute of Medical Sciences, Mandya, Karnataka under Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences, Karnataka u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.**

Read: the Council Assessor's report (13th February, 2014) on the physical and other teaching facilities available at Mandya Institute of Medical Sciences, Mandya, Karnataka under Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences, Karnataka for Starting of MD(DVL) course u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Assessor's report (13th February, 2014) and decided to recommend to the Central Govt. to issue Letter of Permission for Starting of MD(DVL) course at Mandya Institute of Medical Sciences, Mandya, Karnataka under Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences, Karnataka u/s 10A of the I.M.C. Act, 1956 prospectively i.e. from the academic session 2014-2015 restricting the number of admissions to 1 (One) student per year, till the first batch admitted appears in the final examination of the said course. The institution be advised to apply for recognition of the qualification at the time of first available examination as per the provision of Section 11(2) of the IMC Act, 1956.

9. Starting of MD(Physiology) course at Mandya Institute of Medical Sciences, Mandya, Karnataka under Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences, Karnataka u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.

Read: the Council Assessor's report (13/02/2014) on the physical and other teaching facilities available at Mandya Institute of Medical Sciences, Mandya, Karnataka under Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences, Karnataka for Starting of MD(Physiology) course u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Assessor's report (13/02/2014) and decided to recommend to the Central Govt. to disapprove the scheme for Starting of MD(Physiology) course at Mandya Institute of Medical Sciences, Mandya, Karnataka under Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences, Karnataka u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 because of the following reasons:-

1. The number of required tutors is 4 as per MCI norms. The website of the Institute as accessed on 13/02/2014 shows only 1 tutor in Physiology. On physical verifications 4 tutors were found and out of these 4 tutors, 2 tutors were transferred to Department of Physiology from Department of Community Medicine on 1st February (i.e. 12 days back) and one tutor from Department of Forensic Medicine on 23/01/2014. Further, the appointment of these tutors are only for 6 months.
2. Central Research Laboratory not available.
3. Other deficiencies pointed out in the assessment report.

10. Starting of MS(Ophthalmology) course at Mandya Institute of Medical Sciences, Mandya, Karnataka under Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences, Karnataka u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.

Read: the Council Assessor's report (12/02/2014) on the physical and other teaching facilities available at Mandya Institute of Medical Sciences, Mandya, Karnataka under Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences, Karnataka for Starting of MS(Ophthalmology) course u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Assessor's report (12/02/2014) and decided to recommend to the Central Govt. to disapprove the scheme for Starting of MS(Ophthalmology) course at Mandya Institute of Medical Sciences, Mandya, Karnataka under Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences, Karnataka u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 because of the following reasons:-

1. The only Unit has 2 faculty; hence it cannot be considered as PG Unit.
2. No Senior Residents are available.
3. Space in OPD is small.
4. There is no regular OT allocated to the department. Only one makeshift room OT with 2 tables is available twice a week. Total number of major surgeries has decreased from 686 in 2011 to 382 in 2013, giving daily average of 1.3 / day which is inadequate. Only small incision cataract surgery is performed as per OT register.
5. No speciality clinics are run by the department.
6. Investigative aids like FA, OCT & USG are not available.
7. Central Research Laboratory is not available.
8. Keratoplasty & Eye bank are not available.
9. There are no publications from the department in indexed journals in last 3 years.
10. Other deficiencies pointed out in the assessment report.

11. Starting of MS(ENT) course at Mandya Institute of Medical Sciences, Mandya, Karnataka under Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences, Karnataka u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.

Read: the Council Assessor's report (13/02/2014) on the physical and other teaching facilities available at Mandya Institute of Medical Sciences, Mandya, Karnataka under Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences, Karnataka for Starting of MS(ENT) course u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Assessor's report (13/02/2014) and decided to recommend to the Central Govt. to disapprove the scheme for Starting of MS(ENT) course at Mandya Institute of Medical Sciences, Mandya, Karnataka under Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences, Karnataka u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 because of the following reasons:-

1. Operative workload and range of operations is inadequate. It is 12/ week which gives daily average of 2. Present OT is shared with other departments and works only twice a week.
2. Audiometrician is not available.
3. Shortage of Senior Resident: 1.
4. There are no Junior Residents.
5. Bed Occupancy on the day of assessment was 70%
6. Other deficiencies pointed out in the assessment report.

12. Increase of seats in MS(General Surgery) course at Netaji Subhash Chandra Bose Medical College Jabalpur (M.P.) under Rani Durgawti Vishwavidyalaya, Jabalpur u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.

Read: the Council Assessor's report (17/01/2014) on the physical and other teaching facilities available at Netaji Subhash Chandra Bose Medical College Jabalpur (M.P.) under Rani Durgawti Vishwavidyalaya, Jabalpur for Increase of seats in MS(General Surgery) course u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Assessor's report (17/01/2014) and decided to recommend to the Central Govt. to disapprove the scheme for Increase of seats in MS(General Surgery) course at Netaji Subhash Chandra Bose Medical College Jabalpur (M.P.) under Rani Durgawti Vishwavidyalaya, Jabalpur u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 because of the following reasons:-

1. There is no Asso. Prof. in Unit I; resultantly, faculty complement is inadequate.
2. Unit V & VI have only 2 faculty each; hence they cannot be considered as PG Units.
3. Average daily OPD is 70.35.
4. Other deficiencies pointed out in the assessment report.

13. Increase of seats in MD(Physiology) course at Netaji Subhash Chandra Bose Medical College Jabalpur (M.P.) under Rani Durgawti Vishwavidyalaya, Jabalpur u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.

Read: the Council Assessor's report (12/02/2014) on the physical and other teaching facilities available at Netaji Subhash Chandra Bose Medical College Jabalpur (M.P.) under Rani Durgawti Vishwavidyalaya, Jabalpur for Increase of seats in MD(Physiology) course u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Assessor's report (12/02/2014) and decided to recommend to the Central Govt. to disapprove the scheme for Increase of seats in MD(Physiology) course at Netaji Subhash Chandra Bose Medical

College Jabalpur (M.P.) under Rani Durgawti Vishwavidyalaya, Jabalpur u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 because of the following reasons:-

1. There is no Professor in the Department. The Department is headed by Asso. Professor.
2. Other deficiencies pointed out in the assessment report.

However, the Institution did not comply with the decision of the General Body dated 16/11/2007 to stop admission, a Legal opinion may be obtained in this regard for further action in the matter.

14. Increase of seats in MD(Anatomy) course at Netaji Subhash Chandra Bose Medical College Jabalpur (M.P.) under Rani Durgawti Vishwavidyalaya, Jabalpur u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.

Read: the Council Assessor's report (10/02/2014) on the physical and other teaching facilities available at Netaji Subhash Chandra Bose Medical College Jabalpur (M.P.) under Rani Durgawti Vishwavidyalaya, Jabalpur for Increase of seats in MD(Anatomy) course u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Assessor's report (10/02/2014) and decided to recommend to the Central Govt. to issue Letter of Permission for Increase of seats in MD(Anatomy) course at Netaji Subhash Chandra Bose Medical College Jabalpur (M.P.) under Rani Durgawti Vishwavidyalaya, Jabalpur u/s 10A of the I.M.C. Act, 1956 prospectively i.e. from the academic session 2014-2015 from 1 (One) to 5 (Five) students per year till the first batch admitted against the increased number appears in the final examination of the said course. The institution be advised to apply for recognition of the qualification for the additional increased intake at the time of first available examination as per the provision of Section 11(2) of the IMC Act, 1956.

However, the Institution did not comply with the decision of the General Body dated 16/11/2007 to stop admission, a Legal opinion may be obtained in this regard for further action in the matter.

15. Starting of MD(Forensic Medicine) course at Pramukhswami Medical College, Karamsad (Gujarat) under Sardar Patel University, Gujarat u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.

Read: the Council Assessor's report (12th February, 2014) on the physical and other teaching facilities available at Pramukhswami Medical College, Karamsad (Gujarat) under Sardar Patel University, Gujarat for Starting of MD(Forensic Medicine) course u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Assessor's report (12th February, 2014) and decided to recommend to the Central Govt. to disapprove the scheme for Starting of MD(Forensic Medicine) course at Pramukhswami Medical College, Karamsad (Gujarat) under Sardar Patel University, Gujarat u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 because of the following reasons:-

1. PG Teaching compliment is not complete as there is only 2 faculties in the department.
2. Other deficiencies pointed out in the assessment report.

16. Starting of MS(OBG) course at Rajiv Gandhi Institute of Medical Sciences, Srikakulam under Dr. NTR University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.

Read: the Council Assessor's report (12/02/2014) on the physical and other teaching facilities available at Rajiv Gandhi Institute of Medical Sciences, Srikakulam under Dr. NTR University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada for Starting of MS(OBG) course u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Assessor's report (12/02/2014) and decided to recommend to the Central Govt. to disapprove the scheme for Starting of MS(OBG) course at Rajiv Gandhi Institute of Medical Sciences, Srikakulam under Dr. NTR University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 because of the following reasons:-

1. There is no Professor. Department & Unit I are headed by Asso. Prof. Unit II has only 1 Faculty hence, it cannot be considered as a teaching Unit.
2. OPD: Number of cubicles not adequate. Separate consultation room for Professor / HOD not available. No privacy for patients. PV examination area not available. Family Planning OPD inadequate, examination room not available. It is managed by M.O. not working in the department.
3. Labour Room: Instruments not adequate. Ventouse apparatus not functioning. Sterilization of instruments not adequate. Minor PT procedures performed in Labour Room. Labour Room sterility not adequate.
4. O.T.: There is no Minor O.T. Specimens sent to Pathology department but there is no corresponding entry in Pathology department.
5. Departmental office is not available.
6. There are no minutes of meetings or registers of MMR, PNMR meetings.
7. There is no seminar room. Audiovisual aids are not available.
8. Critical care area for Obstetrics & for Gynaecology are not available.
9. There is no departmental library.
10. Unit II has only 2 faculty; hence it cannot be considered as PG Unit.
11. MTP clinic & Menopausal Clinic are not run by the department.
12. Artificial insemination is not available.
13. There are no publications from the department in indexed journals in last 3 years.
14. Other deficiencies pointed out in the assessment report.

17. Increase of seats in MD(Pharmacology) course at S. Nijalingappa Medical College & HSK Hospital & Research Centre, Bagalkot under Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences, Karnataka u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.

Read: the Council Assessor's report (12/02/2014) on the physical and other teaching facilities available at S. Nijalingappa Medical College & HSK Hospital & Research Centre, Bagalkot under Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences, Karnataka for Increase of seats in MD(Pharmacology) course u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Assessor's report (12/02/2014) and decided to recommend to the Central Govt. to issue Letter of Permission for Increase of seats in MD(Pharmacology) course at S. Nijalingappa Medical College & HSK Hospital & Research Centre, Bagalkot under Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences, Karnataka u/s 10A of the I.M.C. Act, 1956 prospectively i.e. from the academic session 2014-2015 from 1 (One) to 2 (Two) students per year till the first batch admitted against the increased number appears in the final examination

of the said course. The institution be advised to apply for recognition of the qualification for the additional increased intake at the time of first available examination as per the provision of Section 11(2) of the IMC Act, 1956.

18. Increase of seats in MS(General Surgery) course at S. Nijalingappa Medical College & HSK Hospital & Research Centre, Bagalkot under Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences, Karnataka u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.

Read: the Council Assessor's report (12/02/2014) on the physical and other teaching facilities available at S. Nijalingappa Medical College & HSK Hospital & Research Centre, Bagalkot under Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences, Karnataka for Increase of seats in MS(General Surgery) course u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Assessor's report (12/02/2014) and decided to recommend to the Central Govt. to disapprove the scheme for Increase of seats in MS(General Surgery) course at S. Nijalingappa Medical College & HSK Hospital & Research Centre, Bagalkot under Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences, Karnataka u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 because of the following reasons:-

1. Total average daily major operations are only 5-6 in 6 OTs which gives an average of about 1 major operation / OT / day which is inadequate.
2. Stipend is not paid to any Resident.
3. Other deficiencies pointed out in the assessment report.

19. Increase of seats in MD(Anaesthesia) course at S. Nijalingappa Medical College & HSK Hospital & Research Centre, Bagalkot under Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences, Karnataka u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Assessor's report (12th February, 2014) and decided to recommend to the Central Govt. to disapprove the scheme for Increase of seats in MD(Anaesthesia) course at S. 5. Bed occupancy is 65 %, mostly occupied by trauma and low back pain patients.
6. There are 2 tables in O.T. but one table was totally vacant during assessment and another one was run by Senior Resident only.
7. Orthopaedics department is having one room of Professor, one for Asst. Prof. and one for Residents but they were looking unused for long time.
8. There is no Asso. Prof. in Unit I. Dr. KunalVij, Asst. Prof. did not have any residence proof. Resultantly, faculty complement is not complete.
9. Dr. P.K. Suri, shown as Professor in Unit II was absent on day of assessment. Dr. Rajiv Kumar, Asso. Prof. and Dr. Anil K. Sharma Asst. Prof. in Unit II are not having any residence proof.; resultantly faculty complement is not complete in Unit II.
10. Though it is stated in SIF that blood bank is issuing 20 - 25 units / day, issue register shows issue of 8 - 9 bags only.
11. Although average daily major operations are shown as 3, average daily histopathological workload from the department is shown as 7.7 which is not feasible. There is data mismatch.
12. Occupational therapy is not available.
13. Other deficiencies pointed out in the assessment report.

1. Clinical workload as claimed by the institute seems to be false and inadequate. As per the institute's claim, total number of major surgeries are 1,954; total minor surgeries 3,883 and average number of deliveries per day is 6 - 7. Average daily OPD is 154 and average daily IPD is 18. However when during the visit of the labour room, there was no patient in labour room. In eclampsia room, there was no patient of eclampsia but preeclamptic patients were shown as eclamptic patients. In Gynaecology ward, post partum and post caesarean patients were admitted and shown as Gynaecology patients. There was only 1 surgery in OT on the day of assessment and second theater allotted to Gynaecology was in fact being used by Urology. The data in OT register was mismatching with data given by the institute. The same data was

matched with Histopathology department which was again controversial. Data given regarding radiology, pathology, microbiology and biochemistry seemed to be inflated.

2. There is no emergency Obstetric O.T.
3. Specialty clinics are not run by the department.
4. ART center is not available.
5. Average daily operative workload of major operations is shown as 7 while average daily Histopathological workload from the department is shown as 12 which is not feasible. There is data mismatch.
6. Average occupancy of NICU is 39 %.
7. Critical care area for Obstetrics & Gynaecology is not available.
8. Other deficiencies pointed out in the assessment report.

3. Promotion of Dr. R.K. Singh is not as per regulations as he has worked as Asst. Professor for 4 years 1 month.
4. No Blood component separation facility available in the college.
5. Other deficiencies pointed out in the assessment report.

63. Increase of seats in MD(General Medicine) course at Stanley Medical College, Tamil Nadu under The Tamilnadu Dr. MGR Medical Univeristy, Chennai u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.

Read: the Council Assessor's report (10th February 2014) on the physical and other teaching facilities available at Stanley Medical College, Tamil Nadu under The Tamilnadu Dr. MGR Medical Univeristy, Chennai for Increase of seats in MD(General Medicine) course u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.
