4. Office for faculty is inadequate.
5. Average daily OPD is 30 - 35.
6. Class room & teaching space inadequate.
7. Other deficiencies pointed out in the assessment report.

2. No facility for Kidney transplant
3. Biopsy work is only 5 - 6 / month which is less.
4. Dr. G. Suresh Kumar, Asso. Prof. has not submitted relieving order from the previous institute with his D.F. He has joined the institute on 01/01/2014.
5. There are only 40 books in Departmental Library.
6. Other deficiencies pointed out in the assessment report.

10. Starting of M.Ch(Neuro-Surgery) course at Deccan College of Medical Sciences, Hyderabad under Dr. NTR University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.

Read: the Council Assessor's report (20th February, 2014) on the physical and other teaching facilities available at Deccan College of Medical Sciences, Hyderabad under Dr. NTR University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada for Starting of M.Ch(Neuro-Surgery) course u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Assessor's report (20th February, 2014) and decided to recommend to the Central Govt. to disapprove the scheme for Starting of M.Ch(Neuro-Surgery) course at Deccan College of Medical Sciences, Hyderabad under Dr. NTR University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 because of the following reasons:-

1. Blood Component facility not available.
2. Daily OPD 12-15 per day
3. No departmental Library
4. Kidney transplant facility not available.
5. No special equipment for neurosurgery
6. No separate ICU for Neuro Surgery
7. Operative workload Major 1-2 per day
8. Other deficiencies pointed out in the assessment report.

11. Starting of M.Ch (Paediatric Surgery) course at Deccan College of Medical Sciences, Hyderabad under Dr. NTR University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.

Read: the Council Assessor's report (20th February, 2014) on the physical and other teaching facilities available at Deccan College of Medical Sciences, Hyderabad under Dr. NTR University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada for Starting of M.Ch (Paediatric Surgery) course u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Assessor's report (20th February, 2014) and decided to recommend to the Central Govt. to disapprove the scheme for Starting of M.Ch (Paediatric Surgery) course at Deccan College of Medical Sciences, Hyderabad under Dr. NTR University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 because of the following reasons:-

1. Teaching complement is inadequate. Dr. G. Raghavendra Prasad was shown as Professor. His appointment order as Asst. Prof. and relieving order from the previous institute were not submitted.
2. Clinical material is inadequate. Only 3 Neonatal surgeries are performed in a year. There are no Thoracic or Emergency Abdominal Surgeries performed.
3. Average daily OPD is 22.
4. Average daily major operations is only 1 only.
5. Instruments and other facilities are inadequate. Operative Laparoscopic Surgery equipment is not available.
6. Blood component separation is not available in P.E. Hospital where this department is located.
7. Other deficiencies pointed out in the assessment report.

12. Starting of M.Ch.(Urology) course at Father Mullers Institute of Medical Education and Research, Mangalore under Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences, Karnataka u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.

Read: the Council Assessor's report (11/03/2014) on the physical and other teaching facilities available at Father Mullers Institute of Medical Education and Research, Mangalore under Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences, Karnataka for Starting of M.Ch.(Urology) course u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Assessor's report (11/03/2014) and decided to recommend to the Central Govt. to issue Letter of

Permission for Starting of M.Ch.(Urology) course at Father Mullers Institute of Medical Education and Research, Mangalore under Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences, Karnataka u/s 10A of the I.M.C. Act, 1956 prospectively i.e. from the academic session 2014-2015 restricting the number of admissions to 1 (One) student per year, till the first batch admitted appears in the final examination of the said course. The institution be advised to apply for recognition of the qualification at the time of first available examination as per the provision of Section 11(2) of the IMC Act, 1956.

13. Starting of DM(Neonatology) course at Indira Gandhi Institute of Child Health, Bangalore under Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences, Karnataka u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.

Read: the Council Assessor's report (03/03/2014) on the physical and other teaching facilities available at Indira Gandhi Institute of Child Health, Bangalore under Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences, Karnataka for Starting of DM(Neonatology) course u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Assessor's report (03/03/2014) and decided to recommend to the Central Govt. to disapprove the scheme for Starting of DM(Neonatology) course at Indira Gandhi Institute of Child Health, Bangalore under Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences, Karnataka u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 because of the following reasons:-

1. There is no maternity wing or labour room within this hospital. Hence high risk deliveries are not attended by trainees. Attached maternity hospital is about 1.5 - 2 kms. Away but only low risk deliveries are conducted there.
2. Average daily OPD is 45 which includes OPD attendance at own hospital IGICH & Jaynagar Hospitals and also High risk; hence OPD at individual hospital is too low.
3. None of the faculty has qualification in Neonatology.
4. No publications from the department.
5. Other deficiencies pointed out in the assessment report.

14. Increase of seats in M.Ch.(Paediatric Surgery) course at Indira Gandhi Institute of Child Health, Bangalore under Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences, Karnataka u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.

Read: the Council Assessor's report (06/03/2014) on the physical and other teaching facilities available at Indira Gandhi Institute of Child Health, Bangalore under Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences, Karnataka for Increase of seats in M.Ch.(Paediatric Surgery) course u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Assessor's report (06/03/2014) and decided to recommend to the Central Govt. to issue Letter of Permission for Increase of seats in M.Ch.(Paediatric Surgery) course at Indira Gandhi Institute of Child Health, Bangalore under Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences, Karnataka u/s 10A of the I.M.C. Act, 1956 prospectively i.e. from the academic session 2014-2015 from 1 (One) to 2 (Two) students per year till the first batch admitted against the increased number appears in the final examination of the said course. The

Read: the Council Assessor's report (14/03/2014) on the physical and other teaching facilities available at JJM Medical College, Davangere under Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences, Karnataka for Starting of M.Ch.(Paediatric Surgery) course u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Assessor's report (14/03/2014) and decided to recommend to the Central Govt. to disapprove the scheme for Starting of M.Ch.(Paediatric Surgery) course at JJM Medical College, Davangere under Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences, Karnataka u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 because of the following reasons:-

1. Most of the faculty has teaching experience in General Surgery mostly, not sufficient in Paediatric Surgery, as required. The D.F. of faculty are self contradictory in some cases.
2. There is no posting of Senior Resident to look after and admit and operate patients round the clock.
3. Research work is poor.
4. Clinical material is inadequate. Average daily OPD is only 10 / day.
5. No Neonatal Surgical beds are present.
6. There are 2 Units in 2 hospitals - BH & BCHI. Out of these, the Unit at BCHI has only 2 faculty; hence it cannot be considered as PG Unit.
7. Departmental Library does not exist.
8. Other deficiencies pointed out in the assessment report.

16. Starting of DM (Nephrology) course at JSS Medical College, Mysore under JSS University, Mysore u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.

Read: the Council Assessor's report (03/03/2014) on the physical and other teaching facilities available at JSS Medical College, Mysore under JSS University, Mysore for Starting of DM (Nephrology) course u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Assessor's report (03/03/2014) and decided to recommend to the Central Govt. to disapprove the scheme for Starting of DM (Nephrology) course at JSS Medical College, Mysore under JSS University, Mysore u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 because of the following reasons:-

1. Dr. Aiyappa M.R. who is shown as Senior Resident was also shown as Senior Resident in Medicine. He cannot be counted and consequently, there is a deficiency of 1 Senior Resident.
2. Experience details of H.O.D. Dr. M.S. Shetty has given on page 2 of SAF and declaration form do not match. His promotion from Associate to Professor is not as per Regulations.
3. Electron microscopy is not available.
4. Renal biopsy less than 1 per day.
5. Other deficiencies pointed out in the assessment report.

Office Note: Council office is directed to write a letter to the college seeking clarification on the discrepancy of Dr. Manjunath S. Shetty, Professor & HoD, whose experience details as given on page 2 of SAF & Declaration forms do not match.

17. Starting of M.Ch (Neuro-Surgery) course at JSS Medical College, Mysore under JSS University, Mysore u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.

Read: the Council Assessor's report (10/03/2014) on the physical and other teaching facilities available at JSS Medical College, Mysore under JSS University, Mysore for Starting of M.Ch (Neuro-Surgery) course u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Assessor's report (10/03/2014) and decided to recommend to the Central Govt. to disapprove the scheme for Starting of M.Ch (Neuro-Surgery) course at JSS Medical College, Mysore under JSS University, Mysore u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 because of the following reasons:-

1. Promotion of Col. T.S. Vasan, Professor & HoD is not as per regulations. As per Director General, Armed Forces Medical Services letter dated 2/8/2002, which was approved by the General Body on 24/03/2003 Command Hospital, Kolkata is not in the list of teaching hospitals.
2. Daily Major Surgery 1.4 only.
3. No Regular Death review meeting.
4. Other deficiencies pointed out in the assessment report.

18. Increase of seats in M.Ch (Urology) course at JSS Medical College, Mysore under JSS University, Mysore u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.

Read: the Council Assessor's report (03/03/2014) on the physical and other teaching facilities available at JSS Medical College, Mysore under JSS University, Mysore for Increase of seats in M.Ch (Urology) course u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Assessor's report (03/03/2014) and decided to recommend to the Central Govt. to disapprove the scheme for Increase of seats in M.Ch (Urology) course at JSS Medical College, Mysore under JSS University, Mysore u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 because of the following reasons:-

1. ESWL machine presently not available.
2. Dr. P. P. Darakh (Asst. Prof.) has not submitted reliable DNB degree proof.
3. There is no publication by any faculty member.
4. Other deficiencies pointed out in the assessment report.

19. Starting of M.Ch(Plastic Surgery) course at JSS Medical College, Mysore under JSS University, Mysore u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.

Read: the Council Assessor's report (22nd February, 2014) on the physical and other teaching facilities available at JSS Medical College, Mysore under JSS University, Mysore for Starting of M.Ch(Plastic Surgery) course u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Assessor's report (22nd February, 2014) and decided to recommend to the Central Govt. to disapprove the scheme for Starting of M.Ch(Plastic Surgery) course at JSS Medical College, Mysore under JSS University, Mysore u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 because of the following reasons:-

1. Department space, including office, are inadequate. There is no Residents' duty room. There is no museum. There are no Radiological or Surgical specimens.
2. Clinical material is inadequate. Bed occupancy was 60 % on day of assessment. Types of cases were inadequate.
3. There is no separate departmental seminar room. Audiovisual equipment is not available.
4. There is no specific ward designated for Burns and Plastic Surgery.
5. There is no separate O.T. for Plastic Surgery. Number of blood units consumed are verified and found to be inadequate.
6. In OPD, attendance of new patients is inadequate.
7. Other deficiencies pointed out in the assessment report.

20. Starting of DM (Cardiology) course at JSS Medical College, Mysore under JSS University, Mysore u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.

Read: the Council Assessor's report (04/03/2014) on the physical and other teaching facilities available at JSS Medical College, Mysore under JSS University, Mysore for Starting of DM (Cardiology) course u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Assessor's report (04/03/2014) and decided to recommend to the Central Govt. to disapprove the scheme for Starting of DM (Cardiology) course at JSS Medical College, Mysore under JSS University, Mysore u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 because of the following reasons:-

1. Promotions of Dr. Arun Srinivas, Dr. Guru Prasad and Dr. Sunil Kumar are not as per Regulations as their experience of non-teaching hospital cannot be counted. Consequently, teaching complement is incomplete
2. No publication from the department in three years
3. There is no Halter Monitoring facility.
4. No EPS/ RFA
5. Dr. Venkatesh C.R., Senior Resident was also shown as Senior Resident in Medicine. He cannot be counted as Senior Resident.
6. Other deficiencies pointed out in the assessment report.

Office Note: Council office is directed to write a letter to the college seeking clarification on the discrepancy of Dr. Venkatesh R., Senior Resident in Cardiology who has also been shown as Senior Resident in the department of General Medicine.

21. Starting of DM(Neonatology) course at Kasturba Medical College, Manipal under Manipal University, Karnataka u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.

Read: the Council Assessor's report (12/03/2014) on the physical and other teaching facilities available at Kasturba Medical College, Manipal under Manipal University, Karnataka for Starting of DM(Neonatology) course u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Assessor's report (12/03/2014) and decided to recommend to the Central Govt. to disapprove the scheme for Starting of DM(Neonatology) course at Kasturba Medical College, Manipal under Manipal University, Karnataka u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 because of the following reasons:-

1. Neonatology Unit is part of Department of Paediatrics.

2. Average daily OPD is only 6.

1. Bed occupancy was 36.67 % on day of assessment.
2. In OPD, there were only 13 cases on day of assessment.
3. There was no major or minor surgery on day of assessment.

4. There was no patient in ICU.
5. There is no biopsy, FNAC, Frozen Section.
6. There is only 1 faculty in the only Unit; hence it cannot be accepted as a Unit at all; resultantly, there is no Unit which can qualify as a PG Unit.
7. There are no Senior or Junior Residents.
8. Average daily operative workload of major operations is only 1 - 2.
9. Other deficiencies pointed out in the assessment report.

104. Starting of M.Ch.(Paediatric Surgery) course at B.J. Govt. Medical College, Pune under Maharashtra University of Health Sciences, Nashik u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.

Read: the Council Assessor's report (13th March 2014) on the physical and other teaching facilities available at B.J. Govt. Medical College, Pune under Maharashtra University of Health Sciences, Nashik for Starting of M.Ch.(Paediatric Surgery) course u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Assessor's report (13th March 2014) and decided to recommend to the Central Govt. to disapprove the scheme for Starting of M.Ch.(Paediatric Surgery) course at B.J. Govt. Medical College, Pune under Maharashtra University of Health Sciences, Nashik u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 because of the following reasons:-

1. No separate department of paediatric Surgery exists. It is a Unit of General Surgery only. There are no separate beds dedicated for Paediatric Surgery.
2. Infrastructure is grossly inadequate. There are no separate wards, no intensive care area, no separate O.T., no separate OPD space & no separate office space.
3. Instrumentation is grossly inadequate. There are no separate Paediatric Surgery endoscopic equipment (like uroendoscopy, bronchoscopy, oesophagoscopy or laparoscopy) dedicated for the department of Paediatric Surgery. Many equipment are non-functional. Muscle Stimulator is not available.
4. Office staff for the department is not available.
5. The only Professor, Dr. Dasmit Singh Khokar who is shown regular on contract basis is actually a part timer who is paid only Rs. 1,500 p.m. and does private practice in a few clinics/hospitals in Pune. He has neither signed D.F. nor submitted requisite documents; hence he cannot be considered as faculty.
6. Resultantly, there is no Professor in the department.
7. Clinical material is inadequate. On average, only 40 cases / month are seen in OPD which runs twice a week.
8. The number of operations performed every year by the department (380 - 491 over a period of 3 years) seems to be inflated figure. It was revealed that these figures are higher as the faculty also operates on patients admitted in other Units. The number of operations had decreased from 491 in 2011 to 380 in 2012 and 445 in 2013.
9. There are no Senior or Junior Residents in the department.
10. Other deficiencies pointed out in the assessment report.

105. Increase of seats in DM(Cardiology) course at Govt. Medical College, Kolkata under The West Bengal University of Health Sciences, Kolkata u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.

Read: the Council Assessor's report (15th March 2014) on the physical and other teaching facilities available at Govt. Medical College, Kolkata under The West Bengal University of Health Sciences, Kolkata for Increase of seats in DM(Cardiology) course u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Assessor's report (15th March 2014) and decided to recommend to the Central Govt. to disapprove the scheme for Increase of seats in DM(Cardiology) course at Govt. Medical College, Kolkata under The West Bengal University of Health Sciences, Kolkata u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 because of the following reasons:-

1. Already 3 seats in 1 Unit, which is commensurate with the available clinical material and facilities.
2. Other deficiencies pointed out in the assessment report.

106. Starting of DM(Reproductive Medicine) course at Chettinad Hospital & Research Institute, Kanchipuram, Tamilnadu under Chettinad Academy of Research & Education (Deemed to be University) u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.

Read: the Council Assessor's report (13th March 2014) on the physical and other teaching facilities available at Chettinad Hospital & Research Institute, Kanchipuram, Tamilnadu under Chettinad Academy of Research & Education (Deemed to be University) for Starting of DM(Reproductive Medicine) course u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Assessor's report (13th March 2014) and decided to recommend to the Central Govt. to disapprove the scheme for Starting of DM(Reproductive Medicine) course at Chettinad Hospital & Research Institute, Kanchipuram, Tamilnadu under Chettinad Academy of Research & Education (Deemed to be University) u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 because of the following reasons:-

1. There is no accreditation / registration with ICMR or Ministry of Health & Family Welfare. There is no registration of ART bank and use of human embryos.
2. Dr. Gayathri Devi's name was not provided in the staff list nor was she available at the time of attendance at 11 a.m. She only appeared in the afternoon; hence she cannot be considered as a faculty.
3. There is no counselor.
4. There are no recent journals in the department.
5. All the faculty have given residential address of Chennai.
6. There is a shortage of Residents: (a) Senior Resident: 1; (b) Junior Resident: 1.
7. Workload in major supportive department (O.G.) is less.
8. Average daily OPD is 10 - 15.
9. Daily bed occupancy is NIL.
10. Average daily procedures performed are only 1 - 2.
11. Other deficiencies pointed out in the assessment report.
