1. Form 16 of all the faculty members were issued by the college and had not been downloaded from TRACES website. These forms did not have certificate number and so entries could not be verified from the Income Tax website.
2. Services like family Welfare, Cancer, Infertility & Mamta clinics are provided in a common room in OPD.
3. Unit-wise distribution of teaching faculty & Residents not given.
4. Other deficiencies as pointed out in the Assessment Report.

211. The Tamilnadu Dr. MGR Medical University, Chennai - Recognition of DM (Hepatology) qualification for 1 (One) seat in respect of students being trained at Christian Medical College, Vellore, Tamil Nadu.

4. Other deficiencies as pointed out in the Assessment Report.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council assessor's report (June, 2014) and decided to recommend not to recognize MD(Anaesthesiology) qualification for 2 (Two) seats granted by Kerala University of Health Sciences in respect of students being trained at Sri Gokulam Medical College Trust & Research Foundation, Trivandrum, Kerala because of the following facts:-

1. The number of Surgical cases performed are less, even though registers show that they are doing more cases. On 27/06/2014 (i.e. day of assessment), only 3 cases were operated till 12 noon.
2. Audiovisual aids like LCD projector, Computer are not available in the in the class room or the department.
3. Teaching programme registers are not displayed.
4. There are no publications from the department in last 3 years.
5. Total number of major surgeries has decreased from 6, 144 to 5, 699 during the 3 year period.
6. Pain clinic is run by Physiotherapists.
7. All Postgraduates did not submit Form-16, which means they are not paid any Stipend or Salary.
8. Other deficiencies as pointed out in the Assessment Report.

219. Kerala University of Health Sciences - Recognition of MD(Pharmacology) qualification for 2 (Two) seats in respect of students being trained at Government Medical College, Kottayam, Kerala.

Read: the Assessment Report (June, 2014) on the standard of examination and other teaching facilities for Recognition of MD(Pharmacology) qualification for 2 (Two) seats at Government Medical College, Kottayam, Kerala granted by Kerala University of Health Sciences.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council assessor's report (June, 2014) and decided to recommend not to recognize MD(Pharmacology) qualification for 2 (Two) seats granted by Kerala University of Health Sciences in respect of students being trained at Government Medical College, Kottayam, Kerala because of the following facts:-

1. PG degrees of Dr. M.B. Sujatha, Asso. Prof. & Dr. K. Sabeena, Asso. Prof. are not recognized. Consequently, there is a deficiency of 1 Assoc. Professor.
2. There are no publications from the department in last 3 years.
3. All Lecturers are with MBBS qualification. Hence, they cannot be considered as Lecturers.
4. Other deficiencies as pointed out in the Assessment Report.

1. There are only 3 Units against the requirement of 6. There is a deficiency of 3 Units.
2. There is a gross deficiency of Faculty.
3. Other deficiencies as pointed out in the Assessment Report.

Y. Patil Medical College, Kolhapur granted by D.Y. Patil Education Society Deemed University, Kolhapur and decided to verify compliance by way of assessment.

308. Maharashtra University of Health Sciences, Nashik - Recognition of MD(Tuberculosis & Respiratory Diseases/Pulmonary Medicine) qualification for 2 (Two) seats in respect of students being trained at Dr. Vasantarao Pawar Medical College & Research Centre, Nasik – Compliance regarding.

The Postgraduate Medical Education Committee considered the compliance along with Assessment Report (02.05.2014) on the standard of examination and other teaching facilities for Recognition of MS(Orthopaedics) qualification against increased intake from 2 (Two) to 4 (Four) seats at K S Hegde Medical Academy, Mangalore granted by NITTE University, Bangalore and decided to reiterate earlier decision.

311. Arya Bhatta Knowledge University, Patna - Recognition of MD(Paediatrics) qualification for 2 (Two) seats in respect of students being trained at Nalanda Medical College, Patna – Compliance regarding.

Read: the Compliance Verification Assessment Report (17.06.2014) and compliance along with Assessment Report (May, 2013) on the standard of examination and other teaching facilities for Recognition of MD(Paediatrics) qualification for 2 (Two) seats at Nalanda Medical College, Patna granted by Arya Bhatta Knowledge University, Patna.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Compliance Verification Assessment Report (17.06.2014) and compliance along with Council assessor's report (May, 2013) and decided to recommend not to recognize MD(Paediatrics) qualification for 2 (Two) seats granted by Arya Bhatta Knowledge University, Patna in respect of students being trained at Nalanda Medical College, Patna because of the following facts:-

1. The College has only 1 Unit against the requirement of 2. There is a deficiency of 1 full Unit.
2. New CT & MRI is under installation and not yet installed.
3. There is no Assoc. Professor in Unit-I.
4. Other deficiencies as pointed out in the Assessment Report.

312. Devi Ahilya Vishwa Vidyalaya, Indore - Recognition of MS(Orthopaedics) qualification for 3 (Three) seats in respect of students being trained at Sri Aurobindo Medical College and Post Graduate Institute, Indore – Compliance regarding – Compliance regarding.

Read: the compliance along with Assessment Report (23.05.2014) on the standard of examination and other teaching facilities for Recognition of MS(Orthopaedics)

qualification for 3 (Three) seats at Sri Aurobindo Medical College and Post Graduate Institute, Indore granted by Devi Ahilya Vishwa Vidyalaya, Indore.

The Postgraduate Medical Education Committee considered the compliance along with Assessment Report (23.05.2014) and decided to recommend that MS(Orthopaedics) qualification granted by Devi Ahilya Vishwa Vidyalaya, Indore in respect of students being trained at Sri Aurobindo Medical College and Post Graduate Institute, Indore be recognized for 3 (Three) seats and included in the 1st Schedule to the I.M.C. Act, 1956.

The Postgraduate Medical Education Committee further decided that the recognition so granted shall be for a maximum period of 5 years from the date of Notification upon which the Institute shall have to apply for renewal of recognition. Failure to seek timely renewal of recognition as required shall invariably result in stoppage of admission to the Postgraduate Course.
