The Postgraduate Medical Education Committee confirmed the minutes of the Postgraduate Medical Education Committee meeting held on 30th April, 2015.

The Postgraduate Medical Education Committee noted & approved the action taken on the minutes of the previous meeting of the Postgraduate Medical Education Committee.

3. Increase of seats in M.Ch. (Neuro-Surgery) course at SCB Medical College, Cuttack under Utkal University, Bhubaneswar u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 for the academic year 2015-16 – consideration of Compliance Verification Assessment Report.

Read: the Compliance Verification Assessment Report (07/05/2015) along with the Council Assessor's Report (02/03/2015) and Compliance dated 23/04/2015 submitted by the College Authorities on the physical and other teaching facilities available at SCB Medical College, Cuttack under Utkal University, Bhubaneswar for Increase of seats in M.Ch. (Neuro-Surgery) course u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 for the academic year 2015-16.

The Postgraduate Medical Education Committee considered the Compliance Verification Assessment Report (07/05/2015) along with Council Assessor's Report (02/03/2015) and Compliance dated 23/04/2015 submitted by the College Authorities and decided to recommend to the Central Govt. to issue Letter of Permission for Increase of seats in M.Ch. (Neuro-Surgery) course at SCB Medical College, Cuttack under Utkal University, Bhubaneswar u/s 10A of the I.M.C. Act, 1956 prospectively i.e. from the academic session 2015-2016 from 3(Three) to 4(Four) students per year till the first batch admitted against the increased number appears in the final examination of the said course. The Teaching Institution be advised to apply for recognition of the qualification for the additional increased intake at the time of first available examination as per the provision of Section 11(2) of the IMC Act, 1956.

4. Starting of M.Ch. (Urology) course at NRI Medical College, Guntur under Dr. NTR University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada (A.P.) u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 for the academic year 2015-16 – consideration of Compliance.

The Postgraduate Medical Education Committee considered the Council Assessor's Report (10/04/2015) and Compliance dated 07/05/2015 submitted by the College Authorities and decided to recommend to the Central Govt. to disapprove the scheme for Starting of M.Ch. (Urology) course at NRI Medical College, Guntur under Dr. NTR University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada - 520008 (A.P.) u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 for the academic year 2015-16, because of the following facts:-

1. Clinical Material is inadequate in terms of OPD as well as operations. The contention of College Authorities in the compliance that they have shown the census of exclusively Urology cases also confirms that average daily Urology related operations are only 2 Major and 1 Minor, which is not adequate. Since, it is starting of M.Ch. (Urology), we have to count only Urology work.
2. Average daily OPD is 23.
3. Average daily operations are Major only 2 & Minor only 1.
4. OPD/ IPD almost static in the last 3 years.
5. There is no departmental Research Lab.
6. Other deficiencies as pointed out in the Assessment Report.

5. Starting of DM (Critical Care) course at NRI Medical College, Guntur under Dr. NTR University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada (A.P.) u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 for the academic year 2015-16 – consideration of Compliance Verification Assessment Report.

Read: the Council Assessor's Report (07/04/2015) and Compliance dated 06/05/2015 submitted by the College Authorities on the physical and other teaching facilities available at NRI Medical College, Guntur under Dr. NTR University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada (A.P.) for Starting of DM (Critical Care) course u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 for the academic year 2015-16.

The Postgraduate Medical Education Committee considered the Council Assessor's Report (07/04/2015) and Compliance dated 06/05/2015 submitted by the College Authorities and decided to recommend to the Central Govt. to disapprove the scheme for Starting of DM (Critical Care) course at NRI Medical College, Guntur under Dr. NTR University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada - 520008 (A.P.) u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 for the academic year 2015-16, because of the following facts:-

1. All 3 Staff were considered as P.G. Teachers in Anaesthesia department from which this department is not yet separated
2. There cannot be a combined department of Anaesthesia and Critical Care All 3 Staff members are part of Anaesthesia department, if these 3 staff members are taken out from Anaesthesia department then there is a shortage of 3 Asst. Professor in Anaesthesia department in 150 UG seats.
3. No Faculty members have DM or 2 years special training.
 - a. As per declaration forms signed by Dr. Suhasani, Dean and the Assessor, all her appointments in Nizam Institute of Medical Sciences, Hyderabad as well as in NRI Medical College, Guntur are in the department of Anaesthesia and not in Critical Care.
 - i. She has undergone 1 year training in Australia from October, 2001 to October, 2002, which is 10 years after her appointment as Asst. Professor and European Diploma in Intensive Care Medicine (Duration of course not mentioned) is in 2008 i.e. 18 years after her appointment.
 - ii. From the above, it is clear that her appointment is not as per Regulations and she cannot be considered as Professor in Critical Care.
 - b. Dr. Shaik Arif Pasha, Assoc. Professor has 1 year 6 months training in Critical Care instead of the required 2 years. Hence, his appointment is not as per Regulations.
4. Dr. Varalaxmi, Asst. Professor with DNB qualification from non-teaching Hospital is not eligible, since, she has no 3 years teaching experience at the time of appointment.
5. Other deficiencies as pointed out in the Assessment Report.

6. Starting of DM (Neonatology) course at Maulana Azad Medical College, New Delhi under University of Delhi Main Campus, Delhi-110007 u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 for the academic year 2015-16 – consideration of Compliance.

The Teaching Institution be advised to apply for recognition of the qualification at the time of first available examination as per the provision of Section 11(2) of the IMC Act, 1956.

1. As per compliance, there are 40 beds in each Unit, which is not as per Regulations.
2. Promotion of Dr. Vikram Bhatia, Asso. Prof. in Unit II is not as per Regulations as he has been promoted with experience of only 1 y 11 m as Asst. Prof. against requirement of 2 y as per Regulations.
3. With the shifting of Dr. Manoj Kumar Sharma, Addl. Professor from Unit-I to Unit-II, the faculty complement in Unit-I has become incomplete, since, there is no Assoc. Professor or Addl. Professor in Unit-I.
4. Other deficiencies as pointed out in the Assessment Report.

Increase of seats in DM (Organ Transplant Anaesthesia & Critical Care) course at Institute of Liver & Biliary Sciences, New Delhi under Institute of Liver & Biliary Sciences (Deemed to be University), D-1, Vasant Kunj, New Delhi u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 for the academic year 2015-16 – consideration of Compliance.

1. The only Unit has 45 beds.
2. Faculty is shown for Anaesthesiology department. Only faculty designated for Critical care are 3 Asst. Prof. No Professor & Asso. Prof. has been designated for Critical care.
3. Senior Residents shown are for Anaesthesiology department. No Senior Resident is designated for Critical Care.
4. Academic parameters like Case Presentation (15 in year), Group Discussion (NIL in year) are inadequate.
5. All Faculty have MD(Anaesthesia) without any special training of 2 years in Organ Transplant Anaesthesia.
6. All deficiencies pointed out remain as such after considering the compliance.
7. Other deficiencies as pointed out in the Assessment Report.

9. **Increase of seats in DM (Paediatric Hepatology) course at Institute of Liver & Biliary Sciences, New Delhi under Institute of Liver & Biliary Sciences (Deemed to be University), D-1, Vasant Kunj, New Delhi u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 for the academic year 2015-16 – consideration of Compliance.**

6. There are only 16 beds in the only Unit. Rest 4 are beds in PICU which cannot be considered as teaching beds.
7. Dr. Dinesh Rawal, Asst. Prof. does not possess 3 years Residency experience in the department in teaching institutes in India. His experience in U.K. hospitals cannot be considered as they are not recognized teaching hospitals in India.
8. None of the Faculty Members have special Training in Paediatric Hepatology department.
9. Other deficiencies as pointed out in the Assessment Report.

Without invasive procedures, the Cardiology department is not adequate.

8. Blood Bank Stock is grossly inadequate.

 - i. As per Faculty Table signed by the Dean and Assessor, he worked at Miraj from 01/02/2005 to 28/02/2006, whereas, in the compliance it is stated that during this period he worked at Tata Memorial Hospital, Mumbai.

 - a. From perusal of Declaration Forms of Dr. R.C. Ashwini, it has been found that period for which she was shown as on Training in Neonatology and Senior Resident/ Asst. Professor in earlier declaration form are entirely different than what has been stated in the present Declaration Form. Hence, it cannot be relied upon. Retrospective change in dates is not permissible.
2. Consequently, there are only 2 Faculty in the department.
3. Other deficiencies as pointed out in the Assessment Report.

Note: The Committee decided to summon Dr. R.C. Ashwini and the Dean along with all original documents, that why retrospective alterations in appointment dates have been made.
