The Chairman welcomed the members of the Postgraduate Medical Education Committee.

Leave of absence was received from Dr. K.S. Sharma, Member and Dr. (Mrs.) Rani Bhaskaran, Member.

1. Minutes of the last meeting of The Postgraduate Medical Education Committee – confirmation of.

The Postgraduate Medical Education Committee confirmed the minutes of the Postgraduate Medical Education Committee meeting held on 7th January, 2015.

2. Minutes of the last meeting of the Postgraduate Medical Education Committee – action taken thereon.

The Postgraduate Medical Education Committee noted & approved the action taken on the minutes of the previous meeting of the Postgraduate Medical Education Committee.

The Committee noted that the name of the University in the adjourned Item No. 49 of the Postgraduate Medical Education Committee meeting held on 10/10/2014 had inadvertently been mentioned as Rajasthan University of Health Sciences, Jaipur instead of Geetanjali University, Udaipur and the Committee decided that the decision of the Item No. 49 (Adjourned) of the Postgraduate Medical Education Committee meeting dated 10/10/2014 be read corrected as under:

49. Geetanjali University, Udaipur - Recognition of DCP qualification for 01 (One) seat in respect of students being trained at Geetanjali Medical College & Hospital, Udaipur, Rajasthan.

Read: the Council Assessor's Report (July, 2014) on the standard of examination and other teaching facilities for Recognition of DCP qualification for 01 (One) seat at Geetanjali Medical College & Hospital, Udaipur, Rajasthan granted by Geetanjali University, Udaipur.

The Postgraduate Medical Education Committee considered the Council Assessor's Report (July, 2014) and decided to recommend that DCP qualification granted by Geetanjali University, Udaipur in respect of students being trained at Geetanjali Medical College & Hospital, Udaipur, Rajasthan be recognized for 01 (One) seat and included in the 1st Schedule to the I.M.C. Act, 1956.

The Postgraduate Medical Education Committee further decided that the recognition so granted shall be for a maximum period of 5 years from the date of Notification upon which the Institute shall have to apply for renewal of recognition. Failure to seek timely renewal of recognition as required shall invariably result in stoppage of admission to the Postgraduate Course.

The Committee also noted that the seats in the Item No. 294 of the Postgraduate Medical Education Committee meeting held on 30/09/2014 had inadvertently been mentioned as 2(Two) instead of 4(Four) and the Committee decided that the decision of the Item No. 294 of the Postgraduate Medical Education Committee meeting dated 30/09/2014 be read corrected as under:

The Postgraduate Medical Education Committee considered the Compliance Verification Assessment Report (17th & 18th June, 2014) and compliance along with Assessment Report (May, 2013) and decided to recommend that MD(Community Medicine) qualification granted by Dr. NTR University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada, A.P. in respect of students being trained at Dr. Pinnammaneni Siddhartha Institute of Medical Sciences & Research Foundation, Chinnaoutpalli be recognized for 4 (Four) seats and included in the 1st Schedule to the I.M.C. Act, 1956.

The Postgraduate Medical Education Committee further decided that the recognition so granted shall be for a maximum period of 5 years from the date of Notification upon which the Institute shall have to apply for renewal of recognition. Failure to seek timely renewal of recognition as required shall invariably result in stoppage of admission to the Postgraduate Course.

The Dean, Vydehi Institute of Medical Sciences & Research Centre, Bangalore appeared in person and gave explanation to the submissions made by MCI in letter No.MCI-50(22)/2014-Med./146621 dated 26/12/2014. 86. Starting of MD (Microbiology) course at Amala Institute of Medical Sciences, Thrissur under Kerala University of Health & Allied Sciences, Thrissur u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 for the academic year 2015-16 – consideration of Compliance Verification Assessment Report.

Read: the Compliance Verification Assessment Report (11th December 2014) along with the Council Assessor's Report (10th September 2014) and compliance dated 11th November 2014 submitted by the College Authorities on the physical and other teaching facilities available at Amala Institute of Medical Sciences, Thrissur under Kerala University of Health & Allied Sciences, Thrissur for Starting of MD (Microbiology) course u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 for the academic year 2015-16.

The Postgraduate Medical Education Committee considered the Compliance Verification Assessment Report (15th December 2014) along with the Council Assessor's Report (18th September 2014) and compliance dated 12th November 2014 submitted by the College Authorities and decided to recommend to the Central Govt. to disapprove the scheme for Starting of MS (General Surgery) course at Azeezia Institute of Medical Sciences & Research, Meeyannor, Kerala under Kerala University of Health & Allied Sciences, Thrissur u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 for the academic year 2015-16, because of the following facts:-

1. There is no MRI, no Mammography
2. Total IPD of 2013 was 5010 in old Report, whereas in the present Report it is mentioned as 5840.
3. The College Authorities in the Assessment Report 18/09/2014 have stated that 1207 were Day Care Surgeries in addition to 8030 Major & Minor Surgeries, which obviously means they were on Indoor Patients. The contention of the College Authorities that Minor Surgeries were without admission cannot be accepted because they had separately given 1207 Day Care Surgeries and this column of Day Care Surgeries have been omitted from the Assessment Report dated 15/12/2014. Retrospective manipulation of data is not permissible.
4. Other deficiencies as pointed out in the Assessment Report.

89. Increase of seats in MD (Psychiatry) course at Era's Lucknow Medical College & Hospital, Lucknow, Uttar Pradesh under Dr. R.M.L Avadh University, Faizabad, U.P. u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 for the academic year 2015-16 – consideration of Compliance Verification Assessment Report.

Read: the Compliance Verification Assessment Report (08th December 2014) along with the Council Assessor's Report (24th September 2014) and compliance dated 13th November 2014 submitted by the College Authorities on the physical and other teaching facilities available at Era's Lucknow Medical College & Hospital, Lucknow,

Uttar Pradesh under Dr. R.M.L Avadh University, Faizabad, U.P. for Increase of seats in MD (Psychiatry) course u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 for the academic year 2015-16.

The Postgraduate Medical Education Committee considered the Compliance Verification Assessment Report (08th December 2014) along with the Council Assessor's Report (24th September 2014) and compliance dated 13th November 2014 submitted by the College Authorities and decided to recommend to the Central Govt. to disapprove the scheme for Increase of seats in MD (Psychiatry) course at Era's Lucknow Medical College & Hospital, Lucknow, Uttar Pradesh under Dr. R.M.L Avadh University, Faizabad, U.P. u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 for the academic year 2015-16, because of the following facts:-

1. As per Postgraduate Medical Education Regulations, 2000; sub-clause 13.3; Amendment dated 20/10/2008, Postgraduate Degree/ Diploma/ Super-Speciality Course students shall be paid stipend at par with the stipend being paid to the Postgraduate students of State Government Medical Institutions/ Central Government Medical Institutions in the State/ Union Territory, where the Teaching Institution be located. U.P. Government is paying stipend at the rate of 52,800 per month. Whereas, the College Authorities are paying Stipend at the rate of Rs. 21,000 per month and that also in cash, which is not permissible.
2. Other deficiencies as pointed out in the Assessment Report.

90. Increase of seats in MD (Paediatrics) course at Geetanjali Medical College & Hospital, Udaipur under Geetanjali University, Udaipur, Rajasthan u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 for the academic year 2015-16 – consideration of Compliance Verification Assessment Report.

Read: the Compliance Verification Assessment Report (11th December 2014) along with the Council Assessor's Report (11th October 2014) and compliance dated 21st November 2014 submitted by the College Authorities on the physical and other teaching facilities available at Geetanjali Medical College & Hospital, Udaipur under Geetanjali University, Udaipur, Rajasthan for Increase of seats in MD (Paediatrics) course u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 for the academic year 2015-16.

The Postgraduate Medical Education Committee considered the Compliance Verification Assessment Report (11th December 2014) along with the Council Assessor's Report (11th October 2014) and compliance dated 21st November 2014 submitted by the College Authorities and decided to recommend to the Central Govt. to disapprove the scheme for Increase of seats in MD (Paediatrics) course at Geetanjali Medical College & Hospital, Udaipur under Geetanjali University, Udaipur, Rajasthan u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 for the academic year 2015-16, because of the following facts:-

1. There was no Paediatric patient in casualty on the day of Assessment. Deficiency remains as it is.
2. In case 3 Senior Resident, experience certificate for Junior Resident/ DCH is not available. Hence, they cannot be considered as Senior Residents. Resultantly, there is shortage of Senior Residents: 3. Deficiency remains as it is.
3. There was no patient in speciality clinic on the day of Assessment. On an average only 2-4 cases are seen in speciality clinics which remains inadequate. Deficiency remains as it is.
4. On physical verification, there was only one single OP Register provided, which includes, patients attending OPD, Immunization and all others.
5. IPD work load for the month of December, 2014 (11 days) as available from IP Register was:

6. Workload in PICU on the day of inspection was 3 patients. Register maintained shows 38 patients in November, 2014.
7. Workload in NICU on the day of inspection 3 babies were there. Register maintained shows 43 babies in November, 2014 and 13 babies in December, 2014 (include both intramural and extramural babies).
8. Speciality Clinic on Thursday (High risk clinic on day of inspection) at 3 P.M. on physical verification there were not patients.
9. On an average 2-4 patients are seen in a speciality clinic. There is no follow up Register.
10. Central Oxygen and suction line is available on 4 beds only, in each ward.
11. Other deficiencies as pointed out in the Assessment Report.

1. Dr. Ashutosh Soni, M.Ch. and Professor of Burn & Plastic Surgery at M.P. Shah Medical College, Jamnagar has been shown as Asst. Professor in Unit-V, which is most unexpected for a Professor of Super-Speciality to join as Asst. Professor in General Surgery. Further there is no Relieving Order from M.P. Shah Medical College, Jamnagar. Hence, he cannot be accepted.
2. Postgraduate Degree (MS General Surgery) of Dr. Ram Avtar, Asst. Professor is not recognized. He is also a Neuro Surgeon and have been shown as Asst. Professor in General Surgery. Consequently, Unit-V is left with only 1 Faculty, which cannot be considered as a Teaching Unit.
3. Dr. Prem Prakash Sharma, Assoc. Professor has not produced his Relieving Order. Hence, he cannot be considered. (Although Faculty complement is complete in that Unit without him.)
4. Other deficiencies as pointed out in the Assessment Report.

4. Journals are not available after 2012. Deficiency remains as it is.
5. MRD is not computerized. Deficiency remains as it is.
6. PG Degrees of Dr. J.D.S. Rodrigues & Dr. M.J.W. Pinto are not recognized. Deficiency remains as it is.
7. Other deficiencies as pointed out in the Assessment Report.

4. Other deficiencies as pointed out in the Assessment Report.

There were 12 cubicles on I floor which were either private or semiprivate and were shown as 24 teaching beds; on asking majority of patients divulged that they were admitted on single occupancy basis in cabins & were paying patients. Hence these beds cannot be considered as teaching beds; resultantly the number of teaching beds is reduced to 90 which is inadequate.
7. Occupancy in semiprivate wards was 50% on day of assessment.
8. It is difficult to reconcile high nursery admission rate of babies.

This cannot be accepted. The Committee decided to seek explanation from the Teacher as well as Dean for this discrepancy.
 4. Another Asso. Prof. Dr. Narendra Wagh is absent.
 5. Resultantly, faculty complement is incomplete in Unit III.
 6. Dr. Sanjay Patil, has been shown as Asst. Professor for 2 years 8 months at JNM, Belgaum and 5 year 8 months as Registrar at JNM, Belgaum. In the current Report, he has been shown as Asst. Professor for 8 year 1 month at JNM, Belgaum, which is contradictory. The Committee decided to seek explanation from the Teacher as well as Dean for this discrepancy.
 7. Other deficiencies as pointed out in the Assessment Report.
12. **Increase of seats in MD (DVL) course at Geetanjali Medical College & Hospital, Udaipur under Geetanjali University, Udaipur, Rajasthan u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 for the academic year 2015-16 – consideration of Compliance Verification Assessment Report.**

6. Very few investigations for Mycology are carried out from the department.
7. STI data are very inadequate. Deficiency remains as it is.
8. Leprosy cases are very few. Deficiency remains as it is.
9. Specialty clinics are very primitive. Deficiency remains as it is.
10. No formal teaching schedule is displayed on notice board. No attendance register is maintained.
11. There is hardly any publication in indexed journal from the department in last 5 years.

6. There is only 1 research publication from the departments in last 3 years. Deficiency is not rectified.
7. Surgeries like Tracheoplasty are not performed. Deficiency remains as it is.
8. Rhinology related specialty clinic is not run. Deficiency remains as it is.
9. Other deficiencies as pointed out in the Assessment Report.

4. For OPD/IPD, all the verified data Xerox copies were not provided. All the admissions in casualty do not match OPD/RMO mentioned in the list of casualty records.
5. Orthopaedics minor patients were listed but no patient as mentioned in records was found.
6. The following faculty cannot be considered due to reasons mentioned in the report:
