**1. Minutes of the last meeting of the Postgraduate Medical Education Committee – confirmation of.**

The minutes of the Postgraduate Medical Education Committee meeting held on 09/10/2015 were read out and confirmed in the meeting itself.

**2. Minutes of the last meeting of the Postgraduate Medical Education Committee – action taken thereon.**

The Postgraduate Medical Education Committee noted & approved the action taken on the minutes of the previous meeting of the Postgraduate Medical Education Committee.

**3. Increase of seats in MD (Radio-Therapy) course at Guru Gobind Singh Medical College & Hospital, Faridkot under Baba Farid University of Health Sciences, Faridkot u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 for the academic year 2016-17.**

Read: the Council Assessor's Report (28/08/2015) on the physical and other teaching facilities available at Guru Gobind Singh Medical College & Hospital, Faridkot under Baba Farid University of Health Sciences, Faridkot for Increase of seats in MD (Radio-Therapy) course u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 for the academic year 2016-17.

The Postgraduate Medical Education Committee considered the Assessment Report (28/08/2015) and decided to recommend to the Central Govt. to issue Letter of Permission for Increase of seats in MD (Radio-Therapy) course at Guru Gobind Singh Medical College & Hospital, Faridkot under Baba Farid University of Health Sciences, Faridkot u/s 10A of the I.M.C. Act, 1956 prospectively i.e. from the academic session 2016-2017 from 3(Three) to 5(Five) students per year till the first batch admitted against the increased number appears in the final examination of the said course. The Teaching Institution be advised to apply for recognition of the qualification for the additional increased intake at the time of first available examination as per the provision of Section 11(2) of the IMC Act, 1956.

**4. Increase of seats in MD (Radio-Diagnosis) course at PES Institute of Medical Sciences & Research, Kuppam, Andhra Pradesh under Dr. NTR University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 for the academic year 2016-17.**

Read: the Council Assessor's Report (01/09/2015) on the physical and other teaching facilities available at PES Institute of Medical Sciences & Research, Kuppam, Andhra Pradesh under Dr. NTR University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada for Increase of seats in MD (Radio-Diagnosis) course u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 for the academic year 2016-17.

The Postgraduate Medical Education Committee considered the Council Assessor's Report (01/09/2015) and decided to recommend to the Central Govt. to disapprove the scheme for Increase of seats in MD (Radio-Diagnosis) course at PES Institute of Medical Sciences & Research, Kuppam, Andhra Pradesh under Dr. NTR University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 for the academic year 2016-17, because of the following facts:-

1. OPD/IPD and other data at Sl.No.5 on page 2 cannot be data of Radio-Diagnosis department. It has no OPD/IPD.
2. Investigative workload of department on inspection date is as below:

MRI	07
Mammography	01
DSA	01
CT Scan	15

MRI (from average of 03 years) is 4.8 per day.

This is grossly inadequate.

3. Out of 04 publications cited, 02 are case report and cannot be considered. No full reference/reprint of remaining 02 has been provided. (No authors names given)
4. For surrender of Diploma seats, College Authorities are directed to approach for Notification by Government of India deleting Diploma seats from the Schedule. Surrender of diploma by college authorities cannot be accepted. It has to be deleted from the Schedule through a Notification by the Central Government.

5. Already 05 seats commensurate with available clinical material.
6. Other deficiencies as pointed out in the Assessment Report.

In case, any compliance is being submitted by the college authorities, the same should reach to this Office, directly within one month along with supported documentary evidence. Incomplete/ without proper documents, the compliance would not be entertained/ considered.

**5. Increase of seats in MS (Ophthalmology) course at PES Institute of Medical Sciences & Research, Kuppam, Andhra Pradesh under Dr. NTR University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 for the academic year 2016-17.**

Read: the Council Assessor's Report (01/09/2015) on the physical and other teaching facilities available at PES Institute of Medical Sciences & Research, Kuppam, Andhra Pradesh under Dr. NTR University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada for Increase of seats in MS (Ophthalmology) course u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 for the academic year 2016-17.

The Postgraduate Medical Education Committee considered the Council Assessor's Report (01/09/2015) and decided to recommend to the Central Govt. to disapprove the scheme for Increase of seats in MS (Ophthalmology) course at PES Institute of Medical Sciences & Research, Kuppam, Andhra Pradesh under Dr. NTR University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 for the academic year 2016-17, because of the following facts:-

1. There are only 2 research publications from the department in indexed journals in last 3 years. Rest in the list are case reports. No authors name in any publication has been given.
2. Facilities for Retinal Surgery are not available. Only Medical Retina services are available.
3. Academic parameter like Theory Classes (21/year), Group Discussions (04 in no.) are inadequate.
4. For surrender of Diploma seats, College Authorities are directed to approach for Notification by Government of India deleting Diploma seats from the Schedule. Surrender of diploma by college authorities cannot be accepted. It has to be deleted from the Schedule through a Notification by the Central Government.
5. Other deficiencies as pointed out in the Assessment Report.

In case, any compliance is being submitted by the college authorities, the same should reach to this Office, directly within one month along with supported documentary evidence. Incomplete/ without proper documents, the compliance would not be entertained/ considered.

**6. Increase of seats in MS (General Surgery) course at PES Institute of Medical Sciences & Research, Kuppam, Andhra Pradesh under Dr. NTR University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 for the academic year 2016-17.**

Read: the Council Assessor's Report (01/09/2015) on the physical and other teaching facilities available at PES Institute of Medical Sciences & Research, Kuppam, Andhra Pradesh under Dr. NTR University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada for Increase of seats in MS (General Surgery) course u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 for the academic year 2016-17.

The Postgraduate Medical Education Committee considered the Council Assessor's Report (01/09/2015) and decided to recommend to the Central Govt. to disapprove the scheme for Increase of seats in MS (General Surgery) course at PES Institute of Medical Sciences & Research, Kuppam, Andhra Pradesh under Dr. NTR University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 for the academic year 2016-17, because of the following facts:-

1. Promotion of Dr. K.R. Geetha, Professor in Unit V is not as per Regulations as she has been promoted as Professor with experience of only 3 years 2 months as Asso. Prof. against requirement of 4 years as per Regulations & no benefit of Research publications has been given as per details given in faculty table.
2. Resultantly, Unit V has only 2 faculty & is headed by Asst. Prof.; Hence it cannot be considered a PG teaching Unit at all.
3. Total number of patients admitted as IPD is shown as 6,813 in 2014; however total number of Major & Minor operations in 2014 is shown as 4,543 + 10,122 = 14,665 which is not feasible. There is data mismatch.
4. Only 23 deaths last year out of 6813 admissions. In a sensitive department like Surgery which deals with polytrauma, it indicates that no serious patients are admitted.
5. Other deficiencies as pointed out in the Assessment Report.

In case, any compliance is being submitted by the college authorities, the same should reach to this Office, directly within one month along with supported documentary evidence. Incomplete/ without proper documents, the compliance would not be entertained/ considered.

**7. Increase of seats in MD (General Medicine) course at Pondicherry Institute of Medical Sciences & Research, Pondicherry under Pondicherry University, Puducherry u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 for the academic year 2016-17.**

Read: the Council Assessor's Report (01/09/2015) on the physical and other teaching facilities available at Pondicherry Institute of Medical Sciences & Research, Pondicherry under Pondicherry University, Puducherry for Increase of seats in MD (General Medicine) course u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 for the academic year 2016-17.

The Postgraduate Medical Education Committee considered the Council Assessor's Report (01/09/2015) and decided to recommend to the Central Govt. to disapprove the scheme for Increase of seats in MD (General Medicine) course at Pondicherry Institute of Medical Sciences & Research, Pondicherry under Pondicherry University, Puducherry u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 for the academic year 2016-17, because of the following facts:-

1. Promotion of Dr. Nagarajan, Asso. Prof. in Unit 1 is not as per Regulations as he has been promoted with experience of only 3 years 9 months as Asst. Prof. against minimum 4 years required even with benefit of publications.
2. Resultantly, faculty complement is incomplete in Unit I & it cannot be considered as PG Unit.
3. Dr. Joseph Vimal of Unit 2 has been shown as "Senior Resident" in the column of "Designation"; however, in the column of teaching experience, his experience is shown as Asst. Prof. from 01/09/2013 till date which is not feasible.
4. Dr. Latha, Senior Resident does not possess any experience as Resident in a medical college as shown in the faculty table & she was appointed directly as Senior Resident which is not permissible.
5. Senior Resident in Unit-III is MBBS without any 03 years experience.

6. Senior Resident in Unit-II is DNB from non-teaching hospital and he has no 03 years experience. Hence, not eligible.
7. Consequently, there is no Senior Resident in Unit II & III.
8. Other deficiencies as pointed out in the Assessment Report.

In case, any compliance is being submitted by the college authorities, the same should reach to this Office, directly within one month along with supported documentary evidence. Incomplete/ without proper documents, the compliance would not be entertained/ considered.

**8. Increase of seats in MD (Psychiatry) course at Pondicherry Institute of Medical Sciences & Research, Pondicherry under Pondicherry University, Puducherry u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 for the academic year 2016-17.**

Read: the Council Assessor's Report (01/09/2015) on the physical and other teaching facilities available at Pondicherry Institute of Medical Sciences & Research, Pondicherry under Pondicherry University, Puducherry for Increase of seats in MD (Psychiatry) course u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 for the academic year 2016-17.

The Postgraduate Medical Education Committee considered the Council Assessor's Report (01/09/2015) and decided to recommend to the Central Govt. to disapprove the scheme for Increase of seats in MD (Psychiatry) course at Pondicherry Institute of Medical Sciences & Research, Pondicherry under Pondicherry University, Puducherry u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 for the academic year 2016-17, because of the following facts:-

1. OPD on day of assessment is only 30 which is inadequate. Daily average is only 41 which is inadequate.
2. Total number of patients in OPD has decreased by 57% from 18,086 in 2012 to 7,726 in 2014.
3. There is only 1 research publication from the department in indexed journals in last 3 years; 2nd article in the list is of historical perspective regarding treatment of mentally ill in 11th & 12th centuries AD and cannot be considered as research publication.
4. There is no separate room for Professor & HOD. Partition room provided for him is in a deplorable condition.
5. There is no separate room for Asso. Prof.
6. There is no separate ECT facility including pre & post ECT resuscitation room. ECT is done in Surgical O.T. which is not as per norms.
7. Stipend paid is shown as Rs. 40,000 p.m. while that provided is Rs. 12,000 p.m. onwards.
8. On inspection day, there were 06 MRI and 44 ultrasounds in the entire hospital, which indicate inadequate clinical material.
9. Playground for UG/PG is under renovation.
10. Other deficiencies as pointed out in the Assessment Report.

In case, any compliance is being submitted by the college authorities, the same should reach to this Office, directly within one month along with supported documentary evidence. Incomplete/ without proper documents, the compliance would not be entertained/ considered.

**9. Increase of seats in MD (Anaesthesia) course at Pondicherry Institute of Medical Sciences & Research, Pondicherry under Pondicherry University, Puducherry u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 for the academic year 2016-17.**

Read: the Council Assessor's Report (01/09/2015) on the physical and other teaching facilities available at Pondicherry Institute of Medical Sciences & Research,

Pondicherry under Pondicherry University, Puducherry for Increase of seats in MD (Anaesthesia) course u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 for the academic year 2016-17.

The Postgraduate Medical Education Committee considered the Council Assessor's Report (01/09/2015) and decided to recommend to the Central Govt. to disapprove the scheme for Increase of seats in MD (Anaesthesia) course at Pondicherry Institute of Medical Sciences & Research, Pondicherry under Pondicherry University, Puducherry u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 for the academic year 2016-17, because of the following facts:-

1. Total number of Major operations has decreased from 4,715 in 2012 to 3,657 in 2014.
2. MRI workload on day of assessment is only 06.
3. Daily Major operations are 15 which are bare minimum to start PG course.
4. Average attendance at Pre-Anaesthetic clinic is shown as 08-10 cases/day as against daily average of total Major operations claimed as 15. There is data mismatch.
5. Details of Academic Parameter like Theory Classes are not given for PGs.
6. Stipend paid is shown as Rs. 40,000 p.m. while that actually paid is Rs. 12,000 p.m. onwards.
7. From average of 03 years data, average major operations in 2014 were 12 per day which is grossly inadequate. Minor operations 14 per day which is again grossly inadequate.
8. In the entire hospital, on inspection day, there were 06 MRI and 44 ultrasounds and no Mammography, which indicate grossly inadequate clinical material.
9. Designation of Consultant cannot be considered Professor as it is not in the Regulations.
10. Dr. Shanti Sudha and Dr. Srinath, Senior Residents are not eligible and they do not have 03 years teaching experience at the time of appointment. Consequently, there is a deficiency of 02 Senior Residents.
11. Dr. Mamie Zacharia and Dr. Ranjan R.V. promoted after the cut off date without any publications and hence, their promotion is irregular.
12. Other deficiencies as pointed out in the Assessment Report.

In case, any compliance is being submitted by the college authorities, the same should reach to this Office, directly within one month along with supported documentary evidence. Incomplete/ without proper documents, the compliance would not be entertained/ considered.

**10. Increase of seats in MS (OBG) course at Pondicherry Institute of Medical Sciences & Research, Pondicherry under Pondicherry University, Puducherry u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 for the academic year 2016-17.**

Read: the Council Assessor's Report (01/09/2015) on the physical and other teaching facilities available at Pondicherry Institute of Medical Sciences & Research, Pondicherry under Pondicherry University, Puducherry for Increase of seats in MS (OBG) course u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 for the academic year 2016-17.

The Postgraduate Medical Education Committee considered the Council Assessor's Report (01/09/2015) and decided to recommend to the Central Govt. to disapprove the scheme for Increase of seats in MS (OBG) course at Pondicherry Institute of Medical Sciences & Research, Pondicherry under Pondicherry University, Puducherry u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 for the academic year 2016-17, because of the following facts:-

1. Registers of Specialty clinic like High Risk Pregnancy clinic, Cancer clinic were not shown to assessor.
2. Take home stipend of Residents is Rs. 10,000 - Rs. 12,000 p.m.
3. Dr. Akanksha Agarwal, Senior Resident, does not possess any experience as Resident in a medical college as shown in faculty table.
4. There were only 2 Major Gynaecological operation on day of assessment as well as on randomly selected days.
5. Total number of patients in OPD has decreased from 24,690 in 2012 to 23,263 in 2014.
6. Total number of major operations has decreased from 656 in 2012 to 627 in 2014.
7. Total number of operative vaginal deliveries has decreased from 98 in 2012 to 76 in 2014.
8. Total number of Caesarean Sections has been shown as 340 in 2014 implying daily average of 0.9 which is inadequate.
9. There was only 1 patient in HDU on day of assessment.
10. Occupancy in NICU on day of assessment is not given.
11. Equipment like Multipara Monitors are not available.
12. From 03 years data, average daily major operations 02 only which is grossly inadequate.
13. There was only one death last year out of 3031 admissions which indicate that no serious patients are admitted or data is non-genuine.
14. There is no record of speciality clinics, which means, they are not being run.
15. Promotion of Sneha B. Dhupadkar, Professor is not as per Regulations. She has been Associate Professor for 03 years without any publications. Consequently, there is no other Associate Professor in Unit-I.
16. Other deficiencies as pointed out in the Assessment Report.

In case, any compliance is being submitted by the college authorities, the same should reach to this Office, directly within one month along with supported documentary evidence. Incomplete/ without proper documents, the compliance would not be entertained/ considered.

**11. Starting of MD (General Medicine) course at Sri Lakshmi Narayana Institute of Medical Sciences, Puducherry under Bharath University, Chennai u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 for the academic year 2016-17.**

Read: the Council Assessor's Report (01/09/2015) on the physical and other teaching facilities available at Sri Lakshmi Narayana Institute of Medical Sciences, Puducherry under Bharath University, Chennai for Starting of MD (General Medicine) course u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 for the academic year 2016-17.

The Postgraduate Medical Education Committee considered the Council Assessor's Report (01/09/2015) and decided to recommend to the Central Govt. to disapprove the scheme for Starting of MD (General Medicine) course at Sri Lakshmi Narayana Institute of Medical Sciences, Puducherry under Bharath University, Chennai u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 for the academic year 2016-17, because of the following facts:-

1. Deficiency of faculty: (a) Asst. Prof.: 1.
2. Dr. Baranidharan, Senior Resident in Unit II has experience of only 2 years 10 months as Resident in a medical college; hence not eligible to be a Senior Resident.
3. Resultantly, there is no Senior resident in Unit II.
4. Unit V has only 2 faculty; hence it cannot be considered as PG Unit.
5. Central Library books are not issued; it acts as reference library only.

6. Total deaths last year only 13 out of 7325 admissions which indicate that no serious patients were ever admitted. Either non-genuine patients with minor ailments were admitted or data is non-genuine.
7. Payment of stipend is not committed. Although the college is running postgraduate courses in other departments.
8. 90% of the faculty in all departments joined within last 3 months which indicate that the staff in the college was insufficient even for UG seats prior to 03 months.
9. Other deficiencies as pointed out in the Assessment Report.

In case, any compliance is being submitted by the college authorities, the same should reach to this Office, directly within one month along with supported documentary evidence. Incomplete/ without proper documents, the compliance would not be entertained/ considered.

**12. Starting of MD (Paediatrics) course at Sri Lakshmi Narayana Institute of Medical Sciences, Puducherry under Bharath University, Chennai u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 for the academic year 2016-17.**

Read: the Council Assessor's Report (01/09/2015) on the physical and other teaching facilities available at Sri Lakshmi Narayana Institute of Medical Sciences, Puducherry under Bharath University, Chennai for Starting of MD (Paediatrics) course u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 for the academic year 2016-17.

The Postgraduate Medical Education Committee considered the Council Assessor's Report (01/09/2015) and decided to recommend to the Central Govt. to disapprove the scheme for Starting of MD (Paediatrics) course at Sri Lakshmi Narayana Institute of Medical Sciences, Puducherry under Bharath University, Chennai u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 for the academic year 2016-17, because of the following facts:-

1. No print journal is available for 2015.
2. Central Library books are not issued; it acts as reference library only.
3. NIL patient was admitted in PICU/NICU on day of assessment.
4. Copies of Birth records were not provided to assessor.
5. Amongst non-teaching staff, neither Child Psychologist nor Health Educator are available.
6. Unit I does not have Asso. Prof.; hence faculty complement is incomplete; resultantly it cannot be considered as PG Unit.
7. PG degree of Dr. P. Srinivas is not recognized.
8. Details like days on which run, timings, average attendance of Specialty clinics like Immunization Clinic, Paediatric Asthma clinic, Thalassemia clinic are not provided.
9. Services like Parenteral Nutrition, Child Counseling are not available.
10. Equipment like Paediatric Bronchoscope, Transport Incubator are not available.
11. In the entire hospital there were 14 deaths last year out of 51191 admissions. It simply indicate that no seriously ill patients were ever admitted and patients with minor ailments were admitted or the data is non-genuine.
12. There was no death in the Paediatric department, which simply indicate that IPD data is non-genuine.
13. Total births in the last year – 240 which means less than 01 delivery per day. Obviously, training in neo-natal handling of PG students will be grossly inadequate.
14. Professor & HOD Dr. Uma Ramchandran has worked in Army. There is no certificate of experience from Competent Authority of the Office of Directorate General of Armed Forces indicating her places and period of



posting as Graded/Classified Specialist and Advisor without which her equated academic designation cannot be calculated.

15. 07 out of total 09 faculty members have joined within last 03 months prior to inspection.
16. No transport incubator available.
17. Print journals, both India and International, in the subject of Paediatrics were available only till 2014.
18. Other deficiencies as pointed out in the Assessment Report.

**13. Starting of MS (OBG) course at Sri Lakshmi Narayana Institute of Medical Sciences, Puducherry under Bharath University, Chennai u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 for the academic year 2016-17.**

Read: the Council Assessor's Report (01/09/2015) on the physical and other teaching facilities available at Sri Lakshmi Narayana Institute of Medical Sciences, Puducherry under Bharath University, Chennai for Starting of MS (OBG) course u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 for the academic year 2016-17.

The Postgraduate Medical Education Committee considered the Council Assessor's Report (01/09/2015) and decided to recommend to the Central Govt. to disapprove the scheme for Starting of MS (OBG) course at Sri Lakshmi Narayana Institute of Medical Sciences, Puducherry under Bharath University, Chennai u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 for the academic year 2016-17, because of the following facts:-

1. Total number of Major operations in 2014 is shown as 1,073 while total number of Histopathology specimens sent from the department is shown as 1,941 which is not feasible. There is data mismatch.
2. There were NIL major Obstetric & 2 major Gynaecological operations on day of assessment.
3. On day of assessment, OPD attendance in Obstetrics is shown as 90 & Daily average is shown as 91; however average attendance at Antenatal clinic itself is shown as 95 which is not feasible; this also implies that there is no other patient of any other Obstetric condition coming to OPD implying poor quality of teaching material. There is data mismatch.
4. Daily average Antenatal OPD is shown as 95 while average post-natal attendance is shown as only 8 and that too once a week. There is data mismatch.
5. Prenatal diagnosis services are not provided.
6. On inspection day, major operations 03 which is inadequate.
7. Average daily consumption of blood 2 -3 units which is inadequate.
8. Total births last year-240 which means less than 01 delivery per day which is inadequate.
9. SAF has been altered. Death column has been deleted from the table at Sl.No. 16 of Part I of SAF.
10. Promotion of Dr. Srilatha, Associate Professor, Unit-I is irregular. She has been Assistant Professor for 10 months only which is not as per Regulations.

12. Dr. Shanmugam Priya is shown as Assistant Professor as well as Associate Professor in faculty table.

13. 07 out of 09 faculty joined within last 03 months prior to the inspection, which indicate that prior to this, faculty for even UG was insufficient.
14. Other deficiencies as pointed out in the Assessment Report.

**14. Starting of MS (General Surgery) course at Sri Lakshmi Narayana Institute of Medical Sciences, Puducherry under Bharath University, Chennai u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 for the academic year 2016-17.**

Read: the Council Assessor's Report (01/09/2015) on the physical and other teaching facilities available at Sri Lakshmi Narayana Institute of Medical Sciences, Puducherry under Bharath University, Chennai for Starting of MS (General Surgery) course u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 for the academic year 2016-17.

The Postgraduate Medical Education Committee considered the Council Assessor's Report (01/09/2015) and decided to recommend to the Central Govt. to disapprove the scheme for Starting of MS (General Surgery) course at Sri Lakshmi Narayana Institute of Medical Sciences, Puducherry under Bharath University, Chennai u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 for the academic year 2016-17, because of the following facts:-

1. Shortage of Junior Resident: 1.
2. Most of patients admitted in Casualty were for vague complaints like abdominal pain, Burning micturition, etc. There were NIL accidental injuries or major trauma patients.
3. During visit to O.T. at 11:45 a.m. on day of assessment, all 3 tables were vacant and no operation was going on. Postoperative recovery area was vacant and not a single postoperative patient was found. O.T. list provided contained 8 names – 4 for Major operations & 4 for Minor operations. Only 2 out of these 8 patients were identified.
4. No common O.T. register is maintained; it is claimed to be maintained unitwise. On verification, it was observed that on previous day – i.e. 31/08/2015, there was record of major operations like for Carcinoma Stomach, Gall bladder, Total Gastrectomy; but no such post-operative patients were found in surgical ICU or any Surgical ward. Same was true for patients claimed to have been operated on 30/08/2015.
5. Although 129 patients were found in wards, there was only 1 post-operative male & 1 post-operative female patient amongst them. No major head injuries, trauma & post-operative patients were found.
6. SICU: All the patients in SICU were without IV line or any other type of Cardio respiratory support. On verifying ICU Register, it was not maintained well and no correct entry of admitted patient. Treatment records of admitted patients were also not found.
7. There was no Histopathology register maintained by O.T. staff. On visit to Pathology department, register was available only upto 30/06/2015 – i.e. 2 months before assessment.
8. Only 1 death in the entire year suggests the department is not handling any critically ill patient, high risk patient or Burns' patient.
9. Total deaths in the entire hospital 14 out of 51196 admissions and in Surgery department, 01 out of 6939 admissions. This simply indicates that non-deserving patients with minor ailments are admitted or the data is non-genuine.

10. Without serious patients, the training of postgraduate students will be grossly inadequate.
11. Promotion of Associate Professor Dr. A.B. Chandra is not as per Regulations. He has been Assistant Professor for less than 5 years. In the experience details in faculty table, he has been shown to be working from 6.7.2009 to 30.06.2009 and this period has been counted as 11 months which is not feasible.
12. 11 Faculty members joined within 03 months prior to inspection, which indicate that prior to this, the faculty for even UG was insufficient.
13. Other deficiencies as pointed out in the Assessment Report.

Act, 1956 prospectively i.e. from the academic session 2016-2017 restricting the number of admissions to 1(One) student per year, till the first batch admitted appears in the final examination of the said course. The Teaching Institution be advised to apply for recognition of the qualification at the time of first available examination as per the provision of Section 11(2) of the IMC Act, 1956.

**16. Starting of MS (General Surgery) course at Sri Manakula Vinayagar Medical College and Hospital, Puducherry under Pondicherry University, Puducherry u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 for the academic year 2016-17.**

The Postgraduate Medical Education Committee considered the Council Assessor's Report (02/09/2015) and decided to recommend to the Central Govt. to disapprove the scheme for Starting of MS (General Surgery) course at Sri Manakula Vinayagar Medical College and Hospital, Puducherry under Pondicherry University, Puducherry u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 for the academic year 2016-17, because of the following facts:-

1. Dr. B.T. Saravanan is shown as "Senior Resident" in the column of "Designation" in the faculty table on P. 25; however, in the column of experience, his experience is shown as Asst. Prof. from 18/08/2015 till date. There is mismatch & he cannot be considered as Senior resident.
2. Resultantly, there is shortage of Senior Resident: 1.

3. Average attendance at some specialty clinics is only 2 which is inadequate.
4. There are 5 tables in 4 O.T.s indicating 2 tables in 1 O.T. which is not as per norms.
5. On inspection day, total MRI in the entire hospital were 08 which is inadequate and indicate inadequate clinical material.
6. Total deaths last year in Surgery department – 07 out of 6474 admissions which indicate that either non-deserving patients with minor ailments are admitted or the data is non-genuine.
7. Without serious patients, training of postgraduate students will be inadequate.
8. From faculty table, experience of Assistant Professor Dr. A. Murugan has been counted as 03 years from 21.05.2015 to 20.05.2015 which is not possible.
9. Dr. Annamalai A., Senior Resident with DNB qualification is not eligible. He has no 03 years teaching experience at the time of appointment. Consequently, there is no Senior Resident in Unit-III.
10. Other deficiencies as pointed out in the Assessment Report.

The Postgraduate Medical Education Committee considered the Council Assessor's Report (02/09/2015) and decided to recommend to the Central Govt. to disapprove the scheme for Increase of seats in MS (OBG) course at Sri Manakula Vinayagar Medical College and Hospital, Puducherry under Pondicherry University, Puducherry u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 for the academic year 2016-17, because of the following facts:-

1. Total deaths in the department- Nil out of 5698 admissions which indicate that no serious patients were admitted. Either non-deserving patients with minor ailments were admitted or data is non-genuine.
2. Average daily deliveries (from 3 years data) is 1: 1.4 and 1.4 per day, which is grossly inadequate (296, 448 and 443 during 2012, 2013 & 2014 respectively)
3. Other deficiencies as pointed out in the Assessment Report.

In case, any compliance is being submitted by the college authorities, the same should reach to this Office, directly within one month along with supported documentary evidence. Incomplete/ without proper documents, the compliance would not be entertained/ considered.

1. With regard to promotion of Dr. S. Girija as Professor, she has been promoted as Professor with experience of only 3 years. Out of 5 publications cited, 03 are case reports which cannot be considered. In one publication she is 3rd author. Consequently, only one publication is left to his credit. Consequently, Unit IV is left with 02 Assistant Professor only which cannot be counted as a PG Unit.
2. 08 faculty members joined during the last 03 months only which means prior to this, the faculty was not sufficient even for UG seats.
3. Details of beds occupied in ICCU & ICU on day of assessment are not provided.
4. Other deficiencies as pointed out in the Assessment Report.

In case, any compliance is being submitted by the college authorities, the same should reach to this Office, directly within one month along with supported documentary evidence. Incomplete/ without proper documents, the compliance would not be entertained/ considered.

1. Paediatric Endoscopy & Dialysis are not available in the department.
2. Daily consumption of blood unit (from 03 years data) is 01 per day, which means no serious patients were admitted.
3. Total deaths last year only 02 out of 5724 admissions which indicate that no serious patients were ever admitted. Either non-deserving patients with minor ailments were admitted or data is non-genuine.

4. Except 02, all other faculty members joined within last 03 months which indicates that prior to this, there was hardly any faculty for teaching even UG students.
5. Other deficiencies as pointed out in the Assessment Report.

In case, any compliance is being submitted by the college authorities, the same should reach to this Office, directly within one month along with supported documentary evidence. Incomplete/ without proper documents, the compliance would not be entertained/ considered.

**20. Increase of seats in MD (Anaesthesia) course at Sri Manakula Vinayagar Medical College and Hospital, Puducherry under Pondicherry University, Puducherry u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 for the academic year 2016-17.**

Read: the Council Assessor's Report (02/09/2015) on the physical and other teaching facilities available at Sri Manakula Vinayagar Medical College and Hospital, Puducherry under Pondicherry University, Puducherry for Increase of seats in MD (Anaesthesia) course u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 for the academic year 2016-17.

The Postgraduate Medical Education Committee considered the Council Assessor's Report (02/09/2015) and decided to recommend to the Central Govt. to disapprove the scheme for Increase of seats in MD (Anaesthesia) course at Sri Manakula Vinayagar Medical College and Hospital, Puducherry under Pondicherry University, Puducherry u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 for the academic year 2016-17, because of the following facts:-

1. There is only 1 research publication from the department in indexed journals in last 3 years. Remaining publications in the list are case reports or review articles & cannot be accepted as research publications. In 1 instance, the name of faculty is as 4th author which also cannot be accepted.
2. Museum needs to be upgraded & enlarged.
3. Pain clinic is combined with Preanaesthetic clinic which is not permissible.
4. Teaching programme registers are not signed regularly by the faculty & PG students.
5. Dr. Dinesh Babu is stated to be promoted to post of Asso. Prof. on basis of publications; however both the publications cited are case reports hence not acceptable. Hence his promotion is not as per Regulations.
6. Resultantly there is deficiency of faculty: (a) Asso. Prof.: 1.
7. All Senior Residents except one are postgraduate students who passed in June/July, 2015 from this college which means prior 2015 there was only one Senior Resident in the department.
8. Other deficiencies as pointed out in the Assessment Report.

The Postgraduate Medical Education Committee considered the Council Assessor's Report (03/09/2015) and decided to recommend to the Central Govt. to disapprove the scheme for Starting of MD (Emergency Medicine) course at Mahatma Gandhi Medical College and Research Institute, Puducherry under Sri Balaji Vidyapeeth University, Puducherry u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 for the academic year 2016-17, because of the following facts:-

1. Bed occupancy is 23% on day of assessment.
2. Ward is not as per Minimum Standard Requirement Regulations.
3. Some of Senior & Junior Residents are not staying in campus; hence not considered.
4. Casualty ward is shown as Emergency Medicine Department which is not permissible.
5. Instruments & services are not available in the department.
6. There was only 1 patient in SICU & 2 patients in PICU on day of assessment.
7. The department was not in existence 03 months prior to inspection and all staff have joined during last 2-3 months. Out of them, no one has 02 years special training in Emergency Medicine; hence not eligible (except one Senior Resident)
8. On inspection day, total Surgery – Nil.
9. The total IPD of last 03 years has been shown as 85, 95 & 98. If the department was not in existence then from where these figures have been taken. Similarly, the data of major operations given in the last 03 years is non-genuine.
10. Intensive Care beds of all other departments cannot be counted as emergency beds.
11. Patients waiting area also not there.
12. As per SAF instruments/services available in hospital, not in emergency medicine department.
13. The college authorities have shown casualty ward as emergency medicine department, which is not permissible.
14. Other deficiencies as pointed out in the Assessment Report.

3. Dr. Arun Kudva, Senior Resident is not eligible. He has no 03 years experience at the time of appointment as Senior Resident.
4. Dr. T.H. Shivashankar, Senior Resident does not have experience of 3 years as Resident in a medical college; he cannot be considered.
5. Promotion of Dr. Mayur Rai, Asso. Prof. is not as per Regulations as he has been promoted as Asso. Prof. with experience of only 3 years 2 months against requirement of 5 years as per Regulations.
6. Resultantly, Unit III has only 2 faculty & cannot be considered as PG Unit.
7. There were only 2 Major operations on day of assessment.
8. Academic parameters like Journal Clubs (13/year), Group Discussions (13/year) are inadequate.
9. Total deaths during the last year were 04 out of 2396 admissions, which mean that no serious patients were ever admitted. Either non-genuine patients with minor ailments were admitted or data is non-deserving.
10. Other deficiencies as pointed out in the Assessment Report.

In case, any compliance is being submitted by the college authorities, the same should reach to this Office, directly within one month along with supported documentary evidence. Incomplete/ without proper documents, the compliance would not be entertained/ considered.

**23. Increase of seats in MD (DVL) course at A.J. Institute of Medical Sciences & Research Centre, Mangalore under Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences, Karnataka u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 for the academic year 2016-17.**

3. There is mismatch in data of Declaration Form & Faculty table in respect of Dr. V.A. Shetty with regard to period spent as Lecturer/Senior Resident.



4. Average attendance at Specialty clinics is < 1 in several clinics; in the rest it is 1.
5. Academic parameters like Journal Clubs (22/year), Group Discussions (13/year) are inadequate.
6. Other deficiencies as pointed out in the Assessment Report.

5. Experience details of faculty in different ranks mentioning their department where they worked is not given without which their eligibility to the post they are holding cannot be decided.
6. No faculty has 02 years Special training in Emergency Medicine; hence not eligible.
7. Intensive Care beds of other departments cannot be counted as emergency beds.
8. Other deficiencies as pointed out in the Assessment Report.

8. Dr. Sathya Kumar Biswas has his experience from Army. There is no certificate of experience from the Competent Authority of the Office of the Directorate General of Armed Forces giving his places of posting and experience as Graded, Classified Specialist and Advisor without which his equated academic designation cannot be calculated.
9. Other deficiencies as pointed out in the Assessment Report.

Professor to Associate Professor is not as per Regulations. He was Asstt. Professor for less than 05 years. Consequently, there is deficiency of Assoc.Prof.-1.
5. Other deficiencies as pointed out in the Assessment Report.

7. Average attendance at Specialty clinics like Cancer clinic, Infertility clinic, Gynaec Endocrine clinic is only 3 which is inadequate. At Family Planning clinic it is only 4 which also is inadequate.
8. Prenatal diagnosis services are not available.
9. There was only one death out of 6070 admissions during the last year which indicate that no serious patients were ever admitted. Either non-deserving patients with minor ailments were admitted or data is non-genuine.
10. Prof. J. Karthiki Unit III- Promotion is not as per Regulations. He was Assoc. Prof. for 03 years 11 months without any publication.
11. Dr. Kiran Mahi has been promoted as Assoc. Prof. on 10.08.2015 after the cut off date without any publication, which is not acceptable.
12. Consequently, Unit-III left with only 2 faculty.

3. Pathological post-mortems are not performed.
4. Investigations for Nutritional Anaemia are done in the department of Biochemistry and not in this department, which is not proper.
5. Total number of specimens received of Histopathology and Cytopathology during the year 2015 was 6422. Total reports issued 3828.
6. During the year 2014, total number of specimens of Histopathology and Cytopathology received was 6998. Total reports issued 5415. It is obvious from the above that reports issued are much less than the specimens received. The data is non-genuine and cannot be relied upon.

7. There was only 1 patient in SICU on day of assessment.

13. Average daily major operations (from 03 years data), 3 per day, which is inadequate.
14. Bed occupancy in Burn ICU 20%
15. Laproscopy Endoscopy equipment – non-functional
16. Laproscopic Surgeries 1-2 per month which is grossly inadequate.

8. Average OPD attendance in Obstetrics is shown as 103/day while attendance in Antenatal clinic is shown as 100/day leaving only 3 patients/day for other Postnatal women, Obstetric problems, etc. which is not feasible. There is data mismatch.
9. Academic parameters like Clinical seminars (19/year), Journal Clubs (14/year), Group Discussions (15/year) are inadequate.
10. Total IPD for the year 2014 was 4714. Total number of major operations + deliveries + caesarian were 4817, which is not feasible.
11. There are only 02 publications in 05 years.
12. There was no death out of 4714 admissions, which indicate that no serious patients were admitted. Either non-deserving patients with minor ailments were admitted or data is non-genuine.
13. Dr. C. Rekha, Asstt.Prof., DNB is not eligible. She has no post DNB teaching experience.

7. Audiovisual aids are not available.
8. Promotion of Dr. Ramesh Bajaj is not as per Regulations. He has been promoted as Asso. Prof. with experience of only 5 months as Asst. Prof. and from Asso. Prof. to Professor with experience of only 2 years 1 month as Asso. Prof.; Hence he cannot be accepted.
9. Resultantly, there are only 2 faculty in the only Unit & it cannot be considered as PG Unit. Deficiency of Assoc. Professor: 1.
