51. Kerala University of Health Sciences, Thrissur/ Kerala University - Recognition of MD(Microbiology) qualification for 2 seats in respect of students being trained at M E S Medical College, Perintalmanna Malappuram Distt.Kerala.

Read: the Council Assessor's Report (July, 2016) and compliance dated 23/01/2017 submitted by the college authorities on the standard of examination and other teaching facilities

The Postgraduate Medical Education Committee considered the Council Assessor's Report (July, 2016) and compliance dated 29/12/2016 submitted by the college authorities and decided to recommend to the Central Government that MD(Hospital Administration) qualification against increased intake from 02 to 03 seats granted by Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences, Bangalore in respect of students being trained at Vydehi Institute Of Medical Sciences & Research Centre, Bangalore be recognized and included in the 1st Schedule to the I.M.C. Act, 1956.

The Postgraduate Medical Education Committee further decided that the recognition so granted shall be for a maximum period of 5 years from the date of Notification upon which the Institute shall have to apply for renewal of recognition. Failure to seek timely renewal of recognition as required shall invariably result in stoppage of admission to the Postgraduate Course.

53. West Bengal University of Health Sciences, Kolkata - Recognition of MD(Pharmacology) qualification for 2 seats in respect of students being trained at Midnapore Medical College, Midnapore.

Read: the Council Assessor's Report (July, 2016) and compliance dated 20/01/2017 submitted by the college authorities on the standard of examination and other teaching facilities for Recognition of MD(Pharmacology) qualification for 2 seats at Midnapore Medical College, Midnapore granted by West Bengal University of Health Sciences, Kolkata.

The Postgraduate Medical Education Committee considered the Council Assessor's Report (July, 2016) and compliance dated 20/01/2017 submitted by the college authorities and decided to recommend not to recognize MD(Pharmacology) qualification for 2 seats granted by West Bengal University of Health Sciences, Kolkata in respect of students being trained at Midnapore Medical College, Midnapore because of the following facts:-

Compliance is not satisfactory

1. With regard to promotion of Dr. R.N. Maiti, Prof. & HOD not being as per Regulations due to inadequate research publications, although it is stated there are 15 publications, only 2 have been cited in a compliance; even out of these 2, in 1 he is 3rd author & hence cannot be considered. Thus, it is not clear whether there are 4 eligible research publications in indexed journals to his credit or not.
2. Equipment like Polygraph is not available. PHLC is not available in the department.
3. Animal House: Registration from CPCSEA is not yet available.
4. Additional Technology to minimize animal experiments is not available.
5. Museum facilities are inadequate.
6. Other deficiencies as pointed out in the Assessment Report.

Admissions done (if any) against these seats i.e. 2(Two) seats after the first batch appeared in Examination till their recognition will be irregular/ illegal and not in accordance with MCI regulations (notified with prior permission of Central Government vide notification dated 21/07/2009) and will not be recognized. As per provisions of the Postgraduate Medical Education Regulations, 2000, failure to seek timely recognition as required shall invariably result in stoppage of admission to the concerned Post Graduate Course. This is also clarified in the letter of permission granted u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 issued for these seats, which reads as under:

"This permission for starting/ increase of seats in the above course and admission of students will be till such time the first batch of students admitted against the above course appears for the first final examination in the subject."

In case, the college authorities desire to submit compliance, same should be received in this office preferably within four weeks of issue of this letter but definitely, prior to next admission so that the matter of recognition can be finally decided. If no compliance is received within this period or compliance/ compliance verification is found unsatisfactory, it will result in stoppage of admission to the postgraduate course against the above mentioned seats.

54. Maharashtra University of Health Sciences, Nashik - Renewal of recognition of DCH qualification for 1 seat in respect of students being trained at Dr. Vasantarao Pawar Medical College & Research Centre, Nasik.

The contention of the Institute that it is a time bound promotion as per policy of Govt. of Rajasthan is irrelevant and cannot be accepted as TEQ Regulations are Statutory Regulations and are required to be followed by all and being Central Regulations would prevail over State Rules. Deficiency remains as it is.
2. Promotion of Dr. Riya Narwani as Professor is not as per Regulations as she has nil research publication to her credit against requirement of 4. The contention of the Institute that it is a time bound promotion as per policy of Govt. of Rajasthan is irrelevant and cannot be accepted as TEQ Regulations are Statutory Regulations and are required to be followed by all and being Central Regulations would prevail over State Rules. Deficiency remains as it is.
3. Resultantly deficiency of Faculty (a) Asst.Prof. -1, (b) Tutor-2; remains as it is.
4. Other deficiencies as pointed out in the Assessment Report.

Admissions done (if any) against these seats i.e. increased intake from 3 to 5 seats after the first batch appeared in Examination till their recognition will be irregular/ illegal and not in accordance with MCI regulations (notified with prior permission of Central Government vide notification dated 21/07/2009) and will not be recognized. Admissions done (if any) against these seats i.e. increased intake from 05 to 21 seats after the first batch appeared in Examination till their recognition will be irregular/ illegal and not in accordance with MCI regulations (notified with prior permission of Central Government vide notification dated 21/07/2009) and will not be recognized. As per provisions of the Postgraduate Medical Education Regulations, 2000, failure to seek timely recognition as required shall invariably result in stoppage of admission to the concerned Post Graduate Course. This is also clarified in the letter of permission granted u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 issued for these seats, which reads as under:

"This permission for starting/ increase of seats in the above course and admission of students will be till such time the first batch of students admitted against the above course appears for the first final examination in the subject."
