6. There were only 9 MRI in the entire hospital on the day of assessment.
7. Specialty clinic like Cardiovascular & thoracic Surgery clinic is not run.
8. Attendance at Specialty clinic like Plastic Surgery clinic is low: 1-2 cases/clinic.

It is also shown as "Asst. Prof." 19/02/2018 till date. No explanation is provided for this dichotomy.
4. Bed Occupancy at 10 a.m. on day of assessment was 20 %. Average occupancy of randomly selected days is 20-30 %.
5. Only 2 beds were occupied in PICU, NICU each on day off assessment.
6. OPD workload was mainly for Immunization work only.
7. No Specialty clinic is run.
8. Equipment like Paediatric Bronchoscopy, Paediatric Endoscopy are not available.
9. Thalassaemia Day Care Center is not run.
10. Child Counselling service is not available.
11. Space is inadequate as detailed in the report.

3. Gyanae. OPD only 40 on the day of assessment.
4. Equipment like LEEP are not available.
5. IUI and IVF are not available.
6. Other deficiencies as pointed out in the Assessment Report.

5. On the day of assessment 24 patients were present in 30 beds of the department bed occupancy is 80%. On the review of department hospital record bed occupancy on an average 20 to 30% was noted.
6. Other deficiencies as pointed out in the Assessment Report.
